# Sefer Torah Brought To Spain by Refugee

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) MADRID, July 11-An impressive ceremony of thanksgiving today accompanied the installation in the Madrid Synagogue of a valuable old Sefer Torah (holy scrolls) brought to Spain for safekeeping by a Ger-man-Jewish refugee. The synagogue was filled with worshippers when the formal handing over of the Sefer Torah took place.

Many persons at the ceremony saw it as a symbolic act, reminding them of the time when Jews once were expelled from Spain and Sefer Torahs were carried, homeless, from been brought back to this country.

### Swiss Confiscate Zion Protocols as Jews Move Against Anti-Semites (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BASLE, Switzerland, July 11-The authorities here vesterday confiscated 761 copies of the "Elders of Zion" protocol from the headquarters of the reactionary, anti-Semitic National Front. This organization, it was discovered, had been engaged in distributing the spurious proto-

Since according to Swiss law only the insulted party could bring action, Julius Drevius Brodsky, president of the Jewish community, and Dr. Marcus Cohn brought action against the National Front in their names. They charged this group with distributing outrageous falsifications li-

helling the Tewish neonle. The trial is expected to be held shortly.

Meanwhile a mass meeting called by the National Front proved a double-edged sword. Fifteen hundred persons attended the meeting, but shortly after their arrival they moved that a resolution be passed overthrowing the chairman, and they appointed their own chairman in his place. The latter proclaimed amid generous applause that the meeting would be held with the devotion to the principles of democracy uppermost in everyone's mind.

### Jewish Merchants Liquidate Businesses In Face of Nazi Drive (Tewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, July 11-Despite the recent government declaration of a policy of non-interference with business, the German Nazi drive against Jewish merchants has resulted in their voluntary liquidation of their businesses in many places. This is particularly true in the provinces, where Jewish merchants have liquidated rather than face the alternative of daily picketing of their stores by Nazi storm troopers.

Following last week's panic among Tewish merchants in Dortmund as a result of the reintroduction of an official anti-Jewish boycott, many Jewish firms in that city have closed down altogether. As a result, many non-Jews have been thrown out of work. So many Jews are fleeing Dortmund that the last three Jewish schools there have shut their doors for lack of pupils.

Side by side with the movement against Jewish merchants, Jewish peddlers have been driven from the market places of many towns and cities. In Leipzig the movement against Jewish peddlers has reached such proportions that they are permitted to trade at present only on one street. Thus they are practi-(Continued on Page 4)
