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NOT A ROPEK FOR MATZOTH AND NOT AN HOUR OFF FOR JESISH WORKERS:

"ANTI-FASSOVER SLOGARS IN FIRST ISSUE OF THREST ATHERS TOURNAL

"Not a single kopek for matcoth or other religious ob-servances connected with Passover"; "Not a single kopek for renovat-lng synagogues, supporting Yeshiboth, or the Jewish clergy"; "Not a single hour to be taken off by Jewish workmen in the factories during Passover week".

These slogan's for the anti-Passover campaign are the outatanding feature of the first issue of the Yiddish at helst journal, "Aplkodres", which has just come off the press here. Despite these militant slogens, however, interest in the

anti-religious campaign is very slight now, and the Apikoires has had a great deal of difficulty to get together about a quarter of a column of items from all parts of the country relating to the anti-religious activity. In Kaidanov, it reports, the synagogue has been turned into an artisans' club. In Linetz, the synagogue has been converted into a school. In Monastritchni, the synagogue has been given up for use as a culture house. The Jewish village been given up for use as a cutoure induse. In several visits field "(Red Field"), in the Jewish autonomous region Stalindorf, has seized the costly ornaments which adorned the Sorolls of the Law and has made a present of them to the local Defence Fund. The Jewish settlement Bragin has on a vote decided to give up the Beth Kidrash for cultural purposes. Homel reports that an antireligious University has been organised there with an attendance of 20 students. Lochwitz reports that it has broken the record, with 40 active members of the "Apikoires" atheist organisation. The well known Jewish woman Communist "Esther" (Esther

rrumkin) has an article in the first issue of the "Apikoires", addressed to women, headed "Down with pots and pans, and on to the

factory".

Unperturbed by the anti-Passover campaign of the "Api-koires" and the "Emess", the Jews of Moscow and throughout the Soviet Union generally are calmiy continuing to make their prepara-

tions for the usual celebration of Passover.
"Dos Sozialistiche Dorf" (Socialist village) of Harkov, the capital of the Ukraine, sounds the alarm in view of the approach of the Passover, complaining that in spite of all the cultural work among the Jewish colonists, Jews in the collectives continue to observe, the Jawish customs, and even the younger men who have dis-carded religion and "believe in nothing" cease work on Saturday as a matter of course, dress up in their best clothes and make it a day of rest and enjoyment.

All Jewish colonists, it says, must be "behind the plough during the Passover days". It frankly confesses, however, that it doubts whether this slogan will be realised. During last Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur, it says, many members of the Collectives, who are otherwise reliable and dependable workmen, refused to leave their homes on those days and to put on their working clothes.

The paper urges that an anti-religious nucleus should be formed in every Jewish region to keep up a continuous anti-religious agitation among the Jewish colonists, and that at least one collective in every Jewish region should openly avow itself a hundred per cent. anti-religious body.

The Ark of the Law in the Lubavitch Synagogue at Polotsk was recently converted into a store room for keeping there the paraphornalia used for making wines and spirits for use during Pasaover week, the "Young Worker" ("Der Yunger Arbete"), of Winsk, asserts. Another synagogue in Polotsk, it alleges, has been used as a store room for hoarding goods stolen from co-operatives.

Because of this, it states, the Lubavitch Synagogue has been converted into a Workers! Club, and a decision with re-

gard to the disposal of the second synagogue is pending.

The Jewish clerical elements in Polotsk, it complains, are busy building up stores for the surreptitious sale and distribution of matzoth, fat, sugar and meat among the religious people of the town. In addition, two bakeries are being run by the orthodox Jews of the city for baking matzoth. A Government in vestigation, the paper reports, has disclosed that the goods used by the religious elements were clandestinely sold to them by the

heads of the local co-operative warehouse "Apikorsim Perband", is calling a convention mext Thursday, the 25th inst., a week before Passover, to discuss means of extending the anti-Passover campaign and of putting the anti-religious work among the Jewish workmen on

a practical and permanent basis.

"ORD "TREACHERY" BECOME COMMONFLACE EVEN CITH VETERAN ZIONISTS

WHENEVER THEY DISHROWS PROVE OF DELICY OF LELDERSHIP DR. WEIZMANN

Jerusalem, Mar. 20th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).
The word "treachery" has of late become a commonplace in our ranks, even veteran Zionists joining in the outcry whenever they disapprove of the policy of the leadership, Dr. Weizmann said somewhat bitterly to-day at the Jewish Agency headquarters here, in replying to an address of welcome presented to him by the Jewish agency officials.

The poisoned atmosphere is more difficult to bear than the economic hardships caused by the non-payment of salaries, the spokes-

men complained to Dr. Weizmann.

The atmosphere will soon be cleared and the Jews will again joyfully shoulder their duties, Dr. Weizmann assured them, declaring that he himself is prepared to help the Zionist Congress to make a

thorough house-cleaning by eliminating himself from the leadership.

Dr. Weizmenn had a conference afterwards with the members of the Executive of whom Dr. Ruppin, Colonel Kisch, Dr. Senator, Mr.

Harry Sacher, Mr. Joseph Sprinzak and Dr. Barth were present.

Dr. Weizmann also had an interview of about an hour with the Figh Commissioner, Sir John Chancellor, with whom Mrs. Weizmann

and he had lunch.

During his interview with the Figh Commissioner, the J.T.A. understands, Dr. Weizmann touched on the questions of an understanding with the Arabs, the Hope Simpson development scheme and early immigration facilities. This afternoon, Dr. Weizmann is having a conference with

the Executive of the Histadruth (Palestine Labour Federation), and on Sunday he is visiting the colony of Beer Tuviah, which has been resbuilt after having been razed during the outbreak of August 1929. DR. Stink bombs were thrown by Revisionists who had come in force to a meeting at which Dr. J. L. Lagues, the Chancellor of the Hebrew University in Jerusalem, delivered an address in Hebrew on the work of the University under the auxiliary to the Histariuth Ivrith, the Hebrew-speaking Association of America.

The Zionist Revisionist Organisation of America had adopted a resolution a few days ago before Dr. Magnes' arrival here, demanding that the Council of the Hebrew University should dismiss Dr. Magnes from his position as Chancellor because of his

"activities against Zionism since the riots of 1929"

Dr. Magnes was called a traitor by the Revisionists present at the meeting and there was a real fight with fists between the Revisionists and the General Zionists who came to Dr. Magnes! After lasting for about half-an-hour the riot was subdued by the police, who with great difficulty ejected about 40 or 50 of the rioters.

Dr. Magnes then proceeded to deliver his address on the achievements of the Hebrew University, with occasional heckling by some of the Revisionists who had remained behind.

The riots started as soon as Mr. ab. Goldberg, the Chairmen, introduced Dr. Magnes. Dr. Magnes stood his ground calmly and apologised for being the cause of the unpleasantness. I am accustomed to being called a traitor, he went on. I have heard it before, alluding to the days during the war when he had been called a traitor because of his pacifism.

After the conclusion of the meeting, crowds of Revisionists', who had collected in the street, hurled insulting remarks at Dr. Magnes, who refused, however, the offer of police protection, stating that he was not afraid and preferred to walk home alone.

REVISIONIST RELATIONS "ITH ZIONIST WORLD ORGANISATION: DEMANDS OF PALESTINE REVISIONISTS FOR LEAVING ACTIONS COMMITTEE AND CONVOCATION OF SEPARATE ZIONIST CONGRESS UNACCEPTABLE WORLD EXECUTIVE DECLARES: BOUND BY REVISIONIST WORLD CONFERENCE DE-CISION FOR PARTICIPATION IN SEVENTEENTH ZIONIST CONGRESS

London, Par. 20th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The Executive Committee of the Borld Union of Zionist Revisionists at a recent meeting had under consideration the resolutions of the recent Revisionist Conference in Palestine, calling upon the Executive Committee to take a series of steps in the sphere. of Zionist internal and external policy, says a statement issued here by the Revisionist World Executive Committee.

In this connection, it says, the following decisions have

been arrived at by the Executive Committee.

The question of the recall of the Revisionist representatives on the Actions Committee was put to the members of the Party Council some time ago, and resulted in an overwhelming majority against the proposal. The Executive Committee therefore considers itself bound by this expression of opinion on the part of the Party Council. The Revisionist World Conference in Prague, August 1930, and the session of the Party Council in Berlin of December 1930, unanimously decided that the Revisionist World Union should perticipate in the 17th, Ordinary Zionist Congress, and conduct the election campaign with all possible energy. All proposals contrary to these decisions, such as convocation of a separate Congress, must therefore be regarded as eo ipso unacceptable.

The Statute of the Congress and the Statute of the Congress Court provide no legal possibility, formally, to put on trial the Zionist Executive and its President who has resigned. The Executive Committee is, however, resolved to take advantage of the proceedings of the Congress Court in connection with the case sgainst ir. Grossman, initiated by the Zionist Executive, to reveal the harmful nature of the political activity of the Zionist Executive and Dr. Weizmann.

The Executive Committee has, following the publication of Fr. Remsey LacDonald's letter and the subsequent Statement by Dr. Veizmann, decided to present a definitive demand to the Zionist Executive - which has, despite it qwn assurances, conducted the negotistions with the Eritish Government on the basis of the White Paper of October 1930, and which no longer enjoys the confidence of the Zionist Movement - that it should, pending the election of a new Executive, carry on no further negotiations with the Exendatory Power. Should this demand be rejected, the Executive Committee has decided to call upon the Jewish masses in all countries to protest publicly against the negotiations which are being or are to be carried on in London by Dr. Weizmann and his colleagues.

GERMAN GOVERNMENT APPEALED TO BY CENTRAL UNION OF GERMAN JEWS TO

In view of the attempted murders of two Jews this week in Famburg and Preussiach-Holland, the Fresidium of the Central Union of Gerran Citizens of the Jewish Faith has decided to make immediate and urgent representations to the Federal and State authorities to make energetic use of their powers to prevent further such outrages. These attempted seasasinations, descorations of cometeries and insults of the most victous character levelled against Jews and Judeism are the result of a systematic campaign conducted by the antisemitic Hitlerists in the press and at public meetings, which has no claim to the title of political propagands, the resolution adopted says. A number of mass meetings are being organised to enlighten public opinion of the dangers of this campaign of incitement to anti-Jewish violence upon the general and political
