Dutch Exhibit Books Doomed in Germany In Mourning Display

**Chief Rabbi Warns Against Attack-
ing Germans; Parisians Plan
Monster Demonstration**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

AMSTERDAM, May 9—An exhibition of the books which will be burned in Germany tomorrow has been undertaken on a large scale throughout Holland both by interested organizations and by enterprising book-sellers who are exhibiting the condemned works in special window displays. Some of the bookshops have surrounded the books with black crepe or placed funeral wreaths above them.

The Dutch chief rabbinate today issued a serious warning to the Jewish population to refrain from physical attacks on Germans, describing this as a mistaken method of combatting anti-Semitism. The warning was issued following repeated clashes with Nazis, some of whom acted provocatively, particularly in The Hague, where uniformed Nazis paraded the streets chanting the "Horst Wessel" song, Nazi anthem.

PARIS, May 9—Paris will mark the German auto-da-fe of Jewish books tomorrow with a monster mass meeting to be held tomorrow night. The meeting was organized by the Committee for Protection of Persecuted Jewish Intellectuals in Germany.

Grand Rabbi Israel Levy and many of France's most prominent writers and statesmen will address the meeting.

Jewish Students Leap from Windows to Escape Nazis

VIENNA, May 9—Grave anti-Semitic disturbances broke out at the University of Vienna this morning when Austrian student followers of Hitler began a sudden attack on Jewish men and women students at the institution. Several Jewish students, including a number of women, were injured, particularly through jumping from windows because the Nazis, before be-

Reich's 'Purification' Today

BERLIN, May 9—Over twenty thousand volumes by Jewish authors have been collected in Berlin alone to be fed the monster bonfire tomorrow in the Opera Square. The volumes were seized from private libraries and collections throughout the city, by enthusiastic Nazi student groups, and were contributed by sympathizers eager to aid in the "purification" of German culture through the destruction of literary and scientific works which have previously ranked among the glories of German thought.

Max Liebermann resigned yesterday as president emeritus of the Prussian Academy of Art, because he said his conception of art was not in accordance with that proclaimed by the Nazis and which henceforth must guide artists in the Reich. A Jew, Liebermann had been a member of the Academy for thirty years.

Noted Jewish Scientist Quits University Post After Student Acts

**Nazis Move to Devalue Jewish
Stock in Banks and Concerns;
Reorganize Chain Store Owners**

BERLIN, May 9—Professor Max Neisser, noted biologist, whose works on immunology have won him wide repute in scientific circles, has resigned from the University of Frankfurt where he has been a professor since 1914. Although he was exempt from expulsion from his post under the decree limiting Jews on university faculties, Professor Neisser resigned because disorders by students made continuation of lecturing by him impossible.

Jewish-owned shares in German banks and firms will become valueless as a result of a scheme under consideration by the Nazi Government to establish control of shareholding corporations and eliminate

CHRISTIANS PROTEST NAZI JEWISH PERSECUTION, AMERICAN JEWISH CONGRESS PARADE TODAY

While final preparations were being made by the American Jewish Congress yesterday for the parade in protest against continued degradation of the Jews in Germany and the burning of books by Jewish authors which will take place throughout the Reich today, plans for an impressive protest by leaders of the Christian ministry against "the ruthless persecution of Jews under Herr Hitler's regime" were revealed by the National Conference of Jews and Christians. Newton D. Baker, Professor Carlton J. H. Hayes and Roger W. Straus are co-chairmen of the conference.

Signatures of one thousand ministers of all denominations are now being gathered, it was disclosed, for a statement prepared by the Rev. Dr. Harry Emerson Fosdick, pastor of Riverside Church, and a group of outstanding churchmen. Following collection of the signatures, the statement will be sent to Christian leaders in Germany.

A similar document bearing the signatures of five hundred social sci-

entists in colleges and universities throughout the country, is in preparation and will be sent to German social scientists and university leaders, it was learned.

gining their attack, had blockaded all exits from the university buildings. The rioting spread from the university building to the Chemical, Medical and Anatomic Institutes.

Several Socialist students were also injured in the disturbances. Only the intervention of police and a fire brigade enabled the blockaded students to escape.

Seven Jewish students were arrested this afternoon following accusations in the Nazi press that sixteen Nazi students had been gravely injured in the melee. The Nazi papers charged that Jewish "Marxists" instigated the clash.

American Students Injured

Nine American students were among the wounded in the clashes. Twelve students, the majority of them Nazis, were arrested because they resisted the police, who used their automobiles in dispersing the crowds which gathered.

The injuries the Jewish students sustained were mostly from "knuckledusters," leaded whips and chains used by the Nazis. As a result of the rioting, the Anatomic Institute has been closed.

The American Embassy is expected to intervene in the case. Other embassies are also expected to follow suit since over thirty foreign students, including Poles and Hungarians, were injured. Several cases of severe spinal injuries were reported among the women students and many of the injured received broken legs in their desperate leaps through windows to escape their tormentors.

Demonstration Plans

Bainbridge Colby, Secretary of War in the cabinet of President Wilson, will be the principal speaker at the meeting this afternoon at Battery Park, which will conclude the mass demonstration planned for the day by the American Jewish Congress. General John F. O'Ryan, grand marshal of the parade which will leave Madison Square and march to Battery Park, will also speak, as will former Congressman Fiorella LaGuardia, George Gordon Battle and the Rev. Dr. John Haynes Holmes.

Over two hundred thousand marchers are expected to follow General O'Ryan including a number of non-Jewish groups, according to the Congress. The parade will follow Fifth Avenue to Washington Square, go on to Lafayette Street, proceed to Park Row, cross City Hall Park to Broadway and go down Broadway to Battery Park where it will be reviewed by prominent Jews and non-Jews. Because of the size the demonstration march is expected to reach, it will be assembled in five divisions.

The Church Statement

The statement being prepared for transmission to German Christian leaders by Dr. Fosdick and his associates points out that "the endeavor of the German Nazis to humiliate a whole section of the human family threatens the civilized world with the return of mediaeval barbarity." It follows in full.

"We, a group of Christian ministers, are profoundly disturbed by the plight of our Jewish brethren in Germany. That no doubt may exist anywhere concerning our Christian conscience in the matter we are constrained, alike with sorrow and indignation, to voice our protests against the present ruthless persecution of the Jews under Herr Hitler's regime.

"We acknowledge the grievous provocations which have led to the German revolution; especially the condemnation of unborn generations of German children to economic servitude by the terms of the peace. Our nation shares part of the blame for this situation. We understand

the accumulated resentment which has led German youth to undertake at all costs the reconstruction of the nation and its reestablishment in unity and power. We claim no right to censor the methods by which this shall be accomplished simply because they are not our own.

"We acknowledge, also, the existence of racial and religious prejudice in America, against which we have repeatedly taken our stand, but all the more on that account do we deplore a retreat from gains once made in Germany while we continue to struggle for human rights in the United States.

"For weeks we waited patiently, refusing to believe stories of a state policy against the Jews. Now, however, having in our possession testimony to the facts which seems to us unimpeachable, we cannot forbear speaking. Herr Hitler for years has preached relentless hatred against Jews. One of the fundamental doctrines of the Nazis, explicitly acknowledged by them, is that the Jews are poisonous bacilli in the blood of Germany to be stamped out like a plague. What the followers of Herr Hitler have proclaimed they now practice. Systematically they are prosecuting a "cold pogrom" of inconceivable cruelty against our Jewish brethren, driving them from positions of trust and leadership, depriving them of civil and economic rights, deliberately condemning them, if they survive at all, to survive as an outlawed and excommunicated people, and threatening Jews with massacre if they so much as protest. It is our considered judgment that the endeavor of the German Nazis to humiliate a whole section of the human family threatens the civilized world with the return of mediaeval barbarity.

"We, deplore the consequences that must fall upon the Jews, upon Christendom which permits this ruthless persecution, and in particular upon Germany itself. For protesting thus against Hitler's cruel anti-Semitism, we conceive ourselves to be speaking as the sincere friends of Germany."

The Scientists' Statement

The statement of the scientists follows in full:

"In making public the following opinion on the situation in Germany, those who sign are fully aware that the recent happenings in that country are in large part the result of the lack of fair play to German and the short-sighted slighting of German rights and needs by nations, including our own.

British Jews Seek Relief For German-Jewish

 LONDON, May 9—A special committee has been formed here under the chairmanship of Leonard Anthony Rothschild and will shortly issue an appeal for a fund in behalf of Jewish victims of persecution in Germany, it was announced today. It is learned that the possibility is not excluded that the Zionist fund for German-Jewish victims, as independent of the Paletsine fund, so far as England is concerned, may be united with the Rothschild committee and share the money raised in a certain proportion. It is pointed out that other countries might cooperate locally in order to avoid dividing their energies. Viscount Erleigh, Sir Isadore Salmon and Leonard Montefiore have joined the Rothschild committee.

Rabbi Fox Warns Against Visit of Dr. Goebbels

 CHICAGO, May 9—Condemnation of the action of Chancellor Hitler in appointing Dr. Joseph Goebbels, Nazi Minister of Propaganda to represent Germany at the Century of Progress, Chicago's World's Fair, which opens the end of this month, was expressed here by Rabbi G. George Fox of the South Shore Temple.

"If he comes here," Dr. Fox added, "to receive the plaudits of the American people, I should not like to be responsible for what will happen. Hitler has a great deal of authority to send a man to represent his government here."

Dr. Fox's statement is the first open manifestation of serious doubts expressed by leading Jews of this city following the announcement of Goebbels' appointment to come here. There is a feeling here that an untoward incident is possible which might cause a strain on diplomatic relations between Germany and the United States.

Free One Frankfurt Jew, Still Hold Second

Hague Tribunal May Hear Polish Nazi Victims

 BERLIN, May 9—Only The Hague tribunal can protect Jewish rights and property in Germany is the belief of diplomatic circles here in connection with the reported intention of the Polish Government to bring the cases of maltreated Polish Jews before the international tribunal. Protests of the Polish consulate have failed to result in any definite or satisfactory reply from the German Government. No confirmation, however, could be obtained at the Polish consulate as to whether the Polish Government intended to bring up the matter at The Hague.

Over a thousand Polish Jews in Germany have suffered as a result of Nazi attacks or economic discrimination, according to lists compiled by Polish consulates throughout Germany, but the list is reported still far from complete. The Polish Government, in filing protests with the German Government, reserved the right to claim damages. It is now expected that the Polish Government will avail itself of this provision.

Reduce Appropriations For Educational Work

also recognize that minorities are suppressed and discriminated against to some degree in every land.

"But the growing interdependence of the world makes it appropriate that individuals far from Germany should express their concern about the intense anti-Jewish campaign. As different cultural and racial groups come into close contact with one another, conflict is a frequent result. There are always those who want to destroy or to render impotent those who greatly differ from them. Such an effort is likely to be an emotional and not a rational reaction, and is diametrically opposed to principles of sound statecraft.

"In our interdependent world, which many technical factors have brought upon us, with close contacts between many people and cultures, one of the central problems is how they shall live together to mutual advantage. The world is too small for persecution. Intolerance in every nation is a world concern. One of the great tasks of those possessing intelligence and goodwill is to search for the kind of relationships which will make possible a good life for cultural and racial minorities. This means the setting up of structures and methods which will prevent destructive and violent relations between nations and groups. The end to be sought is rational control through conciliation.

"A poverty-stricken world cannot afford bitter hostility and the denial of civil and religious rights. We

believe that the general welfare of Germany—as of every other nation—will best be served by a friendly policy toward all honorable minorities. Richness of culture and progressiveness of spirit require a wholesome diversity within the larger unity of national life. Indeed, modern society is discovering that civilization means the increasing provision for minorities."

De Valera Concerned Over Jews of Germany
