JUDGE CARDOZA'S APPOINTMENT WILL BE RATIFIED UNANIMOUSLY

New York, Feb. 16th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Judge Cardoza will take the oath on Monday as a

Justice of the United States Supreme Court, it is learnt to-day.

It was never thought that there would be any diffi-culty about obtaining the ratification of the appointment in the Senate, but the unanimity of the Senate exceeds all ex-pectation. Every Senator, Democrat or Republican, issued a statement to-day praising President Hoover for appointing Judge Cardoza to the vacancy, meaning that the appointment will be ratified unanimously by the Senate.

The entire American press praises President Hoover for the courage he has exhibited in appointing Judge Cardoza to the vacancy in spite of the political and racial obstacles

that were in the way.

The Yiddish press in its editorials to-day writes that President Hoover has given the best reply possible to the German Nazis, the Polish National Demograts and the Roumanian Cuzists, as well as to those who are trying to import antismitism into America.

Judge Cardoza's appointment, they add, is also a lesson to the Jewish youth of America that loyalty to Judaism is no obstacle to high achievement or to the attainment of high

position.

50,000 UNEMPLOYED JEWS IN GERMANY: FIGURES REVEALED BY QUES-TIONNAIRE ISSUED TO ALL JEWISH COMMUNITIES IN GERMANY.

Rashid Abu Sulmen and Khani Abu Sulman, two of the Bedouins who were errested last November in connection with the murder of the Jewish boy and girl, Stahl and Zohar, from Tel Aviv, who disappeared while on a walking tour, have been committed for trial on a charge of unpremeditated murder. Khani Abu Sulmah is only 17 years of age.

The other three Bedouins wrested with them at

the time have now been discharged by the Examining Kagistrate.

Representatives of the German and Polish Consulates

attended the hearing, which lasted all day Londay and Tuesday, the families of the victims being from Roland and Germany respectively. Dr. Dernard Joseph appeared at the hearing on behalf of the relativés.

According to one of the Palestine papers, five Bedouth camelteers coming from Jaffa met the couple walking on the seagler ore to the north of the River Yarkon; three of them attacked the couple, stabbing Stahl, and then all five violated the girl, Zohar, who never regained consciousness after the assault. The murderers buried the bodies separately. Stahl's skull was recovered from a hillock, and the girl's body was some distance away. The bodies were decomposed, but the clothes left no doubt of their identity.

Reports are circulating here to the effect that Russia has decided not to admit Passover goods into the country for distribution smong the Jowish population, and some of the reports go so far as to say that people who apply for Passover parcels addressed to them will be arrested. These reports, the aim of which is to try to stop Jows in Europe and America sending Passover parcels to Russia, are absolutely false, ir. Penjamin, the Director in Rigs of the Pias (Hebrew Immigrant Aid Society of America), declared to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency representative here to-day.

on the contrary, Mr. Benjamin said, the Soviet Government is making it more easy for Jews to receive their Passover parcels, and is giving every possible help in this work. The Fiss, he declared, guarantees that all orders received up to April 1st., will be carried out so that the recipients will have their parcels in Russia in good time for Passover.

osal of the Russian representative of the London Federation posal of the Russian representative of the London Federation of Jewish Relief Organisations in connection with the arrangements which it recently concluded with the Russian authorities for the issue of Passover percels to destitute Jews in Russia, according to a communication which the Federation has just received from the Govennent Department concerned. The flour will be issued in accordance with instructions received from London. Other articles of Passover food, such as sugar, tee, and oil, will also be issued in addition to the flour. In view of the extreme distress now prevailing among

the declassed Jews in Russia, the Pederation states, 35 tons of ffour will not meet even one-tenth of the applications which are being received, and funds are urgently required for further purchases of flour and other commediates. The Federation has therefore decided to launch immediately a Passover Relief Appeal, the funds of which will also be used to provide Pags-over relief for the destitute Jews in Poland.

Justice Brandels is taking as deep and keen an interest in all matters Zionist and Palestindan as ever. Indeed, in recent months he has been even more active than usual, though as a laways - privately and modestly behind the scenes. The Dinner ceting in "ashington of January 17th., resulting in the formation of the American Falestine Committee could not have been as impressive and successful as it was but for the powerful and moreal support, advice, and co-operation which Justice Brandels gave me in my offerts through every stage of the affair. ZIONIST EXECUTIVE IN SESSION. DISCUSSES PALESTINE SFAIRS: IN. SENATOR AND MR. NEUMAN PARTICIPATING: MR. MOTZKIM INVITED TO COME TO LONDON.

London, Feb. 17th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Dr. S. Brodetsky, Mr. Emanuel Neuman, Mr. B. Locker, and Mr. Werner Senator, who arrived in London to-day from Ber-lin, are participating in the session of the Zionist Executive which opened here yesterday. Political, economic and financial matters relating to Palestine are being considered.

At the suggestion of Mr. Neuman, Mr. Leo Motzkin, Chairman of the Zionist General Council, has been invited to come to London in order to participate in the sessions of the Exacutive. Dr. Motzkin is expected to arrive in London tomorrow.

SOROCA MURDER RAISED IN HOUSE OF COMMONS: SIR JOHN SIMON REPORTS
NON-COMMITTAL INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM BRITISH MINISTER IN

DEFENCE: NO INFORMATION OF COMPLAINT TO LEAGUE OF NATIONS,

In the House of Commons to-day Colonel Josiah Wedgwood asked the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs whether he had any information as to a shooting of Jews at Soroce on the Roumanian border, and as the Jews in Roumania constitute a minority population, for which we have a treaty liability, would he make enquiries as to what steps were being taken in the matter.

Sir John Simon replied that His Majesty's Minister at Bucharest had reported that the victims of the incident, fave bucharest has reported that the victums of the indicent, important of whom were of the Jewish race, were crossing the River Dniester on a night of January in the direction of Soviet territory when they were challenged by a Roumanian frontier guard. On when they were challenged by a Koumanian frontier guard. On being challenged they did not stop, and the guards accordingly fired, killing four of the party on the spot and wounding two who subsequently did. 'I report of the incident published by the Roumanian Minister of Defence stated that all the victims were, actually Communists and pointed out that as Communists cross-ing the River Dniester had been frequently well-armed, the guards bed statedly condens to fine immediately when Tananas abellanged hid standing orders to fire immediately when persons challenged . refused to stop. No information of any complaint in regard to the Finorities Treaty had been made to the League of Nations, and the facts reported would not require the Government to take action.

Mr. Wedgwood asked if the Minister in Bucharest was satisfied that this was the correct account of what happened. Sir John Simon replied that he had given to the House quite faithfully the report made by the Minister and he would gladly inform him of any further developments. In reply to a further question, he said he was unable to state whether or not the deceased victims had in their possession passports duly visad by the Roumanian authorities.
