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Boycott Against Jews Intensified by Hitlerites In Nation-Wide Drive (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, July 1—A wild and bitter anti-Jewish boycott movement is once again raging throughout Germany, and the spirit of the boycott is so intense that it is unquestionably managed and directed by Nazi officials with typical bureaucratic thoroughness. As was pre-announced in Dr. Paul Joseph Goebbels' speech in Hamburg last week, in which he stated that the Hitler government does not intend to make any compromises regarding its Jewish policies, an organized campaign has been started by the Nazi press in many cities, inciting the populace against Jewish merchants, who are called "criminals."

In many towns scattered far and wide throughout the country brown-shirt pickets are stationed by the authorities outside Jewish shops. In other towns lists are being compiled of persons who patronize stores owned or managed by Jews, with the view of threatening these persons into buying their goods elsewhere.

Christian Names Pilloried

In Quedlinburg and Wernigerode, Prussia, pillories were erected this week in the public market. On the pillories artistically-inclined Nazis have branded the names of Christian merchants buying from Jewish wholesalers and Christian women buying from Jewish retail stores.

Nazis in the town of Gorbachwald pasted "shame-lists" in their shop windows, recording the names of persons who patronize Jewish

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Union of German Jews Dissolved in Thuringia (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, July 1—The branches of the Central Union of German Jews have been dissolved all over Thuringia today, following an order issued by the Thuringian minister of the interior. Jews were prohibited from holding further meetings, according to the order.

The minister based the authority for his edict on article one of the president's ordinance "for the protection of the nation and the country."

OPEN WIDE PALESTINE'S DOORS, ROTHENBERG PLEADS IN REPORT TO ZIONIST EXECUTIVE (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

CHICAGO, July 1—Addressing the Executive Committee of the Zionist Organization of America, at a session preceding the calling to order of the thirty-sixth annual convention of American Zionism Morris Rothenberg, president, tonight submitted his annual report. Therein he outlined the political program of the Zionist Organization as it affects the rebuilding of the Jewish National Home, deplored the failure of Great Britain, the Mandatory Power, to allot a greater number of immigration certificates, but at the same time praised the High Commissioner, Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchop for his co-operation with the Jews of Palestine.

The German Jewish crisis overshadowed every other subject of discussion in the Zionist circle conference throughout the day as the majority of the 5,000 delegates assembled here, the largest number for any American convention on record.

In the opinion of Zionist leaders this is the most important convention in many years, since a definite program must be formulated for the guidance of the delegates to the World Zionist Congress in dealing with a situation more critical than any since the massacres at Kishineff.

A Jew and King of Jews! Nazi Blast at Morgan (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, July 1—Although it is well known everywhere else in the world that J. P. Morgan is a pure Aryan, the Nazi press today printed blasting articles condemning him, not only as a Jew, but even as "the un-crowned Jew king." The Nazis are angry at the American financier because of his anti-German statements made recently in the United States.

Replying to Mr. Morgan's statements criticizing Germany, the Prussian Press Department of the Nazi party circulated an article written by Wilhelm Berger, Reichstag member, condemning him as a Jew.

Among the proposals to be formulated here for presentation to the World Zionist Congress will be a demand for the settlement of 25,000 Jews in Palestine annually, for the next four years and that the executive of the Jewish Agency be elected for four years instead of two.

A strong fight is expected to be waged to secure the adoption by the Agency of the American Zionist proposal for a loan sponsored by the League of Nations to enable German Jews to settle in Palestine.

The spirit animating the convention, as manifested today, was that the situation facing world Jewry was one calling for action, and not merely the passage of the right resolutions.

Summing up the work of the Zionist Organization of America in helping American Jews to settle in Palestine, Mr. Rothenberg stated that for the year from July 1, 1932 to June 1, 1933, the organization had cleared the cases of 1,662 men

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Nazis Kill Jewish Lawyer At Dachau Prison Camp (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

INNSBRUCK, July 1—A Jewish lawyer from Munich, Herr Spiegel, has been shot down in the Dachau Concentration Camp, it was learned here today.

Spiegel attracted worldwide notice recently when photographs taken in Munich were published in foreign countries showing him undergoing indignities at the hands of the Nazis.

The pictures showed Spiegel being marched down the street with his trousers in shreds and a board hung around his neck on which was printed the statement: "Never again will I complain against the Nazis to the police."

In an official statement today authorities at the concentration camp said that Spiegel was shot while attempting to escape, but since it is well known that the Dachau camp is surrounded by electrified barbed wire, the official excuse is obviously false.

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Argentinian Professor, Fired Urging Fascism, Fired

BUENOS AIRES—Carlos Silveiro, professor of mathematics at the Colegio Mariano Moreno, has been dismissed by the minister of education for advocating Fascism during his lectures.

The minister took this step when a number of students, many of them Jewish, called a strike against the professor and demanded that he be discharged.

When the students assembled outside the college in order not to let strike-breakers in, the vice-rector came out and asked that "Argentinians" come into the building, leaving the Jews outside. However, the young students, who, apparently, have not yet been sufficiently "enlightened" politically, did not know which of them were not "Argentinians" and therefore could not follow the instructions of their anti-Semitic rector.

Hebrew Free Loan Society Lends a Million to Needy

More than 13,000 men and women throughout the five boroughs comprising New York were extended non-interest bearing loans to the tune of almost a million dollars during the past fiscal year by the Hebrew Free Loan Society, the president of that organization, Julius J. Dukas, announced.

This association is one of the ninety-one component bodies of the Federation for the Support of Jewish Philanthropic Societies. In his report, Mr. Dukas pointed out that the society lost no more during the period of depression than it had in prosperous years, or no more than one-half of one percent of the sums loaned.

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and women who wished to settle in Palestine. These had brought into the country a capital of \$3,138,046.

12 Millions in Investments

Reviewing the progress in Palestine, Mr. Rothenberg stated that 20,000 Jews had entered the Jewish National Home in the last eighteen months. An indication of the capital influx into the country is found in the fact that in 1932 there were new investments in Palestine totalling more than \$12,000,000.

In the course of his report, Mr. Rothenberg said:

"The calamity that has overtaken the 600,000 Jews in Germany has cast a shadow over everything else in Jewish life. Its colossal character and the terrible consequences accompanying it becomes more apparent with the lapse of time.

"In this tragic situation, aggravated by a world depression which has affected Jews as other peoples everywhere, the progress of the Jewish National Home during the past year takes on new significance for the Jewish people.

"The past year was one of steady economic growth in Palestine. In the main the advance is to be attributed to the uninterrupted flow of Jewish energy and Jewish capital into the country, so that today Palestine stands out as one of the few lands which is relatively prosperous and which shows every sign of increasing absorptive capacity.

Immigration Increase

"During the year 1932 Palestine had a net increase in the Jewish population of approximately 10,000 Jews as against 3,136 in 1931. To this must be added a further increase during the first six months of 1933 of at least 10,000 Jews, making a total increase of 20,000 Jews in eighteen months.

"Together with the increase in immigration there was a corresponding increase in the influx of capital into the country. It is estimated that new investments in Palestine during 1932 amounted to approximately £3,500,000.

Closed Industries Reopen

"In the field of industry Palestine continued to escape the worst effects of the world depression and to make steady progress, especially in Tel-Aviv and Haifa. New industries have been established during the year and several which had previously closed down in the depression of 1927-28, were reopened. An event of the greatest significance for the future economic development of Palestine is the opening of the Haifa Harbor.

"The Palestine Electric Corporation has completed its hydro-electric

power house on the river Jordan and now supplies the whole power distributed by the corporation. Palestine Potash, Ltd., working on the Dead Sea, increases its plant and is now greatly exceeding its former production.

"In the field of agriculture most notable event to be recorded is the consolidation of existing Keren Hayosed settlements. Few new settlements were established, but the old holdings have been cultivated more intensively. Most of the Keren Hayosed colonies have not turned the corner and are self-supporting. This has added greatly to the actual increase of Jewish wealth in Palestine. The extraordinary advance in the economic development of Palestine is best indicated by the finances of the Palestine Government. The total revenue, excluding railways and grants-in-aid, has increased by over £500,000 and the Government now has an accumulated surplus of about £1,000,000.

Political Relations

"The political relations between the Jewish Agency and the Mandatory Power have happily improved during the past year. Much credit for this is due to the present High Commissioner, Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchope, who has shown a sympathetic understanding of the aims of the Zionist movement and of the obligations of the Mandatory Power under the Mandate. A significant contribution in that direction was made by Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff whose tragic death by the dastard hand of an assassin has brought an untimely end a brilliant career dedicated to Jewish National service.

"Despite the advance that has been made toward better relations it must be recorded that much still to be done by the Mandatory Government to meet both the letter and the spirit of the Mandate. Economic progress is inextricably bound up with political security. The safeguarding of political rights in Palestine is the foundation of our work. The characteristic feature of the Zionist program is to endow the Jewish people with national status in Palestine. Our economic achievements in Palestine only take on significance in the light of the recognition of this basic aim and its implications for free and complete Jewish life.

Liberal Immigration Needed

"In the integration of this principle, an increasingly liberal immigration policy is indispensable. While we take satisfaction in the rise in immigration during the past year the figures do not as yet represent

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"How Nero Burned Rome," Sold on Streets of Berlin, Also Tells of Reichstag Fire

LONDON—The Jewish Times here reports that Berlin is agog with a new sensation. A cheaply-published brochure, selling for a pfennig, and entitled "How Nero Burnt Rome," appeared on the streets of the city and was sold by the dozens of copies.

The first pages of the brochure really tell about Nero's burning of the ancient city, but the rest of the pamphlet is devoted to an account of the burning of the Reichstag. Goering, the story says, agreed to the burning of the Reichstag when twelve members of Nazi Storm Troop 17 came to him and announced their incendiary intention. According to the story told in the brochure, Goering, hearing this, said that if they did so he would have them arrested, but that from his tone the Nazis inferred that their plan had his sanction.

Whereupon, the pamphlet says, the Nazis, with the help of Van de Lube, set fire to the Reichstag. The Nazis were given an opportunity to disappear into safe hideaways, but Van de Lube, a native of Holland, was arrested. His trial is being postponed until such evidence can be prepared as will bury the truth forever.

Characteristically, the Nazi police did not realize for some time the exact nature of the pamphlet, "How Nero Burned Rome," so that many copies were sold before it was confiscated.

"Come to Austria"

U. S. Tourists Urged

CINCINNATI, July 1—A plea to American tourists to favor Austrian summer resorts has been received at B'nai B'rith National Headquarters here from Dr. Moritz Schnabl, president of the Austrian B'nai B'rith District.

The German Nazis, Dr. Schnabl explains, have been boycotting summer resorts in the western part of Austria to such an extent that those who make their living from such resorts fear they will be without tourist trade from Germany this summer.

"This situation is being used by the National Socialists in Austria to stir up enmity against our government," Dr. Schnabl writes. "It is therefore in the interest of the Jews that the Austrian summer resorts be visited by tourists from other nations."

"There is every reason to believe," he added, "that the National Socialists will make no further progress (in Austria) but will lose many of their followers in consequence of the energetic measures which our government has taken."

Lawyers at Hague to Sift Reichstag Fire Evidence as Accused Tried at Leipzig

AMSTERDAM, July 1—While the five communists accused of setting fire to the Reichstag building in Berlin are being tried in Leipzig some time late this summer, a parallel trial will be organized at The Hague, in which lawyers from nine countries will take part, it was learned today. Clarence Darrow, famous American lawyer, will be one of counsel, it was stated.

The lawyers and judges will hear more than 25 witnesses and compare evidence at the same time that the trial is taking place in Leipzig. Evidence at The Hague will be supplied by witnesses who will not be in danger of being terrorized by the Nazis.

Jewish journalists expelled from Germany, led by Otto Katz, will compile evidence for the guidance of the lawyers.

Frau Wagner Denies Romance With Hitler

LONDON, June 23—According to the Evening Standard here, Frau Winifred Wagner, the English-born widow of Siegfried Wagner and director of the Bayreuth Festival, has denied the rumor prevalent on the Continent that there is a romance between her and Adolf Hitler, or that their friendship has been affected by her engagement of two Jewish singers for the festival next month.

Frau Wagner stated:

"I have known Hitler a long time. There is an old friendship between us, but love, no. We have never been in love. I know there has been a lot of talk about our supposed romance, but there is no truth in it, not a word."

The Best for Bayreuth

"I have not seen Herr Hitler for about two months, when I had a talk with him about foreign artists appearing in Germany. We did not discuss the question of the Jews in the musical world, and I can assure you that the engagement of Kipnis and List to sing at the Bayreuth Festival will not in any way affect a friendship that has never been more than a friendship."

"Alexander Kipnis and Emanuel List are Americans and are among the best singers in the world. I have engaged them because we must try to get the best for Bayreuth."

"I believe that they are Jews, but all that matters to me is that they have wonderful voices. Not for a moment do I anticipate any consequences through having Jews taking part in the festival. I am hopeful that art will triumph over na-

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Exiles, Lured Back by Nazi Promises, Clapped into Jail

LONDON, July 1—The gruesome details of how German-Jewish refugees have been lured back to Germany with the promise of freedom and then arrested and sentenced to terms in prisons or concentration camps upon their return were related in today's Manchester Guardian.

The newspaper stated further that leaders in the fur business in London are greatly perturbed over the Nazis' treatment of German-Jewish fur traders who escaped to England, Paris and Warsaw from Leipzig. A few weeks ago these refugees received offers from Nazi headquarters in Berlin to return to Leipzig, where they were promised freedom from molestation and help in their efforts to restore equilibrium to the dilapidated German fur trade. Many accepted the "kind" offer of the Nazis and returned, whereupon they were immediately clapped into jail after being sentenced to long terms of imprisonment. They were charged with organizing their industry outside of Germany.

At a result of this brutal treatment of German-Jewish fur merchants a conflict is looming between fur traders elsewhere and the Hitler government.

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a satisfactory growth of the Jewish population in the national home. The soundness of the formula that immigration must proceed in consonance with the absorptive capacity of the country is not to be challenged. But the formula that immigration should be guided by the absorptive capacity of the country is sound only if adopted in a positive sense.

"The time has come for giving a new interpretation to that formula. Hitherto the phrase has been employed in a negative sense, and was so used as to constrict the Jewish National Home. That an absorptive capacity is itself promoted by immigration is proved by the experience of the last few years. The satisfactory economic condition in Palestine is factually in large measure the result of Jewish immigration. Of course there will be those who may be expected to show opposition to an increased immigration, but they will object under all circumstances. We have a right to expect that the Mandatory Power will not be deflected from pursuing a policy proven to promote the best interests of the country.

"Aside from the fact that a homeless people whose tragic lot has been accentuated by a new calamity, is knocking at the door of the ancient land internationally recognized as its rightful home, it should not be overlooked that the expansion of Palestine has in every manner benefited the Arabs as well. Apart from the benefits which they are enjoying as a result of the economic growth of Palestine, Jews are paying directly to the Arabs in wages, rentals, and purchase of agricultural products over £500,000 more than received from them in a similar way.

Fears Income Tax

"There is much still to be achieved in improving the Government's attitude in connection with school work, the health service, employment of Jewish labor in public works. The question of taxation also rouses considerable concern. The proposal of an income tax by the Government can only mean a check to the inflow of capital, and seems wholly unwarranted at a time when the Government has a large surplus in its treasury.

"The expressed intention of the High Commissioner to proceed with the organization of a Legislative Council gives cause for serious anx-

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tionality." Frau Wagner's statement has created tremendous interest here and on the Continent, as it will be remembered that she was the woman who in many ways was responsible for Hitler's rise to power. Her desire for a title in past years is said by many to have been her reason for boosting Hitler's stock and introducing him to the right circles in Germany after Hitler was imprisoned following the Munich Beer Hall putsch.

The questions now being debated in many circles here is whether Frau Wagner will be as anti-Semitic as her family was well known to be. If she is true to her word and employs Jews at the Bayreuth Festival it is a matter of conjecture whether Herr Hitler will turn round on her, as he has done on many of his old friends and aides, and cancel the famous musical festival.
