19 Jewish Students Injured As New Nazi Attacks Occur at Vienna Colleges

University Closed Again: Jewish Organizations Plan Action Against Terrorization

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA, Oct. 26-Nineteen Jewish students were injured today when renewed Nazi disturbances broke out at the University of Vienna, the Ana-tomical Institute and the Physiological College.

Twelve of the Jewish students injured were matriculated at the University, five at the Anatomical Institute and two at the Physiological College. The windows of the latter building were also broken by the Nazis.

For the second time within a week the Nazi anti-Iewish excesses have brought about the closing of the University.

Last week serious excesses at the University in which 25 Tewish students were injured caused the institution's closing. The University resumed classes on Monday only after the Nazis had pledged themselves to maintain order and not to prevent the enrollment of Tewish students.

One Nazi was also injured when the Jewish students offered resistance to the attack. The Nazi students used iron bars, whips and sticks as weapons. Members of the faculty and the rector tried unsuccessfully to halt the Nazi
