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THE ANY JEWISH OUTBREAK AT BERLIN UNIVERSITY: ABOUT 40
GENISH STUDENTS INJURED: 500 NAZIS SJRROUNDED 35 JEWS
RECTOR APPEALING POR QUIET BOSED BY NAZIS: POLICE
MILEGED TO HAVE DRIVEN OF REPUBLICAN STUDENTS TRYING TO HELP JEWS AND ALLOWED NAZIS TO GO ON BEATING JEWS.

Berlin, Jan. 22nd. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).
About 40 Jewish students were injured in the anti-

Jewish rioting at Berlin University, because of which the authorities have closed down the University till Monday. The J.T.A. representative has visited the Jewish students in hospital, and has found several in a serious condition. On of them, Reyersbach, who is a member of the Central Union of German Citizons of Jewish Faith, has had his teeth knocked out, the bridge of his nose is smashed, and his ear is torn. Mother named Karfunkelstein has had the bridge of his nose A third named Domp has had his cheek torn open, another named Schreiber has had his jaw smashed and is in a very serious condition, and a fifth named Muensterberger has a bad eye injury.

About 30 others, all members of the Sprevia Jewish

Students' Organisation, have slighter injuries.

About 300 Nazi students, the J.T.A. representative was told by the injured Jewish students, surrounded 35 members of the Sprevia, who put up a heroic resistance and tried to break their way through. Some Socialist stude Some Socialist students came to their help, and brought up the Rector of the University, who called upon the Nazi students to desist, but they only booed him. Two Zionist students, Glasberg and Heimann, and several Jewish girl students have also been injured.

Some of the students allege that the police drove off and arrested a number of Republican students who had come up wanting to help the Jewish students, but allowed the Nazistudents to continue beating the Jews and singing their anti-Jewish songs, with calls for Jewish blood.

Dr. Reichmann, Syndikus of the Central Union of German Citizens of the Jewish Faith, has intervened with the police authorities and with the Minister of Education, who have promised him that by Monday, when the University be reopened, measures will be taken which will make it impossible for any disturbances to recur. The Minister of Education added that if there

repetition of the anti-Jewish outbreaks, he will order the Universi'y to be closed down for the rest of the term.

The Jewish students demand the dissolution of the

Nazi Student Union, the suspension of those Nazi students who took part in the attack on the Jewish students, and the legalisation of a student self-defence organisation, to be responsible for the maintenance of order, in face of any further attempts at creating disturbances.

The Hitlerist organ "Angriff", which is edited by Deputy Goebbels, alleges that the Jess started the outbreak.
A crowd of Jess provoked the National Socialists, it
says, heading the report "Jesis provocation", end the Nazie beat back the Jews.

Serlin, Jan. 22nd. (Jewish Telegraphio 'gency'). Deputy Gosbbels, the Serlin leader of the hitlerists, was called to-day as a winess in the continued hearing of the appeal of Count "eldoof and his associates, who were found guilty of carrying out the anti-Jewish attack in the Kurfuerstendam last Roch Teshanat, and arrogantly declared that he would not answer the question put to him whether he had arranged for a pogrom in the Kurfuerstendamm, and put "elldorf in Jeargo of it, unless he was confronted with the police spy who had given that information.

Deputy Goebbels went on to make insulting remarks about the Police President, Dr. Weiss.

The court finally decided to record in the minutes of the proceedings that Leputy Coebbels had refused to give evidence.

Ex-Senator Horiz Carp, one of the leaders of the Union of Roumanian Jews, has an editorial in the "Gurierul Israelit", the organ of the Union, on the Scroca shooting affair. in which he says:

In this way six young Jewish lives have been lost. They were not even prisoners, as was the case in that terrible affair in Gasoho-Slovakia. They were only people who were looking for work. They could have been detained and arrested end brought up for trial to answer for their fault in attempting to cross the frontier, but instead of that they were sadistically shot down - because they were Jews. /nd is allowed to protest against it. "e must not protest oecause we are Jews. No corporal of a frontier guard would commit so terrible a deed against people of another nationality, but we are Jews, and against us there is a campaign of hatred and of calumny. Openly in the sittings of Parliament, the Cuzists are permitted to insult and threaten us. The murderer of Falik becomes a national hero. it student congresses there is open preaching of hatred against us Jews, and those whose duty it should be to take steps to put a stop to this propaganda think only of their petty political interests, and show excessive tolerance in regard to this most important matter of putting down an agitation which is harmful to the wellbeing and to the peace of the whole country.

## DEATH OF DR. M. RION PHILLIPS FIRST JEWISH WOMAN M.P.

London, Jan. 23rd. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Dr. marion Phillips, the chief woman officer of the-Labour Party, and the first Jewish woman member of Parliament, died to-day after a long illness at the age of 50. Phillips, who was born in Australia, came to England to study economics, on which subject she became an acknowledged authority. In June 1929, shortly after her election to Parliament, Dr. Marion Phillips spoke at a dinner arranged by the B'nai B'rith in London, and declared that it was the first time in 25 years that she had been asked to a Jewish gathering. It was the first time in 25 years' residence in England, she said, that she had received an invitation to be present at a gathering of members of the Jewish race. If there was anyone to blame, it was she herself, for she had taken no part in the Jewish Community. In Australia, where she was born, there was scarcely any difference to be noticed between members of the Jewish race and members of other races. There was no doubt of her Jewish race. .. hundred years ago, members of her family on both sides emigrated from England to Australia, and the, had a record that an ancestor of hers was connected with the synagogue. She confessed that her memories and studies came from English and not Jewish sources. loyalties were diverse. She thought that a few would agree with her at this gathering, when she said that it was her opinion that the future of the Jewish people should be in assimilation rather than in separation. It was her view, too, that all peoples should be united and assimilated, and that there should be a loving-kindness of people of the world.
