Jews Beaten as Hitlerites Halt "All Quiet" Showing

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Berlin, Dec. 6.—A number of Jews were badly beaten and others roughly handled during the Hitlerite demonstration yesterday which resulted in the withdrawal of the American talking picture, All Quiet on the Western Front. The entire uproar created by the Hitlerites in the theatre was of a definite anti-Semitic character.

The trouble began during the second showing of the film at the Nollendorfplatz Theatre where Joseph Goebbels, Hitler's Berlin lieutenant, led the chorus that shouted "out with the Jews." Outside the theatre Father Muenchenmayer, an anti-Semitic priest who was recently freed of court charges, delivered an anti-Jewish harangue to an assembled crowd.

Shouting "down with the Jews" and throwing all sorts of things at the screen the Hitlerites created a terrific uproar which was only ended when police intervened and cleared the theatre. In the midst of yells of "German awake. This film is an insult to German soldiers," the members of the audience were having a number of free-for-all fights.

La Scala Opens New Year With Jewess at Helm

Milan, Italy, Dec. 6.—The new season at La Scala, famous Milanese opera house, opens Sunday with a woman, who is a Jewess besides, in complete command for the first time in the 150 years of the company's history. Signorina Anita Colombo is now the director of La Scala, having been appointed to that post following the recent death of Signor Scandiani, who directed the opera house for many years.

Miss Colombo, who was formerly assistant to Arturo Toscanini, conductor of the La Scala Orchestra, was promoted over the head of others connected with the management of the famous institution. She is described as not only a first class musician and linguist, speaking fluently four languages, but also as an intelligent, energetic business woman, fitted to cope with the serious financial problems facing La Scala.

Rutenberg Not to Take Part in Government-Agency Parley

London, Dec. 6.—Pinchas Rutenberg, chairman of the Palestine Zionist National Council, today informed the Zionist Executive here that he was not coming to London to participate in the negotiations with the British government because the negotiations had been initiated without his approval. Earlier in the week the Jewish National Council adopted a resolution urging its chairman to go to London.

Jew Named Ambassador of Belgium to United States

Washington, Dec. 6.—The Belgian embassy here today confirmed that Paul May will succeed Prince de Ligne as Belgian ambassador to the United States. M. May is now Belgian ambassador to Brazil. He was formerly minister to Sweden. It is not yet known when M. May will assume his new post. "M. May will be the first Jewish ambassador in Washington since the Marquis of Reading represented England here during the World War. M. May is married to a Rothschild.

Bira Bidjan Asks Ozet to Send Jewish Immigrants

Moscow, Dec. 6.—A plea to send Jewish immigrants came from Bira Bidjan, Far Eastern Republic, today to the Moscow Ozet, the society for settling the Jews on the land. Of the 500 families supposed to be sent to Bira Bidjan last summer, according to the Ozet's plans, only 300 actually went. Of this number only 100 remained, the rest returning disappointed. This explains why only 105 hectares of land instead of 605 have been sown, the Ozet says.

Einstein Urges Jews to Seek Understanding with Arabs; Attacked by Hitlerites, Assimilationists; to Speak Under Avukah Auspices

On Board S. S. Belgenland, Dec. 6.—The Jews should seek to reach a direct understanding with the Arab masses and thus diminish the Palestine government's function as the protecting judge of Jewish-Arab interests, Professor Albert Einstein told the Jewish Telegraphic Agency's correspondent in response to a question of what the Jews should do in the present Palestine situation.

Dr. Einstein, who yesterday agreed to deliver an international radio address on Palestine under the auspices of Avukah said "I believe it possible to reach such an understanding." Referring to the White Paper, Dr. Einstein feels that the "British government has done an injustice to the Jews. I believe that the Palestine administration has not loyally fulfilled the obligations of the Mandate.

Britain's Injustice to Jews

"The British government has not handled the Palestine question with objectivity, which is the most that was expected. It is however gratifying that British public opinion is not sold and that voices are raised in favor of justice." As for the negotiations now in progress between the British government and the Jewish Agency, Dr. Einstein is of the opinion that the outcome will be "only paper resolutions and it cannot be foreseen how they will be executed. The Arabs should feel that the Palestine

St. John Ervine Claims De Valera Is American Jew

London, Dec. 6.—That Eamon De Valera, noted Irish leader and head of the Fianna Fail is a Jew, is alleged by St. John Ervine, dramatist and critic, in an article in the current issue of Time and Tide, a weekly review. Ervine, who has written a number of anti-Jewish articles since his return from his recent visit to the United States, says "no one knows of De Valera denying that he is a Jew but if anyone did, De Valera's features would speak for themselves."

Ervine says that De Valera was born in New York, is an American citizen and was taken to Ireland as a child and "has been a nuisance there ever since. Unless he has lately secretly naturalized himself, De Valera is an alien in Ireland and has no right to sit in the Dail at all. If I were a resident of Ireland I should apply to a court to remove De Valera on the ground that as a foreigner he cannot sit in parliament until he acquires legal status as a citizen. I should be interested to see the passport that De Valera uses when he travels to the United States."

Georg Cohn Named on Polish U. S. Arbitration Commission

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Washington, Dec. 6.—Georg Cohn, Counselor of International Law of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs at Copenhagen, has been designated Joint Commissioner on the Treaty of Arbitration and Conciliation between the United States and Poland, it was announced by the State Department here today. The other Commissioners are George W. Wickersham, General J. B. M. Hertzog, Prime Minister of South Africa, Jan Mrzowski and General Johan Laidoner. Counselor Cohn was the joint choice of both governments.

Ussishkin to Discuss Political Issues at Mecca Temple Tonight

Menachem Ussishkin, Zionist leader and president of the World Jewish National Fund, who is now visiting this country, will be the chief speaker at a Zionist mass meeting which will be held tonight at Mecca Temple under the auspices of the Jewish National Fund of America. Emanuel Neumann, president of the American Fund, will preside.

The meeting was called at a public reception to the much-acclaimed Zionist leader but, it was stated, that the "iron will" Zionist will make this the occasion for a thorough discussion of the political issues between the Zionists and the British Government as Mandatory for Palestine and between the Jews and the Arabs of Palestine.

Indian Moslems Pledge Aid to Palestine Arabs

Bombay, Dec. 6.—The All India Moslem Conference today adopted a resolution pledging its support to the Palestine Arabs.

Fate Plays Mean Trick on Canadian Anti-Semites as Windsor Elects David Croll, 30-Year Old Jewish Lawyer, Its Mayor

Detroit, Dec. 6.—Fate, in the words of Dryden, "flung the dice" and played an awfully mean trick on the anti-Semites in Canada.

When, three weeks ago, Camilien Houde, mayor of Montreal, at a public meeting derided and attacked the Jewish people, telling them to go back to Palestine and endorsing a cry from the audience that they go to Hades, at least two of the five candidates for the office of mayor in Windsor, Ontario, the important Canadian industrial center bordering on Detroit, pleaded with their constituents not to elect a Jew mayor of a Christian community. Christian pulpits heard this plea, and radio audiences.

Youngest Mayor Elected

Then came the day of judgment. And at the approach of midnight on Monday, December 1, what was hitherto considered the impossible occurred in the Dominion of Canada: David Arnold Croll, 30-year old Jewish barrister, ran far ahead of his four opponents and was elected mayor of Windsor, today the first large city in Canada to elect a Jew to the chief executive's chair. On top of that, mayor-elect Croll is today the youngest man to be elected mayor of a Canadian city.

This briefly is the story of David Arnold Croll's triumph in his first campaign for political office. But there is more to it than these simple facts. In the first place Barrister Croll is a foreign-born and a naturalized citizen of Canada, and his constituents knew it. His opponents made sure that they should learn of it if they did not know it. Then again, he is a Jew, and a devoted leader of the Jewish community. His fellow-citizens could not help knowing that because for several years he has been president of the Windsor Talmud Torah. He is a member of the Board of Directors of Congregation Shaar Hashomayim. He is a Zionist. To top it all, his opponents broadcast the fact that he was born near Moscow, Russia. One "crime" after another: a multitude of sins for which many candidates have gone down in defeat. But Windsor, Ontario, emerged above prejudice, and the Border Cities Star, one of the leading daily newspapers in Ontario, summed the election up editorially in this fashion:

Example of Tolerance

"The Star regards the result as a commendable example of the fact that racial and religious tolerance abounds in Windsor. Mr. Croll was attacked in some quarters, we regret to say, on the ground that he happens to be a member of the Jewish faith, also that he was born near Moscow, Russia. The result of the vote shows what the people of Windsor think of tactics of that kind."

This newspaper knew whereof it spoke because for years it sold newspapers to the mayor-elect who peddled them as a newsboy on the streets of

Windsor and thus helped support himself through school and assisted his family.

Mr. Croll came to Windsor, from Russia, with his parents and four brothers in 1906. Theirs was the typical struggle of a typical immigrant group. But the four brothers emerged from the shackles of poverty and the obstacles that hold the foreign-born down and have triumphed professionally.

And now David is mayor of Windsor! No wonder that the press in this part of the country plays David's triumph up as if it were as much that of his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Hillel Croll!

Junior Camp Idea Gaining in Order Sons of Zion

The idea of junior camps in the Order Sons of Zion is rapidly gaining headway, according to Isaac Allen, grandmaster, who announced today that the second camp of this kind has already been temporarily organized in Newark. The first junior camp, comprised of thirty charter members between the ages of 18 and 21, known as Friends of Zion Camp, was formally installed last Saturday night, in New York.

These camps are the direct outgrowth of a resolution adopted at the last annual convention of the Order. The youth who comprise the membership will concern themselves primarily with Zionist cultural and educational endeavor.

Georgia Establishes Second Hebrew Conference in South

Macon, Ga., Dec. 6.—The Georgia Hebrew conference, second permanent state union being organized under the auspices of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations in South Carolina, Georgia, North Carolina, Florida, Alabama, Mississippi and Tennessee, was established here yesterday. Morton H. Levy, of Savannah, was elected state chairman.

Other officers named were Max Michael, Athens, vice-chairman; and Herman Julius, Columbus, secretary. The purpose of the state union is to promote cooperation of congregations belonging to the U. A. H. C. and to undertake a program of religious education, particularly for Jewish children in rural districts.

Louis Nathan Elected Mayor of Miami Shores

Miami, Florida, Dec. 6.—Louis Nathan, Jewish communal worker, has been elected mayor of Miami Shores, a suburb of Miami. Mr. Nathan helped to develop Miami Shores as a residential suburb.

Montreal Jewish School Board May Exist as Advisory Body

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Montreal, Dec. 6.—The Montreal Jewish School Commission may continue to exist simply as an advisory and consultative body, since its active functions have ceased as a result of the agreement which it entered into with the Protestants. This was the opinion expressed today by J. A. Mathewson, chairman of the Protestant School Board.

"The future status of the Jewish School Commission is a matter for the Legislature to decide," said Mr. Mathewson, "but the control over the schools under the new arrangement lies entirely with the Protestants. I imagine that the Jewish Board might be kept as an advisory body to see that the spirit and letter of the agreement are carried out."

Mr. Mathewson pointed out that Jewish children form one-third of the pupils of the Protestant schools and that the cost of educating Jewish children is \$850,000, of which \$515,000 is covered by Jewish taxes. The deficit, he said, will have to be contributed partly by the neutral tax panel and the remainder by the Catholic and Protestant sections.

Jewish leaders in this city who have been fighting for separate Jewish schools claim that Jewish taxes alone would have been sufficient to cover the cost of maintaining an independent Jewish school system.

Zeta Beta Tau's 32nd Annual Conclave to Meet December 28

St. Louis, Dec. 6.—Zeta Beta Tau, the oldest and largest national Jewish college fraternity, will hold its thirty-second annual conclave in the city of St. Louis, Mo. on the last four days of 1930. Zeta Beta Tau was founded in 1898 and has thirty-two chapters in the universities of the United States and Canada and thirty graduate clubs in the principal cities.

Zeta Beta Tau is known as the donor of the Gottheil Medal, which it gives each year to the American who has done the most for Jewry during the year for which the particular annual award is given. Senator James A. Reed, of Missouri, will deliver an address at Zeta Beta Tau's annual banquet, which will be held at the Coronado Hotel on the evening of December 30th.

Cleveland to Name Playground for Late Joseph Neshkes

Cleveland, Dec. 6.—Plans to erect a playground at the Orthodox Jewish Orphans' Home, which will be designated as the Neshkes Memorial Playground in honor of Joseph Neshkes, the president of the Home, who died suddenly this week, will be presented to the Board at its meeting on January 4. Israel Rabb is chairman of the committee which is planning the memorial.

Mr. Neshkes had been president of the Home for the past ten years.

Report Shows No Drop in Children Getting Jewish Education Despite Depression

A report describing the work of the Jewish Education Association since its foundation nine years ago, with special data on the work of the past year, has been issued by Israel Unterberg, president of the organization, which will mark its ninth anniversary at a dinner on Sunday, December 14th at the Commodore Hotel. Justice Benjamin N. Cardozo, Chief Justice of the Court of Appeals of the State of New York; Col. Michael Friedsam, merchant and philanthropist; and Adolph S. Ochs, publisher of the New York Times, are the honorary chairmen of the dinner.

Increase in Attendance

Dealing with the work of the past year, Mr. Unterberg states that despite the economic slump, there has been no drop in the total number of children receiving a Jewish education in Greater New York, that number consisting of 71,462 pupils in attendance at organized religious schools and approximately 30,000 receiving private instruction. During the period that the Jewish Education Association has been in existence, Mr. Unterberg says, there has been an increase in the number of Jewish children receiving a Jewish education of 25,000. He reports further that 3,650 prizes were awarded this year for which 35,000 pupils and 140 schools competed and that the number of prizes awarded for the nine years of the existence of the Association amounts to 37,650. The prizes consisted of Menorahs and other objects made in the Bezalel School of Arts and Crafts in Jerusalem, as well as books of Jewish interest.

During the past year 73 schools have received from the Association \$73,573 in scholarship grants to provide tuition for the children of the poor. Since the founding of the Association nine years ago it has expended \$378,121.48 for this purpose.

Licensing of Teachers

The progress that has been made in the licensing of teachers of Hebrew schools is, perhaps, the most important forward step that Jewish education has to record during the past year, says Mr. Unterberg in his report. Licensed teachers, according to him, are a necessity not only in the interest of the teaching profession, but even more so for the sake of the children who are entitled to receive their Jewish knowledge and Jewish inspiration from men and women who are qualified by education, temperament and training.

Applications for licenses have already been received from 850 teachers, out of a possible total of 1,100. A considerable number of schools, the largest and foremost institutions among them, have already pledged themselves to cooperate by engaging licensed teachers only. The License Board of the Jewish Education Association consists of Dr. P. Churgin, H. Handler, Israel Konowitz, Rabbi Alter F. Landesman, Prof. Morris Levine, Rabbi Jacob Levinson, B. Levitsky, Dr. David de Sola Pool, Albert P. Schoolman, Dr. Benjamin Veit and Kalman Whiteman.

135,000 Immigrants Who Might Become "Public Charges" Barred

Washington, Dec. 6.—About 135,000 immigrants will not be admitted to this country during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1931, by the refusal of consuls abroad to grant visas to all those who might become "public charges" after entering the United States. This information was given yesterday by the House Immigration Committee by Anderson L. Hodgdon, chief of the visa office of the State Department.

During an executive session of the committee, over which Representative Albert John of Washington presided, Mr. Hodgdon submitted figures which showed that only 1,687 visas were issued during the month of October, when the new immigration policy of President Hoover was first inaugurated, and that there are 11,517 visas now being issued instead of 14,846 which are available under the quota law.

It was explained that the halting of immigration through consular refusal to grant visas to immigrants who might become "public charges" is only temporary and will cease when unemployment lessens in this country.

Theodore Hoefler, Buffalo Philanthropist, Dead at 76

Buffalo, Dec. 6.—Theodore Hoefler, philanthropist and head of the firm of Theodore Hoefler & Co., died at his home here yesterday at the age of seventy-six. Mr. Hoefler was an active leader in Jewish affairs in Buffalo for many years.

Born in Germany, Mr. Hoefler came to Buffalo with his parents when a small boy. After graduating from the local public schools he entered the clothing business and a few years later became associated with Oppenheimer & Co., scrap dealers. He then founded in 1881 the firm of Theodore Hoefler & Co., trading in old rubber, in which business he continued for thirty-five years until his recent retirement.

Throughout his life Mr. Hoefler was interested in Jewish charities and was the first secretary and later the president of the Hebrew Men's Benevolent Society, continuing until the organization became part of the Jewish Federation for Social Service. He was president of the Federation for some time and was a member of its board of directors for many years. In 1916 he was chairman of the Buffalo committee to aid Jewish war sufferers.

Many Drives for Allied Jewish Campaign in Progress

With more than \$21,000 reported at the beginning of a drive in Seattle, and \$12,000 raised on the first day of Houston's effort, many communities are engaged in vigorous canvasses on behalf of the Allied Jewish Campaign. The leading Jewish communities of the state of Washington are all having campaigns under the general direction of Alfred Shemanski, state chairman. The Seattle drive is headed by Emanuel Rosenberg.

The Betrayal December Choice of Jewish Book Club

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Chicago, Dec. 6.—The Betrayal, by Stephen S. Wise and Jacob de Haas is the December choice of the Jewish Book Club for its subscribers. In discussing the choice, Dr. Ralph H. Goldman, president and editor-in-chief, stated that the book is a clear, concise and deliberate statement, devoid of any overstatement, regarding the British government's change of attitude toward Zionism.

In this volume the authors disclose for the first time public documents affecting the American relations to the Balfour Declaration which hitherto have been state secrets. Included among these is the draft of a note by President Wilson directed to the British Cabinet in regard to the Declaration.

Workmen's Circle Will Raise \$25,000 for HIAS

At a conference of delegates from branches of the Workmen's Circle held at its headquarters, it was unanimously decided to raise a minimum of \$25,000 from the members of the Workmen's Circle for the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society. A resolution calling upon each branch to raise its quota in the form of a voluntary per capita tax was unanimously adopted.

The conference was attended by 250 delegates representing 89 branches from New York and nearby cities. It was called for the purpose of finding ways and means to help the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society in its efforts to raise \$150,000 to cover its deficit and approximately \$400,000 for current expenses.

Attacked as Propagandist
On the other hand the National German-Jewish Union, a small group of extreme nationalist and anti-Zionist Jews who are not represented on the council of the Berlin Jewish community, headed by Max Naumann, protested against Professor Einstein's using his world fame as a scientist for "propagating Zionism."

Protesting against his recent speech in London, which was broadcast over an international hookup, the Union criticizes Dr. Einstein for favoring maintenance of the culture traditions and consolidation of the Jewish people. "We German-speaking Jews protest against Einstein's stimulating Jewish nationalism. Our duty as Germans is to declare openly that this Einstein talk is objectionable to us," the Union declares.

Questions Sincerity of Home Mission Congress' Program of Good Will Towards Jews

In an open letter to the North American Home Missions Congress, Dr. Israel Goldstein, rabbi of Congregation B'nai Jehshurun, questions the sincerity of its program of good-will towards the Jews adopted at its meeting in Washington this week and asks whether it is a means toward an end, namely, of winning the Jew to Christianity. Dr. Goldstein's letter follows:

Text of Letter

"The New York Times of this morning reports the proposal submitted by your conference group on Jewish and Christian relationship, as urging the expression of 'good-will and friendly feeling toward the Jewish people,' the deploring of 'the long record of injustice and ill-usage of the Jews on the part of professedly Christian people,' the declaring of 'such conduct to be a violation of the teaching and the spirit of Christ,' and the calling upon all churches and Christians to oppose anti-Semitism in every form and all unjust discrimination against Jews."

"Having been privileged to address your body in Atlantic City three years ago, when I endeavored to make clear the Jewish attitude toward Christian missionizing among Jews, I beg to take this occasion to ask for a clarification of the above mentioned proposal.

"Is the motive and intention of the proposal, the hope that an attitude of goodwill and friendly feeling toward the Jews would be a more effective means of winning him to Christianity?"

"It is my impression that such is the intention and the motive. My impression is based upon the fact that at a conference of Protestant Mission Organizations, in which some of your constituent groups were represented, held at Budapest and Warsaw in April, 1927, for the purpose of discussing the subject of Evangelization among Jews, the following statement was adopted: We believe that all un-Christian treatment Jewish and Christian relationship of the Jew and all race-prejudice are great stumbling-blocks to the acceptance of the Christian message. ("The Christian Approach to the Jew," a report of the conferences, published London, 1927, page 18).

Aim to Convert Jews

"The entire discussions of that conference converge upon the same idea, that it is essential to make Jewish converts to Christianity, and that this end can be accomplished most effectively by substituting an attitude of friendship for the attitude of hostility and persecution.

"Let me assure you that any change in the attitude of Christians toward Jews which would correct the injustice and persecution from which the Jew has suffered in the past, is to be welcomed and deeply appreciated by Jews. At the same time, it is also important to know whether there is any ulterior motive behind the new dispensation, and whether it is merely a new strategy

Find Fakers Posing as Rabbis in New York

That there are men who pose as Jewish Rabbis, but who have no claim to that title, was brought to the attention of both the New York Board of Jewish Ministers and the Brooklyn Jewish Ministers' Association at recent meetings of these respective organizations. A joint committee was appointed by both of these organizations. After a thorough investigation by the committee both bodies adopted the following resolution.

"Be it resolved that the Jewish public be earnestly requested to withhold invitations to officiate at religious functions without first ascertaining that the officiants are bona fide Jewish Ministers; that the general public be requested, on all occasions, to inquire of the New York Board of Jewish Ministers or the Brooklyn Jewish Ministers' Association as to the status of men purporting to be Rabbis, and that all Rabbis make earnest effort to avoid participating in any public program which contains the name of any man falsely posing as a member of their profession."

The president of the New York Board of Jewish Ministers is Rev. Dr. Elias Solomon, Rabbi of Temple Shaare Zedek, Manhattan; and the president of the Brooklyn Jewish Ministers' Association is Rabbi Israel Herbert Levinthal of the Brooklyn Jewish Center. The committee which investigated the fake rabbis consisted of Rabbi Moses J. S. Abels of Temple Emanuel in Boro Park, chairman; Rabbi Samuel J. Levinson of Temple Beth Emeth in Flatbush; Rabbi A. Burstein of the Bay Ridge Community Center; Alexander Lyons, Simon Cohen, Barnett Elzas and Clifton H. Levy, the last three being ex-presidents of the New York Board of Jewish Ministers.

"It is the predominant opinion among Jewish leaders that there can not be honest and effective goodwill between Jew and Christian so long as Judaism is recognized as an inferior religion, and as being inadequate for the salvation of those who are born in that religion.
