NO COALITION GOVER NMENT WITH HITLERISTS IF IT MEANS DEPRIV-ING JEWS OF RIGHTS: STATEMENT BY PRESIDENT OF GERMAN GENTRE PARTY: "E OF THE CENTRE PARTY TO-DAY AND IN FUTURE WILL FIRMLY AND WITH UTWOST DETERMINATION BEAT BACK ALL ATTEMPTS TO MENACE POSITION OF OUR JETISH
PELLOW CITIZENS.

Berlin, May 5th. (Jawish Relegraphic Agency).
The Centre (Catholic) Party will never join a Coalition Covernment with the Nazis, if the Nazis demand that
Jawish citizens should be deprived of their rights, Professor
Ludwig Kasa, Dean of the Cathedral of Trier, the President 0 of the Centre Party, whose Parliamentary leader is the Prime hinister, Dr. Bruening, has declared to-day in a statement. made in his official capacity to the "Israelitische Familienblatt".

In the course of its 60 years of existence, Centre Party, he said, has always stood for the equality of rights of our Jewish fellow citizens, who have contributed so much to Gorman culture and economic life. To-day Christians and Jews stand together in the common fight against the Godless propagands, and we of the Centre Party, to-day and in the future, will firmly and with the utmost determination beat back all attempts to menace the position of our Jewish fellow citizens.

In November, before the last elections, when there were persistent rumours about the Bruening Government admitting the Hitlerists into a Coalition Government, Dean Kaas declared at a meeting of the Executive of the Centre Party that there was no foundation whatever in the reports that Chancellor Bruening or anyone representing him was conducting negotiations with Fittler or his representatives, with a view to forming a Coalition Government. The Centre Party fights against racehatred, he said, and there is no likelihood of the Party ever changing its views on this matter. A formal resolution presented by Dean Kaas was adopted by the Executive of the Party at the time, declaring that there could be no coalition between the Centre Party and the Hitlerists.

The Centre Party has repeatedly condemned antisemitism, through its various leaders, the ex-Premier Dr. Marx, at the time he was Prime Minister, the late Minister of the Interior, Dr. Wirth, as well as Dean Kaas, and Dr. Bruening, who is the head of the Government as the representative of the Centre Party in the present Coalition. All the Catholic Bishops and Archbishops in Germany have is sued pastoral letters declaring that no Hitlerist can be a member of the Catholic Church, which is tantamount to excommunication, and some Catholic Bishops have refused burial to members of the some catholic discreps nawe refused curried to memoers of the fitterist Party. The fitterists refaliate by coupling the Catholic church with their anti-Jewish agivation, making, their slogan "Down with Kome and Judest".

At the last "catholic slections Ferr Georg Arreaki, a formen President of the Berlin Jewish Community, stood as a candidate of the Centre Party, explaining that it was mainly

but 'not exclusively Catholic.

## MOSES MENDELSSCHN'S BIRTHTOWN BECOMES SEAT OF HITLERIST GOVERNMENT.

Berlin, May 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The Parliament of the State of Anhalt. the only State in which the ditlerists and their Nationalist allies obtained a majority of the seats in the elections held at the end of last month, has elected the local Hitlerist leader, Advocate Freyberg, as head of the State Government.

Thus an antisemitic Eitlerist Government has been established with its seat in the famous town of Dessau, the capital of Anhalt, which is the birthtown of Moses Mendel-ssohn, the educator and emancipator of German Jewry - he was Also known and signed himself as Moses Dessau - to whom it has a monument erected on his centenary, and which was the scene of the Mandelsachn bicentenary celebrations in 1929 (when the then head of the Aphalt Government, Herr Deist,

opening the Mendelssohn Eahibition in the Dessau Art Gallery, said that Mendelssohn's idea of toleration was the basis of the German State). The Jewish Community of Dessau, which has produced

many other Jewish scholars ( it was also the town from which the Philippson family, to which the late M: Franz Philippson, President of the Jewish Colonisation Association, Ica, originhas a long tradition of Jewish culture and activity, and led in the struggle for Jewish emancipation in Germany. Last January, the City Council of Dessau, with a Fitlerist-Nationalist majority, prohibited Sheshita in the

city.

AUSTRIAN JEWEY CREATES UNITED FRONT TO RESIST CROWING HITLERIST MENACE: CONFERENCE OF ALL JEWISH PRINTES AND ORGANIZATIONS HELD ON INITIATIVE OF VIENNA JEWISH COMMONITY.

Vienna, May 5th, (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). A preliminary Conference of all Jewish Parties, organisations and Todges has been held here on the initiative of the Board of the Vienna Jewish Community to create a united Jewish front to resist the growing menace of Hitlerism, as denonstrated by the last electrons. The Hitlerist successes have also had the effect of intensifying the antisemitism of other political parties, which are now emphasising the antisemitic points in their programmes much more, to meet the Eitlerist competition. This has happened, for example, with the Christian Socialist Party, which, in the recent elections, lost heavily to the Hitlerists, and with the Heimwehr organisation.

The Social Democratic Party, at the same time. alleges that the Bitlerists are receiving large sums towards their funds from Jewish capitalists, intent only upon smashing the workers! movement.

A second Conference is to be held shortly, which will proceed to the organisation of a Jewish defence movement in Austria.

VIENTA JE'S UNEASY OVER HITLENIST THREAT TO ATTACK ANNUAL PILGRILAGE MARCH ON SUNDAY TO DR. HERZL'S CRAVE: MANY "ILL STOP IN CEMETERY FOR GOOD SAYS HITLERIST PAPER: POLICE OUTHORITIES ASSURE ZIONIST LEADERS THEY NEED NOT PEAR: WOMEN AND CHILDREN MAY MARCH IN PROCESSION AND NO ONE WILL BE HARMED

Vienna, May 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). All the Zionist Parties and groups in Austria have had an extraordinary meeting here to consider what steps to take in view of the threats made by the Hitlerists that they will organise a pogrom during the annual pilgrimage march next Sunday to the grave of Dr. Theodor Herzl, the founder of the Zionist Organisation, to commemorate his birthday (72nd.), which occurred last Monday.

The clief Fitherist organ here went so far as to

say that many of the marchers to Herzl's grave would stop

with him in the cemetery for good.

The meeting decided unanimously that the march will take place under all circumstances, because if the Jews showed that they were intimidated, the Hitlerists would only become more aggressive. If the police would not do their duty of keeping order during a Jewish pilgrimage to the grave of the Zionist leader, the Zionist youth organisa-tions would undertake themselves to maintain order.

Representations in this sense were made to the Vienna Police Presidium which has in reply assured the Zionist leaders that the police will guarantee absolute order in connection with the march on Sunday to Dr. herzl's grave. The entire resources of the police force will be drawn upon to make it impossible for any hostile demonstration to occur and the Jewish population, it is stated, may arrange their march without any fear. Women and children may join in the procession, and no one will be allowed to come to any harm,

The firm tone adopted by the police authorities has put a stop to the Hitlerist threats, and some of the Hitlerist papers deny that there had been any intention to disturb the

Herzl pilgrimage.

HITLERIST OUTBURST IN CORGEC-SLOVAKIAN PARLIAMENT MAINST PRESIDENT MASARIK FOR PUBLISHING ANTI-HITLERIST INTERVIEW. GOVERNMENT MAKES NO REFLY: SAID TO BE ANYOUS NOT 40 BEHING ASOUT COMPLICATIONS "THE GENERAL IN CASE HITLERIST JOIN GOVERNMENT: PRESID N'TH MESAKK'S OFFICE ALSO SILEMY: SUGGESTED THAT HE SPOKE AS GREAT INTERNATIONAL FIGURE BUT NOT AS PRESTIENT OF REPUBLIC.

Prague, May 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). An interview given by Professor Masaryk, the President of the Czecho-Slowkian Republic, to Dr. Frant Benedikt, the publisher of the Vienna "News Freie Presse", and reprinted from there in many other papers, in which he denounced Hitlerism, as a movement without any positive aim, and intent only on negative things, has led to a furious attack being made on the President in the Czecho-Slovakian Parliament by the bitlerist Deputies

Hitler and his movement have no programme except enmity and hatred against the Jews, the French, the Poles and the Czechs, President Masaryk said in the interview, and the German masses follow him only in the way they would follow a man walking about the streets naked. No one knows what Pitler does want, he went on. We only know what he does not

want - no Jews, no French, no Poles.

Deputy Krebs, one of the Fitlerist Deputies, said that ditlerist Germany surrounded Caseho-Slovakia on three sides, and in the Czecho-Slovakia nepublic itself the Hitlerists were the strongest German Party. If President leasaryk wanted to know what the Hitlerists did not want; he could tell him that it was Germanic race purity, and the destruction of the influence of foreign races on the German people and on German State life; Above all, they were out to destroy the Liberalist Jowies spirit. Only pure German blood would create a pure German State policy. The doctrine of race purity, he claimed, had been adopted also in America, where immigration was nowlegulated in such a way as to assure that the immigratis should be of Mordic stock.

The Government spokesmen did not reply to the attack, to defend the Fresident, and no comment has been made on it by the President's Chancellery. It is claimed in some quarters that the Government is silent because it is anxious to avoid any possibility of complications with Germany in case the Fitherists should join the Government. It is suggested in the same quarters that President Masaryk's Chancellery has made no comment in order to show that the interview was given by him as a great international figure, but not in his official capacity as President of the Republic.

In Democratic and Catholic circles in Czecho-Slovakia, however, presid ant maserykis denunciation of Fitlerism has given great sattsfaction.

STRIOUS FOOD SHORTAGE IN JEWISH COLONISS IN UKRAINE: GROJOINT SENDS TEN CARLOADS OF FLOOR TO RELIEVE NEED; BYTTER SITUATION IN GRIMMA: JEWS WHO DEFT LIND TO GO INTO FACTORISS NO? CLAMOURING TO GO BACK TO LAND IN CRIMBA.

Berlin, May 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Ten carloads of flour have been sent by the Agrojoint into the Jewish colonies of the Cherson and Krivoyrog districts in the Ukraine; in order to relieve the distress caused by the shortage of food there, according to information received here to-day, despite the fact that the agrojoint has not been working in these regions for the past two years. The flour was bought in Russia with the sid of the Conzet, the Soviet Covernment Commission for Jewish Settlement, the Agrojoint agreeing to pay for it in valuat in order to guarantee sufficient food for the Jewish colonies until the new crop is available.

The only region where the Jewish colonists are not suffering from a shortage of bread is the Crimea. In the entire Ukraine, however, both Jewish and non-Jewish peasants have no food. The shortage of food, which is affecting not only the villeges in the Ukraine, but also the cities, is driving hundreds of Jews from the Ukrainian townships into the Orimea, anxious to obtain facilities to go into the colonies there, because there is sufficient food in the Crimea.

Among these who are now deserting the townships are many Jews who were already on the soil previously, but left the colonies when the industrialisation movement started and went back to their home-towns to work in the factories there. Now they are invading the Comzet offices, asking to be sent back to the land.

## TEN JETISH CONSULS IN PALESTINE REPRESENTING FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS.

Jorusalem, May 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).
Mr. Moses Sheloush, head of the Palestine-Eulgarian
Institute, has been appelnted Eulgarian Consul in Palestine,

with his seat in Tel Aviv.

This makes the seventh Jewish foreign Consular representative in Tel Aviv, not counting ex-Deputy Bernard Hausner, the Polish Commercial Representative in Palestine. The others are Mr. M. Dizengoff, representing Belgium, Dr. S. Rosenbaum, Lithuania, Mr. Hoofien, Holland, Mr. Rokach, Roumania, Mr. Tadros, Norway, and Mr. Litvinsky, Esthonia. In addition Mr. Van Vyriesland is Dutch Consul in Jerusalem and in K. Rosenfeld is Belgian Consul in Haife

Jerusalem, May 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency):
The Arab press has during the week been conducting an agitation on the basis of rumowns to the effect that a Jewish policemen, acting as warder in the Jerusalem Prison had beaten a Moslem prisoner, who was reading the Koren, and had thrown the Koren to the floor. It has now been established that the warder was not aware that the book was a Koran, and that he beat the prisoner for refusing to do the work which had been allotted to him. A folice communique has been issued to-day which states that the Police Commandant, as the result of an enquiry, has established that the warder under provocation "temporarily lost his temper while dealing with an insubordinate prisoner, and acted in an improper way, and that he has been severely punished and is being transferred".

## NEW YESHIBAH IN JERUSALEM.

Jerusalem, May 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).
The cornerstone was laid to day for a new building for the oldest Teshibah in Jerusalem, the Yeshibah Hayeiolam. The new building will include also a Telmud Torah and a kitchen for feeding orphan children. Chief Rabbis Kook and Jacob Weier were present, as well as many high Government officials.

DEATH OF FAMOUS JETISP PHILANTHROPIST IN GERMANY: CELUBRATED
BETH, BIRTHDAY RECENTLY AND WAS GONGRATULATED BY PRESIDENT
HINDENDRG.

Berlin, May 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Herr Herrmann Abraham, the famous philanthropist, who was the pioneer of child welfare homes and other welfare institutions in Germany, died here to-day. As recently as March. Ferr Abraham celebrated his 85th. birthday, receiving messages of congratulation from the President of the Republic, Field Warshal von Hindenburg; the Federal Prime Minister, Dr. Bruening; the Prussien Prime Minister, Herr Braun; the Minister of Public Welfare, Dr. Hirtslefer; the Berlin Police President, Herr Crzesinski; the Lord Mayor of Berlin, Dr. Sahm, and many other prominent personages. On your 85th. birthday President von Hindenburg wrote to him, I want to congratulate you on the many years of service that you have rendered the country in your quiet, unobtrusive and threless way, in providing feeding facilities for our school children, in menitaining food kitchens for the middle-class and for officials during the war, and in opening after the war your numerous children's seaside and mountain homes, a work which will never be I send you my most cordial wishes for your conforgotten. tinued health and for many more years in the evening of your life.

The Berlin Jewish Community, too, sent him a message, in which it said: On the occasion of your 85th. birthday, we are happy to be able to offer you our heartiest wishes. You have for decades given your life, to social welfare work, helping the unfortunate and the suffering and making their road easier for them. The heads of the Government, and leading men and women in all branches of public life have expressed to you their recognition of your work. You have opened import ant institutions which have done an incalculable amount of good You have opened importto children of all faiths by giving them their most important weapon in the struggle of life - health. In many of the excesses against Jews in the Rast you were the first to come to their aid and to alleviate their distress. During the war, when there was widespread distress in the country, you helped the sufferers. Even now, at your advanced age, conlined to your sick bed, you have not ceased to carry on your work of helping others. You still personally supervise your great work which has won the recognition of Jewish and non-Jewish people everywhere. You can look back on a long life of doing good and of bringing blessings to thousands upon thousands. We hope that you will live for many years yet to see your work grow and continue to benefit humanity.
