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THE ANTI-JEWISH OUTBREAK AT BERLIN UNIVERSITY: ABOUT 40  
JEWISH STUDENTS INJURED: 300 NAZIS SURROUNDED 35 JEWS:  
RECTOR APPEALING FOR QUIET BOOED BY NAZIS: POLICE  
ALLEGED TO HAVE DRIVEN OFF REPUBLICAN STUDENTS TRYING  
TO HELP JEWS AND ALLOWED NAZIS TO GO ON BEATING JEWS.

Berlin, Jan. 22nd. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

About 40 Jewish students were injured in the anti-Jewish rioting at Berlin University, because of which the authorities have closed down the University till Monday. The J.T.A. representative has visited the Jewish students in hospital, and has found several in a serious condition. One of them, Meyersbach, who is a member of the Central Union of German Citizens of Jewish Faith, has had his teeth knocked out, the bridge of his nose is smashed, and his ear is torn. Another named Karfunkelstein has had the bridge of his nose smashed. A third named Domp has had his cheek torn open, another named Schreiber has had his jaw smashed and is in a very serious condition, and a fifth named Muensterberger has a bad eye injury.

About 30 others, all members of the Sprevia Jewish Students' Organisation, have slighter injuries.

About 300 Nazi students, the J.T.A. representative was told by the injured Jewish students, surrounded 35 members of the Sprevia, who put up a heroic resistance and tried to break their way through. Some Socialist students came to their help, and brought up the Rector of the University, who called upon the Nazi students to desist, but they only booed him. Two Zionist students, Glasberg and Heimann, and several Jewish girl students have also been injured.

Some of the students allege that the police drove off and arrested a number of Republican students who had come up wanting to help the Jewish students, but allowed the Nazi students to continue beating the Jews and singing their anti-Jewish songs, with calls for Jewish blood.

Dr. Reichmann, Syndikus of the Central Union of German Citizens of the Jewish Faith, has intervened with the police authorities and with the Minister of Education, who have promised him that by Monday, when the University is to be reopened, measures will be taken which will make it impossible for any disturbances to recur.

The Minister of Education added that if there is any repetition of the anti-Jewish outbreaks, he will order the University to be closed down for the rest of the term.

The Jewish students demand the dissolution of the Nazi Student Union, the suspension of those Nazi students who took part in the attack on the Jewish students, and the legalisation of a student self-defence organisation, to be responsible for the maintenance of order, in face of any further attempts at creating disturbances.

The Hitlerist organ "Angriff", which is edited by Deputy Goebbels, alleges that the Jews started the outbreak.

A crowd of Jews provoked the National Socialists, it says, heading the report "Jewish Provocation", and the Nazis beat back the Jews.

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DEPUTY GOEBBELS SAYS HE WILL NOT TELL WHETHER HE ARRANGED  
POGROM IN KURFUERSTENDAMM UNLESS HE IS CONFRONTED WITH  
POLICE SPY WHO SAID SO.

Deputy Goebbels, the Berlin leader of the Hitlerists, was called to-day as a witness in the continued hearing of the appeal of Count Helldorf and his associates, who were found guilty of carrying out the anti-Jewish attack in the Kurfuerstendamm last Rosh Hashanah, and arrogantly declared that he would not answer the question put to him whether he had arranged for a pogrom in the Kurfuerstendamm, and put Helldorf in charge of it, unless he was confronted with the police spy who had given that information.

Deputy Goebbels went on to make insulting remarks about the Police Presidium and about the Jewish Police Vice-President, Dr. Weiss.

The court finally decided to record in the minutes of the proceedings that Deputy Goebbels had refused to give evidence.

MOSES MENDELSSOHN'S BIRTH-TOWN PROHIBITS SHECHITA.

Berlin, Jan. 22nd. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The City Council of Dessau, famous as the birth-town of Moses Mendelssohn, has adopted a resolution introduced by the Nazi Party, prohibiting Shechita in the town.

INCREASING HITLERIST ACTIVITY IN HOLLAND..

Amsterdam, Jan. 22nd. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The Dutch Hitlerists who recently organised a branch of the Hitlerist movement in Holland, are displaying a great deal of activity and the antisemitic movement in the country appears to be on the increase. A Roman Catholic Democratic member of Parliament, Dr. Moeller, has joined the National Socialist Party. A number of branches of the Party have been established in the southern provinces of Holland.

This week a German Hitlerist member of Parliament, Deputy Dr. Hans Nieland, delivered a Lecture at The Hague on the Hitlerist programme, and the fight against the Jews. A great deal of comment has been aroused by the fact that the German Ambassador in Holland was present at the lecture.

The organisers of the lecture encountered a great deal of difficulty in finding a hall in which the lecture could be delivered, because most of the owners of halls at The Hague refused to rent them for a Hitlerist meeting. The Dutch Nazis are circulating pamphlets in which they point to this as another example of the influence of Dutch Jews on public opinion in the country so that it is even impossible to obtain a hall in which to expose their pernicious influence.

YESSER'S IMPRISONMENT FOR SMASHING JEWISH WINDOWS IN VILNA DURING  
NOVEMBER EXCESSES.

Varsaw, Jan. 22nd. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Bronislaw Siemaszko, a youth of 18 years of age, has been sentenced to one year's imprisonment for smashing windows in Jewish houses and shops on November 10th., when the anti-Jewish excesses took place in Vilna.

THE MURDERS OF SOROC: HUNGARIAN PAPER IN ROUMANIA SUSPENDED  
FOR ATTACKING GOVERNMENT'S ACTION IN CONDONING CRIME.

Bucharest, Jan. 22nd. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The "Brassai Lapok", a Hungarian newspaper appearing in Roumania, has been suspended by the authorities for publishing an article in which it attacked the Government for condoning the murders of the six young Jews at Soroca.

BECUSE THEY WERE JEWS SAYS EX-SENATOR CARP: COULD HAVE BEEN  
ARRESTED AND TRIED FOR ATTEMPTING TO CROSS FRONTIER BUT  
INSTEAD THEY WERE SATISTICALLY SHOT.

Bucharest, Jan. 21st. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Ex-Senator Horia Carp, one of the leaders of the Union of Roumanian Jews, has an editorial in the "Curierul Israelit", the organ of the Union, on the Soroca shooting affair, in which he says:

In this way six young Jewish lives have been lost. They were not even prisoners, as was the case in that terrible affair in Czecho-Slovakia. They were only people who were looking for work. They could have been detained and arrested and brought up for trial to answer for their fault in attempting to cross the frontier, but instead of that they were sadistically shot down - because they were Jews. And no one is allowed to protest against it. We must not protest because we are Jews. No corporal of a frontier guard would commit so terrible a deed against people of another nationality, but we are Jews, and against us there is a campaign of hatred and of calumny. Openly in the sittings of Parliament, the Cuzists are permitted to insult and threaten us. The murderer of Palik becomes a national hero. At student congresses there is open preaching of hatred against us Jews, and those whose duty it should be to take steps to put a stop to this propaganda think only of their petty political interests, and show excessive tolerance in regard to this most important matter of putting down an agitation which is harmful to the well-being and to the peace of the whole country.

PALESTINE HIGH COMMISSIONER INAUGURATES PLANTING OF TREES ON  
JEWISH NEW YEAR OF TREES.

Jerusalem, Jan. 23rd. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The High Commissioner, Sir Arthur Waughope, inaugurated to-day, on the Jewish New Year of the Trees, the planting of trees at the farm owned by Mr. Broza in Netza.

The High Commissioner paid his visit there together with Dr. Weissbroff, member of the Zionist Executive. He also inspected the Girls' Farm in Jerusalem and the Jewish colony at Dilb, where he spent an hour and a half in conversation with the Haluzim.

GERER REBBE ON WAY TO PALESTINE GIVEN BIG RECEPTION AT

CONSTANTINOPLE.

Constantinople, Jan. 23rd. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The Gerer Rebbe arrived here yesterday on his way to Palestine, and was given a big reception by the Jewish population. The Sephardic, the Ashkenazic and the Georgian

Jewish Communities arranged receptions for the Rabbi, who attended the Sabbath table arranged in his honour.

The Turkish and French press in Constantinople are showing a great deal of interest in the Gerer Rebbe's visit.

#### LORD READING MAKING SATISFACTORY PROGRESS.

Cairo, Jan. 22nd. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The doctor who flew to Luxor from Cairo in a Royal Air Force machine with a nurse to attend Lord Reading, who is lying ill at Luxor, left Luxor this afternoon on his way back to Cairo, stating that he found Lord Reading's condition satisfactory and that there is no cause for anxiety.

The nurse has remained behind to attend to Lord Reading.

Lord Reading's condition is stated to be generally satisfactory.

#### DEATH OF DR. MARION PHILLIPS FIRST JEWISH WOMAN M.P.

London, Jan. 23rd. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Dr. Marion Phillips, the chief woman officer of the Labour Party, and the first Jewish woman member of Parliament, died to-day after a long illness at the age of 50. Dr. Phillips, who was born in Australia, came to England to study economics, on which subject she became an acknowledged authority.

In June, 1929, shortly after her election to Parliament, Dr. Marion Phillips spoke at a dinner arranged by the B'nai B'rith in London, and declared that it was the first time in 25 years that she had been asked to a Jewish gathering. It was the first time in 25 years' residence in England, she said, that she had received an invitation to be present at a gathering of members of the Jewish race. If there was anyone to blame, it was she herself, for she had taken no part in the Jewish Community. In Australia, where she was born, there was scarcely any difference to be noticed between members of the Jewish race and members of other races. There was no doubt of her Jewish race. A hundred years ago, members of her family on both sides emigrated from England to Australia, and they had a record that an ancestor of hers was connected with the synagogue. She confessed that her memories and studies came from English and not Jewish sources. Her own loyalties were diverse. She thought that a few would agree with her at this gathering, when she said that it was her opinion that the future of the Jewish people should be in assimilation rather than in separation. It was her view, too, that all peoples should be united and assimilated, and that there should be a loving-kindness of people of the world.
