The insertion of a paragraph in the new German penal odde now under discussion by the Reichstag Commission, to deal with the desecrators of commeteries, was demanded by Deputy Joses, one of the Jewish members of the Social Democratic Party, at to-day's meeting of the Commission. Furing the last few years there have been 117 Jawish cemeteries descarated implementary, Deputy Moses said, and it has been established that the vandals are for the most part young people who have been influenced by the wild anti-Jawish agitation conducted by the Nazis.

The Government representative on the Commission spoke in support of Deputy Moses motion, Scalaring that the Government is in favour of such a paragraph. Of 83 deservators of Jawish cemeteries who had been traced and punished, he said, 45 were women and girls belonging to the Mazi movement.

... A bill directed against the desecration of synagogues

A bill directed against the deseration of symagogues and Jogish cemeteries in Germany came up before the Law Commission of the Reichstag, two years ago, in February 1929. The bill was designed also to punish persons disturbing Jowathe in funerals, since there had been many cases at the time of, stones thrown after Jowish funerals and insulting remarks made while they were passing. The Rapporteur on the bill, in introducing it, said that though the German State was not identified with any Church, there being no established Church in the German Republic, the German State, nevertheless, regarded it as its dutage of the equal protection to every religious community in the country and to protect their sacred places from desecration.

is for back as October 1927, the Prussian Linister of the Interior issued instructions to all police authorities. In the country, to spare no effort to track down the deserrators of Jawish cemeteries and to punish them by the most severe penalties provided under the law. He also instructed the police to offer rewards for the detection of the vandals. At the end of 1928 the Prussian kinister of Justice issued similar instructions to all judicial authorities, recalling the police instructions to that had been issued by the kinister of the Interior, and telling them to give special attention to the increasing number of deserrations of Jawish cemeteries. In view of the Shoulish character of these outrages, these instructions said, all persons arrested on this charge should be punished in a way that will act as a deterrent to others.

About the same time, the Federal Minister of Justice, Dr. Koch, the leader of the German Democratic Party, and a number of other statesmen, politicians and police chiefs were present at a big mass meeting held in Berlin under the auspices of the Central Union of German Citizens of Jewish Faith to protest against the repeated desecrations of Jewish cemeteries and synagones in Germany. The Federal Government, in whose name I speak, joins with you in your indignation and grief that it has been possible for Germans to do such things, Dr. Koch said We are at one with you in condemning outrages in his speech. committed by Gorman citizens against German citizens in their places of worship, But when enmity is carried against the dead, that exceeds the counds even of antisemitism. Then it is, no longer a conflict between Germans of the Jewish faith and antisemites, but between human beings and beasts. You may be convinced that the Federal Government as the custodian of public order and poace and in the interests of Germany's good name abroad, will do its duty in regard to such outrages, for it is most deaply hurt and humiliated by those vandalistic offences against right and decency. The Government of Germany is with you in every way in your protest.
In the summer of 1930 the Cerman Government, through

the German imbassador in the United States, Beron von Prittwitz, wrete to lr. Jacob Landau, the Lanaging Director of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, with regard to the frequent desecrations of Jowish cemeteries in Germany: "Please be convinced that the Covernment of the Reich knows its duty as against such outrages and that it will act according to this duty as the preservor of order and peace and also in the interest of Germany's reputation abroad, the Government feeling itself deeply offended by such outrages. I am sure you have done the right thing in sending out this protest to the world, a protest which the Government

ment of the Reich endorses without reservation".

Budagist, Feb. 18th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Bishop Dr. Desider Balthasar, the head of the Calvinist Church in Hungary, has published a protest against the conversionist work among the Jews which is being carried on in Hungary by the Budapest hission of the Presbyterian Church of Scotland.

Organised conversionist activity ought to be cerried on only among those peoples who have not yet attained to a high moral and spiritual conception of God, the Bishop says. No one can say that this is true of the Jews. When Judeism, therefore, points out, as it has every right to do, that it has given the world its noblest idea of God and its highest ethical ideals, that its holy scriptures are also the holy scriptures of Christianity, that there is no other realigious community in the world which, in spite of being a small minority among the peoples, has given the world such an immense number of great men in science, art, economic life, and in every other field of activity, that the Dispersion and persecution and suffering have not destroyed its feith, then every thinking man might come

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to the conclusion that the Jewish religion has the power to make men noble and happy. I have learnt from my Christian faith that no man should be robbed of the consolation of the religion in which he finds hepfiness, and that no man should be robbed of his religious tradition and his sense of the velue of his religious tradition and his sense of the velue of his religious tradition and his sense of the Judaiam has rendered to the whole world to to teach us Fungarian Christians that we must have nothing to do with conversionist work among the Jows, which can only bring a feeling of resentment end estrengement.

Mishop Balthear, who is the Primate of the Church to which Admiral Horthy, the Regent of Lungary, belongs, played a hercic part in saving many Jows from the regromists during the "hite Torrer in Hungary. He used to go about the streets of Debressin with a big crucifix, which, at the risk of his own life, he would hold up over any Jew who was being attacked and

under its protection he would lead him to safety.

The Bishop is one of the leaders of the Liberal Persocratic movement in Hungary and a strenuous opponent of antisemitism and of the numerus clausus. When antisemitic disturbances occurred in 1928 at the Debreszin University, of which he is Chancellor, he issued a statement to the press of the world dissociating himself and the authorities of the University from the antisemitic activitées: I am anxious to explain to the press of we world, he wrote, that the authorities of Debreszin University were in no way involved in the deplorable incidents which have taken place here. as my duty, for it was from me during my American visit, that the civilised world learned of the spirit of Debreszin University, to inform those who have assisted us, that the University authorities have nothing whatever in common with the reactionary student movement, and that they do not approve of these demonstrations, or of the hate-engendered Numerus Clausus.

I think that an attempt will not be made to set up a Caliphate, Professor Arnold Toynbee, Director of the Royal Institute of International Affairs, said when he lectured last night to the Anglo-Palestine Club on Palestine and the Caliphate.

This idea has definitely been given up, he declared, but I do believe that there will be an attempt towards co-operation by Nozlems. In the way that Jows and Christians achieve co-operation, that is by way of the consesses and meetings. While the Caliphate idea has broken come it must not be inferred that the idea of consolidation of Islam has broken down too. It will not break down, so long as Moslems consider themselves the under-dox.

The Caliphate idea is the expression of this feeling of being the under-dog. It is an idea which in its intention is to transcend race and nationality. The nationality idea is

inimical to it, as it undercute unity. The Turke have gone in head over heels for Western nationality, which is inimical, as I say, to the Caliphate idea, and the question is whether this example is going to be followed by other nations of the Islam world.

In Palestine the Arabs feel themselves doubly weak because they have not only Christians to deal with, but also the new Jewish situation. It is therefore not surprising that the last Islam Congress was held in Palestine, because if people think that in solidarity there is strength they mobilise their forces in support of this idea where their security is felt to be much threatened.

If you look at the composition of the last Congress, Professor Toynbee said, you may not think it was very representative or that the delegates had credentials. But in my view the Congress did largely represent the feeling of the

masses of the Islam world.

"hile in his view, even the Moslems who were not mationalists thought that the Caliphate idea was an out-of-Loake method of effecting unity in the Moslem world, Professor Toynbee added, the movement towards consolidation by way of Congresses was not purely an artificial agitation. I think it is a genuine movement, he said, and not likely to decay. Referring specially to the Arab countries around Palestine, he said, that he thought that unity was a possibility on account of identity of language, increased transport facilities and newspapers. The movement for solidarity is real, and not artificial, and quite genuine, he declared.
