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## Soviet News Agency Reports Zionist Leaders Said Jewish National Home Was Childish

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Moscow, Jan. 4.—That prominent Zionist leaders had testified before the Palestine Inquiry Commission that they "considered the creation of Palestine as a Jewish National Home just as foolish as a children's tale," was reported today by Tass, the official Russian news agency, in a dispatch emanating from Constantinople.

These same Zionist leaders were further quoted as having said that their "ideal is for Palestine to be converted into a British colony with national and cultural autonomy for the Jews."

On the basis of this dispatch "Pravda" today says editorially that "the Zionist leaders themselves now admit that the legends about a Jewish National Home are just children's tales which hides the real aim of helping Great Britain to maintain Palestine as a colony necessary to protect British imperialistic interests along the Suez Canal. The Zionists volunteered to become the stick in Great Britain's hand to oppress the Arab nationalist movement." The "Pravda" adds that the Palestine Arabs therefore "made no mistake in hating the Zionists and English equally much."

In the Tass's report the Hebrew daily, "Davar," is quoted as having demanded that the British government take away land from the Arab fellaheen and turn it over to the Zionists.

## Arabs of Hebron and Safed to Fight Collective Punishments

Jerusalem, Jan. 4.—The district commissioners at Hebron and Safed have summoned the Arab leaders of both towns preliminary to the levying of the collective punishments. The Arabs of Safed are energetically preparing to contest the collective punishments and have sent a special delegation to Jerusalem to confer with the Arab executive. They expect to engage lawyers to fight the matter while the Safed branch of the Moslem Supreme Council is appealing for contributions to finance the fight.

## "Dos Yiddishe Folk,"

### Z. O. Organ, Discontinued

"Dos Yiddishe Folk," official Yiddish organ of the Zionist Organization of America, will be discontinued, the editor announces. This action has been taken, the announcement explains, because of the urgent necessity for introducing a regime of strict economy in the expenditures of the organization.

## Debtors of Hebron Murder Victims Deny Their Debts

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Jerusalem, Jan. 4.—"Shall the Hebron murderers inherit the money of their victims?" asks the Hebrew daily, "Doar Hayom," in reporting that Arabs indebted to murdered Jews now decline to pay their debts and in some cases allege that they did not receive the money, although they admit the existence of promissory notes. According to the Palestine law, the lender must swear that the borrowers received the money but in view of the massacre this is impossible in many cases.

The paper also asks what has happened to the murderers of Mizrahi, the Jewish youth whose murder was the signal for the August outbreaks, asserting that several Arabs had been arrested at the football field, where the crime was committed but had been bailed out by the Moslem Supreme Council and by their parents. Meanwhile the "Doar Hayom" despairs of justice.

## Split Reported in Syria- Palestine Committee

Cairo, Jan. 4.—A split has been revealed in the ranks of the Syria-Palestine Committee. It is learned that a part of the Committee, headed by Mesim Sebba and Mohamed Ali Taher, supporters of the Grand Mufti, are accusing Dr. Shanhbandhar and his associates of treachery and of carrying on certain activities for their own benefit. The supporters of Dr. Shanhbandhar emphasize the insignificance of the Mufti and deny that the Arab people support him.

A benefit ball for the Arab victims of the Palestine riots, in which some of the most prominent Arabs were to participate, has been cancelled as a result of the quarrel between the two factions.

## Ibn Saud's Foe Seeks Refuge in Syria or Iraq

Jerusalem, Jan. 4.—Feisal Darwish, leader of the rebels and Ibn Saud's implacable foe, is seeking refuge in Iraq or Syria since he was obliged to quit Kuwait where he has been hard-pressed by Ibn Saud's forces. Iraq has refused Darwish a refuge but his application to enter Syria is being considered by the French High Commissioner at Beirut.

Saud is endeavoring to break up possible enemy forces has notified the Sultan Atrash, a famous Druse rebel leader, to evacuate the zone of the Transjordan-Hedjaz boundary. The Arab press reports that this is due to an alleged friendship between Atrash and King Abdullah of Transjordan.

## Greek Government Seeks to Appropriate Part of Jewish Cemetery for Its Refugees

Salonica, Jan. 4.—The Greek government has decided to appropriate a part of the ancient Jewish cemetery here for the settlement of Greek refugees from Adrianople. Senator Mallah and Deputies Bessantchi and Matalon have submitted a memorandum asking that the government postpone the proposed confiscation until Parliament meets January 14.

The memorandum expresses the indignation of the Jewish population and shows that the cemetery has been the property of the Jews of Salonica since 1499 when they came here after the Spanish expulsion.

## Colonial Office Reports on Palestine Unemployment

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

London, Jan. 4.—Despite the disturbed condition of the country since the riots, unemployment figures for the month of October 1929 in Palestine, as just made public by the Colonial office, compare favorably with the figures for October 1928. In October 1929, notwithstanding that nearly 800 workmen entered the country, there were only 700 unemployed Jews and 1,600 unemployed Arabs, while in October 1928 there were 1,400 unemployed Jews and 2,500 unemployed non-Jews. Half of the unemployed Jews in October 1929 are said to have lost their jobs as a result of the disturbances, while about a third of the unemployed Arabs for the same period were in the building trade.

## Harry Sacher on Way to London to See Weizmann

Jerusalem, Jan. 4.—Harry Sacher, chairman of the Palestine Zionist Executive, has left for London in order to see Dr. Chaim Weizmann, president of the World Zionist Organization, before the latter's departure for New York. It is not known when Sacher will return to Jerusalem to resume charge of the Zionist Organization's political department, which he took over for three months and which now reverts to Col. Frederick Kisch.

## Compensation for Riot Victims To Be Paid in February

## Fred Stein Succeeds Sol G. Rosenbaum as President of Montefiore Hospital

The election of Fred M. Stein as president of Montefiore Hospital for Chronic Diseases, following a quarter century of service as a member of the board of trustees of the institution, has been announced by William Goldman, vice-president of the hospital. Mr. Stein took office as of January 1, 1930.

As the third president to hold office since Montefiore was founded in 1884, Mr. Stein succeeds Sol G. Rosenbaum, who resigned the presidency on December 31, after ten years of service, in the belief that rotation in office is desirable.

Montefiore Hospital for Chronic Diseases, which as the foremost hospital for chronics in the country gives more free service than any hospital in its class in New York, according to the impartial findings of the United Hospital Fund, is one of the constituent agencies of the Federation for the Support of Jewish Philanthropic Societies. With the exception of Adolph Lewishohn, who is president of the Hebrew Sheltering Guardian Society and the Hebrew Technical School for Girls, the new president of Montefiore, who has been a member of the board of Federation since its inception in 1917, is the only individual who is the president of two Federation institutions at the same time. In addition to Montefiore, Mr. Stein has been president, for the last sixteen years, of the Committee for the Care of the Jewish Tuberculous, which among other activities maintains a model graduated workshop where the doctors are the bosses and the foremen are the nurses.

A member of the class of '95 of Harvard University, Mr. Stein retired from the banking firm of Borg & Company in 1917 to take up full-time work with the American Red Cross during the war, first in New York and then in Washington. Since that time, he has not been actively connected with business, but has given the major portion of his time to social service work of various kinds.

In addition to being a member of the Federation board and president of two of its institutions, Mr. Stein is secretary of the New York Tuberculosis and Health Association, member of the advisory committee of the Milbank Memorial Fund, member of the executive committee of the Bellevue Yorkville Health Demonstration, chairman of the executive committee, and member of the board of the Potts Memorial Hospital, director of the Training School for Jewish Social Work, and chairman of the Men's Committee of the Child Study Association of America. Mr. Stein has also been chairman of the Allied Dental Clinics, member of the board of the National Tuberculosis Association, and chairman of the health section of the recently completed Jewish Communal Survey.

## Continue Attack on Judge Cayton's Charge of "Jewish Crime Wave"; Rabbi Simon Calls Him Worse Than Klan or "Dearborn Independent"

Washington, D. C., Jan. 4.—"No article from the 'Dearborn Independent' has been as scathing and condemnatory of Israel, and no Ku Klux orator has been more unrighteous," was the unsparing denunciation of Municipal Court Judge Nathan Cayton's recent charge of the existence of a "Jewish crime wave" in an answer delivered here by Rabbi Abram Simon, former president of the Central Conference of American Rabbis, from his pulpit in the Washington Hebrew Congregation.

"Had the address been delivered by a non-Jew, one might have said, 'well what can you expect?' But when one of your own household outdoes the 'Dearborn Independent' and prints poison to become anti-Semitic meat, what self-respecting Jew can withhold his righteous indignation?" asked Rabbi Simon.

Declaring that "no respect of mine for him can withhold me from calling Judge Cayton, the Jew, before the bar of American public opinion for his unseemingly, gratuitous, untrue and cruel condemnation of his people and religion, and yours and mine," Rabbi Simon launched into an extended reply to the young Judge who has brought down upon his head a veritable tidal wave of Jewish indignation since he made his ill-fated remarks at the Adas Israel Synagogue last Friday night.

"Ordinarily one can dismiss with a smile what Nathan Cayton says, but what Judge Cayton says, a government official whose position calls for judicial temper, wide reading and an understanding heart, is quite another thing," declared Rabbi Simon. "However, I am not asking myself what the Gentile will say, I am not asking what motives could have prompted Judge Cayton to deliver such a carefully prepared address to the press before the Hoover Crime Commission has reported its findings. The very words written so nonchalantly and yet containing hidden dynamite should have burned in his soul at the possible effect they must eventually possess. I am not interested in hiding the truth or whitewashing the sins of my people, or finding fault with their sensitiveness. I am interested in knowing the facts, however distressing they may be, nor am I worried at Jewish self-criticism.

"I have known of epidemics of crime due to unemployment, suicidal suggestiveness and intense heat, but I have not known that there was an epidemic of this kind breaking out more or less uniformly all over the land which may be denominated 'Jewish.' I have nowhere heard that any one had the hardihood or the coldness to speak of a Catholic or Protestant crime wave, but I have lived to know a young Jew, stepping out of his position on a municipal bench, to act as a lay preacher in a pulpit, discovering what

he has now christened the 'Jewish crime wave.'

Demanding the facts, Dr. Simon offered his hearers quite an interesting set of figures: "There was a time, we are told, when a prison did not harbor a Jewish criminal in Washington. The fact remains that there was also a time when there were no Jews in Washington. When I came to Washington a quarter of a century ago, there were, in a Jewish population of 5,000, some offenders born in the Jewish fold whose names were on the police docket.

"But why get excited over it? I declare before you today that with our present Jewish population of 15,000 or 3 per cent of the Washington community population, the percentage of Jewish delinquency is far below what would be expected from its population ratio."

Stating that when he wished to ascertain the real effect of a crime wave he sought out the Juvenile Court records, Dr. Simon declared that the court's records showed that in 1914 there were 852 children before it and in 1929 the figure had mounted to 1,051. The number of Jewish children who came officially before the court in 1914 was 31 and there has been a gradual decrease in the number from year to year, until in 1929 but 14 appeared in the court.

He pointed out that in 1928 there were received in Atlanta Penitentiary 2,621 persons, 149 of whom were Jews; in Leavenworth, 70 out of a total of 2,581; at McNeil Island, 12 out of a total of 655; and at the Chillicothe Reformatory for persons between the ages of 17 and 30, 11 of the 490 were Jewish.

After voicing a protest against Judge Cayton's accusations, Rabbi Simon concluded by saying that "we Jews must therefore resent with all the power at our command, the unwarranted statements made by an inexperienced youth."

## Says No Special Privileges for Jewish Settlers Over Natives Solution for Palestine Problem

(J. T. A. Mail Service)

Cairo, Egypt, Dec. 19.—That Jewish immigrants to Palestine should get no special privileges over the native inhabitants, is the suggestion made by the local Arabic newspaper, "Al Mokattam," for solving the Palestine problem. In an article entitled, "Without Prejudice," the newspaper says:

"If the British government really wants to solve the problem which Palestine presents to the administration, then the way to do it is two-fold. First, there should be permission for Jews to enter Palestine as they used to do, and in the same way as people enter other countries. They must come in according to regulations made by the Department of Immigration, regulations which are to be especially drawn up for the purpose. The government will give these people protection, but will give the new immigrants no special privilege over the native inhabitants of the country. They will be treated as immigrants into other countries are treated, all over the face of God's earth."

"Should they become the majority of those in the country during the course of years, then of course they will hold the reins of government in their hands. If, as we sincerely hope, they will remain a minority, then they will be treated as a minority, having merely the rights of a minority."

"In addition it would be sound policy for Great Britain, while retaining the Mandate, to give local government to the people of Palestine, reserving to itself the right of keeping a watch on such a government to see that it carries out the terms of the Mandate."

"If these two suggestions were put into practice, Palestine would have peace. The National Home would depend on time and on immigration and would not depend on artificial props which could be swept away with the first gusts of an unfriendly wind."

## Call Emergency Meeting to Discuss Federation's Deficit

An emergency meeting of the Federation for the Support of Jewish Philanthropic Societies will be held Wednesday to discuss plans for removing the first deficit in the Federation's annual budget that it has faced in thirteen years. A goal of \$2,047,000 was announced when the Federation began its campaign on October 20, but subscriptions to date are \$258,000 short of this needed sum.

As a result of this deficit the campaign will be continued until the evening of January 10, whereas in other years the total amount had been subscribed before the last day of the year. Sam A. Lewisohn, chairman of the campaign, will preside at Wednesday's meeting, which will follow a luncheon at the Bankers' Club.

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## Phi Epsilon Pi Gives \$10,000 to National Farm School

Cincinnati, O., Jan. 4.—Phi Epsilon Pi, national Jewish college fraternity, at its convention here, voted a donation of \$10,000 to the National Farm School, a non-sectarian institution for agricultural training located at Doylestown, Pa., near Philadelphia. The Farm School has an enrollment of about 300 students and was founded by the late Dr. Joseph Krauskopf.

The Rabbi Benjamin Frankel award of \$250 was decided to help a needy member of the fraternity to complete his education. It was created in memory of Rabbi Frankel, founder of the Hillel Foundation of the B'nai B'rith, who died about two years ago.

All national officers were re-elected for another year and are as follows: Eugene Zacharias, of Atlanta, Ga., president; Louis Fushan, of Pittsburgh, Pa., vice-president; Charles Fleishman, of Philadelphia, Pa., secretary; and Emanuel Wirkman, of Philadelphia, Pa., treasurer.

## Spanish Cabinet to Consider Jewish Settlement Shortly

That the Spanish cabinet will at a meeting within the next few days take up the matter of Jewish immigration into Spain, was the statement made by Primo De Rivera, Spanish premier and dictator, to Z. H. Rubinstein, city editor of the "Day," according to a dispatch to that paper from Madrid, dated January 3. The cabinet will consider which part of the country is best for Jewish immigration and how large an immigration Spain today can absorb.

"I wish to tell you that I know my country, I know the sentiment of our people, and I declare to you in all seriousness and with the entire feeling of responsibility which I carry that he old hatred towards Jews has vanished from our country," said De Rivera to Rubinstein. "Through me, there talks to you modern Spain, which wishes to forget the horrors of the mediaeval ages and which wishes to atone for the expulsion of four hundred years ago, when government heralds went through the streets of our towns and proclaimed that if every Jew who hasn't been baptized didn't leave the country within four months, we would be killed."

"Our invitation to the Jews is a whole-hearted one," the Premier concluded. "We wish them to come and work with us in full harmony and live with us in peace."

## Reach Agreement Between Polish and American Jewish Actors

Reubin Guskin, manager of the American-Jewish Actors' Union, returned to New York this week after visiting Poland, Russia and other European countries. While abroad, he reached an agreement with the Jewish Actors' Society of Poland which will put an end to the long dispute between American and Polish-Jewish actors.

Nathan Cayton of the Municipal Court in Washington, in which he charged the existence of a Jewish crime wave as "utterly false as well as injudicious. They fly contrary to facts and statistics."

"Whether the remarks of the Judge were inspired by his desire to curry favor with the Gentiles by posing as a stern and impartial critic, or whether it was due to gross ignorance, I cannot tell. Let us give him the benefit of the doubt and say that he is a victim of an illusion to which unthinking masses are so much subjected. These people have what we call in psychology stereotyped judgments of minority groups, which are derived from the few delinquent members which stand out prominently in their minds. The word 'Jew' brings to their minds not a Heifetz or a Rosenwald, but a Rothstein. We can condone such opinions when they are held by ignorant and unthinking individuals, but that they should be entertained by a man holding the high office that Judge Cayton does is indefensible."

## David Brown Not to Head Coming Joint Campaign

David A. Brown, national chairman of the United Jewish Campaign since September, 1925, will not accept the leadership of the forthcoming combined United Jewish Campaign and United Palestine Appeal for Palestinian and European activities, as it has been presumed, according to a letter which he has just sent out to co-workers in the campaign.

"I have definitely stated that under no circumstances can I accept any important responsibility in the contemplated campaign," says Mr. Brown in his letter. "That my heart shall always be with any effort to relieve the conditions across the seas goes without saying. The chances are that I shall accept such responsibilities as will come to a worker in the ranks, and shall be happy to render such service as will be possible in the light of my many other activities and responsibilities."

## Rabbi Heads Successful Tuberculosis Seal Drive

Selma, Ala., Jan. 4.—Dallas County, Alabama, of which this city is the county seat and principal city, has just concluded a most successful Christmas Seal sale for the Tuberculosis Association, under the chairmanship of Rabbi Jerome Mark.

One thousand dollars were raised, which is twenty-five percent more than its quota set by the State Association. Five hundred dollars was the highest sum ever raised in Selma and the County before. Rabbi Mark doubled his sum, and the state office in Birmingham is now requesting the rabbi to head the tuberculosis work for the county permanently.
