## Salonica Jews Fearful Of Quake Disaster; Aid General Relief

### Quakes Have Not Seriously Affected Jewish Population

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

SALONICA, Oct. 4.—Although the Jewish population has not been seriously affected by the earthquakes which caused much damage and loss of life in Salonica and vicinity, it is living through a state of anguish and fear lest disaster overtake them, too.

So great is the fear of assembling in enclosed spaces that a delegate of the Jewish National Fund, Zuchowitzki, who came from Palestine to organize a campaign for the Fund in Greece, was compelled to abandon his plans because he could not assemble any meetings.

The Jews of Greece are taking an active part in rendering aid to the victims. The Jewish press has opened subscription lists; the Jewish Hospital has allotted ten beds to care for victims while the Hakoah, the Hakoah and Jewish scout organizations are participating in the rescue work organized by the Greek Scout Corps.

The president of the Jewish Community, Elie Benusiglio, was invited by the Governor General of Salonica to join the conference for relief work for the victims.

The Chief Rabbi included in his Rosh Hashanah message an appeal for the victims of the disaster. He also discussed at the same time the unemployment situation which has affected in particular Jewish workers, employers and intellectuals.

## Only 12 Jews in Synagogue Attacked by Nazis

VIENNA, Oct. 4.—Only some twelve Jews were present at the concluding Rosh Hashanah services in the improvised synagogue in a cafe in Sperlstrasse which was attacked by Nazis on Sunday night, it was disclosed last night following a police investigation.

The Jews fought back their attackers until the police came on the scene which was after some delay.

Forty-two Nazis were arrested but only three have been held for trial.

The investigation is being continued by the police despite the allegation of the Nazis that theirs was not attack but self defense after shots were fired at them from the cafe.

## Centre Deputies Vote for Nazi Motion Calling for Dismissal of Jewish Broadcasting Employes

### Leader of Centre Party Says He Is Not Anti-Semite; But Opposed to Jewish Influence in Broadcasting

BERLIN, Oct. 4.—For the second time within a week Centre party deputies of the Prussian Diet yesterday voted in committee in favor of a Nazi motion calling for discrimination against Jewish artists.

The motion, which called for the exclusion of Jews from employment by radio stations, was subsequently defeated by a vote in the Culture Committee of the Diet, but not before Dr. Lauscher, leader of the Centre Party, had spoken in favor of the motion.

"I am not an anti-Semite," Dr. Lauscher asserted, "but I declare that Jewish influence prevails in broadcasting. Therefore the Centrum recommends that when new broadcasting officials are appointed, officials who

## Gives £500 to J.N.F. as Challenge to Anti-Semites

JOHANNESBURG, Oct. 4.—Michael Haskel, prominent Zionist benefactor of South Africa has made an additional contribution of £500 to the Jewish National Fund as an answer to the venomous attack conducted by the anti-Semitic press against South African Jewry largely on the score that its contributions to Zionist endeavors mean the exportation of funds.

In a letter to the press, Mr. Haskel states that these attacks have influenced him to make the additional contribution of £500 for the redemption of land in Palestine.

His action has created a deep impression among South African Jewry and is highly lauded by the Zionist Record and other papers.

In his communication, Mr. Haskel points out that the Zionist movement is neither unphilanthropic nor charitable, but established for re-establishing the Jewish National Home as recognized by the League of Nations.

The money contributed by South African Jewry, he says, is the least any self-respecting people can do for the furtherance of a project which aims at the regeneration of our ancient people on their ancient soil.

## Medalie Named for Senate By Republicans; Two Jews Now Running for Seats

### If Elected Would Be First Jew to Represent New York

BUFFALO, Oct. 4.—George Z. Medalie, United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York, appointed to his office by President Hoover in January of 1931, was named Republican candidate for United States Senator at the State Convention here this afternoon.

Mr. Medalie is the only Jewish candidate on the Republican State ticket.

There have been but three Jews who occupied seats in the United States Senate in the history of the country.

As far back as 1853, Judah Philip Benjamin of Louisiana was elected to the Senate, serving until 1861. A period of thirty-six years elapsed before another Jew won a Senatorial seat. In 1897, Joseph Simon of Oregon became the second Jew to sit in the Senate, holding office until 1903.

Four years later Simon Guggenheim became United States Senator from Colorado, a post he occupied until 1913.

Now, after eighteen years, Mr. Medalie may be the first Jew to represent the State of New York in the Senate of the United States. Another Jew, Gilbert Bettman of Ohio, has also been named a candidate for the Senate.

Mr. Medalie, who is a native of New York City, is forty-nine years old and

received his education in the public schools of the city and at Columbia College and Law School.

His appointment as United States Attorney following a long political controversy was hailed by outstanding personalities as one based on merit.

Mr. Medalie has held a number of public offices and achieved a reputation as one of the best prosecuting attorneys in the state.

In 1910 he was appointed Assistant District Attorney, a position he held for five years. From 1926 to 1928 he served as special Assistant Attorney General in the prosecution of election frauds. He received no compensation. He also acted as special Assistant Attorney General in charge of the prosecution of former Secretary of State, Florence E. S. Knapp, for irregularities in connection with the State census. This was in 1928. A year later, he acted as special counsel for the New York City Bar Association and the New York County Lawyers Association in the investigation of Francis X. Mancuso and as counsel for the Bar Association in the ouster proceedings against Magistrate Albert H. Vitale. In 1931, he was counsel for the legislative committee investigating tax and assessment frauds in the city of Albany.

Mr. Medalie is actively interested in a number of Jewish activities. He is vice-president of the New York Zionist Region and a member of the National Executive Committee of the Zionist Organization of America. Mr. Medalie's father, Aaron Medalie, was the secretary of the first Zionist group in New York City.

Mr. Medalie is the president of the Board of Jewish Guardians and an honorary vice-president of the American Jewish Congress. He is also a trustee

## Need for Skilled Social Workers Stressed by Felix M. Warburg

Issues Call for Sympathy, Understanding and Knowledge at Convocation of Jewish Social Work School

"More than ever before, the best of knowledge and of skills are demanded to help solve the varied problems which confront us," declared Felix M. Warburg, noted Jewish leader and philanthropist, in addressing the students of the Graduate School for Jewish Social Work, at the eight annual convention of the school on Monday.

Mr. Warburg, who is Chairman of the Executive Committee of the Graduate School, addressed a large assembly of faculty, alumni, incoming students, and communal leaders.

Emphasizing the importance of giving consideration to all communal needs, Mr. Warburg stated: "In these times of unemployment, when committees are formed, when councils meet and when city administrators and boards of estimate worry,—constructive, sound suggestions are needed; and how few there are among the social workers who will think long enough, deeply enough and practically enough to evolve anything but general statements. Some people will say 'Accelerate public work.' Others will say, 'Build houses so the working classes may have cheaper living quarters.' Others will say 'Expand manufacturing to employ more people', disregarding the question of whether there would be customers when the articles are finished. These problems call for wide-awake, thorough people; not sermonizing with beautiful words, but sympathy, understanding and knowledge."

Commenting further on the present depression, Mr. Warburg said, "How many are the disappointments when young people who are properly prepared are jumped over the heads of those not so prepared, leaving the latter dissatisfied, disgruntled and under the impression that they are the victims of prejudice or injustice. These people need skillful handling. They need also educational and recreational outlets to soften the blows they received and lighten the burdens which life has placed on them."

Mr. Warburg expressed regret that budgetary requirements had forced

## Remains of Prof. Schatz Enroute to Palestine After Public Services

700 Attend Services Under Auspices of Zionist Organization; Body Placed Aboard S. S. Excalibur

The remains of Professor Boris Schatz, noted Jewish sculptor and founder of the Bezalel School of Arts and Crafts in Palestine, are enroute to Palestine today, aboard the steamer Excalibur which sailed yesterday.

The body of the Palestine art pioneer was shipped for interment in Palestine with whose modern development he is closely linked, following public services on Monday afternoon at the Riverside Memorial Chapel, under the auspices of the Zionist Organization of America.

Seven hundred Jews, including representatives of scores of New York and national Jewish organizations, participated in the services.

Rabbi I. H. Levinthal, of the Brooklyn Jewish Center conducted the religious services. Eulogies were delivered by Morris Rothenberg, President of the Zionist Organization of America, who was the principal speaker; Louis Lipsky, National Chairman of the American Palestine Campaign; Abraham Goldberg, speaking for the Histruth Ivrit; Dr. Chaim Greenberg, representing the Poale Zion and David Pinski, Jewish author.

After the services, a police escort accompanied the funeral procession to the Holland Tunnel enroute to Jersey City. The cortege was met by a motorcycle escort of the Jersey City police department which led the way to the steamer pier in Jersey City.

Mr. Rothenberg described the late Professor Schatz as "an extraordinary man, a great Jew, a distinguished artist, and a creative spirit. Boris Schatz was one of the pioneers of the modern Jewish Renaissance, one of the first champions of and spokesmen for political Zionism."

Professor Schatz died in Denver Colorado, in March following an operation. The body was embalmed and held in a vault in Denver pending completion of arrangements for the shipment of his body for interment in Palestine in accordance with his own wishes and that of his family.

## Thuringia Calls for Prohibition of Schechita

BERLIN, Oct. 4.—The Thuringian government yesterday submitted to the Diet for action a project calling for the prohibition of Schechita, the Jewish method of slaughtering animals for food.

Jewish circles fear that the Diet will endorse the project.

## Mufti's Organ Calls Palestine Republic Report Pure Fantasy

**Makes Known Arabs Would Oppose  
Idea; Stresses Palestine Must Be  
Controlled by Arabs**

JERUSALEM, Oct. 4.—The report that London political circles are debating the establishment of Palestine as a republic is termed pure fantasy today by "Al Jamia Arabijah," organ of the Grand Mufti.

At the same time the paper asserts that the Arabs will never agree to Palestine's becoming a republic with a Zionist premier.

The Mufti's mouthpiece doubts whether Britain is ready for the republic idea for Palestine. "The highest Great Britain wants to donate to us is a Legislative Council with limited rights which already both Jews and Arabs have rejected," the paper says.

"If an agreement could not be reached on the creation of a Legislature, how ever could it be reached for the creation of a Parliament?" it asks.

The Arabs will never relinquish their demand for full control of Palestine which is to be part of a Pan-Arabic Federation, the paper emphasizes.

In the same issue, "Al Jamia" demands that permission be refused to Jews desiring to visit Transjordan.

It warns that the appearance of Jews in Transjordan may lead to attacks upon them.

## Denies He Seeks to Implant Hitlerism Here; Scores Jews in Socialist Party

**Carter Mentioned as Hitler's American  
Representative, Calls It Fabrication;  
Says New Party Has Jewish Support**

The allegations that Adolph Hitler, Nationalist Socialist leader of Germany had commissioned him to form an American branch of the Nazi organization were termed sheer fabrication by John Franklin Carter, former newspaperman and State Department employe, in an interview with a representative of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, at the same time that he affirmed that he is organizing a new national party aimed at supplanting the Socialist Party, whose failure he attributes "to the predominance of Jewish, German and other foreign elements."

Mr. Carter, who was associated with the "New York Times" news and book review staff, returned to the United States last week from Europe. To the representative of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, he denied a Berlin despatch declaring that he had been commissioned to implant Hitlerism in America.

Questioned directly whether or not his new national party is to be aimed at the Jews, Mr. Carter replied in the negative stating that the new party "aims at the social and economic reconstruction of the United States and having such a platform certainly draws no racial lines whatever."

He claimed among supporters for his party Bernard Baruch, noted Jewish industrialist, and Messrs. Simon and Schuster, the book publishers.

"Ours is a progressive party," he asserted, "appealing mainly to the small community. It is meant to supplant the Socialist Party whose failure I attribute to both its name and personnel. By personnel I mean the predominance of Jewish, German and other foreign elements."

Mr. Carter's attention was drawn to a passage in his book "Man Is War," published in 1926, from which the inference may be drawn that if he is not the organizer of an attempted restoration of the defunct Ku Klux Klan, at least he is in sympathy with its purposes.

"That intimation," Mr. Carter asserted, "can well be thrown into the waste basket." As an indication of the fact that he is not anti-Semitic, Mr. Carter told that he had refused an invitation for support from a Swastika organization which he had discarded.

The passage in his book referred to declared: "That the problem of the American Jew is little different from that of the Jew elsewhere is demonstrated by a recent speech of the Imperial Wizard, Grans, of the Ku Klux Klan. Recent attempts to interest American Jews in Zionism, as well as the Ku Klux Klan agitation, reveal what extraordinary viewpoints are

## Court of Appeal Scores District Court's Charge Jews Are Anti-Christian

**Verdict on Wulfin Made Public Says  
It Is Not Excluded Christian Student  
Was Accidentally Injured**

VILNA, Oct. 4.—The Vilna Court of Appeal which reduced the sentence of Shmuel Wulfin, Jewish student found guilty of taking part in the events leading to the death of a Christian student killed in the anti-Semitic riots last November, from two years to two months, today published the reasons for its verdict.

The Court of Appeal scores the District Court which sentenced Wulfin to two years' imprisonment for the assertion made when the verdict was handed down that all Jews are enemies of Christians, particularly Poles, because of the sufferings inflicted on them during the course of centuries by the Inquisition and the Christian world as a whole.

This indictment of the Jewish people as a whole aroused considerable indignation among Polish Jewry.

The Court of Appeal makes public its belief now that the District Court was not entitled to this assumption.

It stresses further that it is not unprejudiced that Stanislaw Wacławski, the Christian student killed, was accidentally injured.

An appeal against the two months' sentence imposed by the Appeal Court will be filed with the Highest Court of Instance by counsel for Wulfin as well as by the prosecution.

## Dr. Greenburg Chairman Of Industrial Health Section

WASHINGTON, Oct. 4.—Dr. Leonard Greenburg, Associate Professor of Public Health at Yale University, and formerly of the U. S. Public Health Service, is chairman of the Industrial Health Section of the 21st Annual Congress of the National Safety Council, which opened its sessions yesterday morning at the Wardman Park Hotel.

The National Safety Council, which is sponsoring the Congress, has an active membership of over 5,000 in the United States and 24 foreign countries.

The section of which Dr. Greenburg is chairman, will consider all questions relating to health maintenance in industry. Dr. Greenburg will present a paper on "Engineering Aspects of Health in Industry" representing the results of many years of activity in this field.

Other Jews participating in the deliberations of the Congress include Dr. Morris S. Viteles, Associate Professor of Psychology, University of Pennsylvania, scheduled to address the Congress on traffic safety, and John J. Bloomfield of U. S. Public Health Service, New Haven, Conn., who will read a paper on "Dust in Industry".

serve the Christian-German culture should prevail."

Dr. Lauscher's assertion caused satisfaction in the Nazi camp and consternation in Jewish circles. Jewish circles are particularly perturbed in view of the fact that Centre leaders in a statement issued to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency on September 30th said that another Nazi motion calling for the listing of all Jews employed in State theatres and orchestras, for which the Centre deputies had voted in committee would be opposed by them on the floor of the Diet. At the same time the explanation was given that the Centre deputies had not understood the full import of the motion.

The Nazi motion had also asked for the dismissal of all Jews from the Artists Employment Bureau. The Centre deputies opposed this part of the motion.

At yesterday's session of the Culture Committee where the Nazi motion was defeated, a Socialist, Meier, criticized the new manager of the literary department of the broadcasting station, Arnold Bronner, for denying that his father was a Jew. Bronner's attitude was labelled by the Socialist as being neither German nor Jewish, but only mean.

reductions in these directions. "Yet," he said, "food, clothing and shelter must come first even though, as I have already said, man cannot live by bread alone. We can only hope that the social service which goes with these elementary needs is of a kind to make up in a measure for the reduction of educational and recreational opportunities. Such service cannot be rendered by untrained workers. The best training is none too good under such conditions."

Dr. Max Weinreich, Director of the Jewish Scientific Institute in Vilna, Poland, who is now a visiting lecturer at the Institute on Human Relations at Yale University, reported on conditions of Jewish life in Poland. He stressed the importance of a continuing active interest on the part of American Jewry in the problems of Jewish communities in Eastern Europe. "The struggle to achieve economic stability and independence has become greatly intensified because of present world economic conditions. If ever European Jewry needed the helpful cooperation of Jews in America, this is the time. He emphasized further the need for this interest in order to keep alive the rich cultural and traditional heritage of East European Jewry. He spoke at length on the work of the Scientific Institute over which he presides and

maintained. That is, that the duty of the Jews is to defend their exclusiveness against the Gentiles, but that the duty of the Gentiles is to abolish any exclusiveness against the Jews. Such opinions, if sincerely held, can only produce turmoil. As a matter of fact, they have."

Mr. Cater admitted that while abroad he had "a good introduction to leaders of the National Socialists." He did not see Adolf Hitler, but he mentioned interviews with Captain Herman Goering, Nazi president of the dissolved Reichstag and Ernst von Harnstaengel, Nazi leader in Munich.

The Jewish question was not discussed at all by Captain Goering, according to Mr. Carter.

He asserted that it is his belief on the basis of personal observation "strengthened by the authority of various authentic sources," that the Hitlerites have radically modified their stand toward the Jews.

He stated further that "young German Jews, defying the dictates of their elders and the saner elements of their group, are aligning themselves with the Hitlerites, because they yearn for expression of their idealism, now that the chieftain is moderating his anti-Semitic zeal. And no objections whatever are raised by Hitler himself."

That the Hitlerites have modified their attitude toward the Jews can be corroborated, Mr. Carter said, by Henri de Jouvenal, Jr., of Jewish extraction, who is the editor of "Le Journal" and Edgar Ansel Mowrer, Berlin correspondent of the "Chicago Daily News." The latter is just completing a work on Hitler and the Nazi movement.

Mr. Carter served in the Eastern Division of the State Department. He also served the Institute of Politics of Williamstown, and the "London Daily Chronicle," whose Rome correspondent he was.
