Difficulties for Palestine **Emigrants Made Despite** Nazi Promise to Britain

Germany Fails to Adhere to Agree-ment Permitting Middle-class Jews to Withdraw Thousand Pounds

(Tewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, May 4-Anxiety is ex-pressed here over the failure of the German government to carry out its promise to allow middle-class German Jews leaving for settlement in Palestine to withdraw one thousand pounds each from their private re-sources in Germany. It is learned on reliable authority that in the middle of April, following representa-tions by the British government, German authorities agreed to permit German authorities agreed to permit such withdrawals, which the cur-rency restrictions would otherwise have prevented. It was actually in connection with this permission that the British government granted spe-cial certificates for the German-Jewish refugees, allowing them entry as middle-class citizens in Palestine. In order to expedite their flight from Germany, the British government in this instance cancelled the usually re-quired confirmation of the certificates

in Palestine.
Suddenly, however, the German government has disregarded the specifications in the agreement, and reduced the permitted withdrawal from fourteen thousand to ten thousand marks, making it difficult for the em-igrants to qualify for their middleclass Palestinian entry. Detroit Rabbis Declare May 10 Penitential Day In Hitler Protest Call (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

DETROIT, May 4-The Vaad Ha-Ir, the Rabbinical Council, Mizrachi and other groups have joined in de-claring Wednesday, May 10, the Nazi book-burning day, as a day of penitence. A call is also issued for all Jewish business and professional men to close their stores and stop work at 4 P. M. on that day, when protest meetings will be held in three of the leading synagogues in the city, the B'nai Moshe, Beth Tephila Emanuel and Ahavath Achim.

In each synagogue, rabbis and lay leaders will speak and prayers will be chanted by the cantors. It is planned to read chapters from the Book of Lamentations and to adopt

resolutions of protest.

On Wednesday evening, the youth of the city will hold a protest meeting. More than 80 organizations, with a membership of about 3,500,

The Reform rabbis of this city, Dr. Leo M. Franklin and Rabbi Leon Fram, conferred with the Orthodox leaders in their plans for this reli-gious protest and will address the planned protest meetings.

Seek Economic Facts

Wednesday night's session was featured by a symposium on "What are the facts of the present economic situation and what are the logical conclusions to be drawn from those facts?" Participants in the sympo-sium were George Soule, editor of the New Republic, Dr. Rufus S. Tucker, noted economist and Rabbi Goldstein, chairman of the Assembly's committee on social justice. A paper which aroused considerable lively discussion was read by Rabbi Jacob Freedman of Chelsea, Mass., on "Bootlegging the American Rabbi-nate." Declaring that the invasion of "free lances" or unordained men in the rabbinate constituted a "disgraceful and pernicious bootlegging of the American Rabbinate," Dr. Freedman called upon the Assembly to formulate plans to deal with this condition. He recommended an amalgamated board consisting of representatives of the various seminaries, rabbinical and synagogue associations to purge "the dross from the religious life of American Is-

Ordain Worthy Practitioners

"Such a broadly representative organization," he said, "aided by the press and by other national organizations, such as the American Jewish Congress, the American Jewish Com-mittee, the Jewish Welfare Board, the Associated Y.M.H.A.'s, the Zionist Organization, the B'nai B'rith and other fraternal groups, has it within its power to bring order out of chaos in our religious life. Let the worthy unordained men of long standing be recognized and welcomed into the rabbinical associations. Let the younger ones prove their sincerity and real devotion to their calling by entering the seminaries as candidates for ordination. Let the others be publicly read out of the ranks of the rabbinate." A special committee of the As-

sembly will be appointed to look into the question of "free lance" rabbis and to take steps, in conjunction with other Jewish seminaries, to rid the rabbinate of these unqualified, unordained men.

The line of march has not yet been determined, but it is known that the procession will make its way of the city.

The eve of the demonstration, May 9, will be reserved for prayer in accordance with a proclamation issued to its affiliates by the Union of Orthodox Congregations of America.

Thirty-one leading labor, fraternal, religious, Zionist and other pewish organizations, representing the vast majority of the 4,000,000 Jews in the United States, yester-day amounced that after careful consideration of the statement issued jointly by the American Jewish Committee and the B'nai B'rith, describing all protests against anti-Tewish discrimination in Germany as "futile", it is their unanimous opinion that the protests must continue as they constitute the most effective means of bringing about the desired intercession.

Again Invite A. J. Committee The organizations which joined

the announcement, says the statement, "are firmly and unanimously behind the protest march arranged on May 10th, under the auspices of the American Jewish Congress." They have already arranged for the participation of their membership. "The cooperation of the Ameri-

can Jewish Committee and the Bnai Brith advocated by us through the American Jewish Congress has been and continues to be invited. Now more than ever there must be no self determined isolation on the part of any organic element in the community.

"In the space of one month, through a series of cabinet decrees, the Hitlerite government has succeeded in depriving more than one hundred thousand of Germany's Jewish population of less than 600,-000 of all means of livelihood.

Social Justice Is Chief Topic for 25th Convention Of United Synagogue

The remaining sessions will be held separately by each organization. The deliberations will center around the subject of social justice. The Women's League will devote its sessions to discussing how the Jewish stons to discussing how the Jewish woman can play a more active part in general communal as well as Jew-ish life. This question will be dis-cussed in the form of a series of questions which will be answered by various speakers.

The National Federation of Jewish Men's Clubs will concern itself with the subject of how the men's club can assist in putting into effect any program of social justice that is de-cided upon by the synagogue, with the emphasis placed on adult educa-

The United Synagogue will also review the progress of Conservative Judaism in the United States during the past year and will discuss the future role of the synagogue.

The American Society of Jewish War Veterans today issued a statement charging the Steuben Society with a "defense of Hitler terrorism. The statement, in the form of a telegram from J. George Fredman, was addressed to John Tjarks, sec-retary of the National Council of the Steuben Society.

Warning was issued vesterday by the Steuben Society that a boycott of Germany would be a "doubleedged weapon", and participants in the protest against treatment of Jews in Germany were characterized by the Society as not being "loyal in their adherence to American princi-ples." The German-American organization also declared that the anti-Nazi agitation would bring about anti-Semitism in other countries.

Nor does any right-thinking American citizen ques-tion Jewish loyalty just because our hearts go out to our stricken breth-ren in the worst calamity in the records of ruthless brutality inflicted upon an inoffensive minority people. upon an inorensive minority people. Unwittingly you include in your question of 'loyal adherence to American principle' the Hon. John P. O'Brien, mayor of New York, former Governor Alfred Smith of New York, your own countryman, Sena-tor Robert F. Wagner, the Rev. John nor kopert P. Wagner, the Rev.
