During Golden Rule week, Americans are asked to eat the cheapest meals that can be devised and to give the money saved by the economy meals for the benefit of the hungry. The beneficiaries have been for the most part hungry children in the United States and abroad. This year "it is planned to use the

funds reaised for the amelioration of local conditions created by unemploy-ment," says the statement. "These conditions transcend all denominational limitations, and the Jews of America should share in this unsectarian and humane endeavor."

# New Sources of Water Supply In Palestine Give Hope of Reclaiming Large Areas

Successful Application of American Methods in Yavniel Reported to Palestine Economic Corporation

Hopes of turning large areas of land in Palestine, now arid, into arable acreage suitable for orange growing and truck farming is seen as a result of the discovery there of new sources of water supply by the application of American methods, according to a cablegram received by the Palestine Economic Corporation. The cable-Yavniel region where previous at-tempts, utilizing antiquated methods, had only resulted in an inadequate

"The well which has been successfully drilled in Yavniel, offers great hopes of turning arid lands into flour-ishing colonies," Bernard Flexner, Chairman of the Board, declared. "This site was chosen because wells which had been driven there by antiquated methods, had resulted in a poor Palestine has long been recognized as a serious one, particularly in the hill The soils of this region are suitable for vineyards, olive groves and grain fields and with irrigation, also for vegetable growing. The first well drilled shows a yield of 440 gallons per minute from a decomposed basalt reservoir at a depth of 170 feet. successful result of the drilling at Yavniel demonstrates that an adequate water supply can be obtained at a lower cost through improved methods. I believe that large tracts of land now unfit for crops due to the inadequacy of the water supply, may, as a result of the application of the methods em-ployed at Yavniel, be transformed into arable areas."

The American drilling unit was sent into Palestine by the Palestine Economic Corporation working in conjunction with the Palestine Jewish Coloniconditions by F. Julius Fohs, noted geologist, in that country and of meth-ods used in California, had indicated that the latter could be successfully ap-

The engineers and machinery will be kept in the Holy Land, Mr. Flexner said, to carry out other projects of the two organizations and will be available for the use of existing colonies and of new colonies to be settled in the future. The Palestine Economic Corporation is an American Organization which has been furthering the economic development of Palestine along sound business lines for many years.
