## Arlosoroff Assassin Escaped to Lebanon, Arab Paper Reports

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

JERUSALEM, June 27.—Falastin, Arab daily newspaper, stated today it had learned that the murderer of Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff has escaped to Lebanon and that the Palestine police had asked the Lebanon police to extradite the man. The police officials here, however, later informed the Jewish Telegraphic Agency that the report published in Falastin was untrue.

Police here are continuing their investigation of Abraham Stavsky, who is being held in connection with Dr. Arlosoroff's assassination. The police insist that by their questioning of Stavsky they are working on the right track because footprints found near the scene of Dr. Arlosoroff's murder coincided with the measurements of Stavsky's footprints. Another reason police suspect Stavsky is that his landlady was the first to inform them against the Revisionist whereupon they started an immediate probe.

Mrs. Arlosoroff remained unshaken in her conviction that Stavsky was the man or one of the men who assassinated her husband. She

## Palestine Treasurer To London for Loan

JERUSALEM, June 27 — The treasurer of the Palestine Government, William Joseph Johnson, will proceed to London on July 7 in connection with the 2,000,000 pound loan for Palestine to be raised in London in connection with the French report on the development of Palestine, it was learned today.

Efforts to have the Jewish observations on the French report annexed to it in its official publication, have proven unavailing, and the Jewish Agency for Palestine is expected to issue its observations simultaneously with the French report, and independently. Whether the Arab Executive will follow this course could not be ascertained.

The French report, prepared by Lewis French, Director of Development, is known to follow generally the lines of the Simpson report which aroused an indignant storm of protest in Jewish circles.

## HITLER CABINET CONSIDERS PROHIBITION OF GERMAN-JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS IN REICH

BERLIN, June 27.—The future existence of Jewish organizations in Germany has been taken up by the Hitler cabinet in connection with the chancellor's recent warning that the Jews of Germany will be cut off from the rest of the world, it was learned today. Whether the decision to dissolve all of the German-Jewish communal, welfare and religious organizations was reached, or whether it was decided to permit some of them to continue functioning, could not be learned.

It is expected, nevertheless, that most Jewish organizations will be declared illegal in the near future, and will be raided by Nazi political police. The possibility is not excluded, however, that Max Naumann, rabid German nationalist and head of the Federation of Nationalist German Jews, may be named as special rapporteur for the government

on Jewish questions. Naumann, during consideration of the Bernheim petition by the League of Nations Council, protested to the League against the Bernheim petition on the grounds that the Jews in Upper Silesia were not a national minority. His federation recently endorsed and voted support of the "national resurgence."

Although Naumann is not considered persona grata with the Government, Jewish circles fear the possibility of his appointment as a rapporteur nevertheless. In this event, organizations such as the Zionist Federation and the Central Union of German Jews, it is feared, would suffer heavily. Naumann recently denounced Zionists as aliens to Germany.

A delegation composed of representatives of the central Jewish organizations attempted to obtain an audience with Chancellor Hitler only to be flatly rebuffed.

"I cannot find any interest in seeing Jews", Hitler was quoted as saying.

With the prohibition of the Stahlhelm, monarchist war veterans' organization, the Jews have lost their

## Labor Mayor Invites Huge Fascist March In Canadian City

MONTREAL, June 27 — Liberal circles in this country expressed surprise and consternation on hearing today of the announcement by Herve Ferland, the labor party mayor of Verdun, to the effect that he has invited the Fascist "troops" of this city to hold their Confederation Day parade in his town on July 1. The parade was officially banned by the city officials of Montreal.

The official uniform of the Canadian Fascist organization is a brown shirt, brown cap and black visor for the men, and a brown beret for the women. Anti-Semitism is one of the tenets held by the organization.

The recently-elected mayor of Verdun has announced his intentions of throwing the streets of his town wide open for the Fascists. Moreover, he has declared his willingness personally to canvass Verdun merchants to subscribe for floats.

The surprise here at Mayor Ferland's actions is due to the fact that

## Expelled Austrian Jews In Exodus from Germany

VIENNA, June 27.—Many Austrian Jews have already crossed the Austro-German borders following their expulsion from the Reich in a Nazi move in retaliation for the ouster of German Nazi leaders from Austria. Four hundred Austrian Jews who had lived in Germany were expected to reach the border tonight.

An official Government statement regarding the German action was expected here momentarily.

The Heimwehr press, which today reports it has confirmed earlier statements that the German Government had embarked on a retaliatory program, stated today that the Nazi authorities have notified all German business houses to compile lists of all Austrian Jews in their employ.

## Synagogue Fight Returns To Synagogue for Decision

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)  
PATERSON, N. J., June 27—A quarrel that began in a synagogue, resulting in charges and counter-charges of atrocious assault and battery, will be settled in the synagogue, according to a decision of Judge Thomas Kennedy of the Second District Criminal Court here.

Judge Kennedy agreed to permit Rabbi Rosen, chief orthodox rabbi here, to preside at the trial which will be held in a synagogue instead of in court. Both parties to the dispute, it is understood, have agreed to submit to Rabbi Rosen's rulings, and the court will also accept decision in the case.

## Ask Insignia Designate German Jewish Veterans

BERLIN, June 27—A suggestion that Jewish war veterans be permitted to display a specially designed insignia before their places of business, along the lines of the Aryan business establishment signs, is put forward by the Berliner Tageblatt, especially in view of the decision of the municipalities not to buy clothes for municipal dependents from Jewish firms. Since the Jewish war veterans are mentioned in many of the discriminatory laws as exempt from the provisions, the paper suggests that they be given these signs officially so that they will not be affected by the laws and will be exempted from the boycott.

## Commencement Exercises For German-Jewish Youth

The prediction that a Hohenzollern would eventually be restored to the throne of the Kaisers was made by James W. Gerard, former Ambassador to Germany, and the principal speaker at a special service held Monday evening at Temple Emanuel as commencement exercises for the Jewish youth of Germany who are no longer permitted to graduate there.

"I think," said Mr. Gerard, "that you will find a return to the monarchy when President von Hindenburg becomes mentally or physically enfeebled or passes away. The Hohenzollerns will come back and then the persecution of the Jews will end."

"Hitler made use of anti-Jewish prejudice in his march towards power; he played on the emotions of his followers and made a scapegoat of the Jewish race and religion. But it can't continue. There can be no expectation of peace in the world, when you see things happening as they are in Germany today."

A baccalaureate sermon was delivered by Rabbi A. Habas of the Central Synagogue of this city, and messages of sympathy were read from Governor Herbert H. Lehman, Dr. Mary H. Woolley, president of Mount Holyoke College; Dr. Frank Aydelotte, president of Swarthmore College; Dr. Frederick B. Robinson, president of the College of the City of New York, and Dr. W. A. Neilson, president of Smith College.

In his message, Governor Lehman said, "You young men and women who are participating in this affair are guaranteed by our free institutions the privilege of carrying on your studies. The young men and women in Germany, however, of the same age and conditions as you, are unfortunately denied even the privilege of an education under present conditions. The injustice of this situation must appeal strongly to you."

Among the other speakers were James Marshall and Rabbi Jonah B. Wise.

## Scouts Honor Dr. Adler

Dr. Cyrus Adler, president of the Jewish Theological Seminary, and president of Dropsie College, has received a message of appreciation from the Boy Scouts of America for his leadership and assistance in bringing scouting to an increasing number of Jewish boys. The message was signed by Dr. James E. West, chief scout executive of the Boy Scouts of America. At a recent meeting of the National Executive of the Boy Scouts, Dr. Adler was the recipient of the Silver Buffalo, the highest honor given annually for distinguished service to boyhood.

## Dr. Weizmann Reception Tonight at Carnegie Hall

Dr. Chaim Weizmann will be tendered a reception by New York Jewry at Carnegie Hall tonight. The world Zionist leader, who arrived here last week to be guest of honor at Jewish Day, Chicago Century of progress Exposition, next Monday, is expected to discuss the possibilities of large-scale settlement of Palestine at the reception tonight.

Samuel Untermyer, chairman of the reception committee, will open the meeting. Other speakers will include Louis Lipsky, Morris Rothenberg and Rabbi Samuel Schulman.

## Nazis Officially Destroy Graves of Jewish Dead

BERLIN, June 27—The National Socialist Party of Adolf Hitler, in its efforts to purge Germany of alien influence has now turned its attentions to the graves of the Jewish dead. The Hitlerized Municipal Council of Munich, by a decree adopted yesterday, orders the graves of two Jews, Kurt Eisner, first Socialist premier of Bavaria, and Gustav Landauer, Socialist writer, "to be obliterated and regarded as expunged, their tombstones to be demolished, the bodies of both to be exhumed and the ashes to be given to the Jewish community."

Eisner was the victim of monarchistic assassins in 1919.

## Maryland Pharmacist Body Protest Nazi Drive on Jews

OCEAN CITY, Md., June 27—Resolution protesting persecution of Jews in Germany by the Hitler Government and discrimination against Jewish pharmacists and professional men in Germany have been adopted by the Maryland Pharmaceutical Society and the Delaware Pharmaceutical Society in joint session here.

The joint resolutions were introduced by Dr. Robert L. Swain, of Baltimore, and copies were ordered sent to President Roosevelt and the two houses of Congress.

Dr. Swain is editor of the "Maryland Pharmacist," the publication of the Maryland society.

## Los Angeles Memorial Meeting

LOS ANGELES, Cal., June 27—All factions of Palestinian interests and activities in Los Angeles and vicinity will unite in a memorial meeting tomorrow evening at the Council House Auditorium in honor of Dr. Chaim Arlossoff, who was assassinated in Palestine.

## Dr. Karpf Drafting Plan To Train Workers on Federal Relief Program

WASHINGTON, June 27—A plan for training workers to be engaged in carrying out the provisions of the \$500,000,000 Federal emergency relief act is being drafted by Dr. Maurice J. Karpf, nationally known Jewish social service worker, it was learned today.

Dr. Karpf was in Washington yesterday at the request of the relief administrators to consult on such a training program. He has been assigned the task of outlining a plan to train the several thousand who will be needed to carry out the relief work.

He conferred yesterday with Harry Hopkins, federal relief administrator, and following the conference, began to map out the program which, it is understood, will scientifically train not only the federal workers engaged in the relief program but also those who will be employed in the various states.

In view of his being called here to draft the program, it is likely that Dr. Karpf will be asked to direct the training program. Dr. Karpf is director of the Graduate School for Jewish Social Work and president of the American Association of Schools for Social Work.

## Alonzo Stagg to Referee Jewish Games at Chicago

CHICAGO, June 27—Coach Amos Alonzo Stagg, football coach at the University of Chicago for the last forty years, has agreed to act as head referee at the Jewish Youth Athletic Tournament which will be held in connection with the Jewish Day of the Century of Progress Exposition here next Sunday afternoon.

Three thousand young men and women, including many city, state and national record holders, have already been enrolled for the preliminary tournaments which will be held simultaneously at Chase Park, Ogden Park and Douglas Park tomorrow. The final events will be run off in Douglas Park on Sunday.

### Cleveland Relief Drive Opens

CLEVELAND, June 27 — The Cleveland campaign for the relief of German Jews, began here with a banquet at which the chairman, Judge Maurice Bernon, executive secretary of the campaign, announced gifts totaling \$10,000. Two anonymous donors contributed \$7,500 and \$2,000 respectively and the rest was raised among the 500 campaign workers who attended the banquet. Miss Dorothy Thompson and Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver were the principal speakers.

## Einstein Welcome in Reich?

LOS ANGELES, June 27 — Citizens of this city have just learned that tales of persecution of Jews in Germany are "absolutely false." Dr. George Gysling, new German vice consul here has so informed them.

"Professor Einstein would be perfectly welcome in Germany," Dr. Gysling stated. He added that "the few Jews who have met with violence in Germany have not been singled out because of their race but because they were Communist leaders and agitators."

All this brought a vigorous denial from Joseph Jonah Cummins, publisher of the B'nai Brith Messenger. Speaking over Station KELW, Cummins reminded his listeners that Dr. Gysling's predecessor had also tried to make people here believe these statements.

## Mandates Body Queries Young on Settlement of Refugees in Palestine

GENEVA, June 27—The League of Nations Mandates Commission began discussion of the Palestine mandate today in a private session. It was learned that members of the commission addressed a number of inquiries to Mark Aicheson Young, retiring chief secretary of the Palestine Government who is representing the administration here prior to taking up his new duties as governor of the Barbados Islands. These questions revolved around the possibility of German Jewish immigration into Palestine and about the progress made in working out a legislative form of government.

Referring to the possibilities of Transjordanian settlement by Jews, Mr. Young stated that while individual Jewish immigration into Transjordan might be considered, larger scale settlement could not be on account of the absence of conditions of security.

## Rabbi Braude Appointed Chaplain

SYRACUSE, June 27 — Rev. Moses J. Braude, cantor and assistant rabbi of the new Temple Beth Israel for the past 33 years since his arrival here from Baltimore, has been appointed as the new chaplain of the Onondaga Penitentiary and Onondaga Sanatorium. In taking charge of these two institutions, Rev. Braude succeeds Rabbi Joshua Zambrowsky, who resigned to accept a new appointment in Buffalo.

## Palestine Sole Solution Of Jewish Problem, Sons of Zion Resolve

LONG BRANCH, N. J., June 27 — Palestine was termed the only solution to the Jewish problem, at the concluding sessions of the 24th annual convention of the Order Sons of Zion here yesterday. After stating that "the post-war economic and financial conditions have caused the ruin of millions of Jews throughout the world, have made intolerance and persecution of Jews rampant in many countries and intensified the acuteness of the so-called Jewish problem", the delegates adopted a resolution stating that "the only solution of the Jewish problem is Herzlian Zionism, that is to say, a Jewish commonwealth in the land of Israel, within its historic boundaries on both sides of the River Jordan."

An impromptu debate was called forth between general Zionists headed by Morris Zeldin and the Revisionist group within the Order ranks, with Elias Ginsburg as spokesman, on the resolution which suggested national arbitration as a means of settling disputes between capital and labor, as well as intra-laborite friction, in Palestine. ## Havana Jewry Upset By Ban on Meetings

HAVANA, June 21—Local Jewry is still in a state of unrest and indecision as a result of the withdrawal, for the second time, of permission by the military commandant to hold a protest demonstration against the Hitler atrocities. This meeting was to have been held June 13. When the meeting was first prohibited, intervention on the part of local Jewish organizations brought the statement from General Herero, Minister of War and acting Minister of Foreign Affairs, that he saw no reason why the Jews should not be permitted to hold a meeting. When asked why the meeting was again prohibited, General Herero stated that he feared that those Jews who are against a protest movement would make trouble. (There is, however, no real indication that such would be the case).

Jewish organizations in Havana cannot agree on a definite stand in the matter. Some are of the opinion that the decision of the military commandant should be accepted, whereas others believe that the matter should be taken up with President Machado and with the American Jewish Congress, which would be asked to intervene.

A meeting at which the presidents of all Jewish institutions in Havana were to consider the matter has also been prohibited.

fainted when she got her first view of Stavsky in the identification parade at police headquarters.

The mystery of the dead Jew who was found near Kiryat-Anavim was solved when he was identified yesterday as Joshua Gozavatzker, 25, who was living in Tel Aviv with his mother and brother and was employed as an electrician.

Suspicion that there was some connection between the dead man and the Arlosoroff murder was dissipated when authorities definitely declared Gozavatzker was a suicide.

The man who took his own life was a moderately active member of Histadruth, Zionist labor organization. A week ago he left Tel Aviv ostensibly bound for a holiday in Kechoboth. But he never returned and following the publication of the picture of his body in all papers throughout Palestine his family today identified him.

This afternoon police made a thorough search of his house in Tel Aviv, but discovered nothing of a suspicious nature. Gozavatzker's suicide was caused by his melancholic brooding for more than a year, according to his brother.

## Frankfurt Disturbances

INNSBRUCK, June 27.—Serious anti-Semitic disturbances broke out in Frankfurt-am-Main, Germany, over the week-end, it was learned here. Thousands of Nazi demonstrators paraded through the streets with shouts of "Kill the Jews, Close Jewish stores!" which were picked up and amplified by loud-speakers.

Spectators who did not take off their hats when the procession went by, were set upon and badly beaten in the presence of the police who failed to interfere.

his election to office was supported by the Canadian Commonwealth Federation, affiliated with the labor party. This week laborites here are sponsoring a big mass meeting against fascism in Canada and to protest at Hitlerism and anti-Semitism in Germany. Prominent labor leaders will address the gathering.

From reliable sources it is learned that the membership rolls of the Fascist Federation of Labor Clubs of Quebec Province now carry 75,000 names. These members are divided among 76 clubs. There is a women's auxiliary of 41 clubs with a membership of 42,000 persons. It is asserted in some sources that there is a semi-militaristic organization within the federation, composed of more than 2,000 "troops."

defeated this resolution the delegates did go on record as requesting its delegates to the forthcoming 18th World Zionist Congress, soon to take place, "to find a way of harmonious co-operation and co-ordination between capital and labor and all Zionist factions in Palestine without favoritism to any of the groups."

In another resolution, the delegates asserted that "the present system of immigration into Palestine is wholly inadequate and not in keeping with the letter and spirit of the Mandate over Palestine, entrusted by the League of Nations to Great Britain." The convention, therefore, demanded "placing of the control of immigration in the hands of a properly constituted Jewish Agency, recognized by the Zionist Congress, subject to supervision of the Mandatory power."

The convention also adopted a resolution asking "commensurate representation" from the Zionist Organization of America, of which the Order is a constituent.

By unanimous vote, the convention decided to inscribe the name of its retiring grandmaster, Isaac Allen, of New York, in the Golden Book of the Jewish National Fund. Mr. Allen declined renomination after serving three consecutive terms.

Joseph Kramer of Newark was elected grand master; Harry A. Pine, first vice-grand master; Louis Myers, second vice-grand master; Jacob Kaplan, grand secretary, and Louis Rimsky, grand treasurer.
