New Austrian Moves

Against Jews Noted (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA, June 10-Revision of the Austrian citizenship of Galician Jews is announced today by the Bauern-Buendler, official organ of Chancellor Engelbert Dollfuss, which assumes that the aristocratic Austrian Jews will agree in this action

which is allegedly directed against the naturalized Jewish masses from Eastern Europe.

The announcement is arousing much concern among the Jews, who are becoming perturbed over this policy which provides for differ-ences in citizenship grades and discrimination at home while assuring equality of citizenship abroad.

Chancellor Dollfuss, who prom-ised to defend Jewish rights in exchange for Jewish support of his government, addressing a conference of artisans this week, unaware that Jewish artisans were also in his audience, proclaimed his intention of wiping out Jewish influence and the Jewish spirit.

The attitude now being revealed by the chancellor, in sharp contra-distinction to his earlier stand, following a Government ban on the wearing of uniforms by the Hagana, government-supporting Jewish self-defense body, and the reports of Nazi-Dollfuss negotiations for a coalition government, has aroused much concern in Jewish circles.

Tell World Jewry to End Protest, or You Will Pay. Reich Jews Are Warned

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, June 10-A warning to Iews the world over to discon-

tinue anti-German propaganda on the threat that, otherwise, the po-sition of the Jews in Germany will be made worse, appeared to-day in the Voelkische Beobachter, offical organ of Chancellor Adolf Hitler, under the signature "A.R.", believed to be that of Dr. Alfred Rosenberg, head of the Nazi party's foreign affairs department. Dr. Rosenberg is editor-in-chief of the paper.

"The situation of the German Jews may become worse in case world Jewry does not give up its plans for destroying German economy", the article declares. "We will watch this, therefore, during the forthcoming months.

The article admits that there are individual Jews in Germany who, it says, are honestly pro-German. "However, they must carry their fate just as the rest of the Germans are compelled to bear the common fate of 1918."

Fear Germany Won't Keep Word on Olympic Games (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

INNSBRUCK, June 10-The International Olympic Games Committee, which voted to keep Berlin as the site of the 1936 Oylmpic Games after the German delegation pledged that no action would be taken to interfere with the participation of Jewish athletes, including German Jews, in the games, permitted itself to be duped, it is being charged.

Jews have been expelled from all German sports organizations under official orders and their participa-tion, therefore, is practically impossible unless they are reinstated. This is not expected nor did the German delegation promise that this

step would be taken

Foreign diplomatic circles in Berlin express surprise that the conference at Vienna permitted itself to be misled by the German delegation regarding the Jewish question and this attitude is directed especially at the American delegation because its members must have been aware that the expulsion of Jewish members of the athletic associations of Germany was complete. It is believed that the national athletic bodies in the various countries will revive the question when their delegates re-turn from Vienna to report on the action they took.

B'rith Abraham Plans Aid for German Jews At Its 47th Convention (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

ATLANTIC CITY, June 10-The vanguard of 1,200 delegates to the three-day session of the 47th annual convention of the Independent Order of B'rith Abraham arrived here today for the opening of con-

ferences tomorrow.

The oppression of Jewish citizens of Germany was to be the central subject during the congress. Funds will be raised to aid in financing the enforced migration of Jews from Germany to Palestine and other sanctuaries.

Isadore Apfel of New York, who finishes his second term as Grand Master of the Order at the convention, is to discuss the tragic plight of Jews in Germany. He is to urge the 100,000 members of his Order to fight for the restoration and pre-servation of German-Jewish rights.

Speakers include Harry Bachrach, Mayor of Atlantic City; Justice Joseph B. Perskie of the New Jer-Sey Supreme Court; Judge Gustave Hartman of New York; former Congressman Nathan D. Perlman; and Rabbi Stephen S. Wise, honorary president of the American Jew-ish Congress. Judge Hartman and former Congressman Perlman are past grand masters of the Order.

DETROIT, June 10—A prospec against it in theory or in practice, we organization to champion the The recognition of the necessary tive organization to champion the of social workers was advocated by the New York delegation at the general session of the National Council of Jewish Social Service this afternoon. Discussing the feasibility of a national protective organization, a report on the subject, presented at the session, recommended that a committee of Jews and non-Jews lay the groundwork for such a movement.

At a joint session of the National Association of Jewish Center Executives and the National Council for Jewish Education, both of which are holding their annual meetings jointly with the National Council of Jewish Social Service, emphasis on adult education in the programs of both bodies was strongly urged. Albert Schoolman, presi dent of the educational group, de-cried the indifference of the Federations to Jewish education.

A call to Jewish Federations to

view their programs on a basis broader than philanthropy, and to include Jewish education in Federation programs on a status of equality with other phases of a communal endeavor, as a matter of right and not toleration, was sounded by the National Council for Jewish Educa-

Jewish School a Barometer This demand was explained in a a tains demand was explained in a statement prepared in behalf of the National Council by Dr. Alexander M. Dushkin and Dr. Leo L. Honor of Chicago. Pointing out that "the flux in American Jewish life is reflected in the Jewish school," it says

in part:
"We consider the Federations of
Jewish Charities and the Jewish Welfare Federations as the effective available bodies to deal with the central needs in education. But we would posit two essentials in the relation between such Federations and Jewish education:

"1. The Federations must view their programs as broader than philanthropy in the specific sense of that term, and must recognize that the Jewish differential in all of their work makes education, both in the specific and general connota-tions, an integral element of their program

Right, Not Toleration

"2. Jewish education must be included in the Federation programs on a status of equality both in principle and in affiliation with all other phases of communal endeavor; it must be in those programs as a mat-ter of right and not of toleration. and there must be no discrimination

economic and professional interests place of education in the community program and its adequate support, will redound not only to the welfare of the school system, but will also

give purposefulness to the work of the Federations themselves." The National Council's statement. also makes definite declarations on the question of synagogues sponsoring schools of their own.

The statement declares that "each congregation and institution must be responsible for the maintenance of its own school, and should be the final authority regarding the curri-culum and spirit of instruction for its children. The central educational agency should do those things which the local schools are unable to do. It is through a co-operative partnership of parents, congregations and community that we may hope to achieve an adequate and worthy American Jewish school."

Poland Praised Here for Assisting German Jews

The attitude of the Polish Govern ment in protecting the rights of Polish Jews in Germany was the subject of a high tribute paid by 450 delegates representing 50,000 mem-bers of the Federation of Polish Iews, at the 25th appual convention of the organization which opened at the Hotel Astor Saturday night

Benjamin Winter, president of the Federation, and Rabbi Stephen S. Wise led a group of speakers who were unanimous in approving of the Polish action during the current

crisis in Germany.

Mr. Winter declared that Jews throughout the world are grateful and civilization in general applauds Poland's attainment of "the highest standards of statesmanshin"

Opened Doors to Refugees
"Poland", said Mr. Winter, "not only registered its sharp and effective protest with Germany, but had also in numerous instances opened its own doors to German-Jewish refugees."

Rahbi Wise recalling the aid given by Poland to Jews following the Arab riots in Palestine four years ago, enumerated present Polish action as the second occasion in current history in which Poland has come to the aid of belabored Jews.

"The Polish republic will find that it shall gain a new place in life, if it, in contradistinction to the German Reich, observes equity and jus-tice with regard to all its minority peoples and, most of all, to that racial and religious minority bound up through centuries of history with the happy and unhappy fortunes of Poland," he said.

Drift to Palestine

Mr. Winter described the recent influx of 2,000 Jews monthly into Palestine. He expressed hope that the development of this country will solve or at least salve the problems of Jewish exiles and called for help from the League of Nations on col-

onization plans.

9 Nazi Prisoners Killed: No Jew Among Released: Cruelty Drive Believed On (Innish Telegraphic Agency)

INNSBRUCK, June 10-Nine centration camp at Dachau, Ger-many, were shot and killed by their guards during the past week, it is reliably learned. A wave of cruelty and nunishment of Tewish prisoners is sweeping camps throughout the country.

Non-Iews receive far more lenient treatment, since the Nazis hope to convert them to National Socialism. This, of course, does not apply to the Iews, for whom hone of release seems almost

non-existent.

Many non-lews are being released from the camps on their pledge not to remain in the communities in which they formerly made their homes and not to maintain their old associations. The Nazi press, in reporting these releases, always emphasizes that there are no lews among them

Books Nazis Rurned Given W. Va. College (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

MORGANTOWN, W. Va., June 10—Copies of books by German and American authors which were burned in Germany on May 10 were presented to the West Virginia University Library today by Jewish students in the name of the Hillel Foundation on the campus, as a gesture of protest against Nazi vandalism. Books by Heine, Lessing, Ludwig, Feuchtwanger, Mann, Ein-stein, Helen Keller, Upton Sinclais, and many others were included in the gift.

In accepting the gift, L. D. Ar-nett, Librarian of the University, stated: "We are very glad to place the books in our Library, for we cannot but feel that this action of German students does not represent the best and sober mind of German scholars, and that the German peo-ple recognize the destruction of the works of such authors as a distinct loss of culture."

To Grill Latest Nazis On Jewish Affiliations

BERLIN, June 10-Examinations for all members of the Nazi party whose membership dates since January 30 of this year, on their asso-ciation or relationship with Jews, has been announced by the Nazir nas oven announced by the Nazi party headquarters for Hesse. Any members found to have associated with Jews, having Jewish wives, in-terested in Jewish concerns or to have violated the anti-Jewish boy-cott will be expelled from the party.

This continual agitation to keep the Jew isolated has resulted in a strengthening of the Jewish boycott. Germans are afraid to meet Jewish friends or to buy from Jews through fear of being denounced as being themselves of Jewish origin.
