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Privy Council Denies Appeal of Arabs Sentenced to Death for Murder of Palestine Jews

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

London, Mar. 29—The appeal of a number of Palestine Arabs who had been sentenced to death in cases arising from the murder of Jews during last Summer's riots, was rejected yesterday by the judicial committee of the Privy Council, the highest legal tribunal in the British Empire. Counsel for the Arabs argued that the Palestine courts had not given due consideration to the Ottoman penal code which should have been applied in these cases.

Lords Dunedin, Thankerton and Mac-Millan, who comprised the committee that dismissed the appeals, pointed out that the appeals were brought not from the decision of the trial judge, but from the judgment of the Court of Criminal Appeals, which had heard all the arguments about the interpretation of the Ottoman penal code and the criminal ordinance. Acting as spokesman for the committee, Lord Dunedin said, "we cannot give the leave asked for without infringing principles relating to appeals which have regulated our practice for many years."

The counsel for the appellants had argued that the difference in Ottoman law between murder with premeditation and willful killing was quite distinct from that in the English law code between murder and manslaughter. He said that many acts that would be considered murder in English law would not be murder with premeditation in Ottoman law.

Goldberg Declares Zionist Ranks and Administration Ready for Brandeis Accord

Pittsburgh, Mar. 29—A statement to the effect that there is no doubt that the Zionist rank and file and the Zionist administration in the United States are prepared to go a long way to have Justice Louis D. Brandeis return to the helm and resume his leadership of the movement was made here today to the "Jewish Indicator" by Abraham Goldberg, vice-president of the Zionist Actions Committee and a member of the Administrative Committee of the Zionist Organization of America.

Mr. Goldberg said too "it is clear also that the Zionists really would like to see all elements and all factions united on a common platform. It is their conviction that this would involve too many compromises. Zionists will regret that no way has yet been found at the last conference in Wash-

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Schatchens Organize to Force Payment of Fees

The much-maligned and historic Jewish profession of schatchen or marriage broker is about to be legalized and organized. No longer will the umbrella-toting votary of Dan Cupid have to argue, plead, beg and cajole for his fee in a case which has resulted in a more or less happy match, for the schatchens have incorporated themselves as the Marriage Brokers' Association of the United States and are about to appeal to the state legislature for legal standing.

In addition to being able to compel payment of fees, the legalization of the ancient profession will enable the schatchens to drive out unscrupulous match-makers and marriage brokers, who have often deceived the parties to a match.

Police Disperse Meeting Addressed by Apostate

Vilna, Mar. 29—The police here yesterday dispersed a large gathering which assembled in the mission-house on Metropolitanska Street to listen to a lecture by Friedrich Pistol, a "meshumad," (apostate), on "Pesach Among Jews," after Pistol declared in the course of his lecture that since the time of Egypt Passover has always been for Jews a symbol of blood.

Congressman Sabath, Speaking at Chicago Hias Conference, Assails Present Immigration Law; Pledges Fight on Registration Bill

Chicago, Mar. 30—Congressman A. J. Sabath, for twenty-two years a member of the Immigration Committee of the House of Representatives, speaking at the Chicago conference of the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society of America, held at the Masonic Temple today, bitterly assailed the present harsh, inhuman, discriminatory immigration law which permits over 150,000 Mexicans, Canadians, Central and South Americans to enter annually and prohibits the entry of the wives and children of old residents and declarants and even of the husbands and aged parents of United States citizens.

He characterized the giving to the husbands and parents of American citizens a preferential status within the quota as mockery—as in all of these cases the quota of country of birth is so small that it will take years before they can be reached.

Jewish Workers on Roumanian Railroads Fear Loss of Jobs Following Registry Order

Vienna, Mar. 29—Jewish employees of Roumanian railroads now fear that they may be dismissed from their posts, as a result of a letter which the Temesvar railroad directors have received from the government in Bucharest requesting that they register all German, Hungarian and Jewish employees of the railroad and send the list of names to Bucharest.

The fear of the Jewish employees is based on the fact that recently the government factories dismissed all officials and employees who belong to the minority nationalities in Roumania.

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J. N. F. Holdings in Palestine Increased Since August Riots

The land possessions of the Jewish National Fund, the Zionist land purchasing agency in Palestine, have been increased by approximately 11,000 dunams during the period following the August riots, according to a report from Jerusalem made public by the American Bureau of the Jewish National Fund. The report, which was submitted to the meeting at the General Zionist Council held last week in London, covers a period of eight months, beginning June 1, 1929, to March 3, 1930.

Popular impressions to the contrary, the report states that there are now great opportunities for large scale land purchases in Palestine. The opportunities have increased following the August riots, as many Arab land-owners are eager to sell land to the Jewish National Fund. The Zionist land purchasing agency obtained from much activity in this direction in view of its unwillingness to increase the Fund's financial obligations.

The acquisition of new land by the Jewish National Fund included an area of 2,300 dunams, purchased with the funds supplied by the Zionists of Pittsburgh for the creation of a colony in the Valley of Jezreel, which is to be known as "Nachlath Pittsburgh".

Professor Winkler's Will Provides Fund for Students

Ann Arbor, Mich., Mar. 29—The will of the late Prof. Max Winkler, for many years head of the German department of the University of Michigan, who died March 14, provides for \$5,000 to be used as the principal sum of a fund from which students of the college of literature, science and the arts of the university may borrow. The fund has been named the Winkler Loan Scholarship Fund in honor of the memory of Professor Winkler's parents, Simon M. and Matilda Winkler. The total of the estate is in excess of \$100,000 and the widow is named executrix.

1,000 ATTEND SESSIONS OF FIRST CONVENTION OF YIDDISH CULTURE SOCIETY IN UNITED STATES

In the presence of nearly a thousand persons, delegates from Yiddish cultural organizations in various parts of the United States and Canada and their guests, the first annual convention of the Yiddish Kultur Gesellschaft, the society for promoting the Yiddish language and literature in this country, was opened Friday night at the Irving Plaza Hall, Manhattan. The convention continued all day yesterday and closes tonight.

Dr. Chaim Zhitlowsky, intellectual leader of the Yiddishists, and Zalman Raisin, editor of the "Tog" of Vilna, Poland, and author of the "Lexicon of Yiddish Literature," were the two main speakers at the opening session. Messages were received from Prof. John Dewey of Columbia, eminent American philosopher; Thomas L. Cotton, director of the Foreign Language Information Service; Prof. Simeon Dubnow, famous Jewish historian; Prof. A. A. Tuck of Cambridge, Mass.; from Yiddish writers' organizations in New York, Argentina and Palestine, and from the Federation of Yiddish Schools in Poland.

"No one can deny now that there is such a thing as a culture in Yiddish," said Dr. Zhitlowsky in his address. "Jewish culture in the Yiddish language is now a fact. It is not only a culture for the great Jewish masses, but it has also drawn to itself a great part of the Jewish intelligentsia.

"Yiddish culture is now world-wide. We in America are only a link in the great chain of Yiddish cultural creativeness. The Yiddish language is the national-psychic connecting force which links us all together. All Jewish movements throughout the world must make use of Yiddish if they wish to appeal to the Jewish masses.

"But it is not only a mass-culture which is being created. We have now higher cultural achievements. The Yiddish Scientific Institute of Vilna, of which Einstein, Freud and even great non-Jewish scientists are honorary members, is one of these achievements."

In the course of his speech Dr. Zhitlowsky also attacked the American "melting pot" idea, declaring that "we are all good Americans, but we want to be not only good citizens of the United States, but in the United Peoples of the United States. At the same time we want the Anglo-Saxons here to be our 'big brothers'. We want the English language to be the expression of our material home, and Yiddish that of our spiritual home."

Zalman Raisin greeted the convention on behalf of the Vilna Scientific Institute. He declared that only in the Yiddish language are Jewish cultural values being created today. Even in America, he said, where Yiddish is in a worse condition than in Eastern Europe, it has managed to create great cultural movements, such as an important daily press, literature, theatres and "What have our opponents accomplished? Where are they?" he asked. In this connection he also stated that in Galicia, as long as the

Yiddish language was strong, great Jewish cultural values were being created, but that with the abandonment of Yiddish came spiritual poverty among Galician Jews.

In Vilna, Raisin said, the Yiddishists have managed to create an entire school system, from kindergarten through gymnasium and technical school. They also have a teachers' seminary there which provides Yiddish teachers for all of Poland. Both Zhitlowsky and Raisin declared that Yiddishism is a revolutionary movement, since it aims "to emancipate the Jewish masses spiritually from the fetters imposed upon them by religion."

John Dewey, in his message to the convention, said:

"I have always felt that the metaphor, 'the melting pot', is unfortunate in so far as it implies a reduction of all elements of our population to a monotonous uniformity. It might be interpreted to mean that through contact and mutual intercourse, these different elements are to produce something new and distinctive, in which each one of the constituent parts should contribute out of its own traditions and culture something enduring in value. This result cannot be attained, however, unless there is an effort to conserve and nurture the characteristic values which each of the component elements has within. The chief problem, it seems to me, is to accomplish this work by means that do not also produce isolation and exclusiveness. I can only regret the existence of whatever forces tend to keep the varied elements of our population separate from one another."

The convention was opened by H. Novack, secretary of the Kultur Gesellschaft.

Jewish National Fund Opens Balfour Volume of Golden Book for Inscriptions

Five thousand American Jews will have the opportunity of participating in paying a unique tribute to the memory of the late Lord Balfour, the author of the declaration pledging the British Government to use its best endeavors in facilitating the establishment of a Jewish National Home in Palestine.

The American office of the Jewish National Fund announced the opening of a special Balfour Volume of the Golden Book of the Jewish National Fund. The Golden Book, which is kept at the headquarters of the Fund at Jerusalem, records the names of the Jews and non-Jews who have rendered meritorious service to the cause of the upbuilding of Palestine. Since its inception 25 years ago, three volumes of the Golden Book have been filled with names of prominent Jews and non-Jews, the entries reading like an International "Who Is Who" and "Who Has Been" during the past twenty-five years. Side by side with the names of little known men and women, who have been honored for their devotion to the Zionist cause, there are the names of many celebrities, including the members of royal families and the names of internationally known statesmen.

The volume, dedicated to the memory of the late Earl of Balfour in recognition of his sponsoring of Zionism and the promulgation of the historical declaration, will be created in accordance with a decision of the Zionist General Council. There will be room in this volume for 5,000 inscriptions. The inscriptions will be entered in the names of persons who subscribe the amount of \$100 towards the National Fund, which applies the money received for acquisition of land in Palestine as the perpetual property of the Jewish people. Jewish National Fund land, under the articles of incorporation, can never be sold. The land is cultivated by Jewish settlers under 90-year lease.

In opening the Balfour volume for American entries, Emanuel Neumann, president of the Jewish National Fund in America, urged Zionist groups, organizations, and individual contributors quickly to avail themselves of this opportunity to perpetuate not only the name of the author of the Balfour Declaration, but also their own names. The Zionists of England inaugurated several years ago a forest, which was planted on Jewish National Fund land in Palestine, and was called the Balfour Forest. When informed of this tribute, the late Lord Balfour expressed his gratification with the honor and stated, in a letter dated November 8, 1927, and addressed to Leopold Schen, chairman of the London Forest Committee, that he "earnestly hoped that it will mark another step in the economic advance of Palestine."

Jewish Leaders Hail Contributions of Young Judaea to Education of Jewish Youth in United States on Its Twentieth Anniversary

The twentieth anniversary of Young Judaea, national Jewish youth organization, was celebrated last night with a mass meeting at the Forrest Theatre where several outstanding leaders of American Jewry, under the chairmanship of Dr. Israel Goldstein, President of Young Judaea, lauded the achievements of Young Judaea in educating the Jewish youth of America to a sense of communal responsibility.

Founded twenty years ago as the first, and today the largest, Jewish youth organization in America, Young Judaea, Dr. Goldstein pointed out, did splendid work in Americanizing the Jewish youth as well as in making them appreciate Jewish cultural values.

Among those who spoke at the meeting were Clarence Y. Palitz, Chairman of the Committee of One Hundred which sponsored the celebration; Mrs. Archibald Silverman, vice-president of Young Judaea, and outstanding Jewish woman leader; Judge Julian W. Mack, of the Federal Circuit Court; Morris Rothenberg, vice-president of the Zionist Organization of America and former Congressman William W. Cohen.

Due to ill health Nathan Straus, the philanthropist, who is honorary president of Young Judaea, was unable to attend but he sent the following message:

"I am delighted to learn that Young Judaea has attained its twentieth birthday. I know that Young Judaea even after many more birthdays will always remain young because it is instinct with the spirit of youth and is inspired with the vigorous spirit of the new Palestine."

"May Young Judaea continue for many years to continue to bring to the Jewish youth of this country the high optimism and prophetic purpose of the Jewish rebuilding of Palestine."

In the principal address of the occasion, Dr. Goldstein, who is Rabbi of Temple Bnai Jeshurun, declared that one of the greatest factors in keeping Judaism alive among the American youth today was the contact that was provided between the Jewish National Home in Palestine and this country. Reviewing the twenty years that had passed since the establishment of Young Judaea, Dr. Goldstein pointed out that the youth of today is the first post-war generation to personify the changes that had been caused by the World War, and that Jewish education would have to adjust itself to these changes.

During his address, he said in part: "Young Judaea's twentieth anniversary is a significant milestone in the march of youth and youth ideals. 1910 and 1930 are separated by a distance which cannot be measured merely in terms of years. This period has witnessed the World War and the tremendous consequent upheaval in social, economic and religious tendencies. The youth of today is the first generation to personify these changes."

"It is called upon to make good use of the new and better opportunities in

the field of Jewish education. It is summoned to respond to the greater call for Jewish service. There are manifold communal activities in which the supply of manpower and womanpower is inadequate to the need. Jewish young men and women must supply the needed human resources. Last and foremost it must share the responsibility of Palestine upbuilding."

"At the same time, the Jewish values which are being created in Palestine, and the example which is there being set by the Chutzim, the young pioneers, provide additional stimulus to the Jewish youth of America, to exercise those qualities and to expend those energies which will make the contribution of the Jewish youth to American Israel at least as approximately as great as the contribution of the Jewish youth to Palestinian Israel."

"Young Judaea has, in its program, during these years, taken cognizance of the situation, and points with pride to the thousands of young Jews in whom it has cultivated and is continuing to cultivate a sense of American and Jewish responsibility, rooted in an understanding of Jewish life, and in an emotional response to the Jewish problem."

Says Soviet Religious War Is Strengthening Religion

The Soviet's war on religion has done organized religion more good than harm, and the Bolsheviks deserve a vote of thanks, declared Rabbi Abraham L. Feinberg, who recently resigned his pulpit at Temple Israel, speaking at the Social Problems Club of New York University. "Modern religion needs the intense social idealism and the willingness to suffer martyrdom that is in the Communist Party in America," Rabbi Feinberg said.

In criticizing "organized religion" for its lack of vitality and its failure to take an interest in the problems of the "young intellectuals," Rabbi Feinberg declared that "one act of violence against the former church in Russia has done more to strengthen organized religion in America than 100 sermons."

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See Inherent Race Prejudice of British Colonial Officials to Blame for Contempt of Court Sentence on Palestine Jewish Papers

The recent contempt of court sentence imposed by a Palestine court upon the Hebrew labor daily, "Davar" for criticizing the court with regard to the Hinkis case, and upon the "Palestine Bulletin", English daily, for reprinting the "Davar" editorial, is regarded by the "Juedische Rundschau", German Zionist organ, as due to the inherent prejudice of the average British colonial official towards those people whom he regards as "natives" or "colored."

The court in sentencing the "Davar" for contempt cited as a precedent a case in the British island of St. Vincent, West Indies, where the court of that time was of the opinion that "in small colonies, consisting principally of a colored population, the enforcement in proper cases of committal for contempt of court for attacks on the Court may be absolutely necessary to preserve in such a community the dignity of, and respect for, the Court."

In sentencing the "Palestine Bulletin" the court said:

"At the same time we must express our disapproval of the fact that the publisher of an English newspaper could commit the error of giving these things wider diffusion."

Commenting on the above two paragraphs, the "Juedische Rundschau" says:

"First there is a comparison with a 'colored colony'. We know how this 'colored' sounds in the mouth of an English colonial official. We know this attitude from every part of the inhabited world, where the ruling Englishman considers himself to be sky-high above the native population whom he governs and upon whom he looks down. We have heard this attitude and its consequences condemned by the best Englishmen of our time and we know exactly what it means. Therefore we get that naive wonder that an 'English' newspaper should print an article which appeared in one of the 'native papers' and which criticized the English rulers. This sentence shows how alien the government feels in the country, when it finds it necessary to base such sentences— to which it is not even entitled—upon such examples. Such an expression characterizes the ruling spirit and sets an example for all the minor officials. Presumptuousness, a feeling of being a stranger to the country, race prejudice here find their expression and their official encouragement."

Two other paragraphs in the Palestine court's sentence upon which the "Rundschau" comments read as follows:

"The 'Davar' describes itself as a Palestine labor daily. The clientele to which it appeals is a cosmopolitan proletariat coming, it may be, from countries where the confidence in the impartiality and probity of the tribunals is not what it is in territories under British rule."

"It is not to salve the wounded *amour propre* of individual judges—if it can

be wounded by attacks in sheets such as these—that proceedings of this nature are taken, but it is to prevent the authorities of the law from being weakened in the eyes of the public at large.”

One asks in amazement: "Why?" Says the "Rundschau" in commenting on these "paragraphs," "Is it in line with the object of maintaining respect for the courts that the Chief Justice of the country should also express his contemptuous attitude towards the Hebrew press, which he by the way cannot even read? What do these remarks mean? One is forced to the conclusion that here for once the attitude of the English officials, or at least part of them, has found unconscious expression. And the same is even more true of the attitude towards the labor element. How can a government, which today is regarded as the recognized protector of the Jews returning to Palestine, which controls the emigration from all the countries, which prided itself before the Mandates Commission on this emigration—how can it today regard an important part of this immigration, and therefore all the Palestine Jews, who feel themselves to be at one with them, as a "cosmopolitan proletariat" which can not understand impartial justice? And this while the Labor Party governs in London! In short, we have in both of these paragraphs not only the typical colonial attitude toward the natives, as it expressed itself in the above-mentioned paragraph about the colored population, but also a little anti-Jewish taint. There is little sense in protesting, showing, arguing. But it is necessary to know that such a situation exists, so that we should be under no illusions."
