Jewish Student Expelled from Polytechnic Institute for Alleged Part in Disturbances

**Jew Receives Severe Sentence, While
One Christian Suspended for 3-Year
Term, Others Simply Reprimanded**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WARSAW, Dec. 20—A Jewish student was expelled from the Polytechnic Institute today upon recommendation of the Disciplinary Committee of the Institute's Senate for alleged participation in the disturbances there during the period of the anti-Semitic excesses in Poland.

The punishment inflicted upon the Jewish student is the heaviest imposed upon any of thirty students who were brought before the Disciplinary Commission. One Christian student was suspended for a period of three years, while five Christian students escaped with reprimands.

LONDON, Dec. 20—British Jews associates itself with the Jews of the world in expressing its abhorrence at the recent anti-Semitic excesses in Poland, Leonard Montefiore, president of the Anglo-Jewish Association, declared Sunday at a meeting of the Board of Deputies of British Jews.

Mr. Montefiore referred to the statement of the Polish Ambassador in London, conveyed in letter to the Board, deploring the excesses and describing them as unrepresentative of the views of the government. At the same time, Mr. Montefiore said, it

Brodetsky Presses for More Immigration Facilities

WARSAW, Dec. 20—Prior to departing for Roumania, Dr. Selig Brodetsky, member of the World Zionist Executive in charge of political affairs, visited the British Ambassador here, as well as the First Secretary of the Embassy and the Palestine passport officer.

Dr. Brodetsky informed the British representatives of the difficulties the Zionist Organization is experiencing in view of the limitations placed in the way of immigration to Palestine. There is a large group of people in Poland, including middle class immigrants who desire to go to Palestine, but are unable to secure immigration permits, Dr. Brodetsky stated.

Nine Nazis Arrested in Vienna; Implicated in Bombing of Jewish Stores

**Nazis Defy Police and Government
Threats of Reprisals; Thirty-two
Released by Police**

VIENNA, Dec. 20—Nine members of the Nazi Storm Troops were arrested here this afternoon after a sudden police raid on the Nazi Brown House.

The police search established that the gas bombs thrown into department stores owned by Jews last Saturday, causing their closing, were either of German or secret Austrian manufacture.

Many Jewish firms received telephoned threats today in connection with the boycott terrorization which the Nazis are conducting in an effort to prevent Christmas trade from benefiting Jewish business.

VIENNA, Dec. 20—The Police Department of Vienna, after a conference between the head of the department and a representative of the Chancellor's office, yesterday threatened reprisals against the Nazis if their leaders do not call off their anti-Semitic boycott terrorization campaign.

Defying this threat and the official government announcement that severest measures would be invoked to punish the boycotters who have caused considerable property damage and serious business losses to the Jews through their campaign of attack and vilification, the Nazis yesterday continued to disseminate boycott leaflets. Loud speakers were stationed in the streets through which imprecations

Keren Hayesod Campaign In England Successful

Federal Judges Sign Decree Granting Permanent Injunction Against Alien Registration

**Decree Voids Action of Michigan
State Legislature in Passing Alien
Registration Law**

DETROIT, Dec. 20—A decree granting a permanent injunction against the Michigan alien registration law passed by the 1931 Legislature and signed by Governor Bruckner, was signed yesterday at an impressive session of the special Federal Court consisting of Judge Charles C. Simons of the Circuit Court of Appeals, and Judges Ernest A. O'Brien and Edward J. Moinet of the District Court.

The decree was asked by Theodore Levin and Attorney General-elect Patrick H. O'Brien. They urged that the case be speedily dispensed with in order to prevent the new Attorney General from being placed in the anomalous position of being called to defend an act he opposed before his election to the highest legal position in the state.

Attorney General R. W. Voorhies, who defended the law last year and who retires this month, approved the final decree.

The law as enacted provided that all aliens in Michigan, within sixty days after the act became effective, be required to register with the State authorities and present proof of legal entry into the United States. Certificates of legal residence in the state would be granted after proof had been produced. The Commissioner of Public Safety under the act was empowered to require photographs and fingerprints of the registrants.

Aliens who entered the country illegally were denied the privilege of establishing residence in the State. Corporations who hired unregistered aliens or who had business dealings with "undesirable" aliens, were to be penalized.

220 Polish Tourists Leave for Palestine

Feuchtwanger Envisions Jerusalem as Great Spiritual World Center

"I am bold enough to dream of a world role emanating from Jerusalem. But the center of this role should not be a government building, but the University of Jerusalem," said Dr. Lion Feuchtwanger in an address on "The Cultural Renaissance in the Near East" at a reception given in his honor last night, at the Harmonie Club. "I even dream that Jerusalem might become for the world what the founders of the League of Nations have dreamed Geneva would become for all mankind," said Dr. Feuchtwanger.

"There is no question but that a great influential center in Palestine would mitigate somewhat anti-Semitism in Europe and America," he said. "The world rule I think of in Palestine, however, should be a spiritual rule, and one only of the spirit. Its means should be none other than infinitely slow and patient attempts not to overpower the adversary but to persuade him."

Dr. A. S. W. Rosenbach, President of the American Friends of the Hebrew University, under whose auspices the reception was arranged, introduced Dr. Feuchtwanger. He said that the German novelist had attempted in his books, "Power" and "Josephus," to show the ways of such Jews who illustrate the conflict between power and mind.

Dr. Feuchtwanger has tried to show that many individuals, Jews among others," said Dr. Rosenbach, "have been confronted by the problems as to which way of life to follow,—that of power or that of mind? He has shown in his books the way of such Jews who went from power to mind, who found the way back from

Jewish Physician Invents Telescopic Lens to Aid Blind

40% of Blind Would Be Aided by Lens
Perfectured by Dr. William Feinbloom;
Approved by Optometry Academy

CHICAGO, Dec. 20.—The perfection of a new type of telescopic lens that will bring vision to people with as little as two per cent sight, was announced here at the eleventh annual convention of the American Academy of Optometry. Dr. William Feinbloom of New York, whose seven years of experiment resulted in the new type lens, revealed the discovery in a paper read before the assembled optometrists.

According to Dr. Feinbloom, who is chief of the optometric staff of the West Side Hospital, New York, the improvement will bring sight to almost-dimmed eyes, and will enable thousands of greatly handicapped people to perform the same tasks as those with perfect vision.

The discovery was received with enthusiasm among members of the Academy and Dr. Thomas McBurnie of Brooklyn, N. Y., president of the American Optometric Association, said:

"Its importance can only be realized when we recall the state of those who are almost blind. This invention which is given freely to the world of science, and can be used by every optometrist to help his patients, will do much to make thousands of people now dependent on public charity, independent. A new world is in store for those partially blind who will be helped by this discovery."

Dr. Feinbloom showed what a distinct improvement the new type lenses were over the old type in use for the past sixty years by comparing the latter with the ordinary opera or field glasses.

"The introduction of the cylindrical lenses into the telescopic spectacles will now enable persons to see as well as with the old type lenses, but they will enjoy the added comfort of seeing things just where they really are," Dr. Feinbloom added.

"In looking through the new type of telescopic spectacles, the object viewed is magnified horizontally," the specialist related. "The ordinary man will seem more corpulent and the objects will seem wider, but this is corrected by a psychological reaction within the person himself."

From statistics taken from his personal study, Dr. Feinbloom is of the opinion that forty per cent of persons now classed as blind, but who are suffering from subnormal vision only, will be aided in returning to the ordinary pursuits of life.

The new lenses are of the cylindrical type and are placed in a heavy, yet compact frame similar to the goggles used by industrial workers. A series of three

Justice Brandeis, in Chanukah Message, Sees Struggle for Democracy Continuing

Regards Feast of Maccabees as "Victory of Many Over Privileged Few"

The Feast of the Maccabees, the eight-day Jewish holiday which will be ushered in on Friday, is notable on the Jewish calendar because it represents "a victory of the many over the privileged, powerful few," Supreme Court Justice Louis D. Brandeis declares in a message issued in connection with the Maccabean Festival that is to be held under the auspices of the New York Zionist Region at Madison Square Garden this Saturday night.

The message was originally written by him in 1915. Its publication at this time was authorized for the Maccabean Festival by the Supreme Court Justice, formerly President and Honorary President of the Zionist Organization of America.

The statement on the Chanukah holiday reads as follows:

"The Jewish calendar has many sorrowful Holy Days. Chanukah—the Feast of Maccabees—is one of the few joyous Red Letter days. It celebrates a victory—not a military victory only; but a victory also of the spirit over things material. Not a victory only over external enemies—the Greeks; but a victory also over more dangerous internal enemies—the Sadducees. A victory of the many over the ease-loving, safety-playing, privileged, powerful few, who in their pliancy would have betrayed the best interests of the people, a victory of democracy over aristocracy.

"As part of the eternal world-wide struggle for democracy, the struggle of the Maccabees is of eternal world-wide interest," Justice Brandeis declares. "It is a struggle of the Jews of today as well as of those of two thousand years ago. It is a struggle of America as well as of Palestine. It is a struggle in which all Americans, non-Jews as well as Jews, should be vitally interested because they are vitally affected.

"For the Zionists the day has special significance. The Maccabees' victory proved that the Jews—then already an old people—possessed the secret of eternal youth. The ability to rejuvenate itself through courage, hope, enthusiasm, devotion and self-sacrifice of the plain people. Then they achieved a rebirth. They will bring again a Jewish Renaissance."

The Committee sponsoring the Festival is headed by Abraham F. Wechsler, Chairman, and former Congressman William W. Cohen, Honorary Chairman.

Trial of Torturers of Samson Bronstein Postponed for Third Time

CZERNOWITZ, Dec. 20.—The trial of Captain Panisoara and three gendarmes charged with responsibility for the torture of Samson Bronstein, Zionist leader of Yedinez, Bessarabia, last May, and scheduled to open today, was postponed for the third time.

Formal reasons are given for this latest postponement of the trial which was originally scheduled to be held in Czernowitz, last summer, was postponed until October 18th in the same city and later set for December 20th in Yedinez.

Samson Bronstein was arrested last May by gendarmes on charges of being identified with Communist activity, a charge completely without foundation. For six hours he was subjected to such torture that after his release he was confined to a hospital for months and it was feared he would be unable to walk again. Bronstein himself described the torture he suffered at the hands of Captain Panisoara and the gendarmes in a written statement to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency.

De Haas Calls for All American Jewish Conference

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 20.—The convening of an All-American-Jewish-Conference "for the cool and deliberate discussion of the realities of Jewish life and of the message of hope which Zionism has for Jewry in this country" was advocated by Jacob de Haas, veteran Zionist and distinguished journalist, in an address delivered last night under the auspices of the Zionist Forum.

Defining Zionism as "the one attempt the Jews have made to recognize their abnormal position in the world and to end it by creating a normal existence," Mr. de Haas recommended "the throwing overboard of all these meaningless syntheses and the resumption by Zionists of a clear national attitude." "This," he said, "would be in the interest of the Jewish people and not out of a desire for party power or glory."

"I emphasize," he added, "cool and deliberate discussion. I would stress the bringing together of the local representatives of the three thousand Jewish communities of the country. I see no purpose in bringing together a 'yes-man' gathering, or in lending aid to one of those publicity stunts, which sicken most of us, have worked incalculable mischief on our morale, and are merely excuses for money raising."

Funeral services were held yesterday at the Riverside Memorial Chapel for Alexander Lehman, former Assistant District Attorney, who succumbed to heart disease at the age of sixty.

He was active in the Hebrew Big Brothers Association.

Nietzsche to Buddha, from Samson to Isaiah."

Judge Irving Lehman of the Court of Appeals, and a member of the Board of Governors of the Hebrew University, also addressed the meeting. He announced that the second graduation exercises at the Hebrew University would be held on Thursday, December 22nd. He stated that Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchope, High Commissioner of Palestine, would make the chief address at the exercises, and that Dr. Nahum Sokolow, President of the World Zionist Organization, now on a visit to Palestine, would also deliver an address. Invitations for the graduation which will include the granting of M.A. degrees, to twelve students have been issued to visitors in Palestine for the winter season, including diplomatic representatives resident in Palestine and government departmental heads.

Dr. Rosenbach, bibliophile and book-collector of New York and Philadelphia, gave a dinner preceding the reception to Dr. Feuchtwanger, at his town house.

Dr. Feuchtwanger said in part:

"Plainly spoken, I am not in every respect a friend of Zionism and of the Hebrew University in Jerusalem. You know that there are four main ideologies of nationalism, namely: the political regional theory, the theory of race, the ideology of the common sharing of historical experiences, and the theory of common language. I am convinced that all these four ideologies have only restricted application to Judaism, or none at all. I am convinced that Judaism is not a race, is not a common soil, is not a common way of life, is not a common language. I know, of course, that just that is the aim of Zionism, to give a common soil and a common language to the Jews. But it is just this last question which makes me, with all my sympathy, a little skeptical about the program of Zionism."

"It is curious and a little tragic that a nation so eminently literary as the Jews, lacks just this common bond. I understand, therefore, thoroughly the desires of the Zionists to fill this lack. I sincerely hope that they succeed, but I can't imagine that they will."

"I follow, I repeat, with the greatest interest and with the warmest sympathy, the strivings of the Zionists today to make a living language of Hebrew. I know that already today many thousands speak Hebrew in daily life from childhood on. I have heard it spoken myself, and I like to hear it. I am touched when I read my books in Hebrew, but, frankly, I don't believe that a language which for so long a time has been cut off from a living development can be artificially revitalized."

"But with this doubt of the endeavors of Zionism to create a new language,

cylindrical lenses are set in each aperture of the frame and worn exactly as a pair of glasses with single lenses. The spectacles are not defacing, Dr. Feinbloom said.

He was enthusiastic over the possibility of the aid that it will afford to those persons now doomed to a life of non-occupation.

Comments from leading members of the profession indicate the revolution that this invention will make in the field of optometry. Dr. J. I. Kurtz of Minneapolis, Minn., editor of the American Journal of Optometry, stated that the new discovery will open a new world to thousands now partly blind and who are kept in public institutions at public expense.

Dr. R. E. Littlefield, eye specialist of Kansas City, Mo., commended Dr. Feinbloom not only for the success in the great discovery, but also for the unselfish way in which he is making it available to every partially blind person through the optometrists of the country without thought of financial reward.

Similar sentiments were voiced by Dr. W. S. Farmer of Oklahoma City, Okla., Dr. D. R. Paine of Topeka, Kansas, Dr. F. Fred Andree of Baltimore, Md., Dr. Ernst H. Kiekenapp of Fairbault, Minn., Dr. J. C. Neill of Philadelphia, Pa., Dr. H. Riley Spiller of Eaton, O., and Dr. E. H. Silver of Washington, D. C.

Dr. Feinbloom is a research fellow of Columbia University and is a consultant in the Bronx Optometric Clinic and the Newark Optometric Clinic.

Nine Nazis Arrested in Vienna; Implicated in Bombing of Jewish Stores

were hurled at the Jews by Nazi leaders.

The Nazi leaders admit the boycott propaganda against the Jews, inaugurated in an effort to prevent Christmas trade from benefiting Jewish business, is part of a campaign. They deny, however, responsibility for the bombs which were thrown into department stores owned by Jews, last Saturday, compelling them to close.

At the same time the Nazis in a communiqué warn the newspapers and even the government that they will enter suit for damages for the libelous accusation that they are responsible for the bombing attacks.

VIENNA, Dec. 20.—Thirty-two Nazi youths arrested in connection with the boycott propaganda against the Jews which has assumed the character of terrorization were released today.

The released Nazis were found not guilty of responsibility for the tear gas bombs which have been thrown into Jewish department stores, causing their closing.

The "Arbeiter Zeitung" today accuses the police of assisting the Nazi campaign against the Jews. This is denied by the police department praesidium which announces the impending arrest of those responsible for the tear gas bombings.

The Merchants Unions join in the accusation against the authorities declaring that they tolerate the Nazi boycott propaganda. The public prosecutor, it is pointed out, declined for days to confiscate the boycott leaflets.

bottom the old Messianic mission of Judaism.

"Considered historically, and with the proper perspective, a great class of Jews is now confronted with this problem which way should they go, and the temptation is great to answer the attacks of power with only the will to power. Nothing, however, would be more foolish in every sense than to counter the Fascism of the others, whether German or Polish, with Jewish Fascism.

"It is true countries have till now always been conquered by violence, and the conquerors in part exterminated and in part enslaved the former population. We Jews, when we first took Palestine, did the very same thing. We exterminated and enslaved the natives, and we thought it blessed to settle in cities which we did not build. Later we had to go through very bitter experiences when other people exterminated us and enslaved us and settled in the cities we built. We are in the midst of the third conquest of Palestine. If this conquest is to succeed, and if it is to have significance, then it must be executed by other means than that of violence. The Third Israel has nothing in common with the Third Italy or the Third realm for which the German nationalists long. The task of the Third Realm of Israel, however, means to me the same as the task of the ancient Greeks after they had been defeated politically. Then, you know it, these defeated Greeks conquered the world without the use of violence — only with the aid of exemplary models in the spirit, only through the mind. The same way, I think, should be the way and the task of the Third Realm of Israel.

"For this task, I think, the University of Jerusalem is most important need. The natural center of a revised and subtilized Zionism, the natural center of the Jewish world and perhaps for the whole spiritual world, is not a government building, but the University of Jerusalem.

"The true Jewish nationalism, I repeat, in contrast to every other nationalism, has the tendency not to materialize itself but to transcend itself. It is cosmopolitan, it is in its essence messianic. Yes, Jewish nationalism longs to be dissolved away in a united world, like salt in water, itself dissolved, no longer visible, yet it is omnipresent and existing forever.

"But I am afraid other long centuries will be required until the world will be united in spirit. Till then, Jewish nationalism is necessary in its current materialistic shape and till then the Jewish University at Jerusalem is doubly necessary in order that Zionism will not forget its ultimate purpose."

cannot be denied that minor subordinates do not support the government's views.

While indignation against the excesses prevailed, the representations made by the Board of Deputies were restrained owing to certain considerations. He recalled in this connection that Poland has recently intervened in behalf of Polish nationals in three countries, particularly in behalf of Polish Jews in Germany who were threatened with the confiscation of their property and expulsion as the result of Nazi agitation.

He ascribed the anti-Semitism in the Universities of Central Europe to the vast overcrowding in professions.

D'Avigdor Goldsmid, president of the Board, announces his definite intention of resigning his office in January. Numerous valedictory speeches were delivered. Gratification was expressed that Mr. Goldsmid will continue as president of the British section of the Jewish Agency.

Dr. Arthur Kraus, an instructor in the Philosophy Department of the College of the City of New York broke his eight day fast on Monday, entered into as a protest against the anti-Semitic excesses in Poland.

He declared that he expects to lead a student protest demonstration to the offices of the Polish Consulate here next Thursday.
