25 Jewish Students Injured In Anti-Semitic Attacks In Warsaw University

Several Jewish Students Sustain Serious Injuries; Riots Started in Connection With Anniversary of Wacławski Death

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WARSAW, Nov. 10 — Twenty-five Jewish students were wounded, a number seriously, in riots which broke out last night at the University of Warsaw, led by anti-Semitic students.

The riots were launched in the lecture halls themselves when anti-Semitic students suddenly ordered the students to rise and observe the first anniversary of the death of Stanisław Wacławski, a Christian student killed in Vilna during the events connected with the anti-Semitic excesses in that city.

Shouting: "Revenge yourselves on the Jews. They are responsible for Wacławski's death," the anti-Semites fell upon the Jewish students and brutally beat them up. Even the feminine members of the Jewish student body were not spared. A number of them were thrown out of the buildings and trampled under foot on the steps of the University.

Among the Jewish students more seriously injured are Simon Budzyner, son of a Senator from Lodz, member of the Agudath Israel, which is friendly to the government; Jakob Braude, likewise a son of a former Senator from Lodz, who is a member of the Zionist party, Irene Burzycka.

Attempts to protect the Jews were made by the Socialist and pro-government.

America Has Turned Judas Nazi Papers Assert

VIENNA, Nov. 10—The results of the American elections are attacked by the Nazi press here which declare that "America has turned Judas."

President-elect Franklin D. Roosevelt is assailed as president of the Freemasons and a member of the Dutch lodge. Mr. Roosevelt, the papers assert, is far more Jewish than President Hoover.

"Let France, Judas and the Masons rejoice over his victory and the election of a Jewish governor for New York and the candidacy of a Jewish financier, Bernard Baruch, for the treasuryship," the Nazi organs assert.

Teachers Besiege Agency Offices; Hold Werner Senator "Prisoner"; Pickets Stationed

All Night Vigil Held and Resumed in Morning as Teachers Attempt to Get Payment of Salary Arrears

JERUSALEM, Nov. 10—One hundred teachers invaded the offices of the Jewish Agency Executive yesterday morning, occupied them, stationed guards at the exits and announced that they would permit no member of the Executive to leave the building until arrears in salary from May to August are paid.

Owing to the crisis in the Executive membership, the leaders of the Executive were absent in Tel Aviv to attend meetings, the only one remaining being Werner Senator, the resigned treasurer.

The teachers, including representatives from all parts of the country, "arrested" Senator in his office, refusing to permit him to leave, even for lunch.

Food was brought in to him from a neighboring restaurant. He was kept

Nazis Attack Jewish Professor, Students at Breslau University; Police Called Twice by Rector

Fall Upon Jewish Professor Despite Police Escort; University Authorities Pledge Protection

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BRESLAU, Nov. 10—Anti-Jewish incidents occurred today at the University of Breslau in connection with the introductory lecture delivered by a newly appointed professor, Ernst Cohn, who is a Jew.

Professor Cohn and Jewish students were attacked and beaten by the Nazis after the police had twice been summoned by the rector to maintain order.

At the opening of Professor Cohn's lecture, the Nazis raised such an uproar that Rector Brockelmann summoned the police who expelled the demonstrators.

When the lecture was resumed, the Nazis took seats on the front benches and began to heap abuse upon Cohn, singing anti-Jewish songs.

For a second time the police were summoned. This time they accompanied Professor Cohn from the University. Undaunted, the Nazis attacked

Nazis Make Overtures to Jews; Promise Protection in Return For Withdrawal of Opposition

Jewish Community Refuses to Reply; Forbids Mediator to Continue Negotiations

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Nov. 10—Overtures by the Nazis to establish contact with the Jews have been made, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency learned yesterday.

A prominent Berlin Jew informed leaders of the Jewish Community that "Gregor Strasser asked me to explain to Jewish leaders that the Nazi leaders will guarantee the security of the Jewish population provided the Jews fully abandon their negative attitude toward the Nazis and that the Mosse press and the Ullstein press discontinue their policy of running down the Nazis. Strasser hopes this will facilitate the Nazi movement's efforts to secure power and gain confidence abroad."

The leaders of the Jewish Community have refused to reply to the advances of the Nazi chieftain, and have forbidden the mediator to continue his negotiations with the Nazis.

Strasser, one of the leaders of the National Socialist Party, has in the past been known for the virulence of his anti-Semitic utterances.

Funeral Services Sunday for Feigenbaum, Socialist Leader

Funeral services for Benjamin Feigenbaum, noted Jewish Socialist writer and leader will be held on Sunday at noon in Forward Hall.

Mr. Feigenbaum died on Thursday morning in the Home for Incurables. He had been ill for the last ten years, the last three of which he was paralyzed.

Up until he was completely incapacitated Mr. Feigenbaum continued to take an interest in Socialist doings with particular reference to the Jewish aspects.

Mr. Feigenbaum who came to this country in 1891, was one of the founders of the Workmen's Circle and the Jewish Daily Forward, remaining as a contributor to the paper for many years. He was the first secretary of the Workmen's Circle to whose development he contributed much. He was also one of the leaders and organizers of the union movement in this country.

Mr. Feigenbaum was born on August

Jewish Center in Havana In Danger of Closing

HAVANA, Nov. 10.—The Jewish Center here is in danger of closing down in view of the resignation of Ben Dizik, its president and the refusal of any other director of the organization to take over the office of president.

The resignation of Mr. Dizik was followed by the resignations of the secretary and that of the directorate.

The Center is in financial difficulties. It has a deficit of \$3,000 while its employees have not received salaries for three months. The employees are now demanding pay, threatening to leave if this request is not granted.

An emergency committee has been formed to deal with the situation. Doubt is expressed however that this committee will be able to meet the crisis.

Zionist Executive Lodges Action Against Revisionist Union on Political Acts

Takes Issue With Visit to Foreign Office of Soskin; Says Infringement of Resolution

LONDON, Nov. 10.—The Zionist Executive announced today that it has lodged an action with the Zionist "judicial authorities" against the infringement of the Revisionists of the resolution of the Actions Committee, respecting the prerogatives of the Zionist Executive in external political affairs.

By the terms of the resolution under which the Revisionist Union was admitted to the Zionist Organization as a separate Union, the Revisionists are prohibited from conducting separatist political activity.

The Zionist Executive in its statement takes exception to the visit paid last week to the Polish Foreign Office in Warsaw, by S. Soskin, Revisionist Secretary, in the course of his visit to Warsaw. The visit to the Foreign Office was in the interests of the Revisionist campaign.

The Revisionist Union has been informed by the Zionist Executive that it will consider any Revisionist negotiations with governments or the League of Nations, without its consent a violation of the resolutions adopted at the Actions Committee sessions in London last July.

Mizrachi Convention in Buffalo, Thanksgiving Day

A national convention of the Mizrachi, Orthodox Zionist Organization of America, will open on November 24, Thanksgiving Day, at the Hotel Statler, Buffalo, N. Y., continuing for four days, it was announced yesterday by Rabbi Wolf Gold, President of the organization.

In the call to the convention, issued by Rabbi Gold, emphasis was laid on the growing immigration to Palestine of the so-called middle-class elements from the United States and other countries, as a result of the economic depression.

Approximately 400 delegates, representing all sections of the country and including the most prominent members of the American Orthodox Rabbinate and the most active congregational leaders, will participate in the sessions. Announcement was also made of the expected arrival here of Rabbi Meyer Berlin, President of the International Mizrachi Organization, and Rabbi J. L. Fishman, well known Hebrew writer and Chairman of the Mizrachi Executive Committee.

Says Vatican Opposition Barred Selection of Polish Jew as League Vice-Secretary General

Head of Health Department of League Proposed by Polish Government But Catholic Organs Opposed Him

WARSAW, Nov. 10.—The opposition of the Vatican frustrated the candidacy for Vice Secretary General of the League of Nations of Ludwik Rajchman, a Polish Jew, according to the "Gazeta Warszawska," organ of the anti-Semitic National Democratic Party.

The paper asserts that the name of Rajchman, who is the head of the Health Department of the League of Nations, was recently proposed by the Polish government.

The highest Catholic authorities however intervened and vigorously campaigned against the appointment. Rajchman was attacked, it says, by the "Osservatore Romano," organ of the Vatican and Catholic organs in other countries.

The fact that Rajchman, with the consent of the League, is also serving as a Chinese Functionaire aroused the opposition of the Japanese as well. Thus Rajchman's selection was rendered impossible, it states.

The paper couples these statements with attacks upon the Polish government for presenting a Jew for office.

Minneapolis Welfare Executive Resigns

MINNEAPOLIS, Nov. 10.—After six years here as executive secretary of the Jewish Family Welfare Association, Miss Anne Skolsky has resigned.

Accepted by the board, it will take effect January 1, according to an announcement of Arthur Brin, board chairman.

Tribute to her achievements in development of the organization and in making it of inestimable value to the Jewish Community and the city at large was paid by Mr. Brin and Rabbi Albert G. Mind, head of the Minneapolis Federation for Jewish Services, of which Miss Skolsky was also secretary.

Dr. Ariel Benzon Dies In Paris at Age of 45

PARIS, Nov. 10.—Dr. Ariel Benzon, representative of the Palestine Foundation Fund of the Sephardic countries, died here yesterday at the age of forty-five.

Dr. Benzon was elected a member of the Spanish Academy of History in Madrid this year following the publication of a book on the Zohar.

Dr. Benzon, who was born in Jerusalem, came of a distinguished Sephardic family. His wife is the former Ida Seigler of Montreal.

Agency Executive Compromise Reached; Arlosoroff, Neumann, Farbstein, to Supervise Treasury

Agree to Return to Office; Agreement Reached After All Night Session

JERUSALEM, Nov. 10.—A joint meeting of the Laborites, the General Zionists and the Mizrahi group held here last night decided to place supervision of the treasury of the Jewish Agency Executive into the hands of a collegium of three consisting of Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff, Emanuel Neumann and Heschel Farbstein.

This decision marks the end to the crisis which developed when Mr. Neumann and Mr. Farbstein resigned as members of the Executive due to differences on the budget and other matters. Mr. Farbstein, the representative from Poland, is to be chairman of the collegium.

The compromise was agreed upon following an all night session.

One of its stipulations is further that Werner Senator, who resigned as treasurer of the Jewish Agency Executive because not sufficient cuts were made in the budget, and is now the head of the immigration department, consult Mr. Farbstein on all matters regarding middle class immigration.

Mr. Neumann and Mr. Farbstein have agreed to the compromise and are ready to return to office.

Funeral Services Held for Max Fertig

MT. VERNON, Nov. 10.—Funeral services were held here yesterday at Emanu-El Synagogue for Max Fertig, actively identified with Jewish philanthropic and religious circles in New York City.

Mr. Fertig succumbed at the age of fifty-seven to an accidental overdose of medicine.

He founded Congregation Emanu-El of this city serving as its first president. Rabbi Elias Margolis of the congregation officiated at the services. Interment took place in Union Field Cemetery.

Mr. Fertig was a member of the boards of the Vaad Hakashruth and Y.M.-Y.W.H.A.'s in this city as well as a member of Congregation Shaare Zedek of New York.

He was affiliated with the Zionist Organization and made numerous gifts to Palestine undertakings and philanthropic endeavors in New York.

Walter Lippman, political writer and publicist, was elected a member of the American Academy of Arts and Letters at the annual dinner of the organization.

Funeral services were held for Benjamin May, uncle of Supreme Court Justice Mitchell May, who died at the Brooklyn Jewish Hospital on Tuesday of heart disease.

Brother to Administer Oath to Governor-Elect Lehman on December 31st

13 Jewish Congressmen Elected to House of Representatives, Completer Returns Show

The oath of office will be administered to Governor-elect Herbert H. Lehman as the first Jewish governor of the State of New York on the night of December 31st by his brother, Judge Irving Lehman of the Court of Appeals.

The oath of office will be administered in the Executive Mansion.

Judge Lehman administered the oath of office to his brother as Lieutenant Governor at both elections.

Colonel Lehman, pleased with his victory and amazed at the size of his plurality, is planning a week's vacation. With 35 districts still to be heard from, Governor-elect Lehman rolled up a plurality of 841,284, the largest on record for office in New York.

Completer returns indicate that more Jews have been elected to office.

The list of Jewish Congressmen in the House of Representatives is thirteen. The state of Illinois is to have two Congressmen, A. J. Sabath, who was re-elected to office, and Julius Klein, elected for his first time as Congressman at large.

Mr. Klein is the editor and publisher of a German language daily in Chicago, "Staats-Herald."

The name of Bernard Baruch is being prominently mentioned for the post of treasurer in the cabinet of President-elect Roosevelt.

Premier Orders Probe of Discrimination Against Jews By Fire Insurance Companies

Investigation Ordered Upon Complaint of Jewish Deputy, Who Showed Many Policies of Jews Cancelled

TORONTO, Nov. 10.—Premier Henry of Ontario has ordered Attorney General Price to investigate the charge of discrimination against the Jews in the matter of fire insurance.

The Premier's order is the result of a complaint registered by E. F. Singer, Jewish member of the Ontario Legislature. Deputy Singer stated that several insurance companies in Toronto have cancelled policies because their holders are Jews.

The Ontario Legislature at its last session enacted a law against discrimination on grounds of race. Penalty for infringement upon this law is cancellation of insurance license if proof can be adduced against the fire insurance companies discriminating against Jews.

It is rumored that the insurance companies have violated the law in order to test its validity in court. Long lists of cancelled policies of Jews have been submitted to the Premier.

The investigation is to be inaugurated next week.

Elliot Insults Raised In House of Commons

LONDON, Nov. 10.—The insulting remarks against the Jews made by L. Elliot, State Attorney in Palestine, which have since been withdrawn, were raised in the House of Commons yesterday by Colonel Josiah Wedgwood.

Colonel Wedgwood asked Sir Philip Cunliffe-Lister, Secretary of State for the Colonies, whether he had received any communication from the High Commissioner on this matter which has agitated the Jewish population.

The Colonial Minister at first denied any knowledge of the matter, presumably because Wedgwood referred to Elliot as Solicitor General of Palestine. Finally, however, Cunliffe-Lister said that the Junior Counsel in Palestine had made ill timed and ill judged remarks for which he had been properly reproved by the court.

A further investigation into the matter, if supplied with additional information, was promised by the Colonial Minister upon the request of the Jewish representative, Barnett Janner.

Heinrich Wolf Appointed German Consul General

BERLIN, Nov. 10.—Heinrich Wolf, for many years an official in the Foreign Office, was appointed German Consul General in Jerusalem yesterday.

Mr. Wolf has more recently been in charge of the Consulate in Naples.

"imprisoned" until evening and then released. The teachers retained their guards for the night, announcing they will hold the offices until something is done to settle the matter of their unpaid salaries.

Issue Only 2,503 of

150,928 Visas Available

WASHINGTON, Nov. 10.—A total of only 2,503 visas were issued yesterday to immigrants to enter the United States out of a possible 150,928 during the fiscal year ended June 30th, according to a tabulation made public by the Department of State.

Of the total visas granted in that period, 1,417 were preference and 1,086 non-preference.

The small number of visas granted was said at the Department of State to have been due to the strict enforcement of the immigration laws.

The greatest number of visas, 418, were granted to immigrants from Great Britain and Northern Ireland. Next came Germany, with 405, and third Italy, with 350. No visas were granted in the case of 20 countries.

Renewal of the riots is expected today inasmuch as a memorial demonstration for Wladyslaw has been arranged and a number of students have arrived from Vilna for this purpose. Placards announcing the memorial have been placed on the campus of the university and carry the legend: "The Jews have murdered Wladyslaw."

The demonstration will be preceded by church services, following which the students will march through the city.

Nazis Get Five and One Year Sentences for Attack
