London Theatre Withdraws Expensive German Film; Disorders Mar Premiers

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON, July 28.—The Empire, biggest cinema theater here, today withdrew the film "Merry Monarch," in which Emil Jennings played the main part, after it had appeared for one night. The film had been extensively advertised and its elaborate production was said to have involved the expenditure of half a million dollars.

Criticism and cries of ridicule when the picture was shown last night compelled the management of the Empire to abandon further public performances. The objection to the showing of the "Merry Monarch" is allegedly attributed to the anti-German boycotters, who are said to have opposed the picture because Jennings is a German.

Some persons, however, believe that public disavowal with the film was due solely to the fact that it provided bad entertainment. This might have been caused by the board of censors, members of whom sat the picture considerably before they released it to the exhibitors.

The matter is causing considerable excitement in motion picture circles here. Prominent exhibitors have said that they doubt whether they will be able to show pictures in London in the future starring German artists. Even if the film is not produced in Germany, but has German actors participating, it was stated, public sentiment would be against it.

Citizenship Limited to Nazis, Labor Front Members, Confirming Jewish Fears

BERLIN, July 19.—Citizenship rights in the new German state will be given only to members of the Nazi party and the Labor Front, an official press communique stated yesterday. This confirmed the earlier fear felt by German Jews that they were in danger of losing their citizenship, since they have been expelled from the Labor Front and naturally cannot be Nazis.

The communique emphasized that non-members of the Labor Front will not be tolerated as German citizens.

To Prohibit Anti-Semitic Organizations in Greece

SALONICA, July 19.—The intention of the government to prohibit anti-Semitic Nationalist organizations which of late have developed in conjunction with the fierce anti-Jewish campaign in Greece was revealed today by open declarations in this direction from government members, led by Premier Tsaldaris and M. Dragoumis, Governor General of Macedonia. The declarations from the government also assailed anarchistic acts against the State and shared them in the same category with anti-Semitic movements.

The organization, Hellas, most fierce of all anti-Semitic groups, which was responsible for the fire in the Campbell Jewish quarter here in June 1931, is almost certain to be closed down by the government because it is undermining governmental authority and leading the country to anarchy, it was said today by state spokesmen.

Nazi Anti-Semitic Drive Hits Lawyers, Actors, Shoemakers, Artisans

BERLIN, July 18.—Instructions were sent today to all branches of the Nazi Lawyers' Association throughout Germany from the group headquarters here that the secretaries of branches must submit regularly every Friday a report regarding firms where private citizens are still employing Jewish lawyers as counsel. The secretaries were instructed to give the Berlin make-office full details, such as the names and addresses of the Jewish lawyers and their clients.

This latest Nazi innovation is calculated to terrify clients into dismissing Jewish lawyers from their employ. Ultimately this will mean that even Jewish lawyers who are war veterans will eventually lose their practice.

Pala Negel was officially branded as a Jewess today as the Nazis released an official list of Jewish actors and actresses whose films they ruled must not be shown in Germany. The list contained the names of 22 of the most prominent theatrical and

Govt. Asks Armistice Takes Measures to End Polish Zionist Strife

WARSAW, July 19.—Government authorities today urged all Zionist parties to declare an armistice for the coming Sunday, when the Zionist Congress elections are slated to be held. Fearing that the bitter party strife, as evidenced in the province of Galicia during the last few days, will lead to bloodshed this week-end, the government has announced that vigorous measures will be enforced against a breach of peace.

Considerable excitement in Jewish circles was aroused today when the government suddenly arrested a number of left wing Polish Zionists, including Councillor Isaac Lev and Dr. Gersburt. The police are conducting a search for other alleged trouble-makers. They have already searched the headquarters of the Polish Zionist left wing here, and have closed the Arbeiter Zeitung.

Vienna Press Continues Hitler Birth Revelations

VIENNA, July 19.—The Österreichische Abendblatt, Holsteiner organ, continued today to print revelations of Hitler's origin in its attempt to prove the German chancellor is of Jewish descent. In tonight's issue the Abendblatt featured a story from the director of the Pohn Museum in which he confirmed, with documents, the story printed previously concerning Hitler's family tree. However, the museum director concluded his confirmation with the note that "if the chancellor belongs to the name Hitler family as the Pohn Jews do, then few Jews have a prouder family tree than the Nazi chieftain."

Die Reichspost, organ of the Christian Socialist (Government) party, emphatically denied that the clearance certificates which were published last week could be used as a basis for proving that Chancellor Hitler was of Jewish origin. At the same time, however, Die Reichspost declared that "Hitler's father was an illegitimate child."

Foreign Artists Allowed New Freedom in Germany

BERLIN, July 19—A new note in the Nazi racial campaign was struck yesterday when Nazi Commissioner Hans Siedel officially declared that foreign and non-Aryan musicians and other artists will be permitted to exercise their professional activities in Germany with full freedom. The Aryan principle will be applied only to artists who are employed in public institutions, he stated in the course of an address at a conference of all German musical organizations assembled here.

Ban Lifted on Deutsche Zeitung

BERLIN, July 19—The Deutsche Zeitung, which was suspended Monday for a period of three months on account of publishing a story that General Italo Balbo, Italian air commander, was partly Jewish, was permitted yesterday to reappear after its management had apologized to the government. The editor, however, will remain in the concentration camp to which he was sent Monday, the police announced. They refused to set a date for his release from prison.

Postpone Gratkowski Trial Again as 3 Accused Jews Deny Murder Guilt

LWOW, Poland, July 19—The trial for murder of the Jan Gratkowski was again postponed today due to the absence of several witnesses. The three Jews charged with the murder, Israel Tsam, Nathania Schauer and Moshe Katz, continue to deny their guilt.

Gratkowski was killed on November 26, 1932, after he and five companions attacked a group of Jews following a drunken revel. He was a student at the University of Lemberg. The work after the slaying there were serious anti-Semitic riots, resulting in the injury of more than 150 Jews. The university was closed when the rioting became serious. Quiet was restored two weeks later after the Zionist Athletic Stadium had been fired and destroyed by anti-Semitic Polish students.

Austrian Jewish Lawyer Refuses to Aid World Body Unless Germans Excluded

In response to a letter from Dean J. H. Wigmore, emeritus dean of the faculty of law at Northwestern University, asking him to lend his support to the creation of an international law association, Dr. Siegfried Kantor, president of the Vienna Bar Association and well known in European legal circles, refused to join any such group less the German Bar Association was excluded until such time as it had rectified the glaring injustices committed against the Jewish lawyers in Germany. The Jewish Daily Bulletin learned yesterday from Dr. Samuel R. Washfield, well known New York lawyer who returned recently from a business trip to Austria.

In his letter to Dean Wigmore, Dr. Kantor included a copy of the rules adopted by the Bar Association of Düsseldorf on the 15th of May, as conclusive evidence that the Jewish attorneys were being discriminated against in a shameful and barbedash fashion.

In reply to this letter of Dr. Kantor's, said Dr. Washfield, Dean Wigmore intimated that the Germans could not be kept out of any international group.

Bernhard Demands Voiced In Last Sunday's Bulletin Still Agitate Nazi Press

BERLIN, July 19—The article by Dr. George Bernhard, German journalist now in exile, which appeared in last Sunday's issue of the Jewish Daily Bulletin of New York, demanding that Germany be forced to pay reparations to Jews for property the Nazis have confiscated, stolen or destroyed, still continues to provoke great public indignation. Yesterday's Volkischer Beobachter declared that Dr. Bernhard's article not only is an insult to Germany but proves that anti-German propaganda abroad has not been stopped by Germans who fled from their fatherland.

The Vossische Zeitung, of which Dr. Bernhard was formerly chief editor, advised German emigrants editorially to abstain from taking part in anti-German politics.

Dr. Lantsobach in Charge of Election Lists

LONDON, July 19—Dr. Leo Lantsobach has been placed in charge of the world election lists to the 15th Zionist World Congress at Prague, according to an announcement of the Central Bureau of the Zionist Organization.

Dr. Cohn, Chief of the Zionist Congress Bureau, was granted a lengthy audience by the Czechoslovakian Minister of Foreign Affairs, M. Krafa, who promised the fullest Government support to the Congress.

Delegates and guests to the Congress will receive certain railway privileges, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency learns.

Kashruth Position for Rabbi Zaslowsky

He is a member of the executive board of the Union of Orthodox Rabbis of the United States and is closely affiliated with the Mizrachi Zionist movement in this country.

motion picture stars, including Max Falkenberg, Richard Tauber, Elizabeth Duggan and Lee Parry. The same list ordered that 118 theatrical directors must be dismissed from positions in Germany because they are Jews.

A resolution to prohibit Jewish shoemakers from working on Saturday and Sunday was adopted today by the Association of German Shoemakers in convention assembled here. This was done, the resolution sarcastically remarked, "in order to give Jews the possibility of observing their religion."

Bar Jewish Artisans

BERLIN, July 19.—A resolution to expel all Jewish members from artisan shops and trade and commerce was passed yesterday by the Chamber of Artisans in Chemnitz. The resolution demanded that Jewish artisans be prohibited from employing Aryan apprentices and Jewish merchants Aryan salesmen. By this method the Nazis in Chemnitz eventually hope to bring Jewish activity to a standstill.

Search Businesses

Among the houses searched was the residence of the Polish Zionist leader, Zerkowiel, but he could not be located. The Friends of Fabrician Labor headquarters was also raided and closed down.

Reasons for the strict police measures are unknown, but Jewish circles here believe the raids were possibly caused by the allegation that the Polish Zionists and Communists have created a united front against the Fascists. Another version is that the police measures are due to a misunderstanding.
