Steuben Council's Right To Whitewash Nazis Is Challenged by Members

John Jacob Astor Lodge Protests-Suggests Appointment of Spe-cial Inquiry Commission

Dissatisfaction within the mem-bership of the Steuben Society with the stand taken by the organization in regard to Nazi treatment of the Jews in Germany has resulted in a challenge to the National Council of the body of its right to issue a statement on the subject without ascertaining the attitude and wishes of the constituent groups, it was learned vesterday.

A delegation representing the John Jacob Astor Lodge of the Steuben Society in a meeting with the national officials protested against the making public of re-solutions by them whitewashing the Nazi regime and denying maltreat-ment of the Jews in Germany, it was learned. The lodge asserted that no such statement should have been issued on the basis of information available here, and said that the situation should have been studied at first hand before any step was taken by the organization.

Representatives of the lodge pro-posed that a special inquiry commitposed that a special injury commi-tee be sent to Germany immediately to make such a study of the situation and report to the Steuben Society. The proposal won warm support among members of the German-American society, it is understood, (Continued on Page 4)

Nazi Anti-Semitic Rioting Reported in Austrian Town

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) VIENNA, May 13—Nazi anti-Se-mitic rioting followed a demonstra-tion by the Austrian Hitlerites yestion oy the Austrian Hitlerites yes-terday in the main streets of Graz, according to reports reaching here today. Windows in Jewish stores and homes were broken and the population of the city was thrown into an uproar. Police cleared the streets of demonstrators only with great difficulty and after arresting a number of Nazis.

Harsher Rules for Young Jews Who Are Drafted In Nazi Labor Gangs

Battalions in Which They Labor to Contain Sixty Percent Pure Hitlerites and Stahlhelms

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, May 13-Young Jews will be drafted into the compulsory labor camps that are to be set up as part of the Government compulsory labor service plans, but unlike non-Jews who will be placed in ordinon-jews who will be placed in ordi-nary battalions, the young Jews will be put in mixed battalions contain-ing 60 percent approved Nazis, or members of the Stahlhelm.

This measure is interpreted as part of a plan to isolate un-Nazified non-Jewish young Germans from Tewish contacts and influence and from the friendship which might spring up as a result of association. The establishment of distinct labor battalions for Jews will also make it possible for the German authori-ties to introduce different regulations and disciplinary measures for them, as opposed to the treatment accorded to non-Jewish labor battalions.

The first recruits for the compulsory labor camps will be drawn from those young Germans who (Continued on Page 4)

WARSAW, May 13-Jewish business firms are moving their headquarters from the Free City of Danzig, at the mouth of the Polish Corridor, to the new Polish harbor city of Gdynia because they fear German Nazis will capture Danzig and will create discrimination against the Jews in Danzig similar to those in effect in Germany.

Non-Zionists Break With Zionists on United Relief Action for German Jews

Rothschilds Agree on Earmarking Half of World Fund for Palestine Refugees

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, May 13—Efforts to combine the Zionist appeal for a fund to aid German-Jewish refugees with the non-Zionist effort, have been unsuccessful, it was learned today, following a meeting which re-presentatives of both groups attend-

The non-Zionists, headed by Lionel and Anthony Rothschild and Sir Robert Waley Cohen, while agree-ing that fifty percent of the fund should be earmarked for Palestine insisted that its distribution should be by a special mixed commission instead of through existing Zionist channels. This commission, the channels of the commission and the Collection held, should proceed to Palestine and work out a plan which would require the final sanction of the general appeal committee.

The Zionists declined this proposal, it was learned, terminating the negotiations for the time. failure to amalgamate the appeals in England should not prejudice such efforts in other countries, it was pointed out here today, as favorable terms of understanding might be reached there. But any united ap-peal, it became apparent, must be purely local in character, with the world-wide Zionist appeal remaining (Continued on Page 4)

Jewry Raising Urgent Million-Mark Fund

Close cooperation between American and European Jewish agencies for the relief of the Jews of Germany has been established, Dr. Jonah B. Wise, national fund-raising chairman of the American Jewish Nazis' Anti-Semitic Rag Joint Distribution Committee, revealed yesterday. Dr. Wise returned Thursday after a trip to London, Paris and Berlin where he conferred with European relief officials and with leaders of German Jewry. A temporary fund of one million marks is being raised for German relief, he reported, of which 400,000 marks are being raised in Germany. A committee representing the

Jews of Germany, known as the Zentralausschluss fuer Hilfe und Aufbau, has been organized. Autoau, has been organized. Its members include Rabbi Dr. Baeck, of Berlin, Dr. Carl McIchior, Direc-tor Stahl, Dr. Kreutzberger and Alfred Berger, Dr. Wise said. Speaking of the Jews of Germany,

Dr. Wise said:
"I can say very definitely that the situation for them is hopeless, and that the young people cannot possibly look forward to living in that country under present conditions, and so feel that they must resort to exile. Thousands of refugees are crowding into London, Paris, Brussels, Basle and Prague. I visited the relief centres there and saw some very pitiful sights. Men of the highest type of education and culture are frantically attempting to adjust themselves to new life in far away lands. Practically all careers are closed to them at the present time, and for the moment relief is the

most important question."

First Time in 247 Years

(Tewish Daily Bulletin) NEWARK, N. J., May 13-For the first time in the 247 years since this city was settled, a Jewish citizen will be its Mayor. Dr. Meyer C. Ellenstein, reelected to the City Commission this week by the highest vote ever received by a candidate and the only member of the Commission to be reclected, will be named as Mayor when the new Commission meets formally next Tuesday to organize, a statement by the other four members of the Commission, revealed.

The new Mayor, who is both a dentist and lawyer, was selected for the Commission last October to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Commissioner John F. Murray. At that time, 154 ballots were taken by the other four Commissioners before he was chosen.

Dr. Ellenstein, whose early life-time was spent in Paterson, is identified with more than thirty fraternal and charitable groups and is active in Tewish affairs. He is a member of the board of trustees of Temple B'nai Abraham and treasurer of the Hebrew Orohans' Sheltering Home

Insults Catholics, Derides Ancestry of the Popes

(J. T. A. Mail Service) BERLIN-Bitter attacks against the Pope and the Roman Catholic Archbishops in France and Melbourne, Australia, who protested against Nazi anti-Jewish atrocities in Germany, have been featured in the Arische Rundschau, successor to the Voelkischer Beobachter as the chief Nazi anti-Semitic propaganda organ. The paper says of the Roman Catholic church that "not less than fifteen of its popes had Jewish blood."

It also takes up the report that the Pope, in his recent interview with Vice-Chancellor Von Papen at Vatican City, had declared that the anti-Jewish policy in Germany was not in accordance with Catholic beliefs and ironically adds that the Nazis are well aware that their revolution "will fall upon the nerves of certain elements."

Ga. Baptists Refer to Germany As So-called Christian Nation (Tewish Daily Bulletin)

MACON, Ga., May 13-A resolution voicing regret that religious intolerance and persecution of Jews have arisen "in certain of the most forward-looking civilized so-called Christian nations" was adopted here at its meeting by the Middle Georgia Baptist Ministers Conference.

Winning Jewish Cemetery

Rayaged by Vandals (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WINNIPEG, Man., May 13-The oldest Jewish cemetery in Western Canada has been desecrated by vandals. Seventy tombstones over the graves of Jewish pioneers who participated in the settlement of Western Canada have been destroyed, the floor of the mortuary has been ripped up, the doors and windows smashed, and prayer shawls and books desecrated. The cemetery belongs to the local congregation B'nai Israel.

Preliminary police investigation revealed that the desecrations were committed within the past two The cemetery is no longer weeks. used and the damage was discovered only when a Winnipeg resident visited there a few days ago.

Indignation has been freely ex-pressed by both the Jewish and non-Jewish population of the city. The police are prosecuting an energetic investigation.

Nashville Jews Spurred, To Open Palestine Campaign (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

NASHVILLE, Tenn., May 13-For the first time in more than two years, the Tewish community of Nashville will have a campaign in the interests of Palestine. It will open with a mass meeting May 17. at which Rabbi James G. Heller of Cincinnati will be the guest of honor.

Responding to the appeals of the officers of the Jewish Agency in New York City, local Jewish leaders have organized a campaign committee that includes all elements of the community. The officers are Jake Silverman, chairman: Harry Lightman and Ike Komisar, associate chairmen; Nathan Davis, treasurer; Isadore Schulman, financial secretary; and Simon Rapoport, secretary.

Syracuse Poale Zion Opens Jewish Culture Campaign (Tewish Dally Bulletin)

SYRACUSE, May 13-In an ef-fort to counteract the effects of the Nazi movement, which aims to eradicate Jewish culture in Ger-many, members of the Syracuse brauch of Young Poale Zion Alli-ance, labor youth Zionists of the country, have inaugurated a camgreater acquaintance with internationally recognized German-Icwish literary, artistic and scientific achievements.

Hitler's Warsaw Consul Tries to Smother Jews In New Nazi Red Tape

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, May 13-Difficulties in obtaining visas for travelling in Germany, even transit visas for passage through the country, have been introduced at the German consulate here directed exclusively against the Iews. Iews having to travel in Germany or to pass through there are required to fill out long forms in which they are compelled to state the length of their Polish citizenship, whether they previously lived in Germany and whether they are quitting Poland permanently. addition they must furnish the consular office with two photographs of themselves and present their rail or steamship tickets disclosing their

exact destination. The Jewish population of Warsaw is indignant at this Nazi practice of racial discrimination within the borders of this country, which they di-rect not only against their own citizens but also against foreigners.

Havana Jews Staging Protest Rally Tomorrow

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) HAVANA, May 13-A mass demonstration in protest against the continued Nazi attacks on the Jews in Germany will take place here on May 16 in the hall of the Jewish

Centre. The meeting has been arranged by a united committee representing all Jewish institutions and organizations in Havana.

Dr. Orestes Ferara, Cuban Minister of Foreign Affairs, has promised to see that no obstacles are put in the way of holding the meeting by the authorities.

No Books by Jew Anywhere Will Be Sold in Germany

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) INNSBRUCK .- "Coordination" of the book publishing business in Germany to the program of the National Socialist party, has been accomplished. Henceforth, books by Jewish authors, written in Germany or abroad, will not be published in Germany. This action was decided upon at a meeting of the "Boersenverein der Deutschen Buchhandler" which includes the largest book publishing and selling firms among its members. They also warned against use of the boycott as being "a two-edged weapon."
