

American Jews Urged To Take German Jewish Children Into Homes

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

PARIS, July 18.—As many as 20,000 German-Jewish children could be admitted into the United States if a movement were started in America for this purpose, Leo Simon, well-known philanthropist, said today in an interview with the Jewish Telegraphic Agency correspondent. He expressed consternation over the plight of young boys and girls who are being poisoned, he said, body and soul, by the atrocious anti-Semitic atmosphere in the schools of Germany.

Many children of Jewish parents, declared M. Simon, are refusing to go to school any more in Germany due to the moral and physical torture to which they are exposed by Nazi teachers who incessantly preach anti-Semitic

Nazi Guards at Dachau Slay Two Jewish Lawyers, Seal Bodies in Coffins

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

FRAGUE, July 18.—Two Jewish lawyers, Oscar Strauss, 33, and Wilhelm Aeon, 32, were shot down and killed in the Dachau concentration camp, the Vorkemfer, organ of the German Social Democrats, which moved its office here after being banned by the Nazis in Germany, reported today. The newspaper stated that according to the press of Munich the number of men shot down in the Dachau concentration camp is now 41.

Strauss' body, the paper reported, was delivered to his parents for burial in a sealed coffin under the conditions that they would not open the coffin or mention the circumstances surrounding their son's death.

Similarly, Aeon's body was delivered to his parents, living in Bamberg, Bavaria, in a lead coffin, after they had promised Nazi authorities that they would not pry open the coffin. Many Catholics, out of sympathy with Aeon's parents, attended the funeral. The Hamburg Volkshilf even reproduced passages from the rabbi's funeral sermon, whereas Hitlerite officials promptly confiscated the whole issue.

Nazi in Rage at Bernhard's Reparations Demand in Sunday Bulletin

BERLIN, July 18.—"Jews will have to wait a long time to receive reparations!" Der Angriff, Nazi-controlled newspaper, fiercely declares in reply to Dr. Georg Bernhard's article, which suggested that out of justice to the Jews an international tribunal force Germany to pay for property the Nazis stole or destroyed, provided tremendous wealth in the entire Nazi-ruled German press.

Der Angriff extended an "invitation" to Dr. Bernhard, now in exile in Paris, to "come to Berlin and collect the reparations himself." The paper warned that if he ever set foot in Germany they could prevent him "a long life—in jail."

The Hugenberg press displayed serious concern over the possibility that the Jews would demand reparations, expressing the hope that "non-Jewish readers in America will not take Dr. Bernhard's article seriously."

The Berliner Nachrichten indignantly featured the news under the heading: "Bernhard Wants Reparations," while the Stormkammer called Dr. Bernhard's project

Jewish Opera Established in Berlin With No Aryans Permitted in Audiences

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, July 18.—Permission to establish a German Opera and Theater where the actors, singers, musicians and theatrical staff will be exclusively Jewish was granted yesterday by the government under the condition that non-Jews will not be admitted to the audience to watch the performances. The staff will embrace all the best-known artists scoured from German opera companies recently because they were Jews.

The establishment of the new company will be aided by the Central Jewish Relief Fund. The theater will be under the directorship of Kurt Singer, former director of the Berlin Municipal Theater, and the opera will be managed by Josef Rosenstock, former director of the Mannheim Theater and for five years with the New York Metropolitan Opera Company.

The German Opera Theater will function daily and will be permitted to issue its own theatrical publication, the authorities announced.

A special cultural union, the "Deutscher Juden, ISJ" has been

ZIONIST LABORITES SWEEP PALESTINE POLL, CONTINUE TO HOLD GAINS HERE

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

The striking gains made by the Zionist Laborite group here in the balloting for delegates to the World Zionist Congress at Prague next month are duplicated in election reports received by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency from its offices abroad.

In Palestine, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency reports, the Labor ticket received seventy percent of the total vote cast which numbered over 30,000. 65,000 were entitled to vote on the basis of the Shetel payments. The Revisionist group received 11 percent of the vote cast; the General Zionists 7 percent; the Hapoel-Mizrachi (orthodox workers group) five and a half percent; and Mizrachi (orthodox Zionists) three and a half percent.

Preliminary election results in England reveal the election of 6 General Zionist delegates and 2 Poale Zion representatives. The sixth place is expected to go to the Mizrachi whose slate received more support than the two Revisionist groups together.

Two General Zionists and two Poale Zionists will represent Canadian Zionism at the Congress.

Results in the election of the 120 delegates from Poland, including Galicia, are not yet known. Previously reported results are: Austria, 3 General Zionists, 1 Poale Zionist, 1 Democratic Revisionist and possibly 1 Laborist Revisionist; Italy, 1 General Zionist; West Galicia, 2

Reich Marriage Subsidies Can't Be Spent in Jews' Shops, Nazi Ministry Rules

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
BERLIN, July 18—Jewish merchants should not benefit even indirectly by the government subsidy granted newly-married couples, the Reich Ministry of Finance indicated today. The ministry issued an order forbidding merchants from buying any of their household effects from stores controlled by Jews.

Another blow was struck at Jewish merchants in Western Bavaria, when Nazi officials in Gollhofen and Oberhelsheim issued decrees prohibiting farmers and peasants from having any business relations with non-Aryans. Anybody violating this order, the Ministers declared, would be officially classified as a traitor.

Rockville Jews to Have Synagogue

HARTFORD, Conn., July 18—Jews of Rockville will soon have a synagogue of their own, according to plans now in progress in this community twenty miles from Hartford. The Rockville Athletic Association building, a two-story wooden structure, will be converted into a synagogue after the official purchase of the place is recorded Thursday. Trustees of the synagogue will be Jacob Cohen, Alex Winter, Alex Giler and Morris Brown.

Further Ban on Notaries, Lawyers

BERLIN, July 18—Another 200 notaries and 150 Jewish advocates in Prussia lost the right to practice their profession following one more decree from the Nazi leaders yesterday. The majority of the Jews deprived of their right to earn a livelihood were practicing law in Berlin.

DISORDERS MARK HERZL ANNIVERSARY SERVICES IN POLAND AS ZIONIST FACTIONS CLASH

WARSAW, July 18—Tension led during the last month by a serious controversy over the murder of Dr. Chaim Arlossoff in Tel Aviv culminated in serious clashes yesterday and today between various Zionist factions in Poland, according to alarming reports received from the provinces of Galicia. Memorial meetings held in honor of the twenty-sixth anniversary of the death of Dr. Theodor Herzl, founder of the Zionist movement, proved to be the added spark necessary to start the long-smoldering fire into a healthy blaze.

At Alexander, near Loda, a veritable battle broke out between Left Wing Polish Zionists and Revisionists. Several persons were grievously injured, and it was necessary for police to make many arrests before order was restored.

At Olkut, near Lwow, somebody fired a shot in the course of a Herzl memorial meeting and a panic ensued. Before the crowd was quieted several persons were bruised in

violent hand-to-hand fighting. Twenty men were arrested.

Near Loda, in the cities of Głowno and Strykow, knives were used in fights between Transpodorites and members of the Histadruth faction. Several men were sent to hospitals for treatment before the fighting was ended.

Arnold Freymuth, Former President of Appeals Court, Commits Suicide in exile

PARIS, July 18—Arnold Freymuth, distinguished German Jewish lawyer, and former member of the Reichstag, committed suicide together with his wife, Margarete, here today. He was 62 years old, and his wife 51. They are survived by two children.

Freymuth was melancholy ever since he was forced to flee from Germany after the Nazis had dismissed him from the presidency of the Court of Appeals in Charlottenburg, near Berlin.

Called Balto Jew—Jailed

BERLIN, July 18—For publishing a report that Italian Air Minister Italo Balbo, who led his air armada from his native land to Chicago, is a converted Jew, the Deutsche Zeitung was closed down for three months yesterday at the personal command of Aviation Minister Hermann Wilhelm Goering. The editor of the newspaper was immediately arrested and shipped to a concentration camp.

Ben-Zvi Officially an Executive

JERUSALEM, July 18—The Jewish Agency Executive officially announced yesterday that the Executives in London and Jerusalem have invited L. Ben-Zvi, Palestine labor leader, to become a member with full rights. He has already started his work.

Ben-Zvi, like the late Dr. Chaim Arlossoff, is an outstanding labor leader. He fills the post on the Jewish Agency Executive made vacant when Dr. Arlossoff was assassinated.

Histadruth Raises Funds For Arlossoff Colony

JERUSALEM, July 18—A total of 220 pounds was raised yesterday, the last day of the campaign for 20,000 pounds being collected by the Histadruth, Zionist laboric organization, for an agricultural enterprise to be named in honor of the late Dr. Chaim Arlossoff.

Mizrachi Considers Calling World Orthodox Parley

WARSAW, July 18—A plan to call a world congress of orthodox Jewry to further the building up of Palestine in the spirit of the Torah will be among the principal points discussed at the world conference of the Mizrachi, orthodox Zionist group, to be held at Krakow on August 8. Rabbi J. L. Fishman, chairman of the council of the Mizrachi World Organization, told a J.T.A. representative here.

Rabbi Fishman also revealed that in addition to questions of internal organization, the Krakow conference would determine the attitude of the Mizrachi at the World Zionist Congress which will open in Prague, August 25.

The Mizrachi will take its usual stand at the Zionist Congress, Dr. Fishman said, advocating the development of Palestine on the basis of Jewish traditions and teachings, and would work for the election of a coalition executive.

New Synagogue for Seattle

Final Results Here Monday

Although final results to the election here will not be known until next Monday, the latest tabulation of all the votes received, shows that the Laborite ticket is maintaining the astounding lead gained in the election. With 16,849 votes already counted, the United Labor Party ticket, number two on the ballot, has 4,563 votes, with its nearest rival, the Mirachi, having only only 3,564 votes. The General Zionists ticket, which was number one on the ballot, ran a close third with 3,416 votes counted. The two Revisionist groups did very badly, receiving a combined vote of only 1,366.

A total vote of 25,000 is expected to be recorded and although it is anticipated that the percentage of the Labor vote may be cut by late returns, the Labor victory remains an utter open for the General Zionists. With some two-thirds of the total vote in, the Laborites have 8,563 votes as compared with 8,288 for all the other four groups combined. The Laborites will therefore control half of the American delegation to the World Zionist Congress.

At the Laborite headquarters, the leaders were jubilant at their unexpected victory, although the feeling was mixed with a desire to placate all the Zionist factions and to stress the constructive side of the Labor program.

Significance of Election

In a statement to the Jewish Daily Bulletin, Meyer Brown, Laborite secretary said: "The election is of particular significance. At this moment of the triumph of reaction and Hitlerism, the organized Zionist electors voted in favor of progressive and democratic labor elements in Zionism."

Professor Haim Flossman of the faculty of Temple University, Philadelphia, and a successful candidate on the Labor ticket, declared: "The American Zionist movement as a whole should be congratulated. At one of the gloucest moments in Jewish history, they rose to the occasion, getting beyond mere party limitations and voted for the labor ticket in Zionism. They were not carried away by names or personalities and realized that the constructive program of the Labor Party will enable all democratic elements in Zionism to further the cause of advanced mass colonization settlement in Palestine.

hour, and American Jewry will not be disappointed in the expression in the achievements and idealism of the Hittadruth, and may feel assured that the labor delegation will unite with all progressive, constructive groups in Zionism to convert the coming Zionist congress into an efficient, truly constructive body."

propaganda in the classrooms, in the direct presence of the youngsters.

'Torture Chamber'

M. Simon stated that many cases have been reported of German teachers calling Jewish children to the blackboard, not by their names, but by some anti-Semitic nickname, thus throwing all the Aryan children in the classroom into mocking laughter. The Jewish children, he said, naturally become confused and often start crying. As a result they absolutely resist all efforts to make them return to what they call their "torture chamber" on the following day.

According to M. Simon, many Jews believe that the most constructive relief for the children of German Jews could come directly from Jews in America starting a campaign in the United States temporarily to admit them into this country. American Jews could bring these children to their homes until the trouble in Germany ended, he pointed out.

He expressed the opinion that it would not be difficult to find 25,000 families among 400,000 Jews in the United States who would be ready to take these unfortunate German-Jewish children into their homes.

M. Simon said that this would mean the saving of a whole generation of Jews. The children could easily obtain American visas, he stated, if proper legal steps were taken, and then there would be no difficulty in getting them into the United States for the time being. Jewish parents in Germany, he asserted, would be happy to see their children depart from the land ruled by the Nazi terror, even though it would mean a separation of mother and father from son and daughter.

German Relief Fund Increases

A total of \$27,000 in new donations has been added to the fund being raised by the German Relief Campaign of the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee, Rabbi Joseph B. Wine has announced. Altogether the Committee now has \$282,000 toward the national quota of \$2,000,000.

formed, to back the venture. Oscar Wassermann, former director of the German Bank and member of the general council of the Reichsbank, was appointed president. On the board of directors are Max Liebermann, well-known artist; Dr. Leo Haeck, Berlin rabbi; Georg Hermann, artist; Martin Buber, former instructor of philosophy at the University of Heidelberg, and Franz Oppenheimer, former professor at Frankfurt-am-Main.

The members of the new society were forced to sign an application declaring themselves Jews. The Nazis also demanded that photographs of all members accompany their application.

The organization eventually hopes to enroll more than 10,000 Jewish members.

Establish Kronick Award At Hebrew University
