ALL GERMAN JEWS TO VOTE ON SUNDAY FOR HINDENBURG: NO TIME
NOW FOR DIFFERENCES SAYS CALL ISSUED BY CENTRAL UNION
OF GERMAN JEWS: EVERYONE WHO IS NOT FOR HINDENBURG IS
HELPING HITLER.

Berlin, Mar. 10th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

A call to German Jewry to stand united and vote on Sunday for President Hindenburg was issued to-day by the Central Union of German Citizens of Jewish Faith.

There is no time now, the statement says, for theoretical differences of opinion, for everyone who is not for Hindenburg in this election is directly assisting Hitler,

A mass meeting of the Federation of Jewish ex-Soldiers in Germany was held here last night at which a resolution was adopted unanimously, urging everyone to vote for Hindenburg.

The Jews had overcome Haman, one speaker said, they had survived the Inquisition in Spain, they had lived through the persecution of the Middle Ages, and they would also live to look back on the Hitlerist peril when it would have long passed into history.

GERMAN GOVERNMENT PUTTING DOWN HITLERIST ANTI-JEWISH BOYCOTT
AGITATION.

Berlin, Mar. 11th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Legal measures have been taken by the Government to prohibit the anti-Jewish boycott agitation of the Hitlerists, the "C. V. Zeitung", the official organ of the Central Union of German Citizens of Jewish Faith, reports to-day.

Law courts in a large number of towns have already acted on these measures and prohibited the local Nazis from carrying on their boycott agitation, it states.

The chief Hitlerist organ, the "Voelkischer Beobachter", nevertheless, publishes a full page call to its readers to-day to boycott Jewish firms.

BIG HITLERIST OPEN-AIR DEMONSTRATION IN BERLIN PASSES WITH-
OUT INCIDENT: NO ANTISEMITIC INCITEMENT.

Berlin, Mar. 10th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The first open-air Hitlerist election demonstration held to-day in the Lustgarten Square, with about 60,000 people present, passed without incident, and there was no anti-Jewish incitement by the speakers. The principal speaker was Deputy Goebbels, the Hitlerist leader in Berlin. Strong police reinforcements were sent out to keep order at the meeting.

HITLERISTS THREATEN TO BRAND GERMAN WOMEN WHO HAVE TO DO WITH
JEWS: WARNING LEAFLETS DISTRIBUTED IN HUGE QUANTITIES.

Berlin, Mar. 10th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The Hitlerist leaflets which have been distributed for months past in public places and restaurants threatening German women that they will be severely dealt with if they have any association with Jews, are being extensively used in the election campaign.

German women, the leaflets, which are being thrown into the houses, read, you are having associations with Jews. We warn you that if you continue this association, we shall enter your name on our register of women who are traitors to the race. Under the Third Regime (the Hitlerist Government) the badge of shame will be branded on the faces of all such women.

HITLERIST BOMB STORE FOUND AND HITLERIST SPIES DISCOVERED
IN POLICE FORCE: TWO POLICE LIEUTENANTS TO BE TRIED ON
TREASON CHARGE.

Berlin, Mar. 10th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

A store of bombs kept by the Hitlerists at Ludwigs-hafen, obviously for use in an attempted rising has been discovered by the authorities and confiscated. About 80 bombs are stated to have been seized.

At the same time, the authorities have got on the track of the Hitlerist spies in the police force. Two police lieutenants have been arrested and will be put on trial on a charge of high treason. It is stated that there is evidence against them that they handed the Nazis confidential police plans which had been drawn up for the purpose of assuring order on Sunday, when the presidential elections take place, and a list of the places where the police keep their stores of arms.

ON THE EVE OF THE ELECTION: BERLIN OUTWARDLY CALM: IMPARTIAL'S
PAPER'S TEST VOTE GIVES HINDENBURG NINETEEN MILLION
VOTES AGAINST HITLER'S ELEVEN MILLION.

Berlin, Mar. 11th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

With two more days to the presidential elections Berlin to-day appears calm on the surface. The entire press, however, of all parties, reveals a feverish excitement, and all papers are filled with propaganda matter.

A test vote taken by the impartial "Zwoelf-Uhr Blatt", the result of which is published to-day, gives President Hindenburg over 19 million votes, and Hitler only 11 million.

HITLERIST MENACE TO JEWS CONDEMNED AT AMERICAN GOODWILL MEET-
ING OF JEWS AND CHRISTIANS: EX-MINISTER OF WAR SECONDS
PROTEST.

New York, Mar. 10th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

A formal resolution condemning the Hitlerist menace to the Jews was adopted to-day at the conclusion of a three days' session at Washington of the National Goodwill Conference on Jews and Christians, in which Jewish, Protestant and Catholic spokesmen participated. Mr. Roger W. Straus, co-Chairman of the Conference and a leading Jewish worker in the Goodwill Movement, presided.

The resolution was moved by Rev. S. McRea Covert, the General Secretary of the Federal Council of the Churches of Christ in America, and seconded by Mr. Newton D. Baker, the ex-Secretary of War.

ANOTHER LAND CLASH IN PALESTINE: ARABS ATTACK JEWISH PLOUGHERS
IN VALLEY OF JEZREEL: ARRESTS ON BOTH SIDES: ONE JEW
SERIOUSLY INJURED: POLICE SUPERINTENDENT ORDERS BOTH
SIDES TO STOP WORK ON DISPUTED LANDS INDIGNATION WITH
DISTRICT OFFICER FOR ADVISING ARABS TO PLOUGH SAME LAND
JEWS HAD PLOUGHED.

Another land clash between Jewish settlers and Arab Bedouins occurred to-day in the Valley of Jezreel, in the settlement of Kuskustabun, which belongs to the Jewish land purchasing organisation, the Meshek Land Company.

Twelve Arabs and three Jews were arrested, all of them being subsequently released on bail. Three Jews sustained injuries, one of them of a somewhat serious character.

There are only four Arab tenant families on the land, which was purchased by the Meshek Company in 1925. The other Arabs who were involved in the encounter are Bedouins and Felaheen from the vicinity, who were trespassing, never having worked on this land.

The Arabs had previously threatened that they would plough the land this morning. The District Administration in Haifa raised no objection to both Arabs and Jews ploughing the land. The Arabs accordingly appeared on land which had been previously ploughed by the Jews, and encountered there thirty Jewish ploughers with their teams, and the clash resulted. After the clash, Police Superintendent Harrington ordered both sides to stop work on the land.

There is a great deal of indignation among the Jewish settlers with the District Officer, Mr. Lees, for advising the Arabs to plough the same land that the Jews had already ploughed.

.. Mr. Lees would appear to be the Area Officer in charge of the Arab villages during the 1929 outbreak, who in his evidence before the Shaw Enquiry Commission, gave the impression of being a pro-Arab. Mr. Lees' evidence, it was complained in Palestine at the time, tended to show that the Jews had provoked the Arabs. Sir Boyd Merriman, the Counsel for the Jewish Agency, challenged his credibility, pointing out that Mr. Lees had only recently come to Palestine from Zanzibar, that he was a great friend of the Arabs, and knew their language, and had no contact with or knowledge of the Jews.

PALESTINE HIGH COMMISSIONER EXPRESSES HIS SYMPATHY FOR JEWISH
MIDDLE-CLASS SETTLEMENT PROJECT EXPLAINED TO HIM BY EX-
DEPUTY FARBESTEIN MEMBER OF JEWISH AGENCY EXECUTIVE.

Ex-Deputy Farbstein, member of the Jewish Agency Executive, was introduced to-day to the High Commissioner, General Sir Arthur Wauchope, by Dr. Arlosoroff, the head of the Palestine Jewish Agency Executive. Mr. Farbstein explained to the High Commissioner his middle-class settlement project, and the High Commissioner expressed his warm sympathy and understanding for the scheme.

WORLD CONFERENCE OF JEWISH STUDENTS BEING CALLED IN PALESTINE
NEXT MONTH.

A world conference of Jewish students is being called in Tel Aviv for the middle of April, while the Levant Fair will be open, in order to discuss the position of Jewish students in the Diaspora, the ability of the Hebrew University and the Haifa Technical High School to provide facilities for Jewish students in the Diaspora, and the task of the Jewish students in the Zionist and the Hebrew cultural movements.

All Jewish student organisations in all countries are being invited to send representatives.

FOREIGN STUDENTS IN CZECHO-SLOVAKIA GO TO ITALY: FIND BETTER
CONDITIONS THERE: RETALIATION TO ANTI-ALIEN AGITATION
AND INCREASED UNIVERSITY FEES IMPOSED ON ALIENS.

Prague, Mar. 10th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Foreign students who have been studying at the Universities in Czecho-Slovakia, a large proportion of them Jewish students mostly from Poland, are answering the agitation against foreign students conducted in the press of the Right and in a section of the progressive press, and the increased fees demanded from foreign students, by leaving Czecho-Slovakia and going to study at Italian Universities. About 100 foreign students have already withdrawn their names from the lists of enrolments at the Czecho-Slovakian universities and have enrolled at the universities of Rome, Bologna, Pisa, and Florence.

The Italian Universities have given these students many facilities. They are required to pay only half the fees paid by native students. They are released from the payment of examination fees; they are allowed reduced travelling rates, they are given material assistance, and they are not asked for any undertaking that they will not settle down to practise their profession in Italy at the end of their studies.

The Czecho-Slovakian Government appears to be concerned at this retaliation by the foreign students to the anti-alien agitation, and the Minister of Education has told press representatives at a specially convoked press representatives' meeting that the measures taken by the University authorities against foreign students were forced upon them by the technical conditions at the universities, and that the Czecho-Slovakian Universities still remain open as before to all students, irrespective of nationality or race.

The Dean of the Medical Faculty of the Czech University in Prague, Professor Weigner, has declared that he is in principle opposed to race distinctions, but the tragic fault of the aliens, he added, is that their race is regarded as if it was their fault.

AMERICAN CONGRESS IMMIGRATION COMMITTEE HEARS JEWISH
ORGANISATIONS' APPEAL FOR FACILITIES FOR REUNITING
FAMILIES.

Representatives of the Independent Order B'nai B'rith, the Hebrew Immigrant Aid Society (Hias), the American Jewish Committee, the American Jewish Congress, the National Council of Jewish Women, and the Independent Order B'rith Abraham, appeared to-day in Washington before the Immigration Committee of Congress to plead for facilities to admit the relatives of residents in the United States in order to re-unite families at present separated by the American immigration laws.

PROFESSOR MENDEL OF YALE UNIVERSITY HONOURED ON HIS 60TH.
BIRTHDAY: ONE OF THE GREATEST AUTHORITIES ON NUTRITION.

Professor Lafayette Benedict Mendel, the well-known physiological chemist, Professor of Physiological Chemistry at Yale University, has been honoured by his colleagues and students this week for the occasion of his 60th. birthday, which occurred on February 5th.

The "Yale Journal of Biology and Medicine" has published a special "Mendel Anniversary Number" containing contributions by eighteen well-known scientists, praising Professor Mendel's achievements in the study of nutrition, in which field he is the American pioneer and one of the greatest authorities in the world.

On his birthday, on February 5th., four hundred students and associates presented Professor Mendel with a portrait of himself painted by John Quincy Adams.

Professor Mendel, who was born in Delhi, in the State of New York, is a graduate of Yale. He is a research worker of the Carnegie Institution of Washington, and a member of the Committee on Drug Addiction, and the Bureau of Social Hygiene. He is editor of the chemistry monographs of the American Chemical Society.

DR. FRITZ LOEWE WHO COMMANDED GERMAN GREENLAND EXPEDITION AFTER
DEATH OF ITS LEADER DR. WEGENER ADDRESSES FEDERATION FOR
JEWISH LAND SETTLEMENT IN GERMANY.

Berlin, Mar. 10th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Dr. Fritz Loewe, the Jewish member of the German Greenland Expedition, who took command of the expedition on its return to Germany after the death of its leader, Dr. Alfred Wegener, has delivered an address on the work of the Expedition at a meeting of the Federation for Jewish Land Settlement in Germany held at the home of Herr Rudolf S. Mosse. Rabbi Dr. Leo Baeck, President of the German Federation of Rabbis, and of the German B'nai B'rith, Dr. Leo Loewenstein, President of the Federation of Jewish ex-Soldiers, Rabbi Dr. Lehmann, Dr. Kollenschner, and other prominent German Jews were present.

Dr. Loewe and his group were cut off on the inland ice, and lost all contact with the main group. All through last winter it was feared that he and his group had perished. When he returned to Germany, several of his toes were frozen, and had to be amputated.

Dr. Hollander, who was in the chair, addressed the gathering on the work of the Federation for Jewish Land Settlement, describing its activities in the Jewish land settlement area at Gross Gaglew, and appealing for assistance in its work. The more menacing the economic crisis was, he said, the more important was the idea of Jewish settlement on the land.
