Max J. Kohler, Jewish Legal Authority and Communal Worker, Informs Insti-tute of Politics of the Civil, Political, Religious and Linguistic Discriminations Against the Jews of Poland; Says 700,000 Jews Lost Livelihood Before Depression, Through Government's Nationalization Attempts; Edward Weintal, Press Attache of the Polish Embassy, Says That Application of Minorities Treaties to Jewish Situation of No Value Whatsoever

Does he not know that the Bible prohibits blood as food, and that down to this day Jews have an abhorrence of blood, so much so that they will not eat an egg with a spot of blood in it? Has he ever heard of the ful accusation? Has he ever read Prothis subject and does he know the conclusion at which this famous Christian theologian arrives? We say to Ray Knight what Tertullian, one of the Church Fathers, said to those who ac-cused the early Christians of what Ray Knight accuses the Jews: 'If you really believe it, prove it; if you cannot, cease

"Not only German Jews but the Jews throughout the world must now arm themselves against Germany and stand on the watch to prevent Hitlerism from rooting itself in the various countries of the world.

"Hitlerism is an international plague and constitutes international danger for us. Because Hitlerism seeks to poison the atmosphere everywhere against us, we must everywhere stand on the watch.

"To vanquish Hitlerism, it is necessary for us not only to prevent the consummation of its plans, but we must take the offensive. And we have suffi-cient weapons against Germany. Many customers of Germany. The Jews in these East European lands are the largpeasants of Lithuania and Poland, Latvia and Roumania, need no German manufactures and do not buy them. But the middle class elements in these lands buy German manufactures and other products. The day will come when Jews throughout the world will refuse to purchase German products. Germany seeks to undermine our foundations, and we must assume both the defensive and means to declare a boycott against German products. Of the 18,000,000 Jews throughout the world, 15,000,000 are buyers of German products. Should the Jews declare an economic boycott against Germany, Germany will fare much worse than if Roumania or Lithuania were boycotting her products.

"Jews throughout the world purchase more German products than do all the Balkan lands combined. The victory of Hitlerism in Germany must produce a general boycott of German products by Tews.

"This will be the concrete evidence of our changed attitude to Germany. is the only language Germany will un-derstand. The great German industri-alists who aid Hitler financially and thus enable to carry on his campaign of villification against us, will feel the loss of their enterprise resulting from an economic boycott by the Jews of the world. If the choice is presented to them of handing millions to Hitler and receiving millions from us, they will sober up. Then Hitlerism will colsober up.
