## ARABS DEMAND OPPORTUNITY TO DEVELOP EMIR ABDULLAH'S LAND; REPORT AMERICAN JEWISH GROUP PREPARED TO SPEND \$1,000,000 TO DEVELOP AREA

Would Have Spent This Sum if Agreement Concluded, Arab Press Reports; Palestine Government Will Not Issue Statement on Matter; Not Within Its Jurisdiction; Transjordan Under Different Government; Report British Subsidy to Transjordan Government Cut from \$20,000 to \$10,000

JERUSALEM, Feb. 13.—The Palestine government informed the Jewish Telegraphic Agency today that it does not intend to issue any statement regarding the reports of Transjordan land leases to Jews.

The Palestine government spokesman explained that the matter is not within its jurisdiction as Transjordan is under a different government.

The Arab press have placed on the Palestine government the responsibility for the refusal of Emir Abdullah to consummate the agreement to lease his land to a Jewish company. The pressure of British officials, according to the Arab press, caused Emir Abdullah to issue his two communiques, the first on January 26th and the most recent yesterday, denying that he intended to lease his personal domain to foreigners. The British officials referred to are the Palestine High Commissioner and the British Military Commander of the Transjordan Frontier Force, Peake Pasha, who conferred with Emir Abdullah last Sunday.

The Arab press are divided with yesterday's communiques from the Emir's

palace which declares that the land will remain unutilized if he is unable to supply his own private capital for its development. The papers demand that the land be leased to Arabs.

Despite the communiques, the feeling here is that the matter is not entirely closed as far as leasing land to a Jewish company is concerned. The view is expressed here that the matter will be closed to Jews only if the Arabs succeed in obtaining the capital for the development of the territory available.

## 30% Jews in Poland, Deceased, Starving; 80% Workers Unemployed

Statistics Given by Jewish Deputy in  
Address to Polish Sejm; 19%  
Earn Bare Subsistence

WARSAW, Feb. 13.—Thirty percent of the Jewish population in Poland are deceased and starving, while 80 percent of the Jewish workers are unemployed and Jewish professionals and intellectuals are in a desperate state, Deputy Rothenstrich informed the Polish Sejm.

The process of uprooting the Jews from their economic positions in, moreover, growing apace, he declared, with 10% of Polish Jewry only earning a bare subsistence. Seventy groshen daily is considered a good wage for an average Jewish family in Warsaw, Lodz and Vilna, formerly thriving industrial centers offering a good livelihood to the Jews.

An investigation of the Jewish schools, he said, disclosed that of 44 children, 13 had their breakfasts, 14 were fed on tea and the rest received no food. Some children, moreover, sought to hide bread received at school meals to take home to their starving families, Deputy Rothenstrich asserted.

## Nazi Minister of Education Orders Probe Into Charges Against Professor Cohn

Two Representatives Interrogate Students; Cohn Given Opportunity to Reply

BRISLAU, Feb. 13.—The Nazi Minister of Education for Prussia, Dr. Bernhard Rust, yesterday ordered an investigation of the charges preferred by Nazi students against the Jewish professor, Ernst Cohn, who has been the target of persistent attack and vilification on the part of the Nazis since his appointment to the Law Faculty of the University last November.

Two representatives of the Ministry of Education visited the University of Breslau yesterday in connection with the investigation and interrogated fifteen students in connection with the charges.

The probe lasted for several hours, following which Professor Cohn was permitted an opportunity to submit his rebuttal.

The representatives of the Ministry of Education have returned to Berlin where they will submit their report to Dr. Rust.

It is believed that the formal center of the Jewish professor will now be accomplished since a Nazi occupies the strategic position of Minister of Education.

Immediately after Hitler's appointment as Chancellor and the replacement of Minister Kaehler by Dr. Rust, Rector Brockhaus of Breslau University announced that he could no longer be responsible for the safety of students attending the lectures of Professor Cohn. Professor Cohn thereupon posted a notice on the University bulletin board that his lectures would be suspended for the time being. At the same time he made known his intention.

## Austrian Jewish Population Decreases; Totals 184,000

VIENNA, Feb. 13.—A decrease in the Jewish population of Austria is revealed in the statistics for 1932 made available today.

The entire Jewish population is estimated at 184,000. A total of 2041 Jews died during 1932 with only 926 births recorded. In addition 819 persons resigned from the Jewish Community.

## Jewish Physicians Lauded By Minister of Health

BUCHAREST, Feb. 13.—Jewish physicians were lauded for their idealism by Minister of Health Ionesco in reply to an attack launched in Parliament by Professor Caza who charged that Jewish physicians poison the Roumanian people.

Amid applause from Parliament, Minister Ionesco recalled the name of a Jewish physician, Dr. Doerfler, recently deceased, who gave his own blood forty-five times for transfusion purposes for non-Jews.

The anti-Semitic deputy, Roba, attempted to attack the Jewish deputy, Michael Lunden, when the latter recalled that a Jewish physician saved the life of Caza's daughter.

Mrs. Zangwill has been in America the past few months, speaking before various groups in behalf of world peace. She came here as the guest of the Women's National League for Peace and Freedom.

Twelve hundred persons attended a reception given by the Women's Association of the American Ort on Tuesday evening at Temple Emanu-El in honor of Lord Dudley Marley, deputy speaker of the British House of Lords, and chairman of the British Parliamentary Ort Committee, who is now in this country in the interests of the Ort campaign for funds.

Lord Marley declared that America could not realize the serious economic plight of the Jews in Europe, particularly in Poland.

### Fast Day to Protest Alleged Religious Persecution in Russia

JERUSALEM, Feb. 15.—A rabbinical conference called by Chief Rabbi A. I. Kook and attended by 200 rabbis, today resolved to proclaim March 27th a day of fast to be observed by Jews throughout the world as a protest against the alleged persecution of the Jewish religion in Soviet Russia.

An appeal to world Jewry to observe this day with special synagogue services and anti-Soviet demonstrations will be issued.

A petition will also be submitted to the League of Nations and prominent world personalities to use their influence with the Soviet government to discontinue the alleged persecution of the Jewish religion and its observers and to permit Jews to leave Soviet Russia.

Reports were delivered at the conference declaring that Russian Jews die of hunger in the streets and many were touched to the point of tears by these reports.

### Hitler Confidant Sails to Report on U. S. Situation

NEWARK, Feb. 15.—Dr. Ludwig R. Santler, a native of this city, and said to be a close confidant of Adolph Hitler, has sailed for Europe to report to the Nazi leader as to the alleged sentiments which Americans evince toward the German Fascist movement.

Sailing via a roundabout route, he is heading first toward South America, where he also will study the reaction toward Hitlerism. He will then cross the Andes for Buenos Aires where he will head for Germany.

At a farewell gathering held here and attended chiefly by members of German singing societies, Dr. Santler asserted:

"Germany wants and favors a strong government. She wants a man of the type of Hitler, who is a 100 per cent patriot, to steer the ship of state—a strong man who will insist on Germany taking her place among the Great Powers in the family of nations".

### Feuchtwanger to Lecture For Jewish Writers Club

## Trial of Torturers of Samson Bronstein Is Postponed for Fourth Time

Formal Reasons Again Given for Postponement of Trial; Torture Took Place Last May

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BUCHAREST, Feb. 15.—The trial of Captain Panisoara and three gendarmes accused of torturing the Zionist leader, Samson Bronstein of Yedinez, Bessarabia, in May, 1932, which was scheduled to open yesterday was postponed for the fourth time.

Lack of witnesses was given again as the reason for the postponement of the trial. The date of the trial has now been set for April 25.

The perpetrators of the attack and torture of Bronstein, who was arrested on baseless charges of conducting Communist activities, which in Roumania are regarded as subversive, were originally scheduled to be placed on trial last August in Czernowitz.

Then the trial was set for October 18th before the Czernowitz Court of Appeal. When that day arrived a change of venue was ordered and the date set for December 20th in Bronstein's home town. On December 20th, the trial was again postponed until February 14th and today it again failed to take place.

## German B'nai Brith Marks 50th Anniversary

BERLIN, Feb. 15.—The fiftieth anniversary of the founding of the German B'nai Brith was celebrated here on Sunday.

The organization now has a membership of 13,000. An anniversary meeting was addressed by Dr. Leo Baeck and Professor Elbogen, who described the history of the German Lodges.

The German B'nai Brith is an independent organization, but continues its association with the American parent organization which co-operates in the interest of Jewry's welfare and as a factor in adjusting internal difficulties among various Jewish groups, it was stated at the meeting.

## Thomas Charges R.F.C. Granted Loan for Arms Shipment to Nazis

The charge that The Reconstruction Finance Corporation granted a loan to the Dupont munition works to permit the manufacture of arms for shipment to the Nazis in Germany was preferred by Norman Thomas, Socialist leader, in an address delivered before the Young People's Peace Conference.

Mr. Thomas, the former Socialist candidate for the presidency of the United States stated, that he had information to this effect "from a reliable source" and that according to the plan, the arms were to be shipped to the Hitlerites via Holland.

## Demand Government Measures Against Spread Of Anti-Semitism in Latvia

Pogrom Agitation Grows Since Rise of Hitler to German Chancellorship; Call for Anti-Jewish Boycott

RIGA, Feb. 15.—Adolph Hitler's appointment as Chancellor of Germany has given impetus to the anti-Semitic movement in Latvia.

A Nazi mass meeting held here last night and attended by a large throng heard an appeal for the isolation of the Jewish population and a complete boycott of Jewish business delivered by the Nazi leader, Stellmacher.

Latvian women, in particular, were urged to avoid all trade with Jews. Latvia alone cannot break away from the yoke of the Jews, but united with similarly minded European countries the domination of world Jewry can be smashed, Stellmacher asserted.

An example of the practical manner in which the anti-Jewish feeling is manifesting itself is the action of the Barbers' Union which voted to exclude Jews from membership. In the past all nationalities were included as members. Now the Union declares that the Jewish members are disgracing it, and as evidence, alleges that many owners of halls refuse to rent their halls to the Union for meetings because of the Jewish membership.

The praesidium of the Jewish Artists organization has called a meeting to deal with the situation which has developed.

In contrast with the action of the Barbers' Union is the refusal of the annual meeting of the football association of the University here to exclude Jews. A motion calling for the exclusion of Jews from the association was presented by the chairman of the student council.

Although Jews were not elected to the council of the association, a representative of the Hakoah was elected to another executive office.

The Jewish press demands that the government take measures to combat the open pogrom agitation which has become current since Hitler's rise to the Chancellorship of Germany.

## Nazi Organ Fined For Attacking Jews

VIENNA, Feb. 15.—The editors of the Nazi organ "Tagesszeitung" were fined 300 schillings, with the alternative of spending seven days in prison, for insulting the Jews.

The editors of the paper were found guilty of insulting a religious community in stating that the Talmud and the Shulchan Aruch permit the sexual abuse of Christian children. The action against the paper was brought by the public prosecutor.

## Urge Kehillah to Make Representations to Austrian Government Regarding Boycott

Jewish Merchants and Artisans Declare They Are Ruined by Agitation Against Them

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA, Feb. 15.—The Jewish Community of Vienna was urged to make representations to the government to secure the protection of the authorities to counteract the Nazi boycott agitation.

The agitation of the Nazis has had serious repercussions for the Jews and Jewish merchants and artisans have sent delegations to the Jewish Community, pleading for intervention in their behalf.

Non-Jewish customers entering shops now make it the custom to ask whether they are owned by Jews. When the answer is in the affirmative, they promptly leave, the Kehillah was informed. As a result, Jewish business has been completely ruined.

Jewish merchants and artisans urge the Kehillah to issue an appeal to the Jewish population to purchase from Jews only, in order to counteract the Nazi boycott agitation.

## Histadruth Convention In Session in Tel Aviv

TEL AVIV, Feb. 15.—The fourth convention of the Histadruth, Palestine Labor Federation, and the first since 1927 is now in session here.

A large audience attended the opening session which featured a review of the work of the last six years by Ben Gurion. He reported that the organization has a membership of 35,500, comprising 17 percent of the entire Jewish population as compared to the 6 percent in 1927.

## Want World Zionist Congress To Be Held in Chicago

CHICAGO, Feb. 15.—The proposal that the Zionist World Congress be held in Chicago, during the period of the World Fair, this summer, was made by Jacob Brande, president of the Chicago Zionist Organization at a Zionist Rally at the Covenant Club.

The suggestion was enthusiastically received by an audience of 1,000. Formal steps in this direction will be taken, it is understood.

## Seven Maccabees Come from Poland by Auto; Refused Entry

## Nazi Minister of Education Orders Probe Into Charges Against Professor Cohn

tention of presenting his case to the highest authority.

As a civil servant, in the employ of the State, Professor Cohn cannot be discharged except for breach of discipline. In the past, despite the efforts of the Nazis, no such breach could be discovered.

BRESLAU, Feb. 15.—The opportunity, presumptively given to Professor Ernst Cohn to reply to the charges directed against him by Nazi students of Breslau University, was turned into a cross-examination by the two investigators of the Prussian Ministry of Education, it is learned today.

Professor Cohn, it is stated, was questioned on the newspaper inquiry with regard to his view on Leon Trotsky's right to asylum in Germany. At the time Professor Cohn replied that, in his opinion, all spiritual workers are entitled to asylum, provided they do not participate in political controversies.

This statement, at the time of its utterance, precipitated a controversy and led to a reprimand, later withdrawn, by the Senate and Rector of Breslau University.

Professor Cohn was also questioned concerning threats received over the telephone, to which he replied, "I am determined to resume my lectures and to give a chance to demonstrate again".

The "Berliner Tageblatt" states that the imminence of Professor Cohn's dismissal can no longer be doubted.

## Eugene O'Neill Called Jew by Nazi Organ

BERLIN, Feb. 15.—Eugene O'Neill, the famous American playwright is called a Jew by the Nazi organ "Voelkischer Beobachter", and accused of degrading the German theatre, through his play "Emperor Jones", in an election appeal.

Charging that the Jews have degraded the German theatre, the paper lists "Emperor Jones" as an example of the work of a Jewish playwright. It also lists a number of other non-Jewish playwrights whom it calls Jews.

The whole harangue concludes with an appeal to vote for Hitler and his party.

BERLIN, Feb. 15.—Not a single high Jewish official remains in the Prussian Administration, following the sweeping cleansing of Minister of Interior Wilhelm Goering.

Dr. Herman Badt, ministerial director to the ousted Braun-Severing government, and for years representative of Prussia in the Federal Council, has been placed by compulsion on the pension list. The pensioning of Badt, it is stated, is temporary.
