German Jewry is dismayed by the results of today's elections to the Prussian Parliament, in which the fitlerists lave emerged as the largest single Party, with a
prospect of becoming one of the chief partners in a Coalition Government. The Fitlerist polled nearly eight
million votes, practically maintaining the figure they
obtained in the second ballot of the presidential elections,
which had been regarded as the high-tide of Fitlerist success,
and was thought to be elready receding, and doubling the
vote they had obtained in the Reichstag elections of 1930,
which boceme known at the time as "Black Sunday".

of the present elections have almost destroyed the effect of the recent victory of the Constitutional Parties in obtaining the re-election of President Findenburg

against Fitler.

About 85 per cent. of the electors entitled to vote went to the polls to-day, and about 35 per cent. of the

poll has gone to the Fitlerists.

Fowever heavy the Kitlerist poll, the Kitlerists are not, however, sufficiently strong to form a Fitlerist Government, even with the support of their allies, the Cerman Nationals. At the same time, meny seats have been lost by the Republican Grand Coaltion, the Centre (Catholic) Farty alone having maintained its old strength, and there is no possibility of the present Republican Government, headed by Perr. Etto Sraum and Ferr Severing, retaining office.

There are 160 Pitlerist Leputies (where in the last Perliament there were only 9), 30 German Astionals and 12 other Psputies of twarfuss Parties of the sight, making a total of 202 on the Ettlerist side out of the total number of 425 seats, with the Republican Parties having a total of only 169 seats, made up of 93 Social Damocrate, 68 Centre Party Leputies and 8 Deputies of the State Democratic Perty. The belance is held by the Communists, with 56 seats, who are not likely to give their support to either side to enacle it to form a Government.

The only other way seems to be for the Centre Party to join the Hitlerists and their allies in a moderate Hitlerist-Centre Coalttion Government. The democratic sections of the Centre Party are opposed to such a Coalition, but the Centre Party also has an extreme Right wing, which is making efforts to bring about the formation of such a Hitlerist-Centre Coaltition Government.

The Hitlerists will agree to that, it is stated, only on condition that their representatives will be included also in the Federal Government headed by Dr. Bruening, himself one of the leaders of the Centre Party, which would practically cancel out Dr. Bruening's defeat of the Hitlerists in the Hindenburg election.

On the other hand, the formation of a Fitlerist-Centre Government would leave the lot of the German Jews less intolerable than it would be under a purely Hitlerist

Government, since the Centre Perty representatives would check the antisentitic extremism of their colleagues.

Jews would probably be dismissed from the public service everywhere, but the Centre Party is definitely opposed to the withdrawal of citizenship rights from German Jews,

and would be able to prevent such action being taken.

The position of the large numbers of East European
and other foreign Jews living in Germany is, however, a
serious matter, and the outlook for them is very black.

In the other States where elections have taken place to-day, the Hitlerists have also secured big successes, though only in Anhalt have they been able to obtain a majority for the seats, together with their Mationalist allies, and will be in a position to form a Overnment. In the Famburg Parliament the old Government remains in power. In Murtemburg, the Nazis have had a great victory, but the old Government has still a small majority, and in Bavaria, the old Government has also maintained its majority, though the Nazi representation has been increased.

The litting ists have scored a verg big victory in the Austrian Parliamentary elections. They have not been able to other an angority, and form a Covernment, but they have secured powerful posttions everywhere, oven invading the

Sederal Council, which is the equivalent to a Senate. In Vionna alone the Mezis have polled about 200,000 votes, compared with an almost infinitesemal number at the last elections, and in all the four State Parliaments of the sustriam Federal equilit the Ythorists have this time obtained big representation, against practically none at all in the previous Parliaments.

Lost of the Fillerist votes, however, have come from the Christian Socialist Frrty, the Pan-Germans, whom they have practically wiped out, and from the very similar Felimwehr Perty. The Social Democratic Perty, their chief opponent, still retains an absolute majority in Vienns.

Immense forces of police were on duty to prevent any disturbances during the announcement of the election

results, and no incidents have occurred.

Drastic changes are not expected as a result of the elections, despite the big Fitlerist gains, which leave the older Ferties still in control. But the big increase in the Fitlerist vote has brought with it a big access also of antisemitic feeling, and Jewish anxiety here is increasing. Already the Austrian Judiciary has yielded to the antisemitic demand to take proceedings sgainst baron Louis de Rothschild in connection with the crash of the Austrian Gredit-Anstalt, and he has been ordered to appear before the Examining lagistrate.

The critical position in Carpatho-Russia, where
large numbers of the population are starving, is all due
to the Jews, iq an ellegation made in "Venkov", the central
organ of the Careh Agrarian Party, which constitutes the
Covernment of the province, and in other papers in the Carpatho-Russian province, causing great anxiety smong the Jewish
ighabitants. The Jews have been exploiting the peasants by
usury and by selling them alcohol, the papers allege, and
thus they are responsible for all the sufferings which
are now being experienced in the province.

The President of the province of Carpatho-Russia, k. Rozsypel, one of the leaders of the Agrarian Party, has in this connection published a statement in the "Official Gazette" of the Carpatho-Russian Government, in which he says:

The accusation made in the Czech press that the Jews in Garpatho-Russia are Communists is an injustice. Communism has taken hold only of about 100 unemployed Jewish discontents. The distress in Carpatho-Russia has taken hold of all inhabitants, including the Jewish inhabitants, who are beaums their sufferings calmly and loval !!

The delegates of the Jewish Nomen's Relief
Committee for Curgates of the Jewish Nomen's Relief
Freud, who have been distributing food and clothing among
the distribution of the province, report
in the Jewish organ Selbstwehr here that the sufferings
of the Gerpatho-Russian Jews are appelling. In Vrohovina,
for instance, 40 per cent. of the Jewish population is destitute. Fundreds of Jews in the mountain villages have
fallen ill as a result of starvetion, and cannot leave their
houses. All the people went work, they write, not charity.
Starvetion is spreading among the Carpathian Jews, they declare, and the situation is desperate.

RICAN ME BERS FORM JETISH - GIPCY BRANCH TO FURTHER PROGRAMME: MR. FELIX M. TARBURG AND JUDGE LACK HONORARY CHAIRLEN: DR. CYRUS ADLER AND DR. STEPHEN WISE TO ACT

New York, Apl. 24th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The American members and deputy members of the Council of the Jewish Agency for Palestine have formed themselves into an organisation, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency is informed.

The newly formed body will further the programme of the Jewish Agency in Palestine, will disseminate information in regard to Palestine upbuilding and will take responsibility for raising the American share of the budget required to maintain the Jewish reconstructive activities in Palestine.

The officers elected to head the new organisation are: Mr. Felix M. Warburg and Judge Julian W. Lack, Honorary Chairmen; Ir. Cyrus Adler and Dr. Stephen S. Wise, Co-Chairmen; Judge Horace Stern and Lr. Robert Szold, Vice-Chairmen.

Wr. Morris Rothenberg has been elected Chairman of the Administrative Committee, which in addition to the officers as ex-officio members consists of the following persons: Mr. James Becker, Ir. Meyer Brown, Rabbi Wolf Gold, Krs. Rose G. Jacobs, Mr. albert H. Liebermen, Mr. Louis Lip-sky, Dr. Solomon Lowensbein, Dr. Samuel Schulman, Mr. Abraham Tulin, and Mr. Hugh Grant Straus.

The Administrative Committee will administer the affairs of the new body between meetings of the general

membership.

One of the primary functions of the Administrative Committee of the newly organised body will be to formulate and carry into effect a plan whereby the American membership in the Council of the Jewish Agency may include as wide a representation as possible of American Jewish life.

ICA GIVES AGRICULTURAL COURSES TO JEWISH FARMERS IN POLAND.

Paris, Apl. 24th. (Jewish Telegraphic agency).

Profiting by the enforced leisure imposed on land workers by the winter, the Polish Agricultural Service of the Jewish Colonisation Association (Ica) carried through this winter travelling courses in agriculture in several of the Jewish colonies in Poland. In a series of lectures and individual consultations, the agronomists of the Ica have been giving the Jewish farmers the elementary ideas in the chief fields of agriculture, paying particular attention to questions relating to the different methods of cultivation, manures, knowledge of the soil, cattle breeding, etc.

The course of instruction was followed with great interest by the Jewish colonists, who attended the lectures in great numbers.

Speaking generally, the Ica headquarters here state, the Jewish agriculturist is applying himself with intelligence to the task of profiting from the instruction given him and rationalising his work.
