PALESTINE GOVERNMENT IS CAUSE FOR THE EXCITEMENT IN THE COUNTRY,
ARAB PAPER DECLARES: HEBREW PAPER SUSPENDED: THE STRIKE OF THE ARAB PPESS.

Terusalem, Aug. 9, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
The Revisionist paper, Haan, was suspended today for an indefinite period by the Palestine Government for an editorial in which the paper suggested that the Palestine authorities staged and managed the incitement of the Arabs against the Jews in connection with the agitation of the Arabs to liquidate the sealed armouries in the Jewish colonies.

While the Arab papers have announced their own suspension beginning with Monday for one week as protest against the Government, the Al Hayat publishes a special stricle accusing the Palestine Government as being the cause of the excitement now preveiling in Palestine. "The Government," the Arab paper writes, "is the cause of all the disturbences in this country. If the reprehensible Mandate and the Jewish National Home were not in existence, if the Government did not arm the Jewish colonies, no disturbances or excitement would ever take place."

Referring to the report which the Palestine Government submitted to the League of Nations, and in which it is stated that the Government did not desire to hold elections for Municipality "Councils in Palestine because it fears that such elections might

open the door to disturbances and excitement, the Arab paper writes:
"If:itiwere supposed that the elections are likely to create disturbances, then why does not the Government give up all the pretense to civilization, and return to the Middle Ages, governing like a despot am being responsible to none? Why does Britain pretend that she came to prepare us for self-government? If there are no elections how can there be a representative government?"

38 SHALL NEVER MAKE PEACE WITH THE JEWS, SAYS ARAB PRESS: WARNS DR. ARLOSOROFF THAT HIS EFFORTS FOR ARAB-JEWISH FRIENDLY RELATIONS ARE DOOMED TO FAILURE.

A warning to Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff, the successor of Col. Miach in Palestine that his efforts to bring about peace between the Jews and the Arabs will not be successful, is made today in the Arab paper, Falastin, on the eve of the Arab Press! seven day's strike. Pointing out that the duty of Dr. Arlosoroff will henceforth be a two-fold one; to represent the Jewish Community before the Government, and at the same time to reach an understanding with the Arabs for establishing Arab-Jewish friendly relations, the paper says:

But with us Arabs he is certainly not likely to succeed. The Almighty knews we shall never come to an agreement with the Zionists as long as they desire our expulsion from the land.

"We shall never make peace with the Jews as long as Zionism exists," the paper continues. "We shall never come to an agreement with them, as long as there is a Zionist Executive and Zionist branches in all parts of the world. We can inform Dr. Arlosoroff right now that failure awaits him," the paper concludes.

THE FUNERAL OF DR. LEE K. FRANKEL IN NEWYORK: TRIBUTE FAID BY FELIX M. WARBURG: MANY PROMINENT AMERICANS ATTEND.

New York, Aug. 9, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Simple rites marked the funeral of Dr. Lee K. Frankel. the joint-chairman of the Jewish Agency Council, who died suddenly in Paris on July 26th.

The body of Dr. Frankel arrived here from Paris last The funeral of the deceased was attended by many promin-

ent personalities including Jewish leaders.

Paying tribute to the late Dr. Frankel, Felix M. Warburg, characterized Dr. Frankel as a "dear, noble, and exterodinary friend."
"In his passing," Mr. Warburg said, "I feel that I have lost a dear, noble and extraordinary friend who sannot be replaced. Fis death is a very painful and severe blow to all of those who had the privilege of knowing him and of working with him in his many activities for the improvement of social and living conditions.
"I have had the privilege," Mr. Warburg continued, "o

meeting and cooperating with him for almost 40 years, and his wise ccunsel, his human interest, his personal charm and his great tact andeared him to me as it did to all who came in contact with him. We who loved him feel grateful that he did not suffer as some of us felt might have been his lot since he had some warnings that his conctitution was breaking down under great strain. He will be sadly missed whenever people come together to try to work out knotty problems of community life.

Through his work in the United Hebrew Charities, he developed understanding and sympathy with those who had to come to the community for charity. Through his connection with the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, he was familiar with the problems of almost every layer of the population in this beehive. In building up the manysized activities of the Federation of Jewish Charities, he developed a breadth of vision which was extraordinary and his fairness made him most teluable not only in the construction but in the administration of the Federation's funds in many directions. In the training of social workers he was both an understanding trustee and a sympathetic guide and in the Welfare Council, which has embraced philanthropic activities of all creeds disregarding denominational lines, his counsel was sought and welcomed.

"But his sympathies were not only city-wide and United States-wide; his understanding extended to all parts of Europe and Palestine; on the Joint Distribution Committee he served faithfully and was beloved by contributor, administrator and recipient alike for he was equally close to all three and he knew them all personally and intimately. In the last few years he gave a good deal of time to the development of the Jewish work in Palestine. He was wise, con-structive, and was not guided by visionary promises but by solid facts. We were colleagues in the Commission that studied Palestinian conditions and only a few weeks ago he was elected to a leading position in the Jewish Agency Council.

Great indignation prevails among the Jewish leaders in Poland in connection with the interference which the Polish Government is now actively exhibiting in inner-Jewish Kehillah matters by crossing out from the Kehilla budgets all subsidies for Jewish cultural institutions.

As an explanation for its action the Government gives the pretext that the Kehillas are just religious and philanthropic institutions, therefore, they have no right to grant subsidies to Jewish schools and other cultural enterprises.

A report from the city of Kielc reveals today that a number of important Jewish artisan schools and also elementary schools where many hundreds of poor Jewish children have been recolving educational training, will have to be closed down now be-cause the Ministry of Education definitely prohibits the Kehillah of Kielc to support these institutions.

The institutions which will be liquidated now due to the interference on the part of the Ministry of Education, were not only of cultural value for those at ending, but also of effective social relief, training their pupils for various professional undertakings, and at the same time providing kitchens in these schools to feed and maintain their pupils. The Kehillah of Kielc found it extremely important to subsidize these schools no twith standing the fact that due to the present economic depression in Poland, the Kehillah funds are very limited.

REWARD FOR FINDING DESECRATORS OF JEWISH CEMETERY ANNOUNCED IN MEMEI GOVERNOR PROMISES AID.

Kovno, Aug. 9 (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). A reward of 1000 Lit was announced today by the Kehillah of Yomel for the disclosure of the hooligans who participated in the desecration of the Jewish cemetery in Memel several days ago.

A delegation of the Kehillah appeared before the Governor of Memel. The Governor promised to take energetic measures for finding the desecrators who are believed to be members of the local German Fitlerites.

Admand that a special section for National Minorities in Bessarabla be established at the Roumanian Ministry of Interior was made yesterday by M. Landau, the Jawish member of the Roumanian Parliament, in a conference which he had with the Minister of Interior.

Deputy Landau appeared before the Minister of Interior with a complaint against the local Roumanian authorities in Besarabia saying that they interfered with the budgets of the Jewish institutions and are cutting these budgets unjustly, thus depriving many Jewish institutions of means for their existence. The situation can be solved only by establishing a special department at the Ministry of Interior for National Minority problems, Deputy Landau stated.

The Roumanian Minister of Interior promised to investigate the actions of the local authorities in Bessarabia and also to consider the question whether a special department for National Minorities can be established.

SPANISH INQUISITION METHODS PRACTISED AT ELLIS ISLAND: 15,000 CLIENS ARE DEPORTED FROM AMERICA ANNUALLY, REPORT SHOWS.

140 undesirable aliens, including several Jews, were deported this week from the United States.
The actual depertation of approximately 15,000 aliens

annually after great hardships, is violating the plainest dictates of humanity, says the official report of the Wickersham Commission which was appointed to investigate the activities of the immigration officials in the United States.

The report of the Wickersham Commission alleges that methods similar to those of the Spanish Inquisition are being practised by the American Immigration officials at Ellis Island. "The unconstitutional, tyrannical and oppressive methods are employed in the examination annually of about 100,000 aliens, the report says.

JEWS BLAMED FOR PRESENT FINANCIAL MANIPULATION IN FRANCE.

A charge that the Jews are responsible for the present financial manipulations in France is made today in the unofficial

Catholic daily newspapers "Tunisie Francaise".

The paper threatens the Jews of France that "their action may result in a violent outbreak of anti-Semitism." It impresses its readers with the fact that the financial complications in France are due to the intention of the Jews to compromise the Catholic political leaders and to play into the hands of the Scielists by involvin; the present politicians of France in scandalous financial affairs. The Jews and the Socialists are identical, the paper says. Therefore, the Jews are interested to help the Socialists in their efforts to discriminate against the Catholic leaders of the present Government.
