NOT QUIET IN VIENNA: JEWISH QUARTER IN STATE OF SIEGE BECAUSE OF "ALL QUIET" PERFORMANCES: THREE THOUSAND FOLICE ON GUARD TO PROTECT POPULATION AGAINST HITLERIST INVASION: JE"IEF SHOPS CLOSED AND BARRICADED: PROPILE AFRAID TO VERYOUSE OUT: CLASHES BETWEEN FOLICE AND HITLERIST DEMONSTRATORS: RUBBER CUDGELS HOPEN, PRESENTAGE AND ANALYSISS. Vienna, Jan. 7th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The Jewish quarter of Vienna was in a state of siege to-day because of the performance of the "All Quiet" talkie in the Apollo Cinema, situated there, the Social Democrats having rejected the suggestion made by the authorities that since the Socialist Mayor of Vienna, Herr Seitz, insists on its production, despite the threats of the Hitlerists, it should be transferred to one of the more purely Labour districts where the organised workers could themselves provide the forces necessary to maintain order. It is understood that to-morrow the film will, however, be transferred to one of the Labour districts, since the police complain that the expense of pro-viding sufficient forces to veep the peace is more than the Police Department can afford, and intend otherwise to use the power given them by the Government to prohibit further performances.

About three thousand police, mounted and on foot, were mobilised in the Jewish quarter to-day heavily armed to repulse All Jewish shops, even in the streets outside the demonstrators. ghetto, but adjoining it, were closed and barricaded. All Jewish meetings which had been arranged for to-day were called off, and altogether there were more police about in the streets than civilians, who feared to venture out lest they were molested. was stopped, even the tramway service being suspended, and the roads leading into the Jewish quarter from the bridges over the Danube, Apart from the demonstrators and the police, Vienna were cut off. The Hitlerists tried repeatedly as a whole was a deserted city. to break through the police cordons and invade the Jewish district. Just before midnight, additional police reinforcements were called out, because it was feared that the Hitlerists might attempt a rush at the time the audience would be leaving the cinema after the final performance (there were several performances, beginning at five o'clock in the afternoon). Arrangements had been made by means of strict control over the sele of the tickets, which were not available for the general public, but were distributed privately through various societies, to prevent Hitlerists or others opposed to the film, obtaining admission to the cinema.

Despite all the precautions taken, several serious clashes occurred between the police and the hitlerists, who were joined by members of the Heimwehr organisation. The demonstrators threw fi works under the legs of the horses of the mounted police when they The demonstrators threw firecharged, and one or two shots were fired. The police were compelled to use their rubber cudgels to disperse the mob. In a number of places outside the immediate protected area the windows of several deserted cafes and of some of the big shops were smashed.

About thirty arrests were made and a number of demon-

strators were injured.

Socor in the office of the "Addwerul", belongs. 26 terrorist cells were found in existence, linking up a complete system of terrorist organisations, with "black lists", containing the names of persons to be assassinated.

IMPRISONMENT FOR HITLERIST CAUGHT RED-HANDED SMASHING WIBDOWS IN
JEWISH SHOP DURING REICHSTAG OPENING DEMONSTRATIONS IN OCTOBER.

Berlin, Jan. 7th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).
Otto Kurtz, a tailor, was sentenced to-day to 8 months' imprisonment for participation in the Hitlerist riots which took place on October 13th, when the new Reichstag was opened. Kurtz was caught red-handed smashing the windows of a big fur store owned by a Jew named Cohn in the Leipziger strasse, one of the principal Wost End shopping streets in Berlin. He is the only Hitlerist who was actually caught in the act during these disturbances:

MOHAMED ALI TO BE TAKEN TO JERUSALEM TO BE BURIED IN MOSQUE OF OMAR.

The highest honour which it is possible for the Moslem world to offer is to be conferred on Maulan Kohamed Ali, the Indian Moslem leader who died in London last Sunday while representing his community at the Indian Round Table Conference, the "News Chronicle" states. He is to be buried, it says, with the Prophets of Islam in the Moslem Holy of Holies, the Mosque of Cmar, in Jerusalem. It will be the first occasion on which an Indian has been interred in the temple. The offer of buriel at the Holy Shrine was telegraphed to-London by the Grand Kufti of Jerusalem, the paper adds.

The body of Mohamed All will be taken by boat to Port Said and will never be left by his relatives until it is placed in the tomb. Every minute, day and night a relative will be beside the remains, reciting from the Koran. At Port Said the funeral party will be met by thousands of their co-religionists, and a great pilgrimage will escort the remains of the departed leader by road to Jorusalem.

DECLINE OF YIDDISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE IN SOVIET RUSSIA REPORTED BY MOSCOW YIDDISH DAILY "EHESS".

Moscow, Jan. 7th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The future of the Yiddish language and literature in Soviet Russis, or more corrocity in the larger Russism cities, is not very promising, according to an investigation into the conditions prevailing in the two fiddish libraries in Moscow, conducted recently, the results of which have just been made public in the Yiddish Community organ "Emess" here.

There are 18,000 Jowlsh worken employed in the factories of Mossow, the investigations report, nearly all of whom are recent arrivals in the capital. That these workens are among the most progressive in the country is testified to by the fact that they left their homes in what was formerly the Pale of Jew-ish Settlement to come to Moscow, where the opportunities are greater and life is more interesting. That these workers, who were readers in their home towns, have not broken with the reading habit upon arriving in Moscow is also evident to all attending habit upon arriving in Moscow is also evident to all strending a meeting of such workers. They are in touch with all ourrent
events, politics, economics, the progress of the Five Year Plan, etc.
They are Marxisté, the investigators state, versed in the litterature of Socialism, both of an earlier day and of the modern poriod.
They are readers of literature, of novels, and of critical works.

But the language they read in, they add, is for the most
park Russian. At least that is what study of the attendance at

the two yaddish libraries in Moscow indicates. Both the Central Xiddish Library and the Library connected with the Communist Club have scarcely more than two hundred patrons.

The writer in the "Emess", reporting on the results of the

investigation, suggests the merging of the Yiddish Library with the library at the Communist Club for the sake of greater efficiency. It is further suggested that a new collection of books should be obtained by the libraries to replace the old shabby-looking volumes, so that—bho taking out of books should be made more attractive.

But, the report goes on to suggest that such palliatives will not greatly alter the situation. The neglect of libraries in their so-called "national" tongue is characteristic, it says, not only of the Jews, but of all other minorities. Moscow teems with libraries in the languages and dialects of its varying national minorities, but these libraries seem to exist merely because they are subsidised in one form or another. They are not kept alive by the interest of their readers. They are looked upon more as museums for the curious or as scientific libraries for specialists and students. The masses are not reached by them. The masses in Mosecow, the report concludes, read and speak the language of the country and of the city - Great Russian.

SOVIET SHOE INDUSTRY MAKING BIG PROGRESS: OLD RUSSIAN FOOTGEAR BARK SANDALS ALMOST DISAPPEARED FROM STREETS: PEASANT NOW WEARS SHOES.

Moscow, Jan. 7th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

With the closing in Moscow of the Ninth All-Russian Congress of Leather and Shoe Workers, whose membership is strongly Jewish, some interesting sidelights on the shoe industry in Russia Jewish, some interesting succingues on the show and any that there have come to the public notice. Although there is a cry that there is a shortage of shoes in the country, the leather and shoe industry for the year 1930 showed remarkable advance. In 1928 there were 23 million pairs of shoes menufactured in Russia, while in 1930 the number increased to 62 million pairs. The number of shoe and lication workers increased proportionately during this period from 124,747 in 1928 to 183,484 in 1930. The total number of workers connected with the leather and shoe industry is now closs on 200,000

The fact that together with this big increase in production there is a big shortage of shoes was explained by the Conference by the fact that the old Russian national footgar of the peasant, Lapt. (bark sandals) has almost entirely disappeared from the cities. The peasant to-day wears shoes.

"BOYCOTT JEWS" SIGNS ON MUNICIPAL-OWNED KIOSKS IN MONTREAL: JEWISH PAPER DEMAND TEST CASE AGAINST CITY FOR ALLOWING ITS PROPERTY TO BE USED FOR ANTISEMITIC PURPOSES.

Montreal, Dec. 26th. (J.T.A. Mail Service).

A call for an active fight against antisemitism in the Province of Quebec has been issued by the Montreal Yiddish daily the Jowish Eagle, which draws attention to the growing antisemitic movement, particularly in Montreal.

The local municipal authorities recently decided to con-

trol the sale of newspapers in the streets by erecting and leasing kiosks at important corners to recommended news wenders, the paper says. Many interpreted this act as a move to drive Jowish news vendors off the streets, one Alderman having openly demanded that newsagents must be bi-lingual, meaning that they should understand French as well as English. Though there was a good deal of protest against its action, the city persisted and has now erected the first kiosk in a busy thoroughfare. This kiosk now carries signs with the following inscription: "Buy your papers from French-Don't buy from Jews".

The "Eagle" demands a test case against the city for allowing its property to be used for antisemitic purposes.

SON OF ONE-TIME JEWISH MINISTER IN HUNGARY LATE DR. VASZONKI ENTERS PUBLIC LIFE IN BUDAPEST.

Budapess, sun. tens. the series as the series of the one-time Minister of Justice, the late Dr. Wilhelm Vaszonyi, who died in 1926 from the effects of an attack made on him by antisemites in the streets of Budapest and who was one of the outstanding champions of the Vewish cause in Hungary, has just entered public life, by being elected for the first time as a member of the Budapest City Council Several of his father's old colleagues in the fight against the antisentism which seet Hungary with the coming of the Christian regime, like Dr. Paul Sandor, Dr. Bela Fabian, Dr. Brody, Dr. Sugen Gal, and Dr. Marzell Hajdu, are among the new members of the Budapest City Council, which so far has 17 Jawish members belonging to the middle class parties. It is pessible that several more Jews will find places on the Council because are conscioustilled. will find places on the Council, because some Councillors have been elected several times, and it is expected that among those who will replace them on their duplicate representation will be some Jews.

There are several Jews also among the Social Democrats who have been returned to the new Council and both the Government Party and the Opposition in the new Council this time include Jews among thoir representatives.

JEWISH PROFESSOR AT VIENNA UNIVERSITY DIES WHILE PREPARING REPLY TO PALESTINE WHITE PAPER.

Vienna, Jan. 8th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Professor Leo Strisower, Professor of International Law at the University of Vienna, has died to-day at the age of 73. He was engaged in drafting a memorandum in reply to the British White Paper on Palestine, at the request of the Jewish students in Vienna, who wanted to submit it to the League of Nations in Geneva and the Permanent Court of International Justice at The Hagus.
