NAZIS RENEW ATTACK ON JEWISH STUDENTS: BERLIN UNIVERSITY CLOSED

Naxis Break Written Guarantee of Peace; University May Remain Closed for an Entire Semester; Bolieve They Deliberately Provoked Attack: Central Union Protests

Breaking their written guarantees given to the rector of the University, Dr. Heinrich Lueders, which led to the reopening of Berlin University on July 2nd, the Nazis attacked Jewish students and those who appeared to be Semites.

Fifteen students received injuries at the hands of the Nazis and were dragged from the University buildings to the street exits where they were tossed into heaps of refuse.

The disturbances started when several wreaths placed Sunday before the University memorial for fallen students were found descrated this morning.

It is believed that the Nazis themselves desecrated the wreaths for the purpose of provoking disturbances Jewish Telegraphic Agency Takes Issue with Roumanian Minister, Charles A. against the lews.

"Down with the Jews!" "Germany Awake!" the Nazis shouted. The injured students received first aid

treatment at the Deutscher Students dormitory.

The Deutscher Student Verband assumes that the University will remain closed until the end of the term since the rector is unable to guarantee protection to the Jewish students.

Davila, on Statements Made in Letters Circulated Among Jewish Leaders; Scores Procedure in Sending to Jewish Leaders Copy of Communication to J.T.A. Without Informing J.T.A. of Having Done So; Facts Quoted Repudiate Allegations That J.T.A. Deliberately Omitted Important Details

Charles Davila. Minister to the United States has misquoted a communique issued by his Legation and reports of the lewish Telegraphic Agency in communications addressed by him to Jewish leaders, attempting to discredit the Jewish Telegraphic Agency in an effort to justify the attitude the Legation has adopted in the torture of Samson Bronstein, Zionist leader of Yedinez, Bessarabia.

This charge is made in a letter addressed yesterday to Minister Davila by Jacob Landau, Managing Director of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency.

Revisionist Charges Against World Zionist Executive to Be Heard This Month

Hearing Before Congress Court in London When Actions Com-mittee Meets

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON, July 12-The Revisionist charges against the World Zionist Executive will be heard before the Congress court when the Actions Committee meets here on July 28th, it was an-nounced by the Revisionist headquarters here today.

The witnesses whom the Revisionists propose to call are Heshel Farbstein of Poland, member of the Jewish Agency Executive; Dr. Leo Motzkin of Paris, Robert Stricker of Vienna, and S. E. Soskin.

The Revisionists charge that the Zionist Executive failed to carry out the decision of the Congress to reconstitute the Palestine office according to the composition of the parties, and that this has been done deliberately. As a result the distribution of Palestine immigration certificates is illegal and the Revisionists therefore demand their cancellation. They also demand the appointment of new Palestine offices.

To Vote for Education Transfer From Agency (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

JERUSALEM, July 12—The Palestine Jewish National Council yesterday instructed its members who will aftend the Actions Committee meeting in London to vote for the transfer of education supervision from the Jewish Agency Executive to the Knesseth Israel.

It was stipulated however that the transfer should be approved only if the . Jewish Agency undertakes for a period of three years to contribute £40,000 annually.

BULLETIN Says Bronstein Would Have Died of Neglect Were It Not for J. T. A. Effort

President of Union of Roumanian Jews, Back from Visit to Roumania, Says Bronstein Faces Amputation

Had it not been for the effort of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, Samson Bronstein, Zionist leader of Yedinez, Bessarabia, would probably have died of neglect, declared D. A. Braham, president of the Union of Roumanian Jews, in a statement to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency following his retturn from a visit to Roumania.

As it is, declared Mr. Braham, Bronstein's condition is so serious that "one or both of his legs may have to be amputated because gangrene resulted owing to lack of proper medical aid."

Mr. Braham visited Bronstein in the

hospital of Czernowitz. Mr. Braham expressed the belief that

a case like that of Samson Bronstein could occur even though the central

government might abhor it and even e ashamed of it. This he explained on the ground that the execution of laws "that would be

a credit to any civilized country" is left in the hands of local prefects "whose methods of government are those of the Turkish Satrap of the Middle Ages, a system which prevailed in the Roumanian provinces until the latter part of the 19th century. Any one who opposes the rule of the prefect risks being tortured, or even hung without trial, regardless of the laws of the central government."-

Mr. Braham said "it must be remembered that the national government does not condone these acts of torture although it may appear to do so be-cause of its desire to cover up these occurrences. The secrecy is the result of shame felt on the part of the na-tional officials."

Hoover Signs Measure Granting Exemption and Preference to Husbands

Requirements Concerning Legality of Marriage and Financial Status of Wives Not Lifted

(Jewish Daily Bulletin) WASHINGTON, July 12—President Hoover yesterday signed the amended Dickstein bill granting exemption from the quota to husbands of American citizens married prior to July 1, 1932 and preference status to those married subsequent to July 1, 1932, and it auto-matically became a law.

The measure does not lift the re-quirements calling for legal proof of marriage and the financial status of the wives. In each case the consuls must be satisfied that the marriage is legal and that the husband will not become a public charge before visas can be obtained.

Alien Remittances Show 13% Decline (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

WASHINGTON, July 12-Immigrant remittances to their native lands by remittances to their native lands by persons living in the United States dropped 13 per cent last year to \$173,000,000, according to a Department of Commerce statement. Almost every country received some of this amount, the largest total going to Italy.

A marked increase in remittances to

Russia was noted.

Remittances during the year, however, were about 13 per cent under those of the previous year. The amount is 30 per cent below the estimate for 1929.

The comparatively small decline in the funds sent abroad during 1931, as compared with the previous year, apparently was due, according to the bulletin; to three more or less unrelated factors. The first of these was the large number of aliens who left the country during the year, many of whom carried accumulated savings with them to aid in the support of friends and relatives in distress abroad. The sharp depreciation of certain foreign currencies during the latter part of the year, which increased the foreign value of the American dollar in those countries, and the marked increases in remittances to Soviet Russia, were also important factors in keeping the decline at a low level.

"Although we reported that an investigation had been started by the

local authorities, I may say in all frankness that we were sceptical about the effectiveness of this investigation, of which obviously not even a report had been submitted by the local authorities to the central authorities. It was due to the publicity given by the J.T.A. in American newspapers (as is stated by your Excellency in one of your communications, we were the only source of this news), that the attention of your Excellency was drawn to this case and that your Excellency urged upon your government prompt investigation of the case and punishment of those guilty. A. D. Braham, President of the Union of Roumanian Iews, who has just returned to this country, testifies in a statement that it was due to the J.T.A. that effective steps have been taken by the authorities in the Bronstein case.

"May I remind your Execllency that when the statement was issued on June 22nd that the guilty officials had been punished, it was found that even then no steps for the punishment of the guilty officials had been taken, and only two days ago was our Agency in a position to report that these measures were being taken. Not until 19 days later was punishment really meted

The most astonishing charge made against us is contained in your remark that we omitted the word 'new' when we published the statement of June 22nd announcing that steps had been taken by your government. The word new was not contained in your state-nent. That statement was reproduced by us in full. Not a single word was omitted, as will be seen from the photostat which I am enclosing.

"The real issue at stake was whether the Bronstein case was invented and whether Bronstein was indeed subjected to the most gruesome tortures. On both these questions no doubt is permissible. It is surprising to me that your Legation has for weeks tried to harp on irrelevant details which you raised in order to instil in the public doubt as to the veracity of the J.T.A.
