ANTISEMITIC STUDENT RIOTS ASSUME FORMIDABLE FORM IN HUNGARY;
 FUENFKIRCHEN UNIVERSITY CLOSED DOWN TILL NEXT WEEK TO ALLOW
 TROUBLE TO PASS OFF: WILL BE CLOSED FOR REST OF TERM IF DIS-
 ORDERS NOT STOPPED RECTORATE THREATENS; POLICE ARREST FIVE
 ROWDIES WHEN DISTURBANCES SPREAD TO STREETS: OFFICES OF LOCAL
 NEWSPAPER ATTACKED AND SHOP WINDOWS SMASHED.

Budapest, Feb. 25th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The new outbreak of antisemitic rioting at the University of Fuenfkirchen (Pecs) has assumed so formidable a form that the University Rectorate, finding it impossible to restore quiet in any other way have ordered the University to be closed down for several days to allow time for feeling to subside. If the disturbances are renewed when the University is reopened next week, the announcement says, the University will be closed down for the rest of the term.

Meanwhile, Jewish students were set upon to-day by their antisemitic colleagues in the University Library and in the building of the Law Faculty. Antisemitic manifestations took place also in the streets. Several shop windows were smashed and an attack was made on the editorial and printing offices of the "Pecsi Naplo" (the Pecs or Fuenfkirchen Journal).

The police took active measures to restore order and five of the antisemitic students were arrested.

The Hungarian Universities are the scene of periodic antisemitic outbreaks, the latest of which took place only last November, when they occurred simultaneously at the Universities of Budapest and Szegedin. It happened that the same month serious anti-Jewish student riots took place also at the Universities of Vienna, Berlin and Lemberg, so that there were four different countries involved. Curiously, Fuenfkirchen was the only Hungarian University where the Jewish students were not molested during the serious anti-Jewish student disturbances in Hungary in 1928, which led to something of an incident, when Mr. Bruno Heilig, the Budapest correspondent of the Ullstein Service, which publishes the "Vossische Zeitung" and other German newspapers, was expelled by the Hungarian Government, which took exception to the reports which he sent to his papers describing the antisemitic student disturbances as pogroms.

EXPORTING HITLERISM ABROAD: SCANDINAVIA REBUFFS HITLER; REFUSAL TO

 SCANDINAVIAN HITLERISTS: HITLER'S BROTHER-IN-LAW GOING TO
 BUCHAREST TO ORGANISE ROMANIAN HITLERISTS MEETS JEWISH EDITOR
 IN TRAIN AND TELLS HIM HITLERIST INACTION REGARDING JEWS HAS
 LOST THEM POPULARITY IN GERMANY: NEW ANTI-JEWISH MOVEMENT BEING
 STARTED TO REGAIN SUPPORT.

Berlin, Feb. 25th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The movement to spread Hitlerism in the Scandinavian countries to which the Hitlerist press in Germany has been giving a great deal of attention recently (reported in the J.T.A. Bulletin of the 21st. inst.) has met with a rebuff, the authorities in Copenhagen, the capital of Denmark, and in Stockholm, the capital of Sweden, refusing to admit Adolf Hitler and his Berlin lieutenant, Deputy Goebbels, who had been announced to speak at Hitlerist meetings there.

The Scandinavian Hitlerist movement has its headquarters in Copenhagen, where it publishes the "Hajekorsset" (Swastika), with the slogan "For the Liberation of the Nordic Races and Against International Judaism". The leader of the Scandinavian Hitlerist movement is a certain Ejnar Baaben, of Copenhagen.

Bucharest, Feb. 25th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Adolf Hitler's brother-in-law, Ernst Goelnike, has arrived in Bucharest to study the situation with Roumanian friends of the Hitlerist movement, Mr. David Israelit, Editor of the "Juedische Presse" of Sziget-Marmorosch, reports on arrival here, stating that he travelled in the same railway carriage with Goelnike from Cluj to Bucharest, and that Goelnike revealed to him his plans, speaking frankly about the Hitlerist movement and its aims.

In Germany, he said, the Hitlerists had lost a great deal of their popularity because after their big victory in the Parliamentary elections of last September they had sat down and adopted an attitude of quiescence in regard to the Jews, instead of starting an aggressive anti-Jewish offensive. This, he explained, is going to be remedied now, by the Hitlerist party proceeding to a big campaign aimed at clearing the Jews out of Germany.

Hitler was acclaimed together with Cuza at an antisemitic conference held at Radautz, in the Bukovina, in the early part of this month (reported in the J.T.A. Bulletin of the 5th. inst.). Impassioned addresses were delivered, the "Dimineatza" stated, glorifying Hitler and Cuza as the founders of the "Christian League for the Protection of Christian Europe Against the Jewish League of Nations", and the participants took an oath to follow Hitler and Cuza and carry out their orders.

The disappointment of the Hitlerist storm troops and other Hitlerist supporters in Germany with the inactivity of the Party leaders against the Jews was reported (in the J.T.A. Bulletin of the 21st. inst.) in a statement issued by the Central Union of German Citizens of Jewish Faith, warning German Jewry that the Hitlerist leaders were preparing a new anti-Jewish campaign to regain their lost popularity.

We have learned on good authority, it said, that the Hitlerist leaders have held a Conference at Munich, with Hitler in the chair, at which it was decided to divert attention from the general political situation by whipping up a big antisemitic campaign. After the Reichstag elections of last September, the statement commented, Hitler appeared before the foreign world as a diplomat and an apostle of law and order, but now that the hopes of the Hitlerists to govern the country have vanished, the masses are to be fed on antisemitic propaganda.

IT WAS HITLERISTS WHO SMASHED WINDOWS AND ORGANISED DISTURBANCES ON DAY OF REICHSTAG OPENING SAYS PRUSSIAN MINISTER OF INTERIOR REPUDIATING HITLERIST CLAIM THAT LEFT ORGANISED DISORDERS TO DISCREDIT HITLERISTS: OUT OF 103 ARRESTED 39 WERE MEMBERS OF HITLERIST PARTY AND 58 ADMITTED BEING SYMPATHISERS HE SAYS.

Out of 103 people who were arrested for window-smashing and violence during the demonstrations on the day of the opening of the new Reichstag, 39 were members of the Hitlerist Party and 58 others admitted being sympathisers, the Prussian Minister of the Interior, Herr Severing, declared in the Prussian Diet to-day, repudiating the Hitlerist contention that the disorders were carried out by the Left to discredit the Hitlerist movement.

RITUAL MURDER ACCUSATION IN ALGIERS: JEW KEPT IN PRISON IN ORAN AND
MALTRATED ON CHARGE OF KILLING HIS SISTER-IN-LAW FOR RITUAL
PURPOSES PRESS REPORTS; FIRST OF THIS YEAR'S PRE-PASSOVER CROP.

Paris, Feb. 25th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The Jewish population of Oran, in Algiers, (a notorious seat of antisemitism, where serious anti-Jewish disturbances have several times occurred, the movement being led by the Mayor of Oran, Deputy Molle, who died a few weeks ago, his campaign being continued by his paper "Le Petit-Oranais") is excited over the arrest of a local Jew named Teboul on a charge of ritual murder.

Teboul was arrested together with his wife and his mother-in-law, following the death of his wife's sister, a girl named Juliette Torjmen. The girl's mother and sister were soon after released, but Teboul is being kept in prison while the authorities are pursuing their enquiries, admittedly to obtain evidence in support of the ritual murder accusation brought up against him, backed by the fact of the approaching Passover festival, for which, it is being claimed, Jews require human blood.

Teboul is being brutally treated in prison, a number of the local papers complain. He is being beaten senseless, and recently when he complained after such a beating that he was ill, he was taken to hospital, where the doctor refused to admit him, saying that there was nothing the matter with him. The authorities are being carried away by medieval prejudice, they say, and are forgetting everything about the principle of humane treatment of prisoners, especially since, nothing at all has been proved against Teboul.

RITUAL MURDER STORIES AND COPIES OF PROTOCOLS OF ZION BEING SPREAD
IN JUGO-SLAVIA: PRIME MINISTER EXPRESSES ASTONISHMENT WHEN
INFORMED BY REPRESENTATIVE OF JEWISH COMMUNITIES AND GIVES
ASSURANCE THAT CAMPAIGN WILL BE PUT DOWN.

Copies of the "Protocols of the Learned Elders of Zion" and pamphlets accusing the Jews of practising ritual murder are being printed and circulated in Jugo-Slavia, Dr. Piade, representative of the Federation of Jewish Communities in Jugo-Slavia has complained here to the Prime Minister, General Zivkovic, who replied that he was astounded to hear of such a campaign in Jugo-Slavia and assured him that the Government will enquire into the matter and will put down with severity every attempt to create disharmony between Jewish and non-Jewish citizens of the country.

COMPULSORY SUNDAY CLOSING DANGER AGITATING CZECHO-SLOVAKIAN JEWS.

Prague, Feb. 25th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The movement in favour of enforcing Compulsory Sunday Closing in Czecho-Slovakia is continuing to cause anxiety among the Jews of the country, who are now beginning to organise a big defensive campaign to ward off the danger. The Government, by enforcing such a law, it is pointed out, would compel the Jews to rest on 124 days in the year, 52 Sabbaths, 52 Sundays, 13 Jewish festival days, 5 Christian festivals, and two State holidays. The idea of Compulsory Sunday Closing, it is claimed, is based on the recommendation of the Third International Labour Conference held in Geneva in 1921, which only urges that all workers should have a full 24 hours rest in the seven days, and does not stipulate that the day of rest must be Sunday. There is nothing said in the recommendation against Jews being compelled to rest 48 hours in the week. In England and Holland, it is pointed out, there are special exemptions for Sabbath observing Jews, as in the recent "Hairdressers' and Barbers' Sunday Closing Act, which recognises the right of Jewish barbers to keep open on Sunday, if they close on Saturday. The 1919 Labour Law in Holland, too, exempts people belonging to a religious community whose day of rest is on the seventh day, and there is a similar legislative provision in French law.

JEWISH CANDIDATES IN LONDON COUNTY COUNCIL ELECTIONS.

London, Feb. 26th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

About 25 Jews are standing as candidates for the London County Council elections, which take place on Thursday, March 5th. The candidates of the Municipal Reform Party (whose leader, Lord Jessel, is a Jew) include Sir Percy C. Simmons in the City of London; Sir Cecil B. Levita, in Kensington; Mr. A. Clavering, in St. Pancras; and Mr. S. Gluckstein, in Westminster.

The Liberal Party is putting forward Mrs. E. J. C. Nathan, the wife of Major H. L. Nathan, M.P., and Mr. Percy A. Harris, in Bethnal Green; Miss Nettie Adler, the daughter of the late Chief Rabbi, Dr. Hermann Adler, in Hackney; and Miss Ida Samuel in Lambeth. The Labour candidates include Mr. Harry Day, M. G. and Mr. L. Silkin, in Southwark; Mr. M.H. Davis, the Mayor of Stepney, (who is President of the Federation of Synagogues) Mr. D. Frankel and Mr. H. Lazarus, both ex-Mayors of Stepney in that constituency; Mr. M. Orbach in Bethnal Green; Mr. H. Samuels in Fulham; Mr. G. Gaster in St. Marylebone; Mr. A. E. Samuels in St. Pancras; Dr. S. W. Jeger, former Mayor of Shoreditch in Shoreditch; Mr. G. R. Straus, M.P. in Lambeth, and Mr. B. Dvorkovitz in Kensington. Miss Miriam Moses is standing as an Independent candidate in Stepney.

PROFESSOR EINSTEIN RETURNING FROM CALIFORNIA: REPORT OF HIS ILLNESSDELETED

New York, Feb. 25th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Professor Einstein is leaving California for New York on Friday, on his return to Europe.

Anxiety has been caused by a report widely circulated through the Hearst Press that Professor Einstein had collapsed during a banquet given in his honour in California. This report is definitely denied on enquiry by the J.T.A. Professor Einstein is in his usual health, it is stated.

BIALIK RETURNS TO PALESTINE.

London, Feb. 26th, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Mr. Ch. N. Bialik, the famous Hebrew poet, left to-day on his return to Palestine. He has been staying in London for several weeks, during which he lectured at the School of Oriental Studies, of London University and was given a reception by members of the P.E.N. Club.

HEBREW UNIVERSITY AS A TEACHING UNIVERSITY: PREPARED TO COMMENCE TEACHING BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES IF NECESSARY FUNDS OBTAINED.

Jerusalem, Feb. 25th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

The Hebrew University is now prepared to commence teaching biological sciences, if the necessary funds are available, says an announcement by the Hebrew University in connection with Dr. Magnes' departure for America, to endeavour to obtain funds to make possible the opening of the biological courses by equipping a physical laboratory for students and inviting a Professor for comparative Anatomy and Histology.

The decision to open a Faculty of Natural Sciences was made by the University Board of Governors in 1929, and the opening is fore-shadowed for 1932.

Dr. Magnes will also endeavour to place the University on a sounder financial basis while working towards the development and extension of those departments which are already functioning, but require completion.

JEWISH EYE SPECIALIST INVITED TO TRANSJORDAN TO TREAT EX-KING HUSSEIN:
DR. TICHO WHO WAS STABBED BY ARAB DURING UNQUIET PERIOD FOLLOWING
AUGUST OUTBREAK.

Jerusalem, Feb. 25th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

Dr. Ticho, the famous Jewish eye specialist here has been invited by the Emir Abdullah to Amman, the capital of Transjordan, to treat his father, the octagenarian ex-King Hussein, who is now staying there as his guest.

Dr. Ticho has lived in Palestine for over 25 years, and is extremely popular with all sections of the population. He has given free treatment to hundreds of Arabs, and numbers many Arabs as his friends. In November 1929, when Palestine was still in a state of disquiet, after the August outbreak, and a number of attacks were being still made on Jews in various parts of the country, (the attempt on Mr. Norman Bentwich was made a few days later.) Dr. Ticho was stabbed by a young Arab outside his surgery, and was in hospital for several weeks. The Arab organ "Felestin" published a condemnation of the outrage, and offered a reward of £25 for information leading to the arrest of Dr. Ticho's assailant "to show what our attitude is to such assailants". A young Christian Arab employed in the Palestine Post Office service was arrested.

When a number of prominent Jews in Palestine connected with the Brith Shalom movement collected signatures to a petition to the Palestine Government to pardon the Arabs who had been sentenced to death for murdering Jews during the August outbreak, Dr. Ticho and his wife were stated to be among the first signatories.

PALESTINE INHABITANTS WERE CANNIBALS BETWEEN 8,000 AND 10,000 B.C.

London, Feb. 26th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

These inhabitants of Palestine between 8,000 and 10,000 B.C., must, it would seem, have been cannibals and have regarded brains as a particular delicacy, for there are several examples of skulls from which a rectangular fragment had been chopped so as to render possible the removal of the interior, a special Representative writes to-day in the "Morning Post", reporting a visit he has paid to the Museum of the Royal College of Surgeons in Lincoln's Inn Fields, where Sir Arthur Keith, former President of the British Association, who is Conservator of the Museum, and Hunterian Professor at the College, and Lord Moynihan, the President of the Society showed him the collection of bones and skeletons in the Museum collected from all ages and countries.

The remark is made in connection with a number of skulls shown him by Sir Arthur Keith, which were recently excavated by the British School of Archaeology in Jerusalem on Mount Carmel and other sites. Holding one beside his own head he demonstrated what a formidable appearance the original must have possessed.

In scientific value, Lord Moynihan claimed, the collections at the Museum are the equal of the next six collections of the kind in the world put together.
