".. In consequence of the threat to the lives and property of British subjects in Shanghai, a British force was dispatched to Shanghai in Jönuary 1927, as has been done now. When Major-General Sir John Duncan, the Commander-in-Chief of the Shanghai British Deféne Force, returned to London a year later, in Jenuary 1928, he sent a message to the Jewish periodical in Shanghai, "Israel's Wessenger", in which he wrote: I was very much touched by the article in "Israel's Kessenger" in regard to my services in Shanghai. I feel that I hardly deserved the flattering remarks you made about me, but it gives me the greatest pleasure to realise that the good wishes for the Jewish Community which has helped me so materially.

"e Jews are again compelled to take up the fight for equal citizenship rights in a number of countries, Government, Councillor J. Kreppel writes in the "tarhrehit" here. The political and economic reaction is seriously threatening the principle of Jewish emancipation. The rise of Hitlerium in Grumany and its repercussions in Austria and other countries, together with recent events in several East-European, Gentral European and South-East European States abow that Jewish corganisations like the Alliance Israelite Universelle, the Anglo-Jowish Association, the Central Union of German citizens of Jewish Faith, the American Jewish Committee, the Union of Roumanian Je's, and the rest, must rise to the new task and intensify their work. The present-day anti-Jewish movement is inter-State, and Cuza in Roumania openly admits-partnership with Hitler in Germany; the areas in Falestine use the "protocols of the Ylders of Zion" in their anti-Jowish campaign, and Mational Socialist organisations are being formed in all sorts.

In face of this it is not enough to maintain of countries. an isolated activity on the part of the existing Jewish organisations, each strictly confined to its own country. must proceed to set up a central organisation of all the Jewist defensive organisations with a united leadership. Our enemies believe that there is a "Secret Jewish Power, and they are constantly talking of its destructive tendencies, and non-Jews generally are inclined to believe in this fairy tale, insofar as they take the view that Jews who are everywhere exposed to threats and persecution ought to have a protective There is no reason why organisation covering all countries. we should not have such an organisation. The existing Jewish defensive organisations constitute a nucleus, and 1 they link up we shall have our organisation. They should each appoint representatives to a Contral Committee, which would have its seat in Geneva, with a representative accredited to the League of Nations. Co-operation with the League of Mations would protect our organisation from the reproach that Jews are secking to interfere in the internal affairs of any particular country, for its activity would be largely conduct4 ed under the control of the League of Nations, and it would be clear that its intention is solely to protect Jewish rights against aggression, and that there is no desire to exceed the functions of a defensive body.

JE"ISH ORGANISATIONS TEROUGHOUT GERMANY CREATS ALL-COUNTRY
REPRESENTATIVE BOLY TO PROTECT JE"ISH LIFE AND INTERESTS

Berlin, Jen. 31st. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Representatives of all the Federations of Jewish Communities in Germany met to-day in Berlin and created a representative committee of thirteen members; representing the Jewish population throughout the German Republic for the purpose of joining the Central Union of German Citizens of Jewish Fatth in negotiations with the Federal Covernment and the States Governments in order to obtain the protection and security of Jewish life and property and the safeguarding of Jewish economic interests against the menace of the growing antisemtic agitation.

The new committee has decided also to join the Jew ish Economic Joint Committee comprising all Jewish organisations in the country, which was formed lest week to promote Jewish co-operative undertakings and in other ways to counter the anti-Jewish boycott agitation. The O.R.T. (Federation for Promoting Jewish Artisanship and Agriculture), which has its headquarters in Berlin, has also joined the Jewish Economic Joint Committee.

LOVE TO PUSH FOR SIGN JETS OUT OF THEIR OCCUPATIONS IN TURKEY.

Constantinople, Jan. 31st. (Jawish Telegraphic Agency).

A bill has been introduced into the National Assembly in angore aiming to prevent foreign subjects from ongaging in a number of cocupations, in Turkey. No alien will be parmitted to follow any occupation, trade, or oraft in any village or small town. In the cities and larger towns aliens will not be allowed to be boot and shee traders, printers, doll-makers, commission agents to sell Government monopoly articles like tobacco, alcohol, sugar, salt, petroleum, or matches; to be interpreters for townists, employees in public institutions like tramways, electricity works, etc., porters or transport workers, drivers, manual labourers, gardeners, night watchmen, waiters, voterinary surgeone or chewats.

JUNISH DEPUTIES IN POLAND ASK FOR INTERVENTION AGAINST DRIVING POLISH STUDENTS FROM BRATISLAVA UNIVERSITY.

The Jewish Deputies in Foland have telegraphed to the Jewish Party of Czecho-Slovakia urging an enquiry into the demonstrations against Jewish medical students from Foland at Brattalava University and the demand made by the Slovakian students that the Government should enforce immediate restrictions against foreign students.

Deputy Angelo Goldstein, member of the Jewish Party in Czecho-Slovakia, has replied promising to make representations to the Government in the matter.

POLIST TIONIST CONFERENCE OPENED: REPRESENTATION AS LARGE AS LAST
