Mufti Named Chairman of Arab Delegation Being Sent to London Shortly

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Jerusalem, Jan. 11—After strenuous balloting at the meeting of the Arab Executive the five members of the Arab delegation to London were chosen. The Grand Mufti will be chairman and the other four are Abdul Auni, secretary; Mayor Nashashibi of Jerusalem, Alfred Roch and Jamal Hussein, secretary of the Arab Executive. Mouza Kazim, president of the Arab Executive and Maughanem, Arab counsel at the Inquiry hearings, were defeated.

A resolution of thanks to Auni and to Maughanem for their successful presentation of the Arab case before the Commission was adopted. Replying to the resolution, Auni declared that the Commission's proceedings were favorable to the Arabs but that justice is liable to be imperilled if it is unsupported by vigorous demands.

The Arab Executive decided to send protests to the Colonial Office and to the League of Nations and to import newspapers against the Seditious Law and the arrest of Mouza Far and other agitators. The meeting also dealt with Jewish immigration and land purchases. There is a rumor that Maughanem, embittered at his failure to be chosen one of the delegates may start dissension within the Arab Executive.

Jews of Norwegian Town Mourn as Anti-Schchita Law Goes Into Effect

Berlin, Jan. 11—The Jewish community of Drondheims in Norway has set aside a number of days for mourning as a result of the new anti-schchita law going into effect. In his mourning sermon, Rabbi Jacobson expressed the hope that the rights of the Jewish religion would eventually be victorious.

Suppresses Anti-Semitism for Fear of Foreign Criticism

Vienna, Jan. 11—The Roumanian government has decided to take energetic measures to fight the revival of anti-Semitism, fearing unfavorable comment abroad. The Roumanian Ministers in Washington and London, particularly, have informed the Foreign Minister in Bucharest of the new intercessions of British and American Jewish organizations and their new interest aroused in the Roumanian Jewish situation.

The Ministries of Education, Interior and Justice have therefore decided to suppress as sternly as possible any anti-Semitic actions, especially student excesses.

J. T. A. Broadcasts Over WMCA, Beginning Today

Starting today (January 13), the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, in co-operation with A. Goodman & Sons, will broadcast every Monday at 8.30 P. Polish Premier Dismisses Jewish Problem Briefly

Warsaw, Jan. 11—Premier Bartel, in a two and a half hours' talk in the Sejm yesterday on the problems of the Polish nation, devoted only one short sentence to the Jewish problem.

"Directions for the regulation of the Jewish religious communities are being prepared in the form of a series of ordinances for the purpose of regulating the various activities of these communities and their relation to the state," was all the Premier had to say about Polish Jewry's problems. The Premier devoted just about as much attention to the Jews as he did to the Mohammedans and Karaites, saying:

"Our religious program also takes in the regulation by law of the relation of the Mohammedan and Karaite religions to the state."

Jatzkan Again Editor of Warsaw "Hajnt"

Warsaw, Jan. 11—Sh. Jatzkan, a former editor of the Warsaw Yiddish daily "Hajnt," one of the leading Yiddish newspapers of Europe, has again been named editor to succeed A. Goldberg, the present editor, who is resigning because of ill-health. Mr. Goldberg, will, however, still remain a member of the "Hajnt" staff.

LORD MELCHETT LEAVES FOR SOUTH AFRICAN TRIP

London, Jan. 11—Lord Melchett, president of the English Zionist Federation, and Lady Melchett, left yesterday for South Africa, where the Imperial Chemical Industries, of which Lord Melchett heads the board, has vast interests. Lord Melchett's trip to South Africa is to investigate South African fuel.

New York Jewish Engineer Gets \$100,000,000 Contract from Roumanian Government

Bucharest, Jan. 11—The New York Jewish construction firm of David Oltarsh, Inc. has been awarded a \$100,000,000 contract by the Roumanian government to build houses for government employes in Bucharest and other large cities. The Oltarsh firm is to do the work in cooperation with another American engineering concern and a number of German contractors.

David M. Oltarsh, president of the company, has been in Bucharest for many weeks negotiating with Premier Maniu and other officials of the government party. Mr. Oltarsh's contract is signed by M. Clinchy, president of the Roumanian Senate. Special legislation providing for the creation of a funding bank to pay the costs of the housing construction was passed by the Roumanian Parliament during Mr. Oltarsh's stay in Bucharest.

Mr. Oltarsh, who is 46 years old, is the son of Wolfe Oltarsh, who came here from Russia when he was 16, and is the founder of the Oltarsh Engineering Company. David Oltarsh's company has built some of the leading buildings in New York, including the Court-Montague Building the Bank of the United States Building, the Bar Building, the 36 Wall Street Building, 400 Madison Avenue, the Gallo and Colony Theatres, and a number of synagogues.

Warsaw Kehillah Pays Honor to Nahum Sokolow

Warsaw, Jan. 11—Nahum Sokolow, Zionist leader, was honored yesterday by the Warsaw Kehillah. Speeches greeting Sokolow were delivered by Deputies Farbstein, Feldstein and Gottlieb and by Rabbis Kahane and Posner. The occasion was recorded in the Souvenir Book of the Kehillah.

Would Give Suicides' Bodies to Warsaw Anatomical Institute

Warsaw, Jan. 11—A proposal that the bodies of suicides be given to the anatomical institute as a means of frightening off prospective suicides, was suggested by Dr. Bychowski, Zionist and associate magistrate. In a memorandum to the Warsaw kehillah (Jewish community) Dr. Bychowski pointed out that such disposal of suicides' bodies would also settle the problem of how to provide corpses for the Jewish medical students.

**New Order Bans Individual
Land Settlement in Russia**
(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Moscow, Jan. 11—Individual settling on the land in Russia will be discontinued, according to an order from the Land Commissariat requesting definitely that from now on the collective form exclusively be applied when settling newcomers on the soil. While the order puts an end to the present system of Jewish colonization which has been conducted on an individual basis, the Jewish organizations concerned are not surprised for they expected such an order and have plans on hand now as to how best to settle the Jews in the future on the land and collectivizing them from the first day of settling.

The entire Yevypartorian region has been proclaimed by the government as the first region in Crimea to be entirely collectivized without a single individual farm remaining. It is learned that the Crimean government is asking the Central government to apply the Yevypartorian order to the entire Crimean Republic.

**Brith Sholom Order Will
Mark 25th Anniversary**
(Jewish Daily Bulletin)

Philadelphia, Jan. 11—The twenty-fifth anniversary of the Independent Order of Brith Sholom will be celebrated here, its headquarters and in leading Jewish communities where the Order has lodges, February 21. The Order, which was founded by a group of 44, has today grown to an organization with lodges in 63 cities and 21 states. Judge William M. Lewis, national chairman of the United Palestine Appeal, is Grand Master of the Order.

The celebration in Philadelphia will be city-wide.

**Sees Religion in Roumanian
Schools Causing Conversions
Among the Jewish Youth**

The fear that an unusually large number of the Roumanian Jewish youth may a few years hence withdraw from the Jewish community and become baptized into Christianity as a result of the fact that Jewish children in Roumania now are forced to take Christian religious instruction in the schools, is expressed in a recent article in the Roumanian Jewish paper, "Stiri." The writer blames the parents for their indifference to the situation and says:

"The attitude of indifference on the part of Jewish parents and pupils has brought now, and will bring in the future even more, dire consequences. Today perhaps they are not filled with a disquieting fear, but their attitude will bring them in the near future the greatest discomforts.

"It is not so hard to foresee that the lack of pride and of Jewish consciousness, which Jewish parents and pupils now show, will encourage the educational authorities to annul the rights won until now by the Jews. On the other hand I think I am not far from the right when I predict for the next few years an unheard of large number of withdrawals from Judaism and mass conversions among the youth, for the youth will be free of all moral obligations and will have no reason for cherishing and preserving those Jewish ethical values which are utterly unknown to it.

"It is also not difficult to foresee that the educational authorities and the Christian religious teachers, who today are disregarding an existing law, since the enforcement of that law is not demanded strongly enough from them, will in the near future abolish entirely a law which is not being used and which is of no use.

"Then the Jewish parents, after a few years when the plague of baptism will rap at every door, will awake and will ask that their children be exempted from Christian religious instruction. But then the education authorities may quite properly refuse them, since they may claim that this is a demand which from long disuse has proven itself to be absolutely useless and harmful for the school system.

"I should be glad if my prophecies were not to come true."

**Detroit School Board Honors
Memory of Louis Goldberg,
Israel Zangwill's Classmate**

Detroit, Jan. 11—The board of education of Detroit has honored the memory of the late Louis J. Goldberg by accepting from the Goldberg family the portrait of the deceased and a picture of "The Spirit of '76," to be placed in the Goldberg School. The offer was made in a communication from Sara Cooper Goldberg in behalf of her brother, Claude K. Goldberg, and sisters, Adah G. Norman and Mildred G. Cohen, and herself.

The late Louis J. Goldberg, who was a member of the board of education, passed away in 1913. He was educated in London, England, and in his early youth was a classmate of the late Israel Zangwill. He was a brother of the late school inspector Hiram Cooper Goldberg, who at the time of his passing, in 1913, was president of the board of education. The Hiram Goldberg Athletic Field was named in his memory.

**Dr. Herman Adler, Illinois
State Criminologist, Quits**

Chicago, Jan. 11—Dr. Herman M. Adler, state criminologist since 1917, tendered his resignation to Governor Louis L. Emmerson yesterday because of illness in his family. It was announced at the same time at the state capital, Springfield, that "Dr. Adler had accepted a professorship of psychiatry at the University of California at Berkeley. Dr. Adler also will be consultant of the California state department of institutions.

Regret at the loss of Dr. Adler was expressed by both Gov. Emmerson and Rodney Brandon, director of the state department of public welfare. Dr. Adler has been in the service of the state since July 1, 1927, when the office, the first of its character in the country, was created under the administration of Governor Frank O. Lowden. From its inception, Dr. Adler was regarded as the leading scientist employed in this work.

Jewish Delinquency in New York Decreasing Faster than That of General Population, Figures from Judge Rosalsky's Office Show

Figures tending to show that not only is the percentage of Jewish criminals less than the percentage of the Jewish population to the whole population but that despite the increase over the last ten years in the Jewish population a decline in Jewish adult delinquency has been noted and that the Jewish juvenile delinquency rate has been decreasing more rapidly than that of the general population were made public today through the Jewish Telegraphic Agency by Judge Otto Rosalsky of the Court of General Sessions. The statistics were compiled for Judge Rosalsky by Edwin J. Cooley, chief probation officer of the Court of General Sessions.

The figures recently made public by the American Jewish Committee in refutation of the charge by Judge Nathan Cayton of municipal court of the District of Columbia, that Jews contribute more than their proportionate share of criminals, are confirmed by the statistics released by Judge Rosalsky.

According to these figures in 1916 the rate of Jewish adult delinquency was 0.89 percent of the Jewish population as compared with 0.76 in 1920. During this same period there has been a 20 percent increase in the Jewish population of New York for which these figures are. The number of Jewish inmates committed to Randafts Island has decreased from 14.88 percent in 1924 to 5.86 in 1925 and 5.2 in 1926.

Dr. Cooley's report to Judge Rosalsky reveals that from 1920 to 1926, 8,484 or 22.9 of the total of juveniles arranged for delinquency in New York were Jewish. In the children's courts 976 cases of Jewish children in 1926 as compared with 1,739 cases of Jewish children in 1916, a decrease of 43.9 is reported. In this connection Dr. Cooley says that the Jewish juvenile delinquency rate has been lower than that of the general population and has been decreasing faster, having fallen from 0.115 per cent of the Jewish population in 1916 to only 0.056 in 1926.

In other cities similar law-abiding tendencies upon the part of Jews are reported says Dr. Cooley. Of 668 arraignments in the Buffalo children's court in 1928 only seven were Jewish cases. This is at a rate of less than one-fourth of the Jewish to the general population. Out of 300 inmates at the Erie County Jail in 1928 only two were Jews. At the Erie County Penitentiary there were two Jews of a total of 872 in 1929.

In Newark where the Jewish population is 15 percent of the total there were no Jewish children in the Parental Home at the time of the survey in 1928 and information obtained from the superintendent showed that few Jewish children were there during the past several years. Of 220 boys at the New Jersey State Home for Boys there were only two Jews in 1928. At the state prison in Elmira Warden Christian declared that there were 67 Jews com-

mitted in 1924, 60 in 1925, 50 in 1926, 37 in 1927, and that there has been a constant decrease in the last ten years. Jews once composed 15 percent of Elmira's prison population and now they are but 5 percent.

Young Judaea Issues Jewish National Fund Program

In accordance with its policy to keep the Jewish youth of America well informed on Jewish achievements in Palestine, Young Judaea has issued a special program on the Jewish National Fund, the land purchasing agency in Palestine. The program is intended primarily for Jewish youth groups and adult study groups.

In addition to a full statement on the history of the National Fund, its land policy, its institutions and its problems, the program contains suggestions for a series of open meetings, discussions and debates. There are also included biographies of the men who were most prominent in the making of the Jewish National Fund during its thirty years of existence.

The appearance of the Jewish National Fund program was timed with the National Conference of the Jewish National Fund to be held in Philadelphia on Sunday, January 19, which will launch an enlarged program of activities for the fund in the United States.

HEBREW NATION CAN BECOME FACT IN PALESTINE THOUGH JEWS REMAIN A MINORITY, SAYS FRENCH ECONOMIST

That a Hebraic nation can be established in Palestine even though the Jews remain for a long time in the minority there, is the opinion expressed by Professor Charles Gide, the well-known French economist and friend of Zionism, in a recent issue of "La Terre Retrouvée," organ of the Jewish National Fund of France. Says Professor Gide:

"It is to be hoped that the tragic occurrences in Palestine will not destroy the great work of Zionism. But these occurrences are a warning which must be taken seriously, since they show that as a result of Jewish nationalism, a Palestinian-Arab nationalism has been created.

"Let us beware of the notion that a superior civilization entails the right to rule, the notion which justifies rule over less-developed races. Jews, even Zionists, even Revisionists, shouldn't adopt such a political orientation, and under no circumstances will England—especially now—and the League of Nations admit this. It seems to me that the future of Palestine can be conceived only as Jewish-Arabic, with equal political rights for both races as in many other bi-lingual or tri-lingual countries, like Belgium, Switzerland, Finland, Czechoslovakia and Yugoslavia. I believe that the majority of Zionists agrees to this solution of the

Asks Christians, as Evidence of Good-Will, Cease Teaching That Jews Killed Jesus

That Christian ministers should stop teaching children in the Sunday schools that the Jews are responsible for the crucifixion of Jesus is demanded in a recent letter to the London "Jewish Chronicle" by D. G. Baker, who notes with disappointment that at the recent conference of Jews and Christians held in London for the purpose of bringing about a better understanding between the faiths the Christian ministers didn't give positive proof of their desire to establish good will.

"To detest the Jew is the first lesson the Christian child receives," says the writer. "His first lesson is at his mother's, or nurse's, knee; he is there taught that God came down on earth and lived as a Man in order to save mankind, but that the wicked Jews killed him. When the child is a little older, he learns, at day-school and at Sunday-school, alleged details as to how Judas, the Jew, with all a Jew's avarice and greed for money, 'betrayed' the Lord for thirty pieces of silver, and delivered Him into the hands of his enemies—the Jews, of course. The young child is supplied with minute particulars of the sufferings of his Lord and Saviour on the Cross. It follows, quite naturally, that the Christian child, having imbibed this teaching, finds his heart going out to the Jews in an ecstasy of love and good-

problem, though hoping some day to attain a majority. This hope seems to me doubtful. The probabilities of a Jewish majority in Palestine are not greater than that of a French majority in Algiers, and for the same reason: the immigration and colonization of Jews in Palestine, of Frenchmen in Algiers—promotes the increase of the native population through increasing the yield of the soil, better hygienic conditions and better living conditions in general. In this way the natural increase becomes greater than the artificial increase through immigration.

"Besides the increase of the agricultural population is limited in Palestine by the amount of land available for tilling. This limit however, cannot be applied to the population of the cities. If Tel Aviv or Haifa should some day become as thickly populated as Alexandria, the question of numbers will be solved in favor of the Jews. But even then it won't be the whole land of Israel that will be under Jewish control, but only the coastal plain, which formerly, before Palestine was conquered by the Hebrews, was the home of the Canaanite or Phoenician traders.

"But numbers do not mean everything, even when there is universal suffrage, and it is not necessary to

Young Jewish Pacifists in Germany Protest Against Arab Death Sentences

A protest by an organization in Germany calling itself "Circle of Young Jewish Pacifists" is published in the Berlin "Juedisch-Liberale Zeitung" of December 18th. The protest reads in part:

"The farce has begun. The courts are going on with their work. Punishments are being meted out, collective punishments which remind one of veritable war methods and of the iron rule which civilization feels called upon to exercise in colonial and semi-colonial countries. And death sentences are now being meted out which are being 'confirmed' in the courts.

"One knows these actions of justice. The few murderers who were incited to their deeds will be sternly dealt with by the law—as everywhere—but the real guilty ones will go unpunished and will vanish behind a historical curtain.

"What is Jewish public opinion doing about it? True there are only a few unimportant Arab proletarians, plebeians—yes, there is also a Jew among them. But the Jewish press is satisfied to record these death sentences, just as one gives a notice about the stock exchange rates or about a meeting of a society, and Jewish organizations, who consider the principle of humanitarianism and justice usually as an important one, are wrapped in silence—now, just when they should speak the loudest.

"No Jewish voice is aroused. The 'Circle of Young Jewish Pacifists' was the only Jewish organization to protest against the unheard-of methods of the Palestine courts. Unfortunately we haven't succeeded until now in getting at least the entire Jewish youth behind our protest. But the Jewish youth must take this step! Let us with all our might demand justice in the Holy Land! The principle of Judaism demands that we say: 'We want no justice based on revenge and retaliation.'

"Jews and Arabs will in the future have to live in peace in Palestine. Such methods cannot lead to peace."

12th Triennial Convention of Council of Jewish Women Opens Today in Los Angeles

Los Angeles, Jan. 11.—The first session of the twelfth Triennial Convention of the National Council of Jewish Women opens here Monday at the Hotel Biltmore, with Mrs. Joseph E. Friend of New Orleans, national president, presiding. Over five hundred women from all parts of the country are gathering here for the convention which will close Friday night.

Monday's speakers at the opening session will be the Governor of California; the Mayor of Los Angeles; Mrs. Hannah J. Solomon of Chicago, honorary president and founder of the council; Mrs. Friend, and Mrs. Lillian Burkhart Goldsmith, president of the Los Angeles chapter of the council.

"Jewish Education" Magazine Ends First Year of Publication

Philadelphia, Jan. 11.—The National Council for Jewish Education, of which Ben Rosen, Director of the Associated Talmud Torahs of Philadelphia, is president, has just published the third issue of "Jewish Education," a quarterly devoted to a review and a record of American Jewish educational experiences and opinions.

This magazine is the only current Jewish educational periodical published in English. It reflects all the new tendencies, programs and experiments in Jewish education, and offers complete news and critical analysis of the aims and methods of all Jewish educational material as it appears.

With the current issue "Jewish Education" rounds out its first year. During this period many important problems have been discussed, a large number of educational studies made, and much news in the field of Jewish education, both here and abroad, presented.

The current issue is devoted largely to reports of the fourth annual conference of the National Council for Jewish Education, with special emphasis on Jewish extension activities. In this connection there are articles on "A Community Program of Extension Education," and another on the "Extension High School in Philadelphia."

Of great interest in this issue is an appreciation of the life and character of Louis Marshall by Dr. S. Benderly, a life-long friend and co-worker. In this issue is also published the last official statement in regard to Jewish education, written in the form of a letter, shortly before his death, by Louis Marshall himself.

There is also an evaluation of the tendencies in Jewish education by Dr. Emanuel Gamoran, Educational Director, Department of Synagogue and School Extension, in which he points out that "the greatest achievement in the last ten or fifteen years in Jewish education has been the gradual but constant growth of communal responsibility throughout the country."

The magazine is edited by Dr. Alexander M. Dushkin, in association with Dr. Jacob S. Golub, Dr. Leo L. Honor and Ben M. Edidin.

have a majority in order to wield power. In Palestine the Jewish minority now is one-fifth of the population—that is much. According to all signs, this minority will some day become a quarter or a half of the population and this minority will, in a cultural and economic sense, have the upper hand; so it will be quite easy for it to re-create in Palestine a Hebrew nation.

"But this will only be possible if Palestine remains under the British Mandate. If it should become autonomous—even in the form of a dominion—there is little hope that the Arabs will respect the rights of the Jewish minority and allow it free development.

"Will, therefore, autonomy have to be refused Palestine for a long time in order to establish and secure a Jewish national home? Most assuredly this is today one of the many serious problems of the rights of peoples with which we are confronted.

"In spite of that, however, we should not give up the hope for a reconciliation of the two peoples, who throughout their history were friends. The Arabs will be conciliated if the Zionists do not insist too strongly on their right of primogeniture and will not regard themselves as the only ones who should lord it over the entire heritage."

But the child is not taught that all this is about something or other that is supposed to have taken place nearly 2,000 years ago; the child is not taught that all the 'evidence' in support of the allegations consists merely of an unsigned undated and anonymous writing, the authenticity of which is doubted even by eminent Churchmen.

"Will the Ministers of the Christian religion, who addressed the Conference of Jews and Christians, give a little practical proof of their desire for 'true fellowship in thought and action,' which is one of the main objects of these conferences? Will those ministers now, in the Sunday-schools and religious classes under their control, cease teaching the children that the Jews killed their God? If they will do so, and if they will influence the leaders of other Protestant churches to act likewise, they will be doing what is far and away the finest and noblest thing Christianity will have accomplished in the whole course of its history."
