New Law Fixes Quota of Non-Aryans in Universities; Eastern Jews Excluded

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, July 6—Restriction of the number of foreign Jewish students in Germany and strict enforcement of the numerus clausus limiting German-Jewish students to one and one-half percent of the total university enrollment was announced in today's new educational law limiting the rights and numbers of Jews seeking an education.

The regulations provide:

1.—At those universities where the number of Jews enrolled has already reached one and one-half percent of the total enrollment, no Jewish students at all must be admitted next term.

2.—At those universities where the quota of one and one-half percent has not yet been reached, Jewish students may be admitted next term up to the quota, under certain conditions.

3.—The administrative board of every university is entitled to admit

1,500 Jewish Physicians Expelled from Sick Funds in Berlin; 6,000 in Reich

BERLIN, July 6—More than 1,500 Jewish doctors have been expelled by the Berlin sick funds alone, up to July 1, while throughout Germany the number exceeds 6,000, a check here today revealed.

Dr. Wilhelm Frick, Nazi minister of the interior, at a meeting of editors of medical publications, today told them that he considers it the duty of every German doctor to be guided by race principles, because the question of pure German blood is also the question of a pure German race.

The doctors were addressed in a similar strain by Franz Seldte, Reich minister of labor, who declared that German doctors must eliminate everything foreign from the German medical system.

ZIONIST CONVENTION RATIFIES HADASSAH SHARE IN NAMING PRAGUE DELEGATES; CHOOSE WEIZMANN AS WORLD LEADER

CHICAGO, July 5—An agreement whereby the Zionist Organization of America and Hadassah will each name ten delegates to the World Zionist Congress at Prague on a coalition ticket was ratified by the conference here late last night after bitter discussion on the floor. The convention also approved the recommendation that the committee on organization terminate the present agreements with the affiliated bodies, Hadassah and Order Sons of Zion, by November, and have the administration negotiate for a new deal.

The convention went on record through a resolution adopted as favoring the elevation of Dr. Chaim Weizmann to world Zionist leader-

ship. The resolution called on all Zionist parties and factions to unite to meet the present crisis under coalition leadership by the world organization, and urged the World Zionist Congress "to call upon Dr. Chaim Weizmann to assume his place in such a leadership."

Palestine a Reply to Foes

Dr. Weizmann, in paying a farewell visit to the convention, referred to the world congress and promised that "If there is work to be done I shall try to do my share." He electrified the audience with his announcement that Dr. Einstein has agreed to head the Institute of Physics in the Hebrew University. Reforms urged by Dr. Einstein in the structure of the university administration would be carried out, Dr. Weizmann declared. He urged a "powerful, proud and peaceful Palestine" as the best answer to the anti-Semitic allegation that Jews are unconstructive and live off the cultures of other people.

Koenigsberg Mob Drives Jews from Courthouse; Berlin Non-Aryans Warned

BERLIN, July 6—All Jewish lawyers were driven out of court in Koenigsberg, Prussia, today, while Jewish lawyers in Berlin received the polite warning to refrain from appearing in courts here "for their own safety."

The Koenigsberg manhunt for Jewish lawyers started in the court on the Hitlerplatz there. Crowds invaded the court building, shouting "Down with Jews!" and interrupted the court sessions. They demanded that all Jewish lawyers and judges leave immediately. Crowds soon collected in the courtroom and masses gathered outside. Non-Jewish lawyers and judges intervened and tried to pacify the mobs, but were unsuccessful.

Similar scenes also took place in other courts in Koenigsberg, Jewish lawyers being forced to flee from excited bloodthirsty mobs.

Nazi Attack and Kidnap Polish Dentists in Berlin; Friends Fear for Lives

INNSBRUCK, July 6—The disappearance of two Jewish dentists, both of whom are Polish citizens, has caused consternation in foreign circles in Berlin, because it is now feared that even foreigners are unsafe from kidnappings at the hands of uniformed Nazi storm troopers.

The two dentists were Dr. Julius and Dr. Otto Blachalts, both well known in Berlin, and having a reputation as leaders in their profession.

Yesterday they were surprised in their homes by storm troopers who, after mistreating them, carried them off to an unknown place. It is believed that they are being forcibly detained at present in some Nazi secret cellar.

The reason for their kidnaping is said to be that the abductors suspected their assistants, even though the latter were members of the Nazi party without their employers being aware of this fact. It is said that a quarrel arose in regard to the matter of the assistants working for Jews, resulting eventually in the kidnaping.

The Polish consul here has taken the matter up with the German authorities.

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DOLLFUSS WAR ON HITLERISM LIFTS LOAD FROM AUSTRIAN JEWRY, OBSERVER REPORTS

"We in America can never realize the profound effect the victory of Hitlerism in Germany had upon the Jews of Austria," said Dr. Samuel R. Wachtell, who has just returned from an extended business trip through Austria and Hungary. "Upon the minds and consciousness of the Jews of Austria was imprinted the dreadful fear that they would share the fate of their German brethren. They felt that they were living literally on the edge of the abyss. Now that fear is lifted and they are catching their breath."

Dr. Wachtell is a member of the legal firm of Wachtell, Mannheim and Grouf, which represents many Austrian and Hungarian clients in this country.

"When I reached Paris," he said, "I went to the railroad station to arrange my passage to Vienna. I knew that there were two routes, one that went through Germany and another through Switzerland. Naturally I chose the Swiss route, but found it difficult to obtain a reservation, the trains that avoided Germany being crowded to capacity."

Into Germany After All

"Finally I got a ticket and boarded the train. About four the next morning I was awakened by a horrid dream in which Storm Troopers had seized me and were going to show me exactly what would happen to an American advocate of the anti-German boycott. When I drew the blind of the sleeper, I saw that we were in Stuttgart, Germany, and the porter informed me that we would reach Austria at noon. That morning I fasted, but none the less the Reichsbahn [German railroad system] received money that had never been intended for them."

"Everywhere I went, both in Austria and Hungary," declared Dr. Wachtell, "the sole topic of conversation among Jews and even Gentiles was Hitlerism. This is true today when the situation has cleared considerably and Hitlerism is no longer the menace it was, in Austria."

Dr. Wachtell brought back the news that Chancellor Dollfuss is extremely popular in Austria today, primarily as a result of the excellent press he received in the various countries of Europe. "The Austrians, like all civilized people, are somewhat cynical and sceptical of their contemporary great men. But they have suddenly awakened to the fact that the world thinks Dollfuss a great man. Now they also think so. Dollfuss's prestige has won over the straddlers and Hitlerism in Austria is on the down-grade. Another important factor in the situa-

tion has been the attitude of the responsible spokesmen of the Catholic Church in Austria, who took a very reasonable and liberal position. The Jews are swimming along with this powerful current, so that at the present time, their position is secure."

"The Austrian Jews, even those who were farthest from Judaism, are now race conscious and proudly so."

"Another effect of Hitlerism has been the creation of an ironclad boycott of all German goods in Vienna and all Austria," said Dr. Wachtell. "German goods are not even being shown in many places. I went to a department store in company with some Gentile friends in order to purchase a gift for a friend. The saleslady showed us a beautiful umbrella of a type formerly made in Germany and before I even had a chance to ask, said very quickly, 'I assure you this was not made in Germany'. Only one store in all Vienna still carries the once familiar sign, 'Jewish patronage is not desired' and when I inquired I was told that they are doing very little business."

Dr. Wachtell told of a conversation with Dr. Richard Beer-Hoffmann, the great Austrian-Jewish poet. Dr. Hoffmann's books were burned in the Berlin bonfire. For some time the poet went around in a daze, utterly unable to realize the full implications of what had happened. Then Dr. Hoffman became desperately ill. Now, upon his convalescent bed, he declared "there are two gains to be counted as the result of Hitlerism: a heightened Zionist consciousness and a heightened sense of racial pride and consciousness."

Worse Than Bolshevism

"And if you want to know what some of the Germans think of Hitlerism," said Dr. Wachtell, "let me tell you of a conversation related to me by a great Austrian industrialist. This gentleman had a conference with one of his important German customers, also a manufacturer."

"After their business was concluded, the German asked the Viennese, 'What are you doing about Hitler?' The Austrian, terribly embarrassed and afraid to lose a customer, mumbled something about Dollfuss taking some steps to maintain Austrian independence. 'You fools,' exclaimed the German, 'don't you see what has happened to us? We German industrialists supported Hitler, thinking he would save us from Bolshevism. Now we have something worse than Bolshevism. If you have any sense you will fight as though your backs were against the wall. Otherwise our fate will be yours.'"

Mr. Rosenblatt's letter follows:

"On behalf of my bereaved mother, her brothers, sisters, and myself, I wish to take this means of expressing to all of you our sincerest appreciation for the very touching tribute which you, his colleagues, paid to the everlasting memory of our sainted father, Cantor Josef Rosenblatt, at the memorial services which you conducted at Carnegie Hall on last Tuesday evening."

"At this hour of grief, your deep-felt sorrow and sympathies are a great consolation to us and will help to lighten the burden of our insufferable loss."

"We are extremely grateful to you."

Madame Tobias, Yiddish Stage Star, 60, Is Dead

Nettie Tobias, who died here Monday at the age of 60, was formerly one of the most talented and best-known actresses on the Yiddish stage. Madame Tobias, whose real name was Tabachnikoff, began her stage career in the chorus of the old Windsor Theatre on the Bowery. Advancement came when she won the admiration of critics and audience in a role which she played with only a few hours' notice, as substitute for one of the leading actresses of the Windsor troupe.

Madame Tobias is survived by three children, two of whom are on the English stage.

Sterilization of Jews Proposed in Magazine As Purge for Disease

BERLIN, July 6—Sterilization of German Jews was proposed today in an article discussing eugenic legislation published in the Rostock University magazine.

The article claimed that it has been proved Jews mostly suffer from hereditary diseases, and predicted that the Third Reich will shortly pass a new law preventing the spreading of diseases by means of sterilization. At the end of the article it was admitted—with regrets—that this would not offer a complete solution to the Jewish problem.

As Von Papen Pulls Strings, Vatican Organ Calls Hitler Policy of Hate Barbarous

ROME, July 6—A subtle blow was struck at Hitlerism when in the midst of the negotiations between Germany's Vice-Chancellor, Franz von Papen, and Cardinal Pacelli over the question of a concordat, the Osservatore Romano, semi-official Vatican organ, appeared with an article attacking the anti-Semitic policy of the Nazis.

"The editorial condemned the Nazis' racial principles as 'materialistic and doctrinaire, verging on idolatry.' Racial nationalism, such as Hitler and his followers profess, declared the paper, went against the grain of history, science, politics and religion.

"In the twentieth century we again have to choose between racial hatred and Christian love and between barbarism and culture," the article concluded.

Berlin Group Opposing Anti-Semitism Disbanded

BERLIN, July 6—The Association for Combatting Anti-Semitism, consisting exclusively of non-Jews, dissolved today after existing for 42 years.

The association had 535 members, including leading Christians prominent in art, science, literature, commerce, industry and other fields.

Gutstadt Speech at Chicago Made Before the B'nai B'rith

The speech of Richard E. Gutstadt, reported in Thursday's issue of the Jewish Daily Bulletin, was delivered at the sixty-fifth annual convention at Chicago of the B'nai B'rith, District Lodge No. 6. This convention was held apart from that of the Zionist Organization of America.

Commons Speaker Asks Intervention on Behalf Of Jews in Germany

LONDON, July 6—A British note to Germany referring to the treatment of Jews by the Nazis was urged last night by Colonel Josiah Wedgwood, Laborite, as the debate in the House of Commons continued. Colonel Wedgwood asserted that the same sentiments that existed in England regarding the Jewish question prevailed also in the United States.

Citing the number of instances in history when England intervened in the internal affairs of another country when a section of the population was oppressed, he pointed out that Italy was freed only as a result of intervention by England.

"We could now take up the old role in conjunction with America," Colonel Wedgwood suggested. "We are not entitled to let things go on as they are in Germany simply because we are afraid our intervention will not meet with enthusiastic support from the present German government."

R. H. Bernays, who just returned to London after a visit to Germany, described before the House of Commons the systematic persecution of Jews taking place there, depriving thousands of Jews of all hope of gaining a livelihood. Bernays urged that England follow France's example and relax immigration restrictions to allow German-Jewish refugees to come to England.

Sir John Simon, Foreign Secretary, making probably his last appearance in the House before starting on a long vacation for his health, wound up the discussion by declaring that "we would be untrue to ourselves if we did not say how deeply we were distressed by the events which occurred in Germany."

A great body of opinion in England was sympathetic to post-war Germany, Sir John declared, but events now happening there have changed feelings here. The English people, he remarked, are just, generous and open-minded, but there are some things which they find difficult to understand. They consider the primary condition for any solution of European problems, he stated, must be complete confidence regarding treatment of minorities.

Sir John promised George Lansbury, who spoke earlier in the day and demanded that the League of Nations intervene, that he would consider the possibility of helping Jewish refugees through the International Red Cross, but he would be unable to help the Germans without a country who did not come under the Nansen passport category.

Abraham Cahan Sails To See, Hear, Investigate Conditions in Europe

Abraham Cahan, editor of the Jewish Daily Forward, and Mrs. Cahan sailed at noon yesterday on the Ile de France for a tour of Europe.

A farewell luncheon was tendered Mr. Cahan by his staff yesterday at the Little Roumanian Rendezvous, 76 Second Avenue. About a hundred persons attended, including representatives of the Forward editorial and business staffs, the Forward Association, the Workmen's Circle, the Socialist Party and other groups.

Mr. Cahan explained the purpose of his trip as "the desire to see, hear and investigate what is going on in Europe."

Mexican Jews Raising Fund to Help Establish German Exiles in Palestine (J.T.A. Special Correspondence)

MEXICO CITY—A campaign for a fund to help settle persecuted German Jews in Palestine was announced here at a mass meeting of the local Jews.

All Jewish institutions have joined the campaign, the object of which will be to collect fifty thousand pesos. In order to assure the success of the campaign all institutions, including the Jewish School and the Relief Association, have postponed their annual campaigns, usually conducted at this time of the year. However, twenty per cent of the total fund will go to these institutions, and ten per cent will be used to combat anti-Semitism in Mexico.

Prominent American Jewish leaders sent telegrams encouraging the campaign, among them Felix M. Warburg, Dr. Cyrus Adler, Morris Rothenberg and Louis Lipsky.

The campaign, which began June 27, will continue through July 31.

Stavsky Remanded; Pleads Innocence

JERUSALEM, July 6—Abraham Stavsky appeared yesterday in Tel-Aviv Magistrate's Court and was remanded back into the custody of the police for fifteen more days.

convention was sharply interrupted several times yesterday when delegates overrode reports of the nominations committee, precipitating many vocal clashes on the floor. The first of these clashes arose when James Waterman Wise, Rabbi Solomon Goldman, of Chicago, and other persons fell upon the resolution thanking the Central Conference of American Rabbis for their support of Zionism. Reform rabbis were sharply criticized for their non-Zionist stand by Rabbi Goldman, who said that non-Zionist Jews should be condemned. The resolution finally was withdrawn by Rabbi William I. Rosenblum, of New York, after bitter discussion and scenes of disorder.

Tulin's Name Is Added

The second occasion for excitement followed the nominations committee's report, delivered by Harry Friedberg, of Kansas City. The list did not include the name of Abraham Tulin, of Kansas City, for a post on the administrative committee, so a minority report was made by Rabbi Victor Epstein, proposing the addition of Tulin's name. A storm of approving and disapproving remarks broke out over the hall. Louis Lipsky, who succeeded Judge William Lewis in the chair, was able to maintain order only with the utmost difficulty. After a prolonged argument Tulin's name was added to the administrative committee when a large vote in his favor recorded the will of the convention.

A resolution affirming support for the World Zionist Congress, sponsored by the American Jewish Congress, was adopted by the convention, as were resolutions expressing regret over the death of Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff; thanking retiring officers; protesting at Germany's persecution of Jews as "a return to barbarism," and empowering the administrative committee of the congress to name the administrative council.

Nathan Straus, Jr., was one of the vice-presidents newly elected by the delegates. A plan to reduce the deficit in the organization by \$65,000 through a settlement payment of \$25,000 was announced by the convention. Each district will be obligated to raise \$100 toward this sum, it was announced. An administrative budget of \$60,000 was adopted by the convention.

Weizmann Carries

After an agreement with Hadassah for a division of mandates was quietly adopted, with many delegates unaware of this action, a storm broke loose when Dr. Weizmann's supporters tried to secure

backing for him from the complete delegation. The argument centered around a resolution proposed by Robert Silverman, of Providence, R. I., stating that delegates to the world congress ought to be morally bound by designation to support Dr. Weizmann's election to the presidency. This resolution was opposed by Louis Lipsky, Robert Szold and other persons. The resolution narrowly avoided being tabled and went to a close vote taken amid scenes of great confusion. It was carried by a narrow margin. It was pointed out by Lipsky, however, that the resolution could not bind the Hadassah delegates to Dr. Weizmann's ticket.

The Hadassah chapter delegates refrained from voting for delegates after a strong attack on their attitude was made by Lipsky and other persons. Morris Rothenberg, newly-elected president, heatedly protested their intention to vote for Zionist Organization of America delegates since they had their own.

For Educational Work

The Z.O.A. delegates named to the world congress were Jacob Fishman, Abraham Goldberg, Rabbi Solomon Goldman, Judge William M. Lewis, Louis Lipsky, Dr. Samuel Margoshes, Morris Margulies, Morris Rothenberg, Elihu D. Stone and Meyer Weisgal.

Lipsky explained that Rabbi Stephen S. Wise, Julian W. Mack, Israel Brodie, Jacob de Haas and Robert Szold would be named on the Hadassah slate.

An important action taken by the convention was the laying of the groundwork for intensive youth Zionist work. A sum of \$5,000 was allocated for educational work, providing the funds are available. The development of the youth program along the lines of Israel Chipkin's report of the Commission for Youth and Education was determined upon by the convention. Delegates recognized the newly-merged Masada Youth Zionist Organization of America as an affiliated body.

Among the Speakers

Among speakers at the convention yesterday was Dr. I. D. Berkson, who recently returned from Palestine. Referring to the death of Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff, he ascribed its cause to lack of discipline and dissension in Jewish life.

Emanuel Neumann, speaking at the Avukah luncheon here yesterday, stressed the importance of the development of a cultural interest in youthful elements in order effectively to reenergize Zionist life in America. Rabbi Meyer Berlin,

less than the prescribed quota of Jewish students, and is not obliged to state its reasons for such a move.

4—Jewish students admitted to universities within the quota must have parents closely connected with the "new German spirit."

5—Foreign students of Jewish descent may be admitted to German universities from time to time only with the approval of a special central commission for foreign students, which will shortly be formed.

The regulations specify that German universities must ban altogether the entrance of East European Jewish students, no matter how long their parents may have been residing in Germany.

Histadruth Ivrit

The organizing of Hebrew classes throughout the country in order to prepare American Jews for the settlement of Palestine was decided upon here yesterday by the Histadruth Ivrit at the conclusion of its annual convention.

Two hundred delegates who were also attending the Zionist convention were present at the Histadruth sessions. Speakers besides Rabbi Goldman included M. Ribalow, Abram Goldberg, Dr. Samuel Feigin, and M. A. Friedland.

Rabbi Goldman was elected president of Histadruth Ivrit. Dr. M. Waxman, Dr. A. L. Honor and C. H. Friedland were elected vice-presidents and Abram Goldberg, chairman of the executive committee.

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
