Ferlin, June 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).
Jewish leaders in Germany are gloomy about the
situation, following the dissolution of Parliament, and the
ordering of fresh elections, which it is feared will almost

certainly bring the Eitherists into power. The Zionist leaders feel that if there is a Eftlerist regime, the fate of Germen Jewry will be shared by the Jews in a number of other countries, like Austria, which will probably follow the German exemple.

The non-Zionist leaders of German Jewry say that they prefer to make he attacements on the situation now.

The coming election campaign is viewed with grave a prehension, particularly with the lifting of the ban on the Hitterist storm troops, who are expected to start a campaign of election terrorism against their political opponents and against the Jews, repeating the Freslau outburst this week on a larger scale throughout the country.

Berlin, June 4th. (Jéwish Telegraphic Agency). The police authorities of Breslau have issued a communique minimising the disturbances in Breslau and denying that they were in the nature of a pogrom, describing them instead as attacks made by Nazis on people belonging to the Perties of the Left.

The Cocialist organ "Vorwaerts" in reporting the Ereslau events states that the Nazis organisêd a hunt against their opponents. Fechle of Jewish appearance and psople wearing Republican symbols were knocked down. A crowd of Nazis demonstrated outside the offices of the Republican Reichsbanner organisation, shouting "Slaves of the Jews!", "Traitors to the Orkers!", "Kurderers!".

Prominent Jews'in Breslau, to whom the Jewish Tele-

graphic agency here telephoned, stated that they were not in a position to make any statement on the events. In street tumults of such a nature, they said, it was not easy to see how far they were of an antisemittic character.

ANTI-JETISH BOYCOTT AND TER ORISK IN GERMAN PROVINCES.

Berlin June 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Jews dare not show themselves in the streets in many of the towns in the northern provinces, because of Nazi terrorism, it is reported here to-day from Schleswig-Tolstein.

There is a fierce anti-Jewish boycott in progress
there, the report says, and Jews are being subjected increasingly to physical maltreatment. Jewish houses and shops are
being attacked.

Similar reports are arriving in Berlin from the Southern Provinces, where the Nazis are conducting an anti-Jewish boycott campaign.

The Jews in the big cities can have no idea how antisemitism hits us Jews in the small provincial places, the reports say.

son of Professor Planck, the great scientist, who is Professor
Einstein's closest friend. Another men who is known for his
friendship with Jews is Privy Gouncillor von Kaufmann, the new
head of the Federal Government Press Department. The new
Poreign Kinister, too, Baron von Neurath, who was till his
appointment Ambassador in London, is well known as a friend
of the Jews.

These appointments show that the new Covernment has no antisemitic tendencies, the J.T.A. was assured, and that it will not encourage antisemitism.

UNFOUNDED RUMOUPS OF REVOLUTION IN GERMANY.

London, June 5th. (Jewish Telegraphic agency).

1 ost of the London Sunday papers comment to-day on
rumours of a revolution in Germany that were circulated withdramatic persistence all over "urope last night. A message
was circulated to the press that "a revolt has broken out in
Cermany, that troops have been called out, and that news messages for abroad have been stopped".

Though this message remained unconfirmed and denied, it reflects the state of unparalleled tension which has seized the German records the "Sunday Express" remarks.

at relects the state of unperalled tented which has select the German people, the "Sundy Express" remarks. Anythin, it says, may happen in Germany this week. In well-informed circles in "Mitchall, it claims, the possibility of a revolution or a dictatorship or both was openly canyassed.

"Sunday Times" says, that President Hindenburg will issue a proclamation on Cotober End., urging the election of the former Crown Frince. Official circles will, no doubt, deny any such intention on the part of the President, but confirmation of the report appears in an article in a Munich Sunday paper. This says: "Rindenburg will resign in the autumn, in favour of the ex-Crown Prince as Administrator of the Reich".

The dismissal of Dr. Bruening from the German Chancellorship last Londay, and the prompt appointment of Capitain on Paper to take his place, may mark the beginning of the end of the German Republic as it has existed under the "eimar Constitution since the end of 1919, Mr. Wickham Steed writes in the "Sunday Times".

To those who believed in him, he proceeds, Dr. Bruening's fall is disconcerting. To those who prefer to look facts in the face it is not unwelcome. They see the true features of a Nationalist Germany emerge, as in a dissolving view, through the smooth and debonsir countenance of the late Chancellor.

Captain von Papen's Cabinet of Junker barons and big industrialists confirms the impression, Mr. Tickham Steed says, that the new Government, which has been placed in power by the advance of Hitlerism, may be more reactionary than Herrither himself. President von Hindenburg's action in dissolving the Reichstag immediately shows that, in him, the feelings of an East Prussian noble have ended by triumphing over his scruples as constitutional guardian of the German Republic.

If the von Papen administration gives the impression of being strong and ruthless, the masses of the German people may follow its lead, for they love, above all, to be commanded and to be told what, they have to do.

ir. Garvin writes in the "Observer" of the astonishing and ominous change in the German stuation. President windenburg has succumbed at last, he says, to dangerous advice. The coup detat decreed in the Reich is calculated, like nothing else conceivable, to increase uncertainty and to prolong it. For this there can be no cure until Germany returns to some sort of representative regime. A Nazi cabinet itself would be better than a junker-junta.

Wise, with an undoubted claim to speak for the majority of the German people. Better for the Nazis to join hands with the Cathelmo Centrum both in Prussia and the Reich. SIX MONTES! IMPRISONMENT FOR PRACTISING SHECHITA IN PRUSSIA IF NAZI BILL SHOULD BE PASSED.

Berlin, June 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Six months' imprisonment and a heav' fine in addition will be the penalty for practising Shechita in Prussia, if the new anti-Shechita bill introduced by the Nazi fraction into the Prussian Diet should be adopted. The bill would prohibit Shechita not only for cattle,

but also for poultry.

NO IMPRISONMENT FOR ANTISEMITIC STUDENT :RIOTERS AT BERLIN UNIVERSITY: APPEAL COURT QUASHES SENTENCES.

Ferlin, June 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). The Prussian Supreme Court has to-day quashed the sentences passed on seven Nazi students by the Lower Court in Berlin for taking part in the antisemitic disturbances at Ferlin University.

The Berlin Court had sentenced the Nazi students a few days after the disturbances to terms of imprisonment ranging from eight months to four months.

The Supreme Court has fined one of the students 150 barks and another 50 Marks for disturbing the peace, dismissing the charges against the rest.

The Democratic press protests that the Supreme Court is, by its decision in this case practically inviting the Nazis to start fresh disturbances at the Universities.

NEW ATTACK ON JEWISH COCIALIST STIDENTS IN VIENNA.

Vienna, June 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). Jewish Socialist students were attacked to-day by Nazis outside the Technical High School. One of them was stabbed.

Inside the Technical Figh School there was no disturbance, the Rectorate giving protection to the Jewish students.

TO JE"S IN NE" FFENCH CABINET: SEVERAL PROMINENT PRO-ZIONISTS INCLUDED.

Paris, June 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency). There are two Jews in the new Herriot Government. E. Leon keyer, who is re-appointed to his old office as kinister of the mercantile Fleet, and Senator llexandre Israel, widdhas been appointed Under-Secretary to the Prime Einister's office.

The new Ministry includes four prominent Pro-7ionists, L. Justin Godart, the President of the French Pro-Palestine Committee, Senator de Monzie, h. Paul Painleve, and the Negro Deputy, M. Candace, who have all frequently addressed Zionist meetings and declared themselves strongly in support of the Jewish work in Palestine.

FOUR NIN JES SHED NO TERS IT FAIL OF JORGA GOVER MEENT SAYS

Bucharest, June 3rd. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Neither from the general point of view by the country at large, nor from the Jewish point of view by the Jewish population is there any regret at the fall of the Jorga Government, Day is a supering the members of the club of Jewish Dayutes, said to the J.T.A. here to day. All wre pleased that it is gone, and there will be no tears shed for it anywhere. For the Jorga Government has failed to act up in any way to the expectations placed in it when it came into office. It has left the country much worse off economically and financially than when it took office. The Government is not responsible for all the difficulties that have since cropped up, but it certainly showed itself incapable of doing anything to avert the crisis.

J." ISF INFLUENCE BEFIND EGYPTIAN GOVERNMENT SAYS JERUSALES LUFTI ORGAN: JE S BLAMED FOR DEPORTATION OF WEBFON ARABS

Jerusalem, June 3rd. (Jewish Telegraphic .gency). Every day kebron merchants are being deported from gypt under police escort to Palestine, the Febron correspondent of the "Jemes el Arabia", the organ of the Orand Mufti, complains.

The number of Hebronites who have been driven from Egypt in this way is in the neighbourhood of 200, he says.

The Egyptian Government claims that these Rebronites entared gypt on merchant visas or without visas at all. we are informed, the Hebron correspondent declares, that the influence of the Jews on the Egyptian Government is responsible for the deportation of these bebronites.

If this state of affairs continues, he says, not a single Repronite will remain in Egypt. We appeal to the national institutions to prevail upon the Egyptian Government to change its policy in this matter.
