NOTE TO WITH FIST GOVERNMENT, IN GER. MY: NAZIS OBTAIN ABSOL-UTR BAJOFITY OF VOTES IN MECKLENBURG-SCHWERIN.

Berlin, June 4th. (J wish Telegraphic agency). The Mazis have gained control of another German State, obtaining an absolute majority of the votes in the elections which took place to-day in the State of mecklenburg-Schwerin.

The itlerists obtained 178,680 votes, more than all the other Perties combined. The Socialists, who came second, polled 107,000 votes, but the Nationalists only solled 30,000 votes, the Communists 25,000, and the Democratic Party and the People's Party 7,000 votes each.

The Nazis, who did not have a single seat in the previous recklenburg Parliament, now have 29. The Socialists have 18 Deputies in the new Parliament.

decklenburg includes several old Jewish communities, among them the town of Postock, which played an important part in the fight for Jewish emancipation in Germany.

NO JETISH CTORS OR PLAYS FOR PRUSSION STATE THEATERS: NET NACI MOTION IN PRUPCIAN PARLICHENT

Perlin, June 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic .gency).
The sazi fraction has introduced a motion into the Prussian Diet which, if adopted would make it illegal for any actors or actresses to be engaged to play at any State theatre unless they can prove that they are of "pure German origin", meaning that they have no Jewish blood. Existing agreemen meaning that they have no Jewish blood. Existing agreements with actors or actresses who are not of purely German origin. must not be renewed, and no new agreements may be entered into with them.

The resolution would also give power to the Prussian List to prevent the performance of plays which are judged to be "anti-Wational" or pacifist, or written by people who are "anti-national".

The press of the left declares that the directors of certain State theatres in the provincial parts of Gormany are already refusing to confirm the engagements of their autors and actresses unless they can produce proof that they are not J. ish. The directors claim that they are compelled to do this under the pressure of public opinion.
In all these cases, the papers point out, the theatres

in question are State subsidised out of the revenue contributed by the taxation of all citizens.

WHAT "CHRISTIAN" LEANS IN NO GOVERNMENT PROGRAMME.

London, June oth. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The word "Christian" occurs several times in the programme of the new German Government, the "manchester Guardian writes to-day, but the programme has nothing to do with Christianity. The Bungarian White Terrorist detachments of 1919, whose atrocities are amongst the most awful in modern x 1919, whose acrocities are amongst the most awful in modern times, the instigators of pogroms throughout Eastern and south-eastern Turope, the Austrian fascists, and all the terrorists and gangsters who have defiled European civilisation since the war have been fond of assuming names like "Ontstien", "Social" "Mational", or have combined them in hyphenations like "Christian-Social" or "Christian-National", so that the foul things they stand for might be hidden under a lofty name.

That is the significance of the word "Christian" in the von Papen Government's programme. The Government is silent about the unchristian things that are going on in Germany now - the ever-increasing arrogance of the Nazis, the incitements to violence against Jews and Repullicans, and Xenophobia (another Englishman has been arrested by Nazis, the third within a few months); the mobbing of a defenceless Jewish girl at Breslau; the insults and menaces to Jewish children in the schools (so that many cautious parents are escorting children to and from school for fear lest they be mobbed by the "Christian" children) .-

A campaign has been opened by members of the Federation of Jewish ex-soldiers in Germany who are going about the country addressing meetings in the Fitlerist centres, explaining to the population the facts about the participation of the

German Jews in the life of the country.
Lost of the campaign speakers are men who were wounded in battle, and they select places where the Mazis have obtained control. They concentrate on the smaller towns and the country districts where the feeling is overwhelmingly Fitlerist.

one Jowelsh disabled ex-servicemen, "erner Schlesinger, reports in the "Schild", the official organ of the Federation, that he has been given a good hearing in a town where 70 per cent. of the possibilities are members of the Newl Party, and 20 per cent. are members of the Scell Heim Brigade. There were 350 people present, and in the discussion which followed one of the local leaders of the Steel Felm said he felt more kinship with a wounded Jawish front-fighter than with same of the speakers of Nationalist Parties, who had never been out at the front.

Another Jewish ex-soldier, Dr. Ludwig Freund, spoke at Castellaun, at a meeting attended by 500 members of the Nazi Party and the Steel Felm Brigade, and at the end of his speech he was loudly applauded.

Dr. Freund spoke at a similar gathering of 400 Nazis and Steel Felm Brigaders at Neiwied, and he was invited to come again and repeat his address at a larger gathering.

fact that it was curing his period of office that his former colleague, the antisemitic lead r Cuza, wasmarked out for special distinction, and when he delivered his attacks in Parliament on the Jews, always got approbatory smiles from the Government benches, is characteristic of the attitude adopted by Jorga as Premier towards the Jews and Jewish questions.

It is also characteristic that after Professor Jorga's resignation, it was not the officials of the initary that he received, aut Professor Cuals Drother. It squares with the talk curing Professor Jorga's term of office about a

coming election pact between Jorga and the Cuzists.

It must be admitted, however, the paper adds, that during the Jorga Covernment there were no Cuzist acts of anti-Jawish violence such as we had under previous Covernments, but this is the achievement of the inister of the Interior, the ingetolanu, who would not tolerate any antisemitic excesses.

The Jorga Government, the paper concludes, will to the entire country, but most of all to the Jews, go down to history as an unpleasant memory.

sucharest, June 3rd. (J.T.A. all Service). The resignation of the Jorga Government is joyful news, the Yiddish daily "ther 2st" of Kishineff, which is edited by Leputy Lendau, one of the leaders of the Club of Jewish Leputies, writes in an editorial article.

The whole country is happy that the Jorga Covernment has gone, it says. People are beginning to breathe egain. /11 the provinces are rejoicing. That does the morrow hold in store? That Government will succeed the Jorga Government? It is difficult to answer these questions. But whatever Government may come after Jorga, it cannot possibly be worse than the Jorga Covernment was, and things cannot possibly be worse than they were under the Jorga Government. That is assuming, of course, that none of the members of the Jorga Government stay on in the new Government, neither the cynic

envernment sawyon in the new covernment, netters the dyfile rigetoising who tried to play the Foundatian Dictator, nor the finister of the Interior, L. Otseu, nor the rest of them.

11 Foundation Covernments for the past 12 years have been such that we have hed no occasion to rejoice. The country has grouned under all the various regimes of all the various Covernments, even under the regime of that "Saviour" Julius aniu, which subjected Jews to plenty of suffering as a result of the activities of the inister of the Interior, . Veyda-Voyvod, who flattered and flirted with the leaders

of the Iron! Guard.

But the blackest and worst regime of any of all these various Governments did not do so much harm, did not rouse so much antagonism, so much bad blood as the regime of the Jorga Government, "Unser Zeit" says. 'The Jorga-Argetoianu regime was a cynical, insolent, scoffing regime. It was a regime of dictatorship, of terrorism, of inquisition. It was a regime which completed the economic devastation of the country, especially of us Jews. Under Jorga, the worst enemy of Israel, the ugliest Jew-baiter, Cuza, sat triumphant with a dozen of his Diputies, and poured obliquy and calumny upon the Jews, and the whole Chamber, led by the Prime inister Jorga, smiled at him for doing so.

It is difficult to say who is likely to be the successor to this black Jorga Government, but the only thing we can say of the Jorga Government is - Thank God it has gone!.

Czernowitz, June 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The whole district of Storozynetz is breathing freely again now that the Prime inister, Professor Jorga, has gone, the local papers write, because his resignation has brought with is the withdrawal of his son-in-law, ajor Chirescu, the Prefect of the Storozynetz district.

The Prefect had made himself highly unpopular among the population by his arbitrary activities, among which was the order for the eviction of the Jews living in the refugee barracks at iznitz, in the Storozynetz district.

The press states that when the news of his withdrawal spread in Storozynetz, people embraced in the streets and tongratulated each other, as if it were a great festival.

The Czernowitz ".orgenblatt" comments that the people

of Storozynetz ought really to be grateful to the ex-Prefect, because they had no cause to be happy when he came, and they certainly had no cause to be happy while he was there, but now that he has gone, they are all a happy lot of people.

CHANGES FOR BETTER EXPECTED IN BESSARABIA THERE PREFECTS TO BE REMOVED AFTER RECENT ANTI-JETISH TERRORISM.

Kishineff, June 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Changes for the better are expected as a result of the fall of the Jorga Government in the administrative staff of Bessarabia, where the administrative authorities have been engaging in acts of anti-Jewish persecution and terrorism.

It is stated that the Prefects of the Departments

of Chotin. Soroca, Orhei, Taghina, and Akerman, in all of which acts of terrorism have occurred, are to be removed. The changes are said to have been decided on under the previous Government, as a result of the investigation carried out by the former kinister for Bessarabia, M. Vladimir Cristi, during his recent tour of inspection through Bessarabia.

PALESTINE I MIGRATION: COUNTRIES "FICH "ILI RECEIVE CERTIFICATES.

Jerusaler, June 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).
The Jewish Agency Executive has distributed the 1,700 immigration certificates released by the Covernment for the current half-year period April - September, by placing 980 at the disposal of the Palestine Immigration Office in Poland, 131 for Poumania, 70 for Lithuania, 60 for Russia, 70 for Adam, 48 for Germany, 40 for Latvia, 21 for Austria, 25 for merica, 35 for Geoho-Slovekia, 15 for Greece, and 24 for Turkey. Other countries are receiving ten certificates or less.

ASHES OF LATE L. J. GREENBERG EDITOR OF "JEWISH CHRONICLE" INTERRED IN PALESTINE COLONY.

Jerusalem, June 4th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

The ashes of the late Mr. L. J. Greenberg, editor of the "Jewish Chronicle", who died in November, were buried yesterday in the Jewish colony of Dagania.

Dr. rlossoroff, head of the Palestine Zionist Executive, delivered an address during the interment.

... In his will hr. Greenberg expressed the wish that his remains should be placed "in an inexpensive casket or box and

bransported to Palestine to an authoritative organisation there which shall take charge of it and then bury it without any

relicious ceremony on kount Scopus, near Jerusalem".

The Chief Pabbinate of Palestine issued a circular. however, to all the Jewish burial societies in Palestine that they must not accept the ashes of any cremated person for burial in Palastine, and it was understood that the circular was issued with special reference to the fact that Mr. Greenberg had been cremated and that his ashes were then on the way to felestine.

DEATH OF BENJAMIN SCHLESINGER H.AD OF LARGEST JE"ISH TRADE UNION

New York, June 6th. (Jewish Telegraphic .gency). Benjamin Schlesinger, who was only last month reelected President of the International Ladies Carment "orkers' Union, the largest and most important Jewish trade union in " america, died last night at Colorado Springs.

ir. Schlesinger, who was 55 years of age, had suffered for years from asthma, and he had recently been very ill. 'e.was born in Lithuania, He had been for many years maneger of the "Jewish Dally Forwards".

DR. CYRUS ADLER HONOUR D ON COMPLETION OF 30 YEARS ORK WITH JEWISH TREOLOGICAL SEMINARY.

New Lork, June 5th. (Jewish Telegraphic Agency).

Dr. (Jyrus Adler, Fresident of the Jewish Theological Seminary of America, was honoured last night at the Seminary on the occasion of his completion of thirty years of service

in the Seminary.

Dr. Adler has been presented with a bound volume conteining the signatures of 500 leading american Jews, including FR. Felix b. Tarburg, Lieut. Governor Lehman, Supreme Court Judge Cardoze, r. Adolf Ochs, the owner of the "New York Times", krs. Jacob F. Schiff, Covernor Arthur Seligman, of New Lexico, Governor Julius Reler of Oregon, ex-Ambassador Abram I. Elkus, Dr. Bernard Flexner, General Abel Davis, Er. Paul Paerwald, the Chairman of the Joint Distribution Committee of America, and Er. Louis B. Mayor.

The presentation of the volume was made by Pr. Sol. k. Stroock, the chairman of the Board of the Seminary.

Dr. Cyrus Adler has played an outstanding part in many fields of Jewish activity, besides the Jewish Theological

Seminary.

Fe is also President of the American Jewish Committee, Chairman of the Army and Navy Committee of the Jewish Telfare Board, Chairman of the Jewish Publication Society, and Chairman of the Board of Editors of the Jewish Bible Foundation.

Fe is, too, President of the Dropsie College for Febrew and Cognate Learning in Philadelphia.

Dr. Cyrus Adler was also one of the organisers on the non-Zionist side of the Jewish Agency for Palestine, and he is the Chairman of the Administrative Committee of the Jewish Agency.
