ARAB-JEWISH CO-OPERATION IN PALESTINE RENDERED IMPOSSIBLE BY NEW INTERPRETATION OF GOVERNMENT POLICY: ARAB EXECUTIVE'S PROTEST TO HIGH COMMISSIONER: CONTRADICTS WHITE PAPER AND IGNORES ARAB POLITICAL RIGHTS.: WHITE PAPER SAID NO LAND AVAILABLE FOR SALE AND NO ROOM FOR IMMIGRATION: NEW LETTER ALLOWS BOTH: ARABS TO BE ASKED TO BOYCOTT JEWS IN RETALIATION FOR JEWISH BOYCOTT OF ARAB LABOUR.

tirely contradicts the White Paper and creates a new policy en-tigence the political rights of the Arab population, concentrating only on their civil and economic status, to the advantage of the Jewish National Fome, and gives approval to the claim of Jewish labour to a share in public works, the delegation from the Palestine Arab Executive, consisting of its President, Mous as Kazim Pasha, and kessrs. Yakoub Faraj, and Bey Aboul Hadi, Jemal Husseini, and Moghanan Effendi, is understood to have declared to the High Commissioner, Sir John Chancellor, when they interviewed him to-day, submitting to him their protest against the change in British policy in Palestine.

The White Paper laid it down that there are no lands available in Palestine for sale and that there is no room for any more immigrants, and the interpretation of the White Paper permits land transfer and heterogeneous immigration, the protest submitted by the delegation to the High Commissioner for transmission to the

British Government in London says.

The threat of a boycott of Jewish products (which was foreshadowed in yesterday's J.T.A. Bulletin) is made formally in the course of the document, which is signed by Moussa Kazim Pasha, as President of the Palestine Arab Executive.

I am obliged, he writes, to propose to the Arabs, that they should boycott the Jews everywhere in retaliation for the

Jewish boycott of Arab labour.

The new interpretation of Government policy in Palestine, the statement declares, makes impossible the Arab-Jewish co-operation for which Mr. MacDonald pleads.

The new Government letter on Falestine policy has at one stroke destroyed the confidence of the Arabs in the good faith of the Asandatory Power, the Arab organ "Al Hayat" declares in an C article published to-day, in which it contrasts the letter very much to its disadvantage with the White Paper of last October.

Some Arabs are of the optnion, Al Hayat" writes, that the Arab Executive, the Supreme Moslem Council, the Senior Arab officers of the Government, including the Arab judges, should all resign as a protest against the Government's retreat from the

policy laid down in the White Paper.

PATESTINE DEBATE EXPECTED IN HOUSE OF COMMONS ON THURSDAY.

London, Feb. 17th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).
There will be a good deal of talk on Thursday about Palestine, when a supplementary estimate for Colonial and Middle Eastern-services will be taken, the "Morning Post" states. The Prime Minister, or Mr. Henderson, is expected to explain the letter to the leader of the Zionist Agency, which professes to interpret Lord Passfield's White Paper, it proceeds, adding that the letter has given unmistakable satisfaction to the Zionists; and equally has roused the fears of the friends of the Arab population in Palestine.

ZIONIST EXECUTIVE MUST GO MR. JABOTINSKY SAYS AT PARIS PUBLIC MEET-ING ELSE MAY RESULT IN BREAK 400% OF ZIONIST ORGANISATION.

Paris, Fec. 17th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The Zionist Executive must go, Mr. Jabotinsky, the Revisionist leader, urged speaking here to-day at a big public Revisionist reader, urged speaking here over a state butter meeting attended by about 1,500 people on the present situation in Zionism. The present Executive, he said, does not represent the feelings of the Jewish masses, and if it continues in office the result may be a break-down of the Zionist Organization.

The Revisionist World Executive is holding its next meeting here on Saturday evening and Sunday, the 21st. and 22nd. inst., when questions relating to the recent developments will be discussed.

AUSTRIAN RADICAL ZIONISTS DECIDE TO ENTER REVISIONIST ORGANISATION.

The Austrian Radical Zionist Organisation, led by ex-Deputy Robert Stricker, has decided by a three-quarters majority to enter the Revisionist Organisation. The majority, including ex-Deputy Stricker himself, will shortly become officially members of the Revisionist World Organisation.

.. Last December, the Austrian Radicals decided to second from the Radical Zionist World Organisation and negotiate with the Zionist Revisionist World Executive in London with regard to joint action in the elections to the forthcoming Zionist Congress and at the Congress itself.

PALESTINE HIGH COMMISSIONER PAIS TRIBUTE TO JEWISH AGRICULTURE IN PALESTINE; FIRST MEETING OF NEW PALESTINE AGRICULTURAL COUNCIL: DR. MAGNES NOT PRESENT HAVING LEFT FOR U.S.

DEATH OF JEWISH GENERAL IN BELGIAN ARMY: COMMANDER OF FIRST ARMY CORPS IN GREAT WAR.

Lieut-General Louis Bernheim, Commander of the First
Army Corps in the Belgian Army during the Great War, has died
here at the age of 69. He held the Great Cross of the Order of
Leopold, the highest Belgian Order.

Professor Arthur Lehman Goodhart, son of Mr. and Mrs.-Philip Goodhart, of New York, has been called to the Chair of Jurieprudence at Oxford University. Professor Goodhart is a Yale graduate, a former visit-

ing Professor at Yale, Assistant Corporation Counsel of New York City, Counsel to the American Mission to Poland in 1919 and an Officiar of Academic of France. He is a cousin of Mrs. Walter Freberg of Cincinnati, past president of the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods.

PROFESSOR LASKI APPOINTED VISITING PROFESSOR OF GOVERNMENT AND LAW AT YALZ UNIVERSITY.

New York, Feb. 16th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Professor Heroid J. Laski, Professor of Political Science at the London School of Economics, London University, has been appointed to the Faculty of Yele University as Visiting Professor of Government and Law for the second term of the academic year.

Amongstudents of political science, both in the United States and in Europe, Professor Laski, who is in his 36th. year, is regarded as the foremost authority in the English speaking world on the newer developments in political theory and governmental structure. At Yele he will work with graduate and undergraduate students in political science and with students in the law school.

Professor Laski was recalled from America by the Frime

Minister, Mr. Ramsay MacDonald in 1929, in order to become a member of the Committee appointed by the Lord Chancellor (the Donoughmore Committee) after consultation with the Premier to investigate the safeguards necessary to secure the constitutional principles of the sovereignty of Parliament and the supremacy of the law. Leese, Scoretary-General of the Importal Fascist League, contended in violent fashion at a "strange-Fascist attack on the League of Nations" made at a meeting held at the Baptist Church Hall in Streathem, the "South London Press" reports. The debate was promoted by the Streathem League of Nations Union. There was a strong contingent of Fascists present, many in uniform.

The Jews had cornered the world's money, Mr. Leese argued, and the interests of the Jews were permeating the action of those

connected with the League.

General Blakeney, who was in charge of the operations on the Suez Canal during the war in 1915 and was Director of Pailway Traffio with the Egyptian Expeditionary Force (of which the Falestine forces were part), speaking against the League, said, "The League is about the most wasteful organisation that has been formed. It is the waste-paper basker of the bureau-oratic table".

On a vote, however, the meeting decided by a large majority against the views of these speakers and in favour of the League of Nations.

AWAZING PREJUDICE AGAINST JEWS IN SCOTLAND CLERGYMAN FINDS
ATTRIBUTING TO IT DIFFICULTY IN GETTING SCOTTISH PROPLE
INTERESTED IN CONVERSION OF JEWS; JEWS RICH ENOUGH TO DO
TESTER OWN YORK PEOPLE SAY.

He found it very difficult in Scotland to get their Scottish people interested in the conversion of the Jews, the Rev. Dr. James Black, of Edinburgh, completined in an address to the Arbroath and District Office Bearers' Union of the Church of Scotland. There was an amazing prejudice in Scotland against the Jews, he said, some of it absolutely unintelligible and unintelligent. They got people saying: Why give to the Jews - were the Jews not rich enough to do their own work? forgetting that it was to convert the Jews to Christ. The Jews were perhaps the greatest gain the Church could have to-day, Dr. Black argued. The Christian Church would never enter into her own until she had won the Jews. They could go out winning people in the fer distant lands, but if they left that Great messimilated mass ef materialism right in the home centre, why, they would poison the native springs of love and thought in the Church.

The work of the Mission in Damesous, it was reported, is being carried on in day schools among Jawish boys and girls, and in evening classes, in both of which special attention is given to Christian religious instruction. Advantage is taken of the Jowish Sabbath to hold a Sabbath school and Bible reading. Personal vieits are paid to Jawish homes and workshops, where the famous Damesous silk and brass are manufactured.

JEWISH PHYSICIAN DENIES GLAUCOMA OR HARDENING OF EYEBALL MORE COMMON AMONG JE'S.

The idea that the Jewish race is singularly predisposed to glaucoma originated in the Vienna School of Ophthalmology, where a large number of Jewish cases were observed, Dr. Brav writes. It is true that in the Allgemeine Krankenhaus a large percentage of Jawish case have been seen. The explanation, however, does not rest in the inherent racial predisposition, but rather in the social and economic environment of the patients that make up the constitutions of the patients of the patients.

Ny own experience, Dr. Brav writes, convinces me that the incidence of glaucoma among Jews is about the same as among other peoples and that heredity is a negligible factor in the causation

of this disease.
