LEVING GEORGE'S SERVICES TO JEWISH PROPLE THROUGHOUT WORLD COMMEMORATED BY TABLET SET UP IN WELSH MEMORIAL INSTITUTE: PRIME MINISTER WHO SANCTIONED ISSUE OF HISTORIC BALFOUR D.CLARATION.

London, Mar. 27th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

"In commemoration and grateful recognition of the services rendered by the Right Honourable David Lloyd George to Jews throughout the world, this Tablet was set up in the forty-first year of his representation of the Carnaryon District Boroughs in the Fouse of Commons", says the inscription on a tablet which was quietly unveiled this week in the little mountain village of Clynceiriog, in the Vale of Ceiriog, in the county of Denbigh, in Wales. The Tablet has been placed in the Ceiriog memorial Institute. a building erected to commemorate distinguished Welshmen and their services to humanity.

"As Prime Minister of the United Aingdom of Great Britain and Ireland" the inscription proceeds, "he senctioned the issue of the historic Balfour Declaration of November 2nd., 1917, whereby a great European Power recognised and approved for the first time the claim of the Jewish people to establish a National Home in Palestine, which Declaration was, during his further period of office as Prime Minister of Great Britain, affirmed by the Conference of the Allied Powers on the 24th. day of April, 1920, when the Mandate for Palestine was conferred upon Great Britain".

Beneath, is the year 1931, and the words "Lest we Forget" with their equivalents in Welsh and Hebrew.

This tribute to Mr. Lloyd George, on the eve of the dinner which is to be given in his honour on April 11th. to inaugurate the "Ramat David", or Lloyd George Colony in Palestine, is the gift, it is understood, of a few Jews of all shades of opinion in this country and of some in Egypt. It will take its place in the institution in which it now stands beside the memorials to other Welsh worthies, such as Saint David, Bishop William Morgan, Sir Hugh Myddleton, and the post Cairiog.

The Coiriog Memorial Institute was founded in 1911 and was recently enlarged at a cost of over £2,000, the opening ceremony on the latter occasion being performed by Lord Lloyd, formerly High Commissioner for Egypt. The president is Sir Alfred T. Davies. formerly Permanent Secretary to the Welsh Department of the Board of

Education, who is an ardent friend of the Zionist movement.

Interest attaches to the fact that the commemorative tribute was made almost on the eve of Mr. Lloyd George's completion of his forty-one years of service as bember of Parliament for the Carnervon District Boroughs (he is the "Father" of the House of Commons, having held his seat for a longer continuous period than any other member of Parliament), his first election for the constituency having taken place on April 10th., 1890.

A plan for the organisation of a great medical centre in Falestine, sebracing the hospital and school of medicine in connection with the Febrew University in Jerusalem was put forward by Dr. L. Magnes, the Chancellor of the Mobrew University, at a dinner given in his honour here by the American Jewish Physicians' Committee, which was formed in 1921 in order "to build a medical college and hospital in commection with the Mewrew University in Palestine".

200 Jewish doctors belonging to the Committee were present at the

Dr. Magnes asked for a sum of 100,000 dollars as an endowment fund for the purpose, to be used for a period of five years. The merican Jowish Physicians' Committee, he announced, has during the ten years of its existence contributed 350,000 dollars for the work of the medical and hygiene departments of the Hebrew University. Funds for the first unit of the Medical Department of the contributed 100 periods of the Hebrew University, an Opthalmic Institute for research and for clinical purposes, were announced in 1920 by Dr. Nethan Ratnoff, the President of the American Jewish Physicians' Committee and Chairman of the Hebrew University Reptital Committee, as the gift of Mr. Isidore D. Morrison, a prominent American Zionist. The building and equipment cost was estimated at about 100,000 dollars, in addition to which Mr. Morrison pledged himself to contribute 10,000 dollars amusally towards the meintenance cost.

JEWISH AGRICULTURAL SCHOOL FOR PALESTINE: GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCES BUILD-ING STARTING NEXT KONTH ON KADOORIE BEQUEST INSTITUTE.

The plans for the farm buildings and dairy and for the general laying out of the proposed Jewish Agricultural School which is to be erected near Mount Tabor, in the Morthern District, by the funds of the Madoorie Bequest, have been completed, says an official statement, issued probably in reply to the recent Jewish criticism that the opening of the Jewish school had been unduly delayed, while the Arab school erected out of the funds bequeathed by the Jewish philanthropist is already functioning. The road formation from the Mesha-Sejera track to the site of the farm has been already made and the site has been labelled, it is stated, and the construction of the farm buildings will begin in April, as soon as the track from Mesha becomes passable for transport. The Government Architect is now working on the designs for the school building. A bore was sunk in 1930 on the land of the School with satisfactory results. JEWS AND ARABS ON NEW SAFED MUNICIPAL COUNCIL.

Four Arabs and three Jews constitute the new Municipal
Council elected in Safed in place of the Municipal Council which
was dissolved when the administration of the town became practically impossible after the massacre of August 1929 and a British
Officer was appointed to conduct its affairs.

The four arabs are Salah-ed-Din Gaddura; Ali Rida Nahawi; Mohammed Salim Shemma, and Khalil Yusef Rustom; and the three Jews are David Bar, Yahuda anteibi and Zindel Kahan.

The Arabs, whether Loslem or Christian, are our brothers, and when I speak of enemies I mean also those Jews who are trying to make us quarrel, in the same way as the "Felestin" is doing, Mr. Mayer Dizengoff, the Mayor of Tel Aviv, writes in a reply to a warning issued to the Arab population by the Falestine Arab Executive, to take no part in the celebrations now being held in honour of Mr. Dizengoff's Toth. birthday. The Zionists will exploit any Arab participation in the celebrations for propaganda purposes, the Palestine Arab Executive said, in its statement. Mr. Dizengoff's reference to "ensmise" is intended to correct the Impression created by the "Felestin", which, in reporting his speech welcoming Dr. Welzmann to Tel Aviv, made him say that the Arabs were enemies.

ROUMANIAN CHIEF RABBI SAYS HE FEARS HIDDEN NUMERUS CLAUSUS IN NEW HIGH SCHOOL REGULATIONS.

Bucharest, kar. 26th. (Jowish Telegraphic Agency).

I am afraid that the new regulations governing admission to the Figh Schools in Roumania by requiring students to sit for special entrance examinations apart from the matriculation examinations, which the law provides as the sole requirement for entrance to the Universities, are intended really for introducing a hidden numerus clausus, Chief Rebbi Senator Dr. Niemirover complained at the meeting of the Senate Commission examining the new regulations.

He could not see the need of these special entrance examinations, the Chief Rabbi said. Either the High Schools have room for all the students applying for admission, in which case all the children of the State are equally entitled to be admitted, or there is a lack of room, and in that case the matriculation examination should be made a more severe test of the students' capabilities, but the examination should be uniform and not left to the caprice of each University authority.

The Minister of Education, Professor Costacescu, rose to protest against Chief Rabbi Miemirover's use of the words "hidden numerus clausus". There can be no question, he dec There can be no question, he declared, of any numerus clausus over being introduced into Roumania. There is really a great deal of difficulty to find room for all students, he said, but there is no intention whatever to prejudice

the Jowish students as against any other students.

Chief Rabbi Dr. Mismirover replied that the Minister's statement did not satisfy him and that he would probably raise the

question at a plenary session of the Senate.

HITLERIST GOVERNMENT IN THURINGIA CENSURED: APPOINTMENT OF ANTISEMI-TIC PROFESSOR OF RACOGLOGY AT JAMA UNIVERSITY UNJUSTIFIED SAYS BUDGET COMMISSION: NO SCIENTIFIC BASIS FOR THIS STUDY.

To Gunther, the leading authority on "scientific antisemitism", who was recently appointed as Professor of the antisemitic science of "Receology" at the world-famous University of Jena, by the Hitlerist Kinister of Education Dr. Frick, has been made the target for the attack the Thuringian Parliament is making against the Hitlerist regime, which is to face a vote of no confidence, assured of a safe majority by the People's Party, hitherto in alliance with the Hitlerists having now joined the Opposition.

The Diet, says a resolution adopted to-day by the Budget Commission, which is now going to the plenary session, disapproves the appointment of the Hitlerist race theoretician, Dr. Guenther, to the professorship of Raceology at Jena University, since no scientific need exists for such a branch of research and the setting up of such a Chair is therefore entirely unnecessary.

GERMAN FITLERISTS ACTIVE IN AMERICA: GERMAN LANGUAGE PAPER REVEALS ATTEMPT BY NEW YORK HITLWRIST ORGANISATION TO DICTATE ITS

POLICY.

New York, Mar. 26th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The German Hitlerists, whose organisation in the United States was disclosed by the J.T.A. recently, is getting active here, the "Freie Zeitung", a German-language newspaper published in Newark, New Jersey, reveals in the course of an editorial article, in which it speaks of an attempt which the New York Hitlerist Organisation has been making to dictate its policy.

After writing about the group, the paper says, it received

a visit from a number of its members, who then sent a letter, where If it is distasteful to you to retract this article, which we can understand, we shall send you an article which you could publish as an editorial in your paper. We should regard

this as perfectly satisfactory, and as for yourselves it would be a much better way of putting yourselves in the right. We have not come to such a pass, the paper comments, that the Press here, German or any other foreign-language press, should have to submit to the dictatorship of any German party, least of all away to submit to the dictatorship of any derman party, least of all a party whose members enjoy the hospitality of this country, a hospitality which would be denied them if the programme of their own Party were applied to its members here by the United States Government. We hope, it concludes, that the leaders of the New York Hitlerist group will take back home to their clique in Germany at least something of American ways of behaviour.
