Grossman Coming to U.S. In Fall; Revisionist Head- Quarters Remain in London

**Intensive Propaganda Work to Be
Undertaken With Active Participa-
tion of Revisionist Leaders**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA, Sept. 8.—The headquarters of the World Union of Zionist Revisionists will continue to be in London for the next six months, it was decided here today at the first meeting of the new Executive elected by the Revisionist Congress.

The headquarters of the Union will be moved when Vladimir Jabotinsky and Meier Grossman, the heads of the Revisionist Organization, take up their planned settlement in Geneva.

Intensive propaganda for the Revisionist cause will be undertaken with the Revisionist heads personally taking an active part.

Meier Grossman, vice-president of the Revisionist Union, will go to Palestine next month. In November he will proceed to the United States for the purpose of conducting the Revisionist campaign as well as in connection with the elections to the world Jewish congress scheduled to be held in the summer of 1934.

Jabotinsky, Soskin and Stricker will proceed to various European countries after the first of next year.

Film Company Headed by Jews Large Advertiser in Nazi Organ

BERLIN, Sept. 8.—Jewish circles in Germany are incensed at the action of the Paramount Company, whose executives are Jews, which has entered an advertising contract with a Nazi film publication, using two pages in each issue.

The Nazi publication is one which calls for the absolute expulsion of Jews from the German film industry.

The Central Union of German Citizens of the Jewish Faith informed the Jewish Telegraphic Agency that none of the German film companies, not even the UFA owned by Dr. Alfred Hugenberg, head of the Nationalist Party, advertises in this sheet.

The advertising placed by the Paramount Company, whose executives are Adolf Zukor, Jesse Lasky, Sam Katz, Emanuel Cohen and I. Blumenthal have enabled the Nazi publication which formerly appeared fortnightly, to make its appearance weekly.

Nazis Blame Jews for Failure To Come Into Power; Anti- Jewish Agitation Renewed

**Hitler Leads Re-opening of Incite-
ment Against Jews as Hope
for Power Wanes**

BERLIN, Sept. 8.—With the chances of the Nazis to obtain control of the government through a coalition with the Centre Party diminishing and the dissolution of the Reichstag impending, Nazi leaders are seeking to allay the wrath of their followers by blaming the Jews for the political situation which has developed and for the failure of the Nazi aspirations.

The lull in the anti-Semitic agitation of the Nazis, apparent during the period when the Nazi hope of obtaining government control was strong, has now been replaced by a renewed and open incitement led by Adolph Hitler himself.

Opening of School in Warsaw Marked by Clashes After Anti-Jewish Boycott Agitation

**Police Reserves Stationed to Protect
Quarter Where Jewish Book
Shops Are Located**

WARSAW, Sept. 8.—The reopening of the school term was signalized here yesterday by clashes between school pupils and boycott agitators of the anti-Semitic National Democratic party, on Stokrzyska Street, where Jewish book shops are located.

The anti-Semitic boycott agitators distributed leaflets among the pupils calling up on them to buy school supplies from non-Jewish shops only and admonished them: "Remember the Jews murdered Wacławski, who fought for the Polish character of the University!"

The fight followed when many pupils ignored the agitation and proceeded to purchase in the Jewish shops. Police detachments had to be summoned to guard the vicinity.

The Wacławski mentioned in the agitation is Stanislas Wacławski, a Christian student who was killed during the anti-Semitic student fights in Vilna last November.

Herriot Assures Recurrence Of Anti-Jewish Outbreaks in Tunisia Will Be Prevented

**Counsels Jews to Avoid Any Mani-
festation Which May Appear to Be
Directed Against Moslem Religion**

PARIS, Sept. 8.—Premier Edouard Herriot, replying to a memorandum submitted to him recently by the League to Combat Anti-Semitism regarding the recent anti-Semitic outbreaks in Tunisia stated that the authorities may be relied upon to prevent a recurrence of the anti-Jewish incidents.

"You may rely upon the authorities to prevent new outbreaks which were inspired by propagandists who took advantage of the economic difficulties," the French Premier asserted.

At the same time he advises the League "to use also your influence to advise the Jews to avoid every imprudence which is essential in an atmosphere where religious hatred is easily awakened."

"The Jews should avoid every manifestation which may appear to be directed against the Moslem religion."

Premier Herriot stated that the Resident General in Tunis dissuaded a Keren Hayesod delegate, Halpern, from addressing a Zionist meeting in Tunis in order to avoid trouble that seemed certain to ensue.

Hold Ort Federation Conference in Crimea

MOSCOW, Sept. 8.—A conference called by the Ort Federation, for the purpose of taking up industrial and occupational problems in the Jewish colonies in Crimean and Ukrainian districts, is now in progress in Yevpatoria, Crimea.

The conference is being attended by representatives of the colonies, of agricultural state institutions and of the Comzet, governmental department for settling Jews on the land and establishing them in industry.

400 Polish Jews Sail for Palestine; Majority Settlers

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Palestine Advances Unbelievable; Tempo That of U.S. at Its Peak, Says Mrs. Lindheim

**Lauds Histadruth Work as Responsible
for Progress; Will Seek to Es-
tablish Palestine Labor Leagues Here**

The advances in Palestine since the Arab riots of 1929 are unbelievable and the tempo of development may be compared to that of the United States at its peak, according to Mrs. Irma Lindheim, prominent Zionist, and former head of the Hadassah organization of America, who has just returned to the United States from her fifth visit to Palestine in the last seven years.

In an interview with the Jewish Telegraphic Agency representative yesterday, Mrs. Lindheim stated the real Palestine has not yet penetrated to the Diaspora, that it is now essential for America to go to Palestine.

Palestine no longer represents a philanthropic undertaking. It offers both investment opportunities and spiritual opportunities exceeded nowhere else in the world, she said.

Because Palestinians have been living on a deflated scale, this present advance has become possible.

There can be seen in Palestine today, according to Mrs. Lindheim, one of the most significant social developments in modern civilization. Responsible for this is the Histadruth, Palestine Labor Federation, she says.

Mrs. Lindheim, who spent six weeks in Palestine surveying the work of the Histadruth, has returned here so deeply impressed that she will undertake the formation of Leagues for Palestine Labor in the United States.

Mrs. Lindheim will seek to create an undertaking in this country of the work of the Histadruth and to secure financial and moral support for the work of the organization in Palestine.

One of her chief interests, she said,

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Rabbi Israel Goldstein Returns from Summer Abroad

Rabbi Israel Goldstein of Congregation B'nai Jeshurun and President of the Jewish Conciliation Court of America, arrived on the "Europa" after a summer spent in Palestine, Turkey, Russia and Holland. His special interest was to observe the conditions of Jewish life in Palestine and Russia.

In Palestine, Rabbi Goldstein found Jewish life developing strength and permanence. The complexion of the cities, Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, and Haifa, has changed substantially due to large building activity, he stated. New houses, many of them of the modernistic design, have been erected and new residential sections have been developed.

The most important single enterprise which has developed in Palestine during the past several years is the potash works at the Dead Sea which afford employment for Arabs and Jews alike, he said.

While in Palestine, Rabbi Goldstein in behalf of Young Judea, of which he is a former President and now an Honorary Chairman of the Board of Trustees, met with representatives of the Boy Scout organizations and succeeded in getting the scout groups together on a common program which Young Judea in America will help to support.

Regarding Russia, Rabbi Goldstein states that while the religious institutions of Judaism seems to be doomed, the Yiddish culture is being encouraged by the government as part of the government's general policy to encourage and stimulate the cultural autonomy of its constituent populations.

Rabbi Goldstein also attended the Anti-War Congress which was held in Amsterdam, Holland, on August 27th, 28th and 29th, and was attended by delegates from Germany, France, England, Poland and the United States.

Lord and Lady Reading Coming to U.S. in October

LONDON, Sept. 8.—The Marquess of Reading, former British Foreign Secretary, accompanied by Lady Reading will come to New York next month, it was announced here yesterday.

Lord Reading has accepted an invitation to address the American Bar Association on October 14th in Washington.

He will also participate in the ceremonies attendant upon the laying of the foundation stone of the new Supreme Court Building.

The visit is to be of a purely personal nature. The press here emphasizes that Lord Reading has no authority from the government to negotiate regarding any political or economic questions affecting British and American relations.

Dr. Philipson Hailed as Lofty Jewish Personality

CINCINNATI, Sept. 8.—Dr. David Philipson, noted Jewish scholar and reform leader who celebrated his seventieth birthday last month, is hailed as a great Jew and a lofty personality in an editorial which appears in the current issue of the B'nai B'rith magazine.

The editorial says:

"We congratulate Dr. David Philipson, seventy years old in August . . . A great Jew, a lofty personality, a noble citizen.

"He is the nearest living link to the spirit of the saintly Dr. Isaac M. Wise, the prophet of Reform Judaism in America; for he is the last survivor of the first class of the Hebrew Union College of which Dr. Wise was the founder.

"In his venerable self, Reform Judaism takes the mellow character of a traditional religion. He has been the outstanding champion of the purely religious concept of Judaism.

"To him Judaism has been a holy way of life and in all his days, he has taken issue with Jews who have taught that the Jewish way of life is toward a national destiny.

"To him to be a Jew is to be one who is the heir of prophets, the possessor of a body of ideals which, by his works as a citizen, he must offer to the common good of the country in which he lives.

"That his teaching has not fallen on deaf ears has been made evident by the notable position of the Jews in the public life of Cincinnati, where Dr. Philipson has preached for forty-four years. In that city Jews who grew up under this teaching of Judaism stand foremost as the banner-bearers of those ideals by which Cincinnati has gained a great name for civic righteousness. Jews have been the prophets of a new order that not only has lifted up a city but also has served as an inspiration to all cities that lie helpless in the slough of corruption. In these Jews, Dr. Philipson has seen the fulfillment of his teaching.

"In Dr. Philipson's city little of anti-Semitism is seen: the Jew is honored in him. These many years, to non-Jewish eyes, he has been the embodiment of the Jewish people of the city who in popular esteem have been given to share something of his character.

"Happy he is to have been permitted to come to ripe age gracefully, in full vigor, his prophetic voice undiminished, still a tower of strength in American Judaism," the editorial concludes.

Confirm Proffer of Duesterberg Resignation; Stahlhelm Prevails On Him to Remain

Stahlhelm Leaders Refuse to Recognize Jewish Origin as Sufficient Cause for Resignation

BERLIN, Sept. 8.—Inquiries by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency with regard to the denial issued by Major von Stephani, organizer of the Steel Helmet convention here on Monday, that Colonel Theodor Duesterberg has resigned his office as second leader of the Stahlhelm, confirm today that Duesterberg tendered his resignation to the praesidium of the Stahlhelm on Tuesday.

The news that Lieutenant Colonel Duesterberg, who is the defeated candidate for president of the Reich, of the Nationalist Party, had submitted his resignation to the Stahlhelm praesidium, following a Nazi campaign against him because he is of Jewish origin was made known not only by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency but was published in the Ullstein press, including the "Vossische Zeitung," which is known to be friendly to the Steel Helmet Society of war veterans.

Leaders of the Stahlhelm have labelled as absurd that racial descent should be regarded as in any way inimical to Duesterberg's continuation in office and have not hesitated to denounce the Nazi campaign against him on this score as deliberate provocation. For this reason, the praesidium of the Stahlhelm did not accept the proffered resignation of Duesterberg and prevailed upon him to remain in office.

Leaders of the Steel Helmet are not desirous of acknowledging that the Nazi campaign against Duesterberg has had any repercussions in the Steel Helmet camp. This is said to explain the silence which is being maintained on what transpired at the meeting of the praesidium.

Duesterberg himself, at the meeting of the praesidium where he tendered his resignation, acknowledged that he was of Jewish descent, stating however, that he had only then learned of it.

Kareski Denies Interview; Says Fabricated by Nazis

BERLIN, Sept. 8.—Complete denial that in an alleged interview with the Brussels paper "Le Soir," he stated that a united Jewish front has been created to frustrate the Nazis hopes of coming into power as asserted by the "Voelkscher Beobachter," is made today by Dr. Georg Kareski, former head of the Berlin Jewish Community in response to an inquiry from the Jewish Telegraphic Agency.

The entire interview has been fabricated by the Nazis in order to cover up Hitler's political failure, Dr. Kareski stated.

Crisis and Hitlerism Make Propaganda for Palestine in Austria

VIENNA.—The catastrophic situation in Austria, both financial and economic and the swift development of Hitlerism in this Catholic country, have in themselves created stronger propaganda for Palestine. For the first time one finds Zionist sentiment bound up with economic interests and with the search for a quiet oasis in a land where a Jew may reside without fronting anti-Semitic insults and attacks.

The thought of rescuing oneself and one's children through settlement in Palestine has recently penetrated Jewish circles which for a long time have been regarded as fully assimilationist in both a political and cultural sense. Hitlerism has overtaken them in the midst of their preparations to record themselves either as "Confessionless" or "Converts" to Christianity, and aroused them from their empty dream to a realization of the stern reality. Acknowledgment of Zionist progress is guarded but they would willingly escape as quickly as possible to Palestine.

The middle class in particular is keenly interested in settlement possibilities in Palestine. Those who still possess some reserve carefully reckon that this reserve will be eaten up within two or three years if they do not speedily escape from this land where there are no hopes for an economic revival. The general economic catastrophic situation in Austria weekly makes sharper inroads in the Jewish economic position because of the intensive Nazi boycott propaganda against the Jews.

The boycott is practically a fait accompli in the provinces, but it is only now beginning to be strongly felt in Vienna. The Hitlerist party is succeeding in increasing its profitable contracts with Aryan firms who wrest the Christian German customer from Jewish business places.

It is becoming a common occurrence for Jewish salesmen, even if they be representatives of non-Jewish firms, to be thrown out of the houses of non-Jews. These incidents have even been brought to the notices of the law courts. These occurrences give food for thought even to outspoken assimilationists and anti-Zionists.

As a result Palestine is looming large as a political and economic reality. True they are still ashamed to openly acknowledge the bankruptcy of assimilationist hopes and aspirations, but in private conversation they are ready to admit that Zionism and Palestine constitute succor not only for "the poor persecuted East European Jews," but also for the only recently satisfied, secure, fortunate former western Jews.

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Creation of Representative Body Of World Jewry Never More Propitious, Says Dr. Tenenbaum

American Jewish Congress Representative Back from Europe Says Jewry Faces Unprecedented Crisis

The creation of a representative body of democratically organized World Jewry has never come at a more propitious time, declared Dr. Joseph Tenenbaum, chairman of the Executive Committee of the American Jewish Congress in a statement issued yesterday to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency following his return from Europe where he attended the world Jewish conference in Geneva which decided to convene a world Jewish congress in the summer of 1934.

"Not many times in our long history of the diaspora was common action as imperative and vital as it is today," Dr. Tenenbaum said. "The Jewish people as a whole face a crisis unprecedented in depth, extent and severity."

"The ten million Jews in Europe are engaged in a bitter struggle of life and death. Assailed and assaulted by so many enemies, herded in concentration camps of economic discrimination and mass starvation, robbed of some of the most elementary civic rights, European Jewry lives through one of the darkest pages of its history. There is mass starvation in Poland, infringement on personal safety and liberty in Roumania and Hitlerism in Germany. Economic boycott has ruined Jewish commerce and industry. Instead of a national economy, European countries have adopted a ruinous and heinous policy of racial economy with barriers to trade and commerce, built on racial lines of demarcation within the confines of the same state."

Discussing the Jewish situation in Germany, Dr. Tenenbaum asserted: "Hitlerism in Germany pours forth insidious, libelous and denunciatory propaganda in over one hundred newspapers scattered throughout the land of Germany with headlines and anti-Jewish slogans reminiscent of the darkest days of medievalism. Nor is the Hitlerite brand confined to Germany alone. It has assumed proportions of an international anti-Semitic movement."

"The 600,000 Jews in Germany," he asserted, "to quote one instance, when isolated and separated from the stem of World Jewry, can hardly offer adequate resistance to the avalanche of de-

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David Lipschitz, English Jewish Journalist, Dies

LONDON, Sept. 8.—David Lipschitz, a collaborator of the London Jewish Times for nineteen years, died here today at the age of fifty-three.

He was known as a translator and was also collaborator in the writing of a number of novels dealing with Arab and Jewish life in Palestine.

"The Jews and the feudal Herren Club," he asserted, "think they can save Germany."

"The threatened Jews have always found the nobility their protecting lords," Hitler mockingly declared.

"We won't let you keep power, not if you dissolve the Reichstag ten times. These old excellencies won't discourage us," he challenged.

Today's "Voelkischer Beobachter," in a front page article heralded by bold streamer headlines asserts: "World Jewry has ordered the prevention of a Nazi government. Jewish High Finance has created an international front against Hitler."

The Jews, the Nazi organ asserts, who are the Nazis deadliest enemies, are manipulating to prevent a Nazi government.

The paper quotes an interview, supposedly published in the Brussels paper, "Le Soir," with Dr. George Kareski, former head of the Berlin Jewish Community, who attended the world Jewish conference in Geneva, wherein the latter allegedly declared that the Jewish conference created a united Jewish front with the assistance of friendly Christians for the purpose of frustrating the possibility of a Nazi government.

The interview with Dr. Kareski, comments the paper, proves the manipulations of world Jewry to prevent a legal approach to power on the part of Hitler.

The latest developments in Germany, it adds, show how successful such Jewish intervention can become.

The renewed Nazi agitation is causing anxiety in Jewish circles where it is feared lest the Nazis make the Jews the scapegoats for their shattered hopes.

Z.O.A. Votes Sum for Schatz Burial; Public Fund Sought Also

The Zionist Organization of America has voted a sum of money to defray the expenses of the transportation to and burial in Palestine of Professor Boris Schatz, prominent Jewish sculptor and founder of the Bezalel School of Arts and Crafts, whose body has remained in a Denver mortuary since his death in March.

The body was embalmed after his death and the Zionist Organization is awaiting instructions from Professor Schatz's son, Bezael Schatz, who is now in Hollywood, regarding the transport of the body.

Yesterday, according to the statement, a letter was received from young Schatz, in Hollywood, advising of his immediate departure for New York, in order to convey the wishes of the

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on the progress of this sentiment is the acknowledgment from all sides that Palestine has been scarcely touched by the crisis that has encompassed the rest of the world. Since there is no means of livelihood in Austria and no hope for a means of livelihood, they prefer to migrate to Palestine rather than to western lands. For this there are many reasons:

First, immigration to Palestine is not as completely restricted as immigration to other lands. Secondly, the other countries have their own economic troubles and hold out little hope for the Jews; thirdly, in these other lands times as large a capital would be required for business as is necessary in Palestine.

While many factors are conducive to the inspiration of a movement toward Palestine upon the part of middle class Jewry in Palestine, organization and information are lacking to convert this sentiment into a real movement. Bureaus, able and willing to advise such prospective immigrants on economic possibilities to Palestine are necessary but at present unavailable here.

In this group of prospective immigrants are Jews with money; some with ready businesses, others with small financial means, still others, industrial and commercial experts; and with old business connections in the Orient. All these groups need the advice and counsel of a competent, trustworthy organization versed on the practical aspects of Palestine settlement.

The vital necessity today in Austria is an information bureau which is able and willing to offer information and advice.

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is the establishment of a Labor Seminar in Palestine for the purpose of acquainting Americans and others outside of Palestine with the situation in the Holy Land. Indeed, Mrs. Lindheim has gone so far as to purchase land in Palestine where she hopes to establish facilities for the Seminar which, would, as she envisions it, be conducted on a three months rotary basis.

The Histadruth in Palestine has a membership in Palestine of 30,000 and is the leading progressive force in the country, she stated. The Histadruth in addition to the purely labor aspects of its works which has included the development of a co-operative marketing system has helped to bring about the development of the individual while it has strengthened the collective, she points out.

The Histadruth has its own system of schools where in addition to the usual education for children, special courses in vocational training are offered. It has tamed the "wild youth" of Palestine; it is responsible for the change in the child labor legislation; it conducts a bank; maintains two convalescent homes; is organizing the working mothers.

The Histadruth further is conducting adult education work. To the outlying districts it sends visiting lecturers; circulating libraries; travelling seminars.

In this year of the world depression the Histadruth Workers Bank is able to pay dividends for the first time in five years.

The Histadruth too is helping to bring about the unionization of the Arabs and in this manner is promoting good will.

The Palestine High Commissioner, Mrs. Lindheim said, is giving strong and intelligent direction to the country.

Among thinking people, both Arabs and Jews, the conviction is that both the Jews and the Arabs are here to stay and that Palestine must be made the common denominator.

Mrs. Lindheim remarked on the marked impetus given to building in Palestine and emphasized the great opportunities for middle class settlers as well as chaltzim.

She also pointed to the remarkable advances in the fruit development in Palestine which she says now is on a par with that of any tropical country.

She plans a coast to coast tour in the winter in the interests of the Histadruth, and hopes to return to Palestine in the spring.
