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QUIET RESTORED AT VIENNA UNIVERSITY: PROCEEDINGS TAKEN BY
 POLICE AGAINST JEWISH STUDENT FOR INJURING ANTISEMITIC
 ASSAILANT: INDICTMENT DRAWN UP DESPITE PLEA OF SELF-
 DEFENCE.

Vienna, Jan. 30th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Everything is quiet again to-day at Vienna University, after the anti-Jewish rioting of the last few days. It is expected that the University authorities will decide to reopen the University on Monday.

Anti-Jewish fighting continued to-day at the Commercial Academy (before the restoration of order) and Jews were also attacked in the Park near the Academy. Three Jewish students have sustained severe head injuries. One Nazi student has also been injured in the course of the fighting, and a Jewish student named Kornfein has been arrested, and charged with inflicting the injuries, and also with using a knife. Kornfein claims that he only used his heavy street-door key and also that he had to act in self-defence. Despite this plea the police are proceeding with their action against him and have drawn up the indictment. Kornfein is calling a number of witnesses who saw him being attacked, and can confirm that he acted only in self-defence.

AGITATION AGAINST FOREIGN JEWISH STUDENTS STARTED AGAIN IN
 CZECHO-SLOVAKIA.

Prague, Jan. 30th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Antisemitic excesses broke out again to-day at Bratislava (Pressburg) University. Jewish students from Poland were driven out of the Medical Faculty, and were told that they would not be admitted again to the University. Neighbouring cafes where some of the students took refuge were attacked.

The Czech Students' Organisation at Prague University has adopted a resolution demanding the enforcement of a numerus clausus against foreign Jews. A number of Deputies have promised to support their demand in Parliament.

The agitation against foreign Jewish students at the Czecho-Slovakian universities has been going on for a long time, and has several times led to serious rioting. At the end of November there were several agitation meetings held at Bratislava University, at which demands were made that no foreign Jews should be admitted to the University.

Deputy Vicanek, of the Czech Clerical Party, spoke in Parliament on November 29th. demanding the enforcement of a numerus clausus against aliens, especially Jews. Czecho-Slovakia is spending large sums of money, he said, in providing Universities for alien students, who afterwards settle in

the country practising as doctors or lawyers, and taking the bread out of the mouths of our own people. Besides, he alleged, the foreign students are in most cases political undesirables, and many of them are Communists.

Deputy Hein, of the National Democratic Party, supported him, protesting against aliens being allowed to study at Czecho-Slovakian Universities, and he, too, alleged that many of the foreign students are conducting Communist propaganda.

Deputy Angelo Goldstein, one of the Jewish members of Parliament, who also raised the matter of the anti-Jewish movement at Bratislava University, obtained an assurance from the Minister of Education, Dr. Derer, a few days later, that no measures would be taken against Jewish students from abroad.

The protest made by the students because of the bad conditions with regard to accommodation at the University has now died down, the Minister went on, and their demands in this connection will be kept in mind when the question of the extension of the University arises. But no measures, he repeated, will be taken against Jewish students from abroad.

Jewish students from Poland attending the Medical Faculty at Bratislava University have several times recently been barred from the lecture halls and the dissection rooms by the Nationalist students, but Jewish students who are Czecho-Slovakian citizens were not molested.

The Nationalist papers in Czecho-Slovakia support the movement against foreign Jewish students insofar as it is directed against aliens.

Serious anti-Jewish student disturbances took place at Bratislava, Prague and other Czecho-Slovakian universities in November 1929, when big forces of police, mounted and on foot, had to be called out, and scores of students were injured and arrested, and the Universities were closed for a number of days.

GERMAN JEWS ORGANISE TO FIGHT ANTI-JEWISH BOYCOTT.

Berlin, Jan. 29th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

A joint committee of all Jewish parties has been formed under the leadership of the Prussian Federation of Jewish Communities to fight against the anti-Jewish economic boycott by creating Jewish co-operative organisations.

The joint committee includes the Central Union of German Citizens of Jewish Faith, the German Zionist Federation, the German B'nai B'rith, the German Women's Union, and the Central Welfare Office of German Jews.

WAR AGAINST JEWS AND COMMUNISTS PROCLAIMED AT BUCHAREST ANTISEMITIC MEETING: SWASTIKA BANNERS CARRIED THROUGH STREETS: SOROCA FRONTIER GUARD EULOGISED BY SPEAKERS.

Bucharest, Jan. 30th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Jews and Communists are the same thing, the speakers urged at a mass meeting arranged jointly by the Cuzists and the Iron Guard organisation in the Atheneum, one of the largest halls in Bucharest, going on to eulogise the frontier guard at Soroca, for shooting down the six young Jews who were trying to cross the River Dnieper.

The participants in the meeting solemnly proclaimed a united national front "against Communism and Judaism".

The demonstrators afterwards formed up and marched in procession through the streets carrying swastika flags, and shouting antisemitic cries.

The demonstration appears to have been arranged with a view to impressing Parliament, which is opening on Monday, in connection with an interpellation put down on the order paper by the Jewish and by the Socialist Deputies with regard to the Broca outrage.

COMMUNIST RAID IN PALESTINE.

Jerusalem, Jan. 30th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

A Communist meeting held in the Valley between the Jewish residential district of Rehavia and the Greek colony Matamon, has been raided by police, and 21 men and 11 girls, all Jewish, have been arrested. A quantity of alleged seditious literature has been confiscated.

ENLISTING AMERICAN STATESMEN FOR ACTIVE INTEREST IN PALESTINE ORK.

New York, Jan. 30th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Mr. Emanuel Neuman, the American member of the Jewish Agency Executive, has left for Washington to attend several important conferences there, the J.T.A. understands, in connection with the formation of the Presidium of the recently formed American Pro-Palestine Committee, which will consist of some of the outstanding American statesmen.

The Conferences will also lead to the establishment of branches of the Pro-Palestine Committee in various parts of the country.

The American press continues to emphasise the importance of Mr. Neuman's work in enlisting the active interest of American statesmen in the Palestine work.

NEGOTIATIONS WITH SOVIET GOVERNMENT FOR SENDING MATZOTH TO RUSSIA BY JEW'S BREAK DOWN: MANESCHEWITZ KATZOTH COMPANY UNABLE TO GUARANTEE MINIMUM QUANTITY OF TWO MILLION POUNDS.

New York, Jan. 29th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The negotiations between the Maneschewitz Katzoth Company and the Am-Deruta Transport Corporation for sending matzoth for Passover into Soviet Russia have fallen through, the J.T.A. is informed by representatives of both organisations.

Mr. Leo Broches, representing Am-Deruta, stated that following representations to the Soviet Government in Moscow, it has found it impossible to withdraw from its original condition that the Maneschewitz Company must guarantee the importation of a minimum of 2,000,000 pounds of matzoth by March 15th., to which the Maneschewitz Company could not agree.

Mr. Max Maneschewitz, on behalf of the matzoth company, said that the Soviet authorities desired a bond to the amount of between 750,000 dollars and one million dollars, to be placed with them by the Maneschewitz Company as a guarantee that the minimum of 2,000,000 pounds of matzoth would be shipped into the Soviet Union.

In view of the very short period left before the expiration of the time limit and the fact that a number of other organisations have received permission to send matzoth to Soviet Russia, he said, his Company could not undertake to guarantee the minimum sum. The matter will be dropped at present, he added, but will be renewed for the year 1933.

If the agreement had been concluded, one of the provisions would have been a guarantee by the Soviet Government to deliver the matzoth packages to their destinations or else refund the Company the amount involved for their non-delivery.

HIAS CONCLUDES AGREEMENT WITH SOVIET GOVERNMENT FOR SENDING MATZOTH AND PASSOVER FOOD PACKAGES TO RUSSIA.

New York, Jan. 29th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Matzoth and Passover food packages may be sent to Soviet Russia by American relatives through the Hebrew Sheltering and Immigrant Aid Society of America, in accordance with an arrangement concluded with the Soviet Government, it is announced by the Hias.

The Passover food packages will be sent into Soviet Russia from Riga, under arrangements similar to those regarding the transmission of ordinary food packages. The duty upon matzoth is high, the Hias office points out, but Passover flour for the baking of matzoth may be sent at the same cost and under the same conditions as ordinary flour.

Eleven pound packages of matzoth may be sent at a cost of ten dollars. The high price, the Hias explains, is due to the high duty, insurance, postage to the destination and return postage. Eleven pounds of flour for baking the matzoth may be purchased for 3.32 dollars.

HITLER'S COMING INTO POWER INEVITABLE AND MUCH UNPLEASANTNESS IN STORE FOR JEWS BUT NO FEAR JEWISH HEADS WILL ROLL IN SAND GERMAN JEWISH BANKER SAYS.

New York, Jan. 20th. (J.T.A. Mail Service).

Hitler's assumption of power appears to be inevitable but there need be no fear that Jewish heads will roll in the sand in Germany, Herr Willy Sundheimer, a well-known German Jewish banker, who is now on a visit to the United States, said to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency here to-day.

Of course, there will be much unpleasantness for the Jews in Germany under a Hitler regime, Mr. Sundheimer said. The first victims will probably be those Jews employed in official capacity with the Government and the municipalities. They will, no doubt, be dismissed. Here and there there may be several Jewish heads smashed, but I don't believe that a pogrom or mass massacre of the Jews in Germany as there used to be in Russia will ever occur in Germany.

No one in Germany doubts now that Hitler is bound to come into power and it seems this will happen very soon, Mr. Sundheimer continued. Every Jew in Germany realises that now. Since this appears to be inevitable, I think that German Jewry as well as the rest of the population would like it to come soon and have it over. The period of expectation and tension creates an anxiety and nervousness which is worse than the actual situation can probably be.

There is no doubt, he went on, that we are facing hard times in Germany, but we must courageously look the facts in the face and try to make the best of them. I, personally, am hopeful that we will survive this dangerous period. As soon as the German young men find work and see a future for themselves, Mr. Sundheimer concluded, they will turn their backs on the Hitlerite movement which is after all nothing else than an expression of despair created by the immeasurable sufferings to which so many millions of Germans are being subjected during the present bitter economic crisis.
