## ASK GOVERNMENT IF IT WILL EVOKE EDICT TO SUPPRESS MASS AGITATION AGAINST JEWS

**Jews Injured in Nazi Attack in Sensburg, East Prussia; Nazi Organ Continues Boycott Agitation Against Jews; Strasser Says Hitler Next Chancellor**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, July 23—The German government is asked today by the "Juedische Rundschau", organ of the German Zionist Federation whether it plans to use the new edicts to suppress mass agitation against the Jews on the part of the Nazis and other anti-Semitic parties.

The paper reminds the government of the assurances given to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency on June 5th that the rights of the Jews would not be infringed upon as re-iterated by Secretary of State Plank.

The "Voelkischer Beobachter" today continuing its attacks upon the Jews and the paper utilizes the birthday of Max Lieberman, internationally known German Jewish painter.

The paper declares: "After the thirty-first of July, we will see other names represent German art." It criticizes the Prussian Minister of Education for greeting Lieberman on his 85th birthday which occurred on July 20th, as well as the German press for hailing him as the King of German art.

No German government will rule without the Nazis after July 31st, declared Deputy Gregor Strasser, Nazi chieftain, at a mass meeting last night.

Adolph Hitler, Nationalist Socialist leader, expects to become Chancellor of Germany within the next few weeks, Deputy Strasser asserted.

## Jewish Dean of Commercial High School Is Re-elected

BERLIN, July 23—The Jewish dean of the Commercial High School in Berlin, Moritz Julius Bonn, was today elected to serve for a second term.

Jewish Communist, seeking escape from Nazis, fled to a Jewish store and escaped through a back door.

The Nazis pursued the Communist through the store and destroyed part of its contents. The Jewish storekeeper was compelled to close the premises.

The incident started an invasion of the Jewish quarter by one hundred and fifty Nazis accompanied by women, girls and children, who assaulted Jews on the street with the cries: "Perish Judaea!"

## B'NAI BRITH DECLINES TO PARTICIPATE IN GENEVA CONFERENCE; CALLS FOR RESCINDING PLANS

**Alfred M. Cohen Says Branches of Order Are Unanimously Opposed to Geneva Conference; Asks Conference Be Withdrawn Until Influential Bodies in World Jewry Decide Such a Meeting Is in Interest of World Jewry; Further Editorial Comment; Zivian Says Conference Will Be Transformed Into Zionist Congress; Wise Scored for Proceeding Despite Opposition**

The B'nai Brith organization, with branches in many parts of the world, will not participate in the forthcoming world Jewish conference in Geneva on August 14, according to a communication received by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency from Alfred M. Cohen, president of the order.

In a letter addressed to Bernard S. Deutsch, president of the American Jewish Congress which is sponsoring the conference, Mr. Cohen declines the invitation to participate for the Executive committee of the order, representing seven districts in America and eight districts beyond the seas, and calls upon the Congress to rescind its plans for the conference.

Mr. Cohen prefaces his declination of the invitation to participate in the conference with the following statement: "Several weeks ago you honored me,

## Sokolow Says World Jewry Must Be Prepared for the Expulsion of German Jews

**Forecasts Greater Hardships for German Jewry; Urges Discussing Settling of German Jews in Palestine**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON, July 23—A dark picture of the future of Jews in Germany as he sees it is painted by Nahum Sokolow, president of the World Zionist Organization and the Jewish Agency for Palestine, in an article which appears today in "Ha'Olam."

The leader of World Zionism terms the Prussian Confiscation Law the greatest historical outrage, and says it is but the beginning of further hardships and difficulties in store for German Jewry. The Jewish world, he states, must be prepared for the possibility of the expulsion of all Jews from Germany. This is a problem with which the elected representatives of World Jewry must now deal. They must discuss the problem of settling at least a part of them in Palestine.

Dr. Sokolow expresses regret that the Jewish press has not adopted a

## Rabbi Niemirower and Three Other Jews Get Senate Seats

BUCHAREST, July 23—Chief Rabbi Niemirower was re-elected as Senator representing the Jewish religion, and three other Jews received Senate mandates as candidates of general parties, it was learned today.

The victorious Jewish candidates include Emil Fagure, Moise Zipstein, and Max Auschnitt.

The Jewish Party entered no candidates. It is expected that several other Jews will receive Senate seats when the final results are made known.

## Funeral Services Held for Edmond E. Wise, Attorney

Funeral services were held yesterday for Edmond E. Wise, outstanding attorney and active in Jewish undertakings, who died suddenly on Saturday at the age of sixty-seven. Interment took place at the Salem Fields Cemetery.

Mr. Wise was born of American parents in Cassel, Germany, on February 12, 1865. He was general counsel for R. H. Macy & Company.

He was a trustee of the Hebrew Orphan Home, the Clara de Hirsch Home for Working Girls and the Fred L. Lavanburg Foundation. He was also an active member of the Federation for the Support of Jewish Philanthropic Societies of both New York and Brooklyn, the United Hospital Fund, the Educational Alliance and the Legal Aid Society.

Judge Lester Wm. Roth of the Los Angeles Superior Court was re-elected president of the Jewish Consumptive and Ex-Patients' Relief Association, at an organization meeting of the board of directors of that institution. The meeting was the final event in a three-day convention held in Los Angeles and attended by 150 delegates from many parts of the country.

The convention elected the following additional members to the board of directors: Morris Abrams, Mark Carter, Wolf Frankenstein, Jacob I. Greene, A. Horowitz, Aaron Levinson, I. Levitt, J. A. Rosenkrantz, H. Rosove, Judge Roth, Max Ruskov, Chaim Shapiro, Harry Sodos and Samuel Therman.

representatives not only of seven districts in America, but also embraces many countries in which our coreligionists will be directly and therefore keenly and vitally interested in topics likely to be brought to the attention of a World Jewish Conference, and that I believed the views of our representatives in those countries ought to be thoroughly known to us in America, who in acting on the proposal would naturally be largely influenced by their opinion.

"I have communicated with all the members of my Executive Committee and this definite answer to your proposal follows as speedily as possible the receipt of answers from those widely scattered correspondents.

"The answers received from the foreign districts are unanimously unfavorable to B'nai Brith's participation in a world Jewish conference at or near the present time." Mr. Cohen says. "Some go further and altogether disapprove of the holding of a world Jewish conference. They admonish us in America to be careful lest we do them harm and not good.

"With scarcely an exception, the opinion of the American Executive Committeemen coincides with the foregoing," states Mr. Cohen.

"In the presence of this advice," he declares, "B'nai Brith cannot participate in a world Jewish conference to be held as proposed by the American Jewish Congress. Moreover, in behalf of B'nai Brith, whose widespread membership makes it above all other organizations representative of world Jewry, I politely though none the less strongly, urge the American Jewish Congress (the rectitude of whose motives no one may question) to recall and rescind its plans for holding the conference in August. A meeting of that character should only be held after all influential bodies in world Jewry decide that such a meeting is in the interests of world Jewry. In the absence of such mandate, a Jewish World Congress can be such in name only. When B'nai Brith learns from its membership spread over the continents that the united voice of Israel may help to right existing wrongs, it will be among the first to heed their cry."

LONDON, July 23—The B'nai Brith here has rescinded its decision to participate in the Geneva conference after learning from Alfred M. Cohen, president of the order, that the majority of the districts oppose participation. This information was imparted to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency today by Gordon Liverman, president of the B'nai Brith here, who stated that the B'nai Brith of Great Britain cannot act independently of the whole order with regard to participation in the Geneva conference.

Therefore, Mr. Liverman stated, its approval of participation in the confer-

ence must be regarded merely as an expression of viewpoint.

## Zivian Says Conference Will Be a Zionist Congress

Zivian, writing in the Jewish Daily Forward, declares:

"The contemplated world Jewish conference in Geneva will, it appears, be transformed into a world Zionist conference.

"Refusal to participate in this conference has been announced not only by American Jews affiliated with the American Jewish Committee, but Jews from other countries whom we are accustomed to term 'assimilationists.' The 'assimilationists' of Germany, of France and of England have declined participation. Nor is the Conference of Jewish Socialists participating. There remain only the general Zionists and the Poale-Zion—and that is all.

"True, Zionists are also Jews. And when Zionists of various countries congregate, they can say that this is a world Jewish conference. However, the name of a conference is not important. Important is what the conference represents. Should the conference in Geneva represent a Zionist gathering, it is, even from the Zionist standpoint, completely superfluous. The Zionists held a conference last summer and will hold another next summer.

"Everyone must agree that a congress can have no worth which is represented by a single group of Jews of a single line of opinion, when other groups of Jews are not only estranged but outspoken in their opposition."

Zivian concludes with pointing out that the American Jewish Congress has not been able to maintain its Geneva office, and that when this office was suspended, debts were owed which have not yet been paid.

## Friends of Bishop Manning Deny He Is Motivated by Prejudice Against the Jews

**Say He Solicited As Well As Accepted  
Gifts from Jews for Building of  
Cathedral of St. John**

Friends of Bishop William T. Manning, in his absence from the city, declare the charges against him to the effect that he stated he does not want Jews in his churches, by Dr. Edward S. Cowles, director of the ousted Body and Soul Clinic of St. Mark's Church in the Bowwerie, are unwarranted, according to the Evening Post.

Friends of the Bishop, according to the same paper, point to the fact that he has solicited as well as accepted substantial gifts from Jews for the building of the Cathedral of St. John the Divine and had served on committees for the same purpose.

The Evening Post says: "The comments of Bishop Manning on cathedral gifts show no evidence of racial feeling. When Mortimer J. Schiff gave \$25,000, the Bishop said: 'I especially appreciate this gift for it illustrates the spirit of fellowship and good will which should prevail in this city and throughout our broad land.'"

The late Colonel Friedsam sent a gift of \$50,000 from the Altman Foundation and praised the project, saying "there need be no question of creed in supporting it." Colonel Friedsam served as chairman of the department stores campaign committee for the cathedral.

Adolph S. Ochs, publisher of the New York Times, made generous gifts to the fund and served as well on its committees.

Trustees of Congregation Beth Elohim, of which Meier Steinbrink is president, sent \$500.

Rabbi Stephen S. Wise pledged aid to the fund at a campaign dinner. Otto H. Kahn served on an honorary committee; Ralph Pulitzer was chairman of a newspaper committee; David Sarnoff headed a radio committee; a theatre committee included Morris Gest, Marcus Loew, A. H. Woods, Arthur Hammerstein, J. J. Shubert and A. L. Erlanger, says the Evening Post in showing how Jews aided the building fund. Eddie Cantor and Roger Wolfe Kahn were among a number of Jews who participated in a benefit for the Cathedral, it also points out.

## Editorials Laud Lieut.-Gov. Lehman as Candidate for Governorship of New York

**Praise Activity in Jewish Life and Exemplary Record During Period  
Of Office**

Lieutenant-Governor Herbert H. Lehman is highly lauded as the probable nominee for the governorship of New York in editorials which appear in the "Jewish Exponent" of Philadelphia and "Opinion."

The papers praise Colonel Lehman's services toward Jewish causes and his exemplary record in office.

The "Jewish Exponent" of Philadelphia states:

"For Governor of New York Lieutenant-Governor Herbert H. Lehman! Unless all present indications go awry this should be the headline in the newspapers some day in the not distant future. Rarely has an individual so endeared himself to the hearts of his fellow-citizens as in his case. Holding a position of prime political importance, he discharged all the duties involved, and considerably more, without at any time resorting to those questionable tactics and policies usually referred to as politics. At no time since his election to office has he been daubed a politician. Somehow no one thinks of him in this light. Doubtless this attitude will continue even after he becomes Governor of the largest and most influential State in the Union. For Lieutenant-Governor Lehman is absolutely lacking in those characteristics that are of the essence of the present day politician.

"In its leading editorial last Saturday the New York Times said: 'Mr. Lehman is a man who, without fuss or false pretenses of any kind, has for three years been applying his business ability to the affairs of this State. . . . It is safe to say that not one of the men talked of as a rival to Mr. Lehman has more than a small fraction of his comprehensive knowledge of the business and the needs of the State of New York. In his quiet and friendly and exceedingly practical way, without oratorical flourishes or the customary hugging methods of politicians, Mr. Lehman has made himself known and valued as an unusually fine example of the business man in politics.' Men of his type are rare; in the political world they are most unusual.

"At this writing it would seem that his nomination is assured. The squawks here and there doubtless will be drowned in the loud, overwhelming chorus of approval. Nor is it likely that the religious issue will be raised. Mr. Lehman's rise politically, the high esteem in which he is held, has come solely as a result of his unique personality and because of the splendid account he has given of himself in the past three years in which he has held public office. ## President of Congress Court Informs Revisionists That Session Has Been Arranged

**To Hear Revisionists' Charges Against  
World Zionist Executive Regarding  
Palestine Offices**

LONDON, July 23—S. Gronemann, President of the Congress Court of the Zionist Organization, has informed the Revisionist Fraction of the Actions Committee that he has arranged for a session of the Congress Court during the meeting of the Actions Committee in London, at the end of this month, in order to deal with the charge brought by the Revisionist Fraction of the Actions Committee against the Zionist Executive, in connection with the affair of the Palestine Offices.

The Congress Court has already received, from the Revisionist Fraction of the Actions Committee, a detailed statement of the charge, supported by documents, claiming to show that the Zionist Executive has failed to carry into effect the Congress decision respecting the reform of the Palestine Offices, and has entrusted to illegal bodies, whose competence had long terminated and whose composition is in contradiction to the decisions of the Congress, with the distribution of the certificates, so that the distribution is *eo ipso* illegal and in diametrical opposition to the Congress decision.

The Revisionist Fraction of the Actions Committee asks that the Zionist

responsible Jewish leaders and organizations in America and throughout the world against the calling of a World Jewish Congress, the American Jewish Congress has taken upon itself the responsibility of calling a conference in August to organize such an international institution. All appeals for caution and calm consideration of the proposal, which none will deny is fraught with serious consequences to all the Jewish people, were cast aside by Rabbi Wise and his associates.

"We do not favor a world Jewish Congress as it is presently constituted. We deny that the 'delegates' chosen by the American Jewish Congress represent American Jewry. We deny that Rabbi Wise and his American Jewish Congress is any more representative of American Jewry than is Dr. Adler and the American Jewish Committee.

"The resolution calling for a world Jewish Congress earnestly urges 'upon all representative bodies that they participate in this Conference to the end that the Jewish people may be united in this critical hour of its history.' All we can say to that is that no group of Jews could conceive of a more effective manner of destroying that laudable object of unity in this critical hour than by forcing a 'World Jewish Congress' down their throats. Rabbi Wise may have his world Congress but he may have it at an awful price to the Jewish people. We do not want to see a definite split in American Jewry after all these years of progress to a decent Jewish unity. Disruption of American Jewish life could not be justified by ten thousand world Jewish Congresses. Let the 'delegates' to that Geneva 'conference' think that over.

"The 'Jewish Standard' of Toronto: 'We are primarily concerned with the main issue: Is a World Jewish Congress feasible or not? Shall representative Jews gathered in conference in Geneva discuss the wisdom or lack of wisdom of such a Congress? It seems to us that there can be only one answer to this question: By all means, yes.' We see no particular danger other than the danger to which Jewry is already exposed by the convening of the Geneva conference and the discussion of the proposal for a World Jewish Congress. It is quite possible that the conference in Geneva may decide against such a Congress at this time. That is its right. But to rule the question out of consideration on the ground that it may give anti-Semites an additional weapon to spread their poison gasses against the so-called Jewish conspiracy, seems to us rather pointless and irrelevant. With or without a Jewish Congress anti-Semites will continue their efforts to alarm the world about a Jewish conspiracy to dominate helpless Christendom. If anything, a Congress openly convened, placing the Jewish question squarely before the

Executive be ordered to dissolve the Palestine Offices; to declare null the distribution of the certificates already made by it and to stop immediately the handing over of the certificates to the persons already designated, without awaiting the result of the Revisionist charge.

whole world, acting courageously and unafraid, may have the exactly opposite effect; an expose of Jewish suffering, misery, and helplessness, may destroy that fiction and effectively contribute toward the amelioration of the Jewish situation.

"It remains, however, for the Jewish leaders who will attend the preliminary conference in Geneva to decide whether a World Jewish Congress at this time or in the near future is feasible."

Nahum Sokolow, president of the World Zionist Organization, says the following in an interview which appears in the "Jewish Exponent" of Philadelphia.

"I am studying this problem most sincerely. One has, for instance, to know whether the Jews of Germany would favor such a gathering. There are pros and cons, but I certainly think it is worth while exploring the idea—not from an external point of view, that is, whether we should expose ourselves to the accusation of internationalism or not—a motive which might paralyze all our activities. I would dismiss such reasoning altogether—because we are compelled to defend ourselves. The question is only an internal one: whether we have the first condition—Jewish unity; whether any practical results can be expected, etc. I hope that all this will not be exploited as a slogan for dividing parties, but as a watch-word to establish a united front of World Jewry in these times of distress and danger."

While in Paris, on his way back to London, Nahum Sokolow was received by the President of the French Republic, who asked a number of questions on the position of Jews in Palestine and in America, and who, Nahum Sokolow says, evinced a great interest in the future of the Jews.

The "American Jewish World" of Minneapolis has also expressed opposition to a world Jewish congress in an editorial.

proper criterion for measuring the seriousness of the situation. He points out, while the present Confiscation Law is directed only against East European Jews, 95% of American Jewry as well as 80% of West European Jewry originates in East Europe. If the measure is confined to East European Jews, it is only because of fear of the stronger governments of Western Europe, Dr. Sokolow declared.

## LETTER TO THE EDITOR

Editor, Jewish Daily Bulletin:

As a constant reader of your most valuable Jewish Daily Bulletin, I was most chagrined with the remarks of Dr. Herman Kaufman of Hamburg in the issue of July 21, 1932.

It is most regrettable that a fellow Jew should publicly express himself disparagingly about his own people. His utterances could easily be attributed to Herr Hitler and his henchmen. It is Jews of the type of Dr. Kaufman who are our greatest menace.
