KOLO CHARGES DISTRICT GOVERNOR OF LWOV AND POLICE DIRECTLY RESPONSIBLE FOR RIOTS; 399 JEWS APPLIED FOR TREATMENT IN FIRST FIVE DAYS

Jewish Council Demands Officials of Polytechnic Institute Be Held Responsible for Anti-Semitic Disturbances; Seven Students Sentenced to Prison; Three Get Fine Alternative for Demonstrations; Demand Jews Be Granted Right of Self Defense; Polish Ambassador to U. S. Says Calm Restored; Scores Exaggerated Reports in Some Press Quarters; Demand Damages for Victims

WARSAW, Dec. 6.—The District Governor of Lwow and the police department of that city are accused of direct responsibility for the anti-Semitic excesses there, because they failed to take adequate precautions to prevent the disturbances whose immensity was evident a fortnight before they occurred, in an interpellation submitted today by the Club of Jewish

Deputies to the Polish Sejm.

At the outset of the disturbances, the police of Lwow were not only passive but actually sided with the attackers, the interpellation charges, and cites instances to support its contention that from first to last, the police sympathized with the rioters. Jews who defended themselves were arrested while the police refused to come to their rescue, and actually took part in the baiting of the Jews, the interpellation asserts.

The interpellation shows that in the five day period from November 26th to December 2nd, 399 Jews registered for first aid treatment. The majority of them suffered from serious head injuries as the result of being beaten up with iron bars or stabbed with knives.

The interpellation contains an exact list of all the injured with full names and addresses.

The Club of Jewish Deputies will demand that the victims be paid damages.

A fortnight before the mass attacks began, individual incidents directed against the Jews occurred in Lwow, such as the breaking of windows and attacks on Jewish stores. Jews were attacked on Szeinacha Street, especially in the evening hours. The press drew the attention of the authorities to the growing disorder in the district and

Professor Einstein Gets Visa To United States; State Department Cables Apology

State Department Expresses Regret Misunderstanding Should Have Occurred; Expected to Sail Saturday

BERLIN, Dec. 6.—Professor Albert Einstein this morning received a cabled apology from the United States State Department for the misunderstanding which occurred yesterday when the distinguished scientist was interrogated by the American consulate in Berlin concerning his political affiliations.

At the same time the American consulate telephoned to inform Professor Einstein that his visa had been granted.

Professor Einstein informed the consulate yesterday that he would cancel his visit to the United States if his visa were not granted him by noon today.

The noted scientist, whose visas have been arranged for him in the past without any action on his part, was compelled to put in a personal appearance yesterday owing to instructions from the State Department, who acted because of

Charge Von Schleicher

Pays Press for Support

BERLIN, Dec. 6.—The insinuation that the Jewish, the Ullstein and the Mosse press support Chancellor Kurt von Schleicher because the latter pays them to do so, is made by the Nazi press today.

The papers declare that "without paying the Jews give only death."

This attack is explained as an effort to let off steam in connection with the recent election losses of the Nazis and Hitler's failure to secure the Chancellorship. In Thuringia, despite Hitler's personal campaign, the Hitlerites lost 20% of their following.

The Jewish hounds have let loose Jewish journalists to praise von Schleicher because they receive assurance that von Schleicher will conduct a policy favoring the Jews, the Nazi papers assert.

BERLIN, Dec. 6.—The appointment of General Kurt von Schleicher as Chancellor of Germany is accepted with toleration by the Jewish press.

The "Voelkischer Beobachter," the Nazi organ, on the other hand, heads its report of the appointment with the designation, "Schleicher, friend of the Jews."

The Nazi organ evidently plans to adopt the same tactics with reference to Chancellor von Schleicher as it did toward former Chancellor von Papen, whom it habitually referred to as the "Jewish Chancellor."

Weizmann to Be in

Palestine for Chanukah

JERUSALEM, Dec. 6.—Dr. Chaim Weizmann, former president of the World Zionist Organization and the Jewish Agency for Palestine, will arrive in Palestine for the Chanukah season which begins on December 23rd, it was learned here today.

The official reason given for Dr. Weizmann's visit to Palestine at this time is that he desires to attend the celebration in honor of the eightieth birthday of his mother, who resides here.

Jewish Student Suspended

For Self-Defense

BRESLAU, Dec. 6.—A Jewish student, Goldschmidt, was suspended from Breslau University yesterday for the remainder of the semester for resisting the attacks of Hitlerites, during the course of which he was severely injured.

The suspension sentence was passed on the Jewish student by the same University court which merely reprimanded Nazi students who attacked Professor Ernst Cohn last week.

BRESLAU, Dec. 6.—The Disciplinary Senate of Breslau University has reprimanded four students who demonstrated against Professor Ernst Cohn on Thursday.

The University Senate threatens to suspend nine other students for the same offense.

The lecture hall of the Jewish professor, who has been the target of continuous attack since his appointment to the Law Faculty early in November, was surrounded on Thursday by a mob of 200 despite a police guard, and attacked.

the particular danger to which the Jews, worshipping in the district synagogue, were exposed, says the Kolo memorandum.

Immediately after the death of Grotowski, the Jewish population became aware that provocation on a large scale was afoot, the memorandum says.

WARSAW, Dec. 6.—The Jewish National Council yesterday made representations to the Minister of Education demanding that the rector and the supervisor of the Polytechnic Institute be made responsible for the anti-Semitic disturbances which led to the closing of the school after Jewish students had been attacked.

The demand is made in a communication addressed to the Minister of Education, wherein it is charged that the rector and supervisor acted contrary to the law and as such are responsible for the events under the criminal code. Both officials, the memorandum asserts, refused to intervene when the Jewish students who were attacked approached them asking protection. At first they pleaded lack of time and when the Jewish students insisted upon aid, informed them that they were fully aware of the nature of their duties.

The Polytechnic Institute remains closed owing to the disturbed atmosphere as does the University of Warsaw.

All was quiet yesterday at the Wawelberg Technical High School and the College of Commerce.

WARSAW, Dec. 6.—Thirty-four students arrested in connection with the demonstrations in Warsaw following a church memorial service for Jan Grotowski, were placed on trial here yesterday.

Twenty-four were acquitted, seven sentenced to two months imprisonment and three were given the alternative of paying a fine of 2000 zlotys, or spending two months in prison.

LWOW, Dec. 6.—Leib Landau, prominent Jewish counsel, who acted as defense counsel in the famous Steiger trial, will head the counsel for the Jews arrested in connection with the death of Jan Grotowski.

Four Jews were arrested following the death of Grotowski who succumbed to knife wounds after he and five companions, returning drunk after an all night revel, early last Sunday morning, attacked Jewish passersby.

LWOW, Dec. 6.—The authorities have prohibited the publication of parts of

the text of the resolution adopted by the Zionist Council here in connection with the anti-Semitic disturbances.

JERUSALEM, Dec. 6.—A demand that Polish Jewry be granted the right to arm for self defense, "in view of the Polish government's insufficient ability to check the riots," was submitted to the Polish Consul General here today by the Executive of the Hebrew University Student Union in a special memorandum.

The Consul was also visited by a delegation of Polish Jews living in Jerusalem who asked stronger protective measures for their relatives in Poland.

The Polish consul informed the delegation that public opinion in Poland condemns the present riots and that those responsible will be severely punished.

Polish Ambassador on Disturbances

The Polish Ambassador in Washington, Tytus Filipowicz, has issued a statement on the disturbances in Poland, through the Polish Telegraphic Agency, stating that "complete calm has been restored," and declaring as follows:

"In connection with the inquiries of American Jewish organizations addressed to the Prime Minister of Poland, to other members of the cabinet and to myself, I am authorized to state that the government of Poland remains determined to prevent and counteract with all firmness any excesses of chauvinistic groups of University students against Jewish citizens.

"Thanks to the energetic measures of government and University authorities as well as to the determined stand taken by the majority of mature public opinion complete calm has been restored.

"It is regrettable that exaggeration on the part of certain organs of the press being reflected abroad in some of the protests and resolutions creates unfounded fears which may only result in hindering normal development of Christian Jewish relations in Poland.

"While during the student riots both Jews and Christians have been injured, the only fatal casualty is a Christian student, Grotowski."

Founder of Boston Academy of Music Dies

SIENA, Dec. 6.—Agide Jacchia, founder of the Boston Academy of Music, died yesterday in Siena, where he has been resident for the last two years in the interest of his health.

Pietro Mascagni, the great Italian composer, visited Jacchia before he died.

Appeal for Support For European Yeshiboth

VILNA, Dec. 6.—A world-wide appeal for the support of the Yeshiboth in Poland, Lithuania and Palestine was decided upon at the conclusion of a conference attended by eighty delegates representing the Yeshiboth in these three countries.

The conference was convoked by Rabbi Chaim Ozer Grodzinski and the Chofetz Chaim in behalf of the Federation of Yeshiboth in Poland.

The financial situation of the Yeshiboth is alarming as a result of the general crisis in Eastern and Central Europe, the paper states, and is due also to the fact that the Joint Distribution Committee in the last few months discontinued the subsidy which had been initiated by the Central Relief Committee.

Rabbi Aaron Teitelbaum of Jerusalem, who for eighteen years served as secretary of the Central Relief Committee, attended the conference.

Montreal Federation Launches Charity Drive

MONTREAL, Dec. 6.—On Sunday, December 4th the Federation of Jewish Philanthropies launched its annual campaign to raise the sum of \$330,000 which is needed for the support of some 7500 destitute families as well as the various institutions which form the constituent societies of the Federation.

Ten percent of the Jewish population in Montreal are being cared for, in one or more ways, by the Federation of Jewish Philanthropies.

H. E. Herschorn, who recently led a successful financial campaign for the Y.M.H.A., is leading the local charity campaign.

Anti-Jewish Campaign Follows Premier's Pledge to Reverse Greek Election System

Will Either Abolish Separate Electoral Colleges or Introduce Them for All Members of Community

SALONICA, Dec. 6.—Anti-Semitic agitation is developing here in connection with the promise given to a Jewish delegation by Premier Tsaldaris, that the existing restrictions with regard to elections, would be abolished.

Premier Tsaldaris promised that the separate Electoral College, which maintains a political ghetto for the Jews, would be abolished.

Consideration, he said, is being given to the revision of the election system. Either proportionate elections will be adopted, applying to the Jews as to all other members of the community, or there will be a general return to separate electoral colleges.

A motion to this effect will be introduced in Parliament in January, the Premier stated.

The organs friendly to former Premier Eleutherios Venizelos, both in Athens and Salonica violently oppose the Premier's pledge, and threaten to withdraw their support, which would result in the downfall of the government, if the project is not abandoned.

Simultaneously the government organ, "Makedonia Nea," controlled by Minister of War, General Condylis, has launched a campaign against the Jews. The paper demands that voting rights be withdrawn from the Jews and announces a series of historical articles on the "Jewish Hangman of Salonica."

The "Jewish Hangman" referred to is a fictitious character, Peretz Covno, who allegedly became the favorite of the Turkish government of Salonica and caused the execution of numerous Greeks.

Smyrna Jews to Change To Turkish Language

ISTAMBUL, Dec. 6.—The abandonment of Spanish for the Turkish language by the Jewish population of Smyrna was resolved upon at a mass meeting under the auspices of the Jewish Youth Movement.

The movement for the adoption of the Turkish language was initiated some years ago by the Jewish population of Milas, with whom Smyrna now joins ranks.

The Jewish population of Istanbul has thus far remained aloof realizing the difficulties that must be surmounted and the impossibility of bringing about a sudden change from Spanish which the Jewish population has employed for centuries. The Istanbul Jewish population prefers to wait for a gradual change to the Turkish language.

Says District Commissioner's Granting of Arab Claim for Haifa Bay Land Not Final

Jewish National Fund States Court Must Hand Down Final Ruling; Land Has Not Yet Passed to Arabs

JERUSALEM, Dec. 6.—The ruling handed down by the District Commissioner on November 17th that 3,500 dunams of land in Haifa Bay owned by the Jewish National Fund and the Bayside Land Corporation, an American Jewish firm, must be returned to the Arabs, is not a final legal judgment but an administrative measure valid only until the court pronounces a final verdict, according to a statement issued today by the Jewish National Fund.

The disputed territory, says the Jewish National Fund, has not yet passed into the hands of the Arabs but remains the legal possession of the Jewish National Fund and the Bayside Land Corporation.

In previous disputes over Haifa Bay land the court has ruled in favor of the Jewish National Fund, rejecting the Arab claims.

Vienna Nazi Leader In Jewish Hospital

VIENNA, Dec. 6.—The "Arbeiter Zeitung" published a photograph of the Vienna Nazi leader, Frauenthal, in the Rothschild Hospital, maintained by the Jewish Community.

The paper asks how it reconciles his week's stay at the Jewish Community Hospital with his anti-Jewish boycott agitation.

Reports Progress on Jewish Contributions to Revenue

LONDON, Dec. 6.—Progress in the consultations between the Jewish Agency Executive and the Palestine government to determine the proportion of the Jewish contribution to the public revenue of Palestine was reported yesterday in the House of Commons by Sir Philip Cunliffe-Lister, Secretary of State for the Colonies.

The Colonial Secretary also stated that the Palestine government is now considering a plan to determine the share of the Jews in employment in public works.

The statements of the Colonial Secretary were in reply to a query raised by David Adams, who pointed out that only forty Jews were employed last year in Jerusalem public works of a total of 280 employees. This despite the fact that the Jews constitute sixty per cent of the population of Jerusalem.

Doak in Annual Report Would Limit Entries to Persons Needed in Specific Trades

Secretary of Labor States Country Will Not Be Able Again to Absorb Large Immigration

WASHINGTON, Dec. 6.—Further strictures to limit the admission of aliens to those who are needed for specific trades is recommended in the annual report submitted to Congress yesterday by Secretary of Labor William N. Doak.

The report points out that for the year ending June 30th, only 35,576 immigrants were admitted, the smallest number in 100 years, as against 32,838 deportees of persons who had departed from the country at their own request to avoid deportation.

Secretary of Labor Doak asks further that a reading knowledge of the English language be made a naturalization requirement.

"Mature consideration of our conditions leads me to believe that the country will not likely again be in condition to absorb successfully a similarly vast number of aliens as were allowed to enter until a few years ago," the report states.

Sees Enough Labor Here

"I believe that in the development of our resources and the natural increase of the present population we have approached or reached a stage when the facilities and opportunities of employment will not exceed our supply of workers at home.

"It is logical then to refer this point to former recommendations of the department that our immigration policy should be revised to provide that no new and unattached immigrants coming for the avowed purpose of seeking work shall be admitted unless it has been previously determined by the department that there is an actual need for the kind of service they are qualified to render.

Vaad Leumi Formally Takes Over Education

JERUSALEM, Dec. 6.—The transfer of the Jewish educational system from the Jewish Agency to the Palestine Jewish National Council was formally consummated when an agreement was signed in Jerusalem.

The agreement stipulates that the Jewish Agency must contribute the sum of £40,000 annually to the Vaad Leumi for the support of the schools. The Palestine Jewish National Council becomes responsible for the entire budget and control of the school system.

At a meeting of Los Angeles Lodge B'nai B'rith, No. 487, Harry Graham Balter, assistant United States District Attorney, was unanimously elected president. Felix J. Jonas, vice-president and Adolph Sieroty, treasurer.

BERLIN, Dec. 6—The difficulties experienced by Professor Albert Einstein in obtaining a visa to the United States where he is to head the Mathematics School of the Institute for Advanced Study, were little known to Berlin yesterday.

A number of distinguished German professors stated to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, however, "It is not awaited that the American authorities will listen to the plaint of the Woman Patriot Corporation or that they can be oblivious to the fact that the Einstein Theories are completely detached from politics and that Einstein himself has never been a party man but has always worked for justice or the well being of suffering humanity. Should the demand of the Woman Patriot Corporation be permitted to interrupt Einstein's visit to the United States, world history will have been created and the story will be told in school text books in the future."

Pinchot Honorary Chairman of Washington Forest Committee

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 6—Governor Gifford Pinchot has accepted the Honorary Chairmanship of the Pennsylvania Committee on the George Washington Forest, commemorating the bicentennial of the birth of the first President, now being established by the Jewish National Fund, according to an announcement made by Jacob B. Hoffman, local Zionist who will head the State Committee.

Governor Pinchot is recognized as one of the outstanding foresters in this country, having been Chief United States Forester in the McKinley, Roosevelt and Taft administrations. To this day he has not lessened his interest in forestry.

In accepting the Honorary Chairmanship of the Pennsylvania Committee, Governor Pinchot explained that as a forester he believes in the program of the afforestation of Palestine.

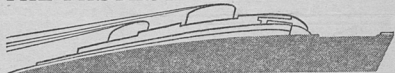
husbands, children and aged parents of citizens and lawfully resident aliens and possibly professional classes, would restrict and reduce general immigration from all countries to the demonstrated requirements of the United States at a given time.

Determined in Advance

"Under such a suggested system this department would determine in advance the necessity for the importation of aliens of a certain trade or calling, whose services were said to be needed, and if the representations were found to be valid the Consuls would then be advised, so that applications could be invited from aliens who would meet these requirements.

"This would seem to be a scientific system of immigration, would redound to the best interests of the country in the future and would be comparable in principle to the free entry under the customs laws of articles of foreign manufacture which do not enter into competition with our own industrial products."
