Hitler and Nazi Regime Acclaimed in British Press, Goebbels' Attack Reprinted

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
LONDON, July 31—Several influential Sunday newspapers have yesterday carried articles praising Adolf Hitler and his Nazi government in Germany. Lord Beaverbrook's Sunday Express splashed over its most important news page a big article praising Chancellor Hitler and President Roosevelt "for leading the world fight against unemployment." Chancellor Hitler, said the Express correspondent from Berlin, has already created jobs for two million German workers.

Lord Rothermere's Daily Mail featured a dispatch from Germany's former Crown Prince, Wilhelm, praising Hitler for "saving the soul of the German people." A yearbook appeared prominently at the top of the story. The Crown Prince wrote that the British public had an entirely false conception of Hitler, whose personality and aims, he said, were deliberately distorted by the Left, but declared he was certain England eventually would revise its judgment of Hitler, as it had in the case of Premier Mussolini of Italy.

"Perish the Jew" Reprinted

Similarly, the Sunday Referee, while editorially disassociating itself from responsibility for views expressed, carried an article by Paul Josef Goebbels, German minister of propaganda and public enlightenment, featuring his story prominently on its front page. The article was headed: "Perish the Jew." It concluded that the Jews finally would perish at last, after many years of perverse influence on civilization.

The Sunday Chronicle praised Hitler's policy eliminating women from labor and providing jobs for men, stating that it "hopes England will do likewise."

"Coordinated" Tiets Firm Gets Nazi Gov't Subsidy

BERLIN, July 31—The Hermann Tiets firm of chain department stores, which the Nazis two weeks ago cleverly manipulated into their own hands, yesterday received a credit of 14,000,000 Marks from the government. Under the old management the firm would not have received this government aid.

Berlin Streets Littered By Piles of Inciting Pogrom Propaganda

BERLIN, July 31—Streets of this city are once again littered with poisonous anti-Jewish pogrom propaganda. A cartload of anti-Semitic leaflets and pamphlets openly calling for massacres of Jews is sweeping the capital, the literature being distributed on almost every street corner, and especially on the Potsdamerplatz in the center of the city.

Foreign observers here are especially interested in the pogrom literature, for most of the pamphlets carry the "Hakenkreuz" which has now become the official government emblem. Each foreign observer asks himself this question: "Would my government permit pogrom literature to be distributed in the streets of New York, London, Paris, Moscow, Rome or Copenhagen with my government's emblem printed conspicuously on it?"

Special attention has been attracted by a booklet entitled: "The Jew, International Pest." The book demands: "Get rid of Jews once and for all. The League of Nations is a product of Jewish machinations. Jews are not human beings, but scorpions dangerous to humanity."

Jailed Revisionists Tell Jabotinsky They're Martyrs

JERUSALEM, July 31—All Revisionists still being held here under charges of membership in a secret terrorist society dispatched a letter to Vladimir Jabotinsky, world Revisionist leader, today from the jails all declaring themselves the victims of libel and asserting they would "suffer patiently as you taught us until the light is triumphant."

The defendants are the remainder of the score arrested when Palestine police made a series of surprise raids in Jerusalem, Tel Aviv and other centers a week ago Sunday, seeking members of an alleged Zionist terrorist organization. Twelve Revisionists were released last Tuesday for examination, two of them being charged with illegal possession of firearms.

Nazi Gov't Promises To Revoke Citizenship Of Jews Born in Germany

BERLIN, July 31—Following close on official revoking of the citizenship of Eastern European Jews, the Nazi government announced yesterday in an official statement that German-born Jews may also expect soon to be deprived of their citizenship rights. The statement announced that a new citizenship law will be promulgated shortly which will declare non-Aryans are "Reichsaussererbt" (associated with the Reich) instead of Reich citizens, thus converting them from citizens into residents no longer enjoying the rights of citizenship.

Whether their status will be similar to that of the Staatslose (men without citizenship in any country) or whether they will still be permitted to enjoy German protection has not yet been indicated by the government. However, the statement made it clear that only Jews, and no other national minority, will be affected by the new law.

"The law is still in preparation and therefore details have not yet been established," the government statement yesterday announced. "However, a certain line of demarcation will be drawn between persons who naturally belong to the German order and persons who at present are only legally citizens of the Reich. This will follow the usual racial policy of the government, distinguishing between Aryans and non-Aryans."

The statement emphasized that the new law will not concern other national or political minorities.

Roumania May Suppress Anti-Semitic Iron Guard

BUCHAREST, July 31—The Government organ, Droptaza, reported today the likelihood that the Government will suppress the anti-Semitic Iron Guard, the Carolist military organization, following the discovery that the Iron Guard leaders have been counterfeiting Roumanian currency.

"We always wondered how they obtained their huge funds," the paper remarked.

Rabbi's Daughter Named To Asheville (N.C.) Council

ASHEVILLE, N. C., July 31—Mrs. I. S. Wiseman, daughter of Rabbi Moses F. Jacobson, of Beth Sh-Typhith Temple, Asheville, has been named secretary of the Community Council by Mayor Wicker Wamboldt.

The council has been formed at the suggestion of the United States Conference of Mayors and the department of agriculture at Washington to see that there is no peddling, particularly in foodstuffs. Similar councils are being formed in most larger cities of the United States.

Los Angeles Sends Funds For Relief on to New York

LOS ANGELES, July 31—Walter S. Hiltner, chairman of the United Jewish Relief, which is soliciting funds here for German Jewish aid under the Joint Distribution Committee and Jewish Agency for Palestine, has announced that his group has sent its first installment to New York.

Teacher Remembers Mrs. Kohut

Mrs. Rebekah Kohut, who was her pupil just fifty years ago, is one of those mentioned in the will of the late Miss Felska Jurew, an educator in San Francisco for more than forty years, who retired from active professional work twenty years ago.

Mrs. Kohut, who resides in New York, spoke of Miss Jurew several times in her autobiography, "My Forties."

Coast Junior Hadassah Holds Conference Friday

SAN FRANCISCO, July 31—Leaders of all chapters of Junior Hadassah in Pacific Coast states have been called to San Francisco for the annual regional conference to open next Friday, continuing for three days.

Miss Miriam Caro is chairman of the conference, which will consider a number of vital Jewish problems, together with plans for expanding the scope of usefulness of Junior Hadassah.

Seek Money in Seattle For Palestine National Fund

SEATTLE, July 31—Volunteers are being sought here for a campaign to raise funds for the Jewish National Fund by placing boxes in all Jewish homes, by Aaron Maslin, president of the newly reorganized chapter of the Kerem Kapmeth, Jewish National Fund. All Zionist branches here, as members of the Jewish National Fund directorate, will be called upon to share in the local chapter's activities, Mr. Maslin announced.

Palestine Jew Stabbed by Arab

JERUSALEM, July 31—Jacob Fishman, a member of the Hashomer Hatzair was stabbed in Karkur yesterday night while walking with a young lady on the outskirts of the colony. A Redoubin is believed to have stabbed Fishman. He was taken to the government hospital, where his condition was said to be not serious.

Mobilize Signs Plead With Petition

MOBILE, Ala., July 31—Catholic and Protestant ministers, city and county officials and approximately a thousand of this city's citizens signed the Plead With petition to President Roosevelt asking him to use his offices with the Hitler Government in Germany to secure a cessation of persecution of the Jews.

Mayor Signs Leavenworth Petition

LEAVENWORTH, Kans., July 31—Among those who have signed the Plead With petition to President Roosevelt here are J. K. Miller, mayor of the city, the county commissioners and members of the judiciary. Rabbi I. J. Sarason is personally soliciting the signatures.

Milwaukee Jews Named To Help Put Through Code

MILWAUKEE, July 31—Milwaukee Jews have just been honored by appointment to a series of important public bodies.

Two of them, Fred D. Goldstone, secretary of the Community Fund, and Rabbi Samuel Hirschberg, of Temple Emma-Eli Pine Jewish, have been named to the city-wide committee which is to campaign for general adoption of the blanket code for higher wages and lower hours proposed by the national administration.

Morris Stern, attorney and communal leader, has been appointed by Mayor Daniel W. Hoan to the city's board of assessments, which draws up plans for assessable public improvements. Mr. Stern is now also a member of the municipal zoning board of review.

Two Jewish women, Mrs. Michael Lewis, of the Council of Jewish Women, and Mrs. I. Greenberg, of the Women's Peace League, were named by Mayor Hoan to a committee of 18 investigating the rise in prices to determine whether profiteering existed.

Brookline Zionists Honor Herzl at Memorial Meeting

BOSTON, July 31—A large Herzl memorial meeting was held last night under the auspices of the Brookline Zionist organization at Nantasket Beach, near here, with Jacob de Haas, Zionist leader and Herzl biographer, as the principal speaker.

Discussing Dr. Herzl's contributions to Zionism, Mr. de Haas said it was the Jewish state idea. He urged Zionists to regard Herzl's life and achievements with a spirit of devotion and sacrifice and help rebuild Palestine as a Jewish national home quickly in order to provide shelter for a half million German Jews.

Others who addressed the meeting were Mrs. Jennie Leitzman Barrow, Judge Jacob J. Kaplan, I. J. Lova, Rabbi Joseph S. Shubov, Coleman Silber and Judge Francis S. Wyner. Samuel B. Hahn, president of the National Federation of Temple Brotherhoods and of the Brookline Zionists, presided at the meeting. Cantor Sol Puchik officiated.

General Zionists Get Greek Mandate

SALONICA, July 31—General Zionists won the mandate in the election for delegates to the World Zionist Congress, a tabulation of votes revealed here yesterday. The General Zionists garnered 224 votes, the Revisionists 202, the Mizrahi 102 and the Radicals 57.

Recruit Local Cast for New York Production of 'The Romance of a People'

Jewish youth organizations have responded to the call sent out by Isaac Van Grove, director of "The Romance of a People," for a cast of 5,000 volunteers required for the pageant which will be presented at the Polo Grounds on September 24. The League of Jewish Youth, Mizrachi Youth Organization, Jewish National Workers, Forward Youth Group, Junior Hadassah and Young Juden, are among the organizations which have volunteered cooperation. "The Romance of a People" is a portrayal in drama, oratorio and dance of four thousand years of Jewish history.

The pageant as it was originally given in Chicago stressed the religious aspect of the history of the Jews. The scenario is being rewritten for the New York presentation and it will deal more extensively with the historical episodes in the development of the Jews and it will include such modern episodes as the conditions of the Jews in Germany under the Hitler regime, it was said yesterday.

Proceeds from the performance of the drama will go to the American Palestine Campaign, which is raising funds in this country to finance the settling in Palestine of Jews who are suffering persecution in Germany.

Isaac Van Grove, director of the Chicago Civic Opera Company, who is in charge of the entire production, has written into the score many ancient Hebrew melodies and has also revived Jewish folk dances thousands of years old. Rehearsals will start on August 8 and one of the problems to be faced in securing an auditorium large enough to include the tremendous cast. Meyer W. Weigand, executive director of Jewish Day at Chicago, is executive director of the production.

The opening scene of the pageant will be the breaking of earth's first dawn, heralded by sunset voices intoning the lines from Genesis: "And God said, 'let there be light.'" Then follows the story of Israel's progress down through the years. The text of the production is taken from the Pentateuch and the Torah.

American Jewish Congress In Session Sunday for Boycott Support Vote

A program to deal with the situation of the Jews in Germany will be submitted for adoption Sunday to delegates to the emergency session of the executive committee of the American Jewish Congress, it was announced yesterday by Dr. Joseph Tennenbaum, chairman of the committee.

Among the questions to be discussed will be that of endorsement of an anti-Nazi boycott. A questionnaire inviting the opinion of constituent organizations on the subject of a boycott has been sent out by the committee. Jewish leaders throughout the country have also been solicited for their views.

A report from Dr. Stephen S. Wise, honorary president of the organization, who is now abroad, will be read to the session, which will be held at the Hotel New Yorker.

Young Polish Zionist Dies After Clash With Reds

WARSAW, July 31—Abraham Rosenberg, 19-year-old Right Wing Poale Zionist, died here yesterday from injuries sustained in a fight with communistic members of the cabinet makers' union.

After holding them for ten days, police yesterday released the Left Wing Poale Zionist leaders, Jacob Kerner and Israel Rosenfeld. They were arrested during clashes which preceded the World Zionist Congress elections last week throughout Poland.

Jewish Students in Poland Apply to Palestine Schools

Suffern Neighbors Object To Nazi Nudist Camps In Exclusive Resort

SUFFERN, N. Y., July 31—The Ramapo Zoning Board is continuing its efforts to bring out of existence the German-American Commercial League's summer camp in the exclusive Viola Road district in this town, it was indicated here today, following charges that the German organization was definitely anti-Semitic and pro-Hitlerism in its make-up. License plates on the cars owned by the Germans are being carefully checked in an effort to discover the real owners. Swastika banners were posted on some of the autos last week.

Harry M. Goldberg, prominent New York lawyer and president of the East Side Chamber of Commerce, who has a summer home and 35 acres of land on Viola Road, and Ira S. Wickes, who also lives on Viola Road, were the original complainants against the German campers. They stated that the two-room house and forty acres which the German-American Commercial League leased from Arthur Johnston, local realtor, was being used for political purposes. Members of the league, they said, paraded on the state roads in the evenings, making insulting anti-Semitic remarks and shouting "Down with Jews!"

Members of the First Baptist Church of Suffern, whose church grounds adjoin the land leased by the Germans, have also protested that the campers are immoral, running nude, mixed swimming parties in the muddy pool near their home.

Henry von L. Meyer, a member of the Ramapo Zoning Board, said that if necessary the current zoning law would be changed in order to erect the Hitlerism.

A. H. Johansson, who is president of the German-American Commercial League, declared that his organization is a private club, affiliated.

They are seeking to conquer the world and especially to destroy Germany as they destroyed Russia.

"There are two kinds of anti-Semitism, one, the higher kind, which is effected by limiting Jewish power by passing restrictive laws. The other kind, the lower kind, is by killing Jews. The latter is perhaps terrible but the results are better. The way definitely to end the Jewish question is to annihilate the Jews. Such an order always comes from the masses, but leadership comes from above, from God Himself."

The letterhead of this organization claims that it has 200,000 members and branches throughout the United States and Canada. He denied that the organization had any political connections, that they ever abused the Jews, or that they ran nude bathing parties.

Mr. Goldberg stated he was determined to press the charges to the hilt and to banish the German-American Commercial League from Suffern.

Seattle's Talmud Torah, 40, Will Mark Anniversary

SEATTLE, July 27—Plans for the celebration of the Seattle Talmud Torah's fortieth anniversary with an elaborate week-long program also marking Seattle's second annual Hebrew Education Week have been announced by Rabbi Max J. Wohlgelegen, Talmud Torah educational director. The Talmud Torah is the largest Jewish educational institution in the Pacific Northwest.

Meanwhile, Rabbi Wohlgelegen has invited Dr. David de Solis Pool, world-famous Hebrew scholar and spiritual leader of the Spanish Portuguese Congregation Shearith Israel in New York, oldest synagogue in the United States, to be principal speaker at the Hebrew Education Week rites.
