19 Jewish Students Injured As New Nazi Attacks Occur at Vienna Colleges

University Closed Again; Jewish Organizations Plan Action Against Terrorization

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA, Oct. 26—Nineteen Jewish students were injured today when renewed Nazi disturbances broke out at the University of Vienna, the Anatomical Institute and the Physiological College.

Twelve of the Jewish students injured were matriculated at the University, five at the Anatomical Institute and two at the Physiological College. The windows of the latter building were also broken by the Nazis.

For the second time within a week the Nazi anti-Jewish excesses have brought about the closing of the University.

Last week serious excesses at the University in which 25 Jewish students were injured caused the institution's closing. The University resumed classes on Monday only after the Nazis had pledged themselves to maintain order and not to prevent the enrollment of Jewish students.

One Nazi was also injured when the Jewish students offered resistance to the attack. The Nazi students used iron bars, whips and sticks as weapons. Members of the faculty and the rector tried unsuccessfully to halt the Nazi terrorization.

Jewish Students Are Attacked by Colleagues

WARSAW, Oct. 26—Jewish students were attacked last night by National Democratic students at a meeting called in connection with elections on the Student Committee of the Faculty of Law.

Several Jews were beaten up by the anti-Semites. When this provoked the Jews to select their own candidate for president of the committee, they were greeted with cries: "Down with the circumcized!" and renewed attacks.

The National Democrats, with the aid of government students, elected a majority on the committee.

Further disturbances were prevented by the appearance of the police.

Polish Chassid Succumbs To Fast Undertaken as Ultimatum to God

Found Dead on the Threshold of Synagogue He Attended; Wandered from Hospital

LEMBERG, Oct. 26—Samuel Bloch, the Chassid who entered on a hunger fast, on Yom Kippur, sixteen days ago, as an ultimatum to God to send a Messiah, was found dead yesterday on the threshold of the synagogue which he attended in the village of Zloczow, near Lemberg, where he lived.

How he made his way to the synagogue no one knows. On Monday night he was removed to a hospital in a neighboring village in a semi-conscious state. Suddenly he disappeared and his whereabouts were not discovered until his body was found yesterday on the synagogue steps.

Physicians had predicted that Bloch would succumb to his fast, but neither their warning nor the entreaties of his relatives and friends could prevail upon Bloch to desist. He was fifty-four years old and deemed his death unimportant if it should prove a sacrifice leading to the redemption of the Jewish people.

General Strike Throughout Palestine on Balfour Day Declared by Arab Executive

Arab Delegations to Demand Stoppage of Immigration and of Land Sales

JERUSALEM, Oct. 26—A general strike throughout Palestine on November 2nd, the anniversary of the issuance of the Balfour Declaration establishing the historic connection of the Jewish people with Palestine, will be held by the Arabs, it was decided by the Arab Executive today.

Delegations from the cities and the villages will appear that day before government authorities demanding the stoppage of immigration of Jews to Palestine as well as the issuance of a law halting the sale of land.

The Arab press will appear that day bordered in black.

Expect Reinstatement of Dr. Badt, Ministerial Director and Member of Federal Council

Action to Follow Rulings of Reichsgericht on Prussian Government's Ouster; Resume Nazi-Centre Negotiations

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Oct. 26—The re-instatement of Dr. Herman Badt, Ministerial Director of the Prussian government, is expected to be one of the results of the verdict of the Leipzig Reichsgericht yesterday, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency was informed today.

The Reichsgericht ruled that the decree issued by President von Hindenburg appointing a Federal Commissioner and deputy commissioners is valid. At the same time it uttered its opinion that the suspension of the Prussian government could be valid for a temporary period only and that even during this temporary suspension the Ministers could be barred from administrative acts only, leaving intact their rights to represent Prussia in the Federal Council, the Diet, etc.

Dr. Badt has been a member of the Federal Council for the past twelve years. An authority on the constitution, he also represented the Braun-Seyring government before the Leipzig court in the matter of the ouster of the Prussian government.

The president of the Tribunal, Bumke, ruled that the dismissal of Dr. Badt was contrary to the constitution.

During the hearings on the unconstitutionality of the ouster of the Prussian government, Dr. Badt read an (Continued on Page 4)

Zerubbabel Meeting Broken Up by Left Wing

HAVANA, Oct. 26—Left wing Jewish elements yesterday broke up a lecture meeting addressed by Zerubbabel, prominent Zionist leader of Poland, at the Jewish Center.

Police had to be summoned to restore order. The lecture was called off and the auditorium cleared of the 900 persons present.

An account of what transpired was handed over to the Military Commandant. It is now feared that further lectures by Zerubbabel will be barred.

The left wing elements demanded to know why the Zwisho, central Jewish school organization of Poland, is dis-

A protest against the disturbances was submitted to the Chancellor by the Jewish Community of Vienna. Jewish organizations are considering measures to be taken against the terrorization and to enable the enrollment of Jewish students for the term.

Today's excesses were the continuation of attacks which began yesterday and in which several American students sustained injury.

A throng of 250 Nazis assembled yesterday while a Jewish student delegation visited the rector to submit their complaints against recent occurrences. The delegation was able to leave the University campus unmolested after the police, on the intervention of Robert Stricker, Revisionist leader, compelled the Nazi throng to disperse.

Considerable astonishment has been caused by the attitude of the rector, Dr. Abel, who departed from the University, leaving the delegation behind him, although they were exposed to grave danger. Dr. Abel is known to be sympathetic to the Nazis.

Walter Lippman Chancellor Of Union College

SCHENECTADY, Oct. 26—Walter Lippman, prominent publicist, has been named Chancellor of Union College, it was announced here last night.

Mr. Lippman is forty-three years old, and is the youngest man to be named to this post at Union College as well as the first newspaper man to receive the appointment.

Lloyd George Makes Pointed Reference to Jewishness of Samuel in Parliamentary Debate

Exchange of Biblical References Between Liberal Leaders Marks Debate

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON, Oct. 26—Pointed reference to the fact that Sir Herbert Samuel, former Home Secretary of the British government, and leader of the Liberal Party, is a Jew, was made last night by David Lloyd George in an address delivered during the Parliamentary debate.

Lloyd George, who has broken with his former Liberal colleague on the tariff question, declared: "The great race, of which Sir Herbert Samuel is a distinguished member, used to be divided into Sadducees and Pharisees, the former taking a broad, tolerant view of their faith and doctrine, not believing in the resurrection. The Pharisees, however," said Lloyd George pointing to Samuel, "were narrow and self righteous straining at gnats like your constitutional points after they had swallowed a camel, and professing belief in the resurrection."

Sir Herbert interrupted Lloyd George and declared: "There were also Esenes who retired into the wilderness." The remark referred to Lloyd George's recent isolation from the Liberal Party.

New Names Added to Advisory Board of Jewish Current Events

Further acceptances of membership on its Advisory Committee have been received by "Jewish Current Events," Jewish youth weekly, which will make its first appearance, published by the Jewish Daily Bulletin, on Friday.

Rabbi William F. Rosenblum of Temple Israel, New York, who is chairman of the Teachers Conference of the Greater New York Committee of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations, has joined the Committee.

The National Council of Jewish Women has designated Mrs. Abraham H. Arons of New York and Mrs. Eugene Springer of Philadelphia, its representatives on the Committee which is comprised of leading educators and representatives of outstanding organizations.

Biennial Convention of Pioneer Women's Organization

TORONTO, Oct. 26—Representatives of seventy clubs in the United States and Canada affiliated with the Pioneer Women's Organization will convene here tomorrow for their biennial convention which is to continue until October 30th.

The conference will be addressed by I. Mereminski and Golda Meyerson, representatives of the Palestine Labor Federation and Dr. Jehuda Kaufman.

Reich Radio Commissioner Instructs Provincial Stations To Bar Jewish Announcer

Alfred Kerr, Dismissed from Berlin Station Because He Is a Jew, Now Barred Throughout Provinces

BERLIN, Oct. 26—The Reich Commissioner for Broadcasts, Scholtz, has issued instructions to radio stations in the provinces not to permit Alfred Kerr, prominent Jewish radio announcer, who was recently dismissed from the Berlin radio station, to deliver addresses.

This disclosure is made by Kerr in an article which appeared in the "Berliner Tageblatt" yesterday. The provincial stations, Herr Kerr says, have acted upon the instructions received and have withdrawn their invitations to him for broadcasts.

Kerr asserts that this boycott of a writer, because he is a Jew, is unconstitutional.

Only Reform Congregation in Montreal to Mark Anniversary

MONTREAL, Oct. 26—Temple Emanu-El, the only reform congregation in the city of Montreal, will next month observe its fiftieth anniversary. The congregation was founded in the fall of 1882 and is acknowledged as the mother of liberal Judaism in the Dominion of Canada.

Other liberal congregations are now located in Toronto and Hamilton, Ont.

The opening celebration of the Jubilee will take place on Friday evening, November 25th, which will be in the form of a special religious service in the Temple. A prominent American Jewish divine will be the preacher. Other celebrations will follow in the next two days.

The honorary chairmen of the Jubilee are Maxwell Goldstein, K. C., Mark Workman and Abraham Sommer.

Real Rabbinate in This Country Not Overcrowded, Says Dr. Cyrus Adler

Addresses Opening Assembly of Seminary; Says Some of Rabbinical Schools Could Have Been Spared

The real rabbinate in this country is not overcrowded, Dr. Cyrus Adler, president of the Jewish Theological Seminary of America, stated yesterday in an address delivered at the opening assembly of the institution.

Dr. Adler expressed agreement with the viewpoint that there are "more rabbinical schools in the United States than are justified adequately to express the different trends of thought into which our community is divided."

Some of these could have been spared, Dr. Adler stated. At the same time he pointed out that "if our Jewish community would reconsider itself I think it would come to the conclusion that the stock market is not the only organization which might with advantage propose the squeezing out of excess water."

Discussing the rabbinate and the statements made recently that it is overcrowded, Dr. Adler said: "But the rabbinate itself is not overcrowded. I mean the real rabbinate. Owing to our lack of any form of religious government or authority, a group has developed whom I believe you know in common parlance as the free lance without regular training from any school, often devoid of knowledge and possessed only of glibness of tongue. They are selected by a congregation and by virtue of election become rabbis. If there were any authority which could deal with this sort of irregularity as similar irregularities can be dealt with in the medical and legal professions, there would be ample room for many more good men. The quack is always a detriment."

Dr. Adler's address yesterday was the first public speech he has made since his return recently from a trip abroad.

Other addresses at the exercises were delivered by Sol M. Stroock, chairman of the Board of Directors of the Seminary and Arthur Oppenheimer.

A special exhibition is being held this week in the Museum of Jewish Ceremonial Objects.

Nazis Provoke Strike; Compelled to Call It Off

Now, If Ever, Jews Throughout World Must Unite, Says Emil Ludwig

GENEVA—Emil Ludwig publishes an article in a new Jewish monthly, "La Revue Juive de Geneve," the first issue of which has just appeared here, under the editorship of the French Jewish writer, M. Joshua Jehouda.

The monthly, according to the editorial introduction, will be an organ for seeking out and synthesizing the modern manifestations of Jewish thought, and at the same time fighting against the moral ostracism to which Jews are subjected everywhere, and of which anti-Semitism is only a coarse and brutal manifestation.

Being both Jewish and universal, it proceeds, the monthly will be intended also for non-Jews, and being issued in Geneva, it will help to enlighten those men and women who are associated with international movements and efforts about Jewish problems. The publication will give space to all currents of Jewish thought and will stand outside all Parties.

M. Andre Spire and Stefan Zweig are among the contributors to the first issue, and messages are printed from the Chief Rabbi of France, M. Israel Levi, M. Justin Godart and M. de Monzie, members of the French Government, M. Edmond Fleg and M. Aime Palliere.

"Not only the politician but also the thinker must come forward and warn the people," Emil Ludwig writes in his article. "A new Jewish periodical could not appear at a better time. All around us there is danger, and, if ever, the Jews of the world must unite now."

"I say this with the greater earnestness," he goes on, "because I am new to this movement. Till the age of 40 I hardly knew that I was a Jew. Neither my education nor my training had made me aware that I was one. The murder of Rathenau was the first sign. It was several days after that happened that I left the Christian Church to which I formally belonged and made it public that I recognized myself as a member of a race that was being persecuted more than at any time previously. Little as I have to do with dogmas, much as my heart and spirit are dissociated from both Testaments, I have however, definitely declared myself before the whole world as belonging to the Jewish race."

"That which ten years ago, when Rathenau was murdered, was a warning has today become fulfillment. All the cultural contributions which the Jews have given to German music, literature, theatre, painting, are despised by the mob, which knows neither this nor Germanic art, and this is happening in Germany! The German nation is degrading itself in the eyes of

Brown Denies Interview to Polish Telegraphic Agency; Pat Asserts Authentic

Gives Lie to Denial; J.T.A. Asked for No Interview; Polish Federation Remarks on Brown's Publicity Shyness

David A. Brown, whose statements made to the Polish Telegraphic Agency that the Jews of Poland suffer no specific misery have elicited wide-spread criticism from the Jewish press, has cabled the "American Hebrew," of which he is the publisher, denying that he has given interviews to the Polish Telegraphic Agency.

Mr. Brown's cable declared: "I deliberately refused to give interviews to the Polish Telegraphic Agency or to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency. I have no confidence in the reliability of their news. My only public statements on conditions in Poland and other countries are contained in my articles appearing in the American Hebrew and Jewish Tribune."

WARSAW, Oct. 26—The Polish Telegraphic Agency today officially confirmed that David A. Brown granted the interview which was published in the press of Poland which it serves.

The interview alluded to is the one which Mr. Brown denies having granted in a cablegram sent from Peiping to his paper in New York, the American Hebrew.

WARSAW, Oct. 26—The Warsaw office of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency today emphatically denied that any member of its staff had approached David A. Brown for an interview during his stay in Warsaw.

Mr. Brown's allegation that he had refused to grant any interviews to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency representatives is termed a blatant untruth.

Advises Brown to Protest to Pat

The Federation of Polish Jews of America which had received from the "American Hebrew" the text of Mr. Brown's cable, yesterday communicated its reply in which it questions Mr. Brown's denial of the interview and remarks on Mr. Brown's sudden publicity shyness.

The communication, signed by Z. Tygel, Executive Director of the Federation, advises Mr. Brown to protest to the Polish Telegraphic Agency if he was really misquoted.

"I have your letter of October 24th," says the communication, "in which you communicate to us the cablegram you received from Mr. David A. Brown. . . . You add that our organization investigated the attack without troubling to inquire into the authenticity of the report upon which our protest is based."

"Permit me to point out that it can not be our concern whether Mr. Brown was rightly or wrongly quoted, or

whether he altogether gave the interview to the Polish Telegraphic Agency. The fact that the Polish Telegraphic Agency issued a statement and gave it wide publicity in the press of Poland—a statement which unquestionably was harmful—this fact is indisputable. It seems to us that our organization only fulfilled its duty when it protested against the ludicrously misleading contents of the report of the Polish Telegraphic Agency, and if Mr. Brown is anxious to remedy whatever harm has been done to Polish Jewry, he should address his protest to the Polish Telegraphic Agency and it is his duty to have the Polish Telegraphic Agency withdraw the statement they issued in his name or carry a denial that he ever gave it to them. We would appreciate it if you would supply us with a copy of the cablegram Mr. Brown will forward to the Polish Telegraphic Agency. Should the Polish Telegraphic Agency refuse to give publicity to that statement, then in that case I wish to say, in behalf of my organization, that we will bend every effort to obtain publicity in the Polish press for Mr. Brown's denial.

"Let me also point out that in this statement any reference to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency by Mr. Brown should be avoided. . . . As a matter of fact, even the reference contained in the cablegram of Mr. Brown to your paper is unintelligible. The Jewish Telegraphic Agency merely reproduced the statement of our organization with regard to the report of the Polish Telegraphic Agency and what blame can be attached to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency for so doing is beyond our comprehension.

"It seems to us that Mr. Brown, who has acquired an enviable world-wide reputation for his shyness and abhorrence of publicity, takes the easiest way out of an embarrassing situation. It is quite customary to blame an unfortunate statement on the reporter, but Mr. Brown goes a step further and denies altogether the report of the Polish Telegraphic Agency. . . . According to Mr. Brown's statement the editor of the Polish Telegraphic Agency invented the entire story. In justice to the Polish Telegraphic Agency, I wish to state that in our years of experience with that agency, they have scrupulously and faithfully reproduced whatever statements we gave them. . . ."

"No graver charge has been levelled against any Jew in our time than that brought by the Jews of Poland against Mr. David A. Brown," says the editorial. "It is a charge of treason and it rises out of statements issued while on a tour by Mr. Brown to the Polish Telegraphic Agency which can be and have already been used to bring aid and comfort to the enemies of Polish Jewry. . . ."

the whole world.

"I have studied many of the great men of the past and the present," Emil Ludwig goes on. "I have never found an anti-Semite among them. What Bismarck said in 1892 is known to everybody. In addition, for five years he had a Jew as his doctor, and for thirty years a Jew as his banker, so that he entrusted both his health and his fortune to Jews.

"In Goethe there are four passages in which he compares the Jews with the Germans. I have quoted them in an anthology. From Mussolini, Masaryk, Briand, Nansen, Edison, I have never heard anything but respect for the gifts and the character of the Jews. It is only in Germany that this pest dominates. If anyone compares the great number of cultural treasures which a million Jewish Germans have procured with those produced by the 61 million Aryan Germans, it will be seen that the Germans must put a spurt on to attain equality. We can fight this disease only if we rigidly exclude those from us who proclaim that they want to exclude themselves from us."
