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Transjordan Settlement By Jews Debate Subject Of League Mandates Body

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

GENEVA, Aug. 3—A strong fight for the right of Jews to settle in Transjordan was put up at the last session of the League of Nations' Mandates Commission, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency learned today, although minutes of the session will not officially appear before September. The fight was conducted mainly by the Dutch representative, Dr. Van Rens, vice-chairman of the Mandates Commission, who demanded an explanation of the British Government's opposition to Jewish settlement of Transjordan. Van Rens emphasized that the mandate does not exclude Jewish immigration in the Transjordan area, and he indicated that the population of Transjordan is in favor of Jewish settlement there. Van Rens pointed out that Transjordan is double the size of Palestine, but has only 200,000 inhabitants at present, while Palestine has 1,000,000.

Land Sale Prohibition

"Besides, why prohibit sale of land there to Jews when the Emir Abdallah of Transjordan desires it?" he asked.

He also pointed out that many Jews living in Palestine at present are not Palestinians, but are still subjects or citizens of countries belonging to the League of Nations. Considering the principle of equality for the citizens or subjects of all countries which are members of the League, it would be impossible to prevent those persons from settling in Transjordan, Van Rens stated.

BERLIN, Aug. 3—Hope that the Roosevelt Administration will fail and that anti-Semitism will grow in America was expressed here today in Der Stürmer, newspaper edited by the notorious Julius Streicher, commander of the storm troops in Nuremberg and organizer of the April boycotts against the Jews.

On the eve of the convention of the National Socialist Party, which opens this week in Nuremberg, the newspaper, which is expected to be distributed to over half a million delegates and guests, asserts that the Roosevelt Administration is too much influenced by the Jews. It predicts that the Republican Party will come to power at the next election in the United States.

"Then," asserts the paper, "America will have a nationalist movement which will make it impossible for

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Bring Walter Orloff to Berlin; Consular Authorities Expect His Release Soon

BERLIN, Aug. 3—Hope that Walter Orloff, young Brooklyn, N. Y., medical student who has been under imprisonment for the past months on charges of communist activities, would be released soon was expressed to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency by George S. Messersmith, American Consul General here today.

Mr. Messersmith's statement came shortly after he had had a conference with the Nazi authorities.

Orloff was brought to Berlin this afternoon from the prison at Grifswald, Pomerania, where he had been held since July 1. The transfer followed persistent efforts of the American consulate, which included the sending of a special mission to

Two Revisionists Charged With Stavsky in Murder Conspiracy; Others Accused

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

JAFFA, Aug. 3—Public Prosecutor Shitrit caused a sensation here this morning when he announced that he was putting Zvi Rosenblatt and Yehuda Misa into the Arlossoff murder case and charging them, together with Abraham Stavsky and others yet unnamed, with having taken part in the conspiracy to assassinate the Zionist leader who met his death on June 15 this year in Tel Aviv. Rosenblatt, a Revisionist; Misa, 19-year-old British Transjordanian, and Stavsky, were all brought together in the court hall here today.

Only two witnesses were examined today as the hearing into the death of Dr. Arlossoff continued before a British Magistrate here. After the hearing court was adjourned until August 5.

Captain Rice, chief of the Palestine police's criminal investigation department, went into the witness box and stayed there for three hours, describing minutely the particulars of the murder case. Captain Rice gave evidence of accounts of the murder told to him by Mrs. Arlossoff, widow of the slain Zionist leader, and other persons who were involved.

Widow Identified Stavsky

Captain Rice stressed the fact that on the day following the murder, which was a Sunday, Mrs. Arlossoff was shown ten photographs of persons suspected as accomplices or conspirators of the crime. She pointed to the picture of Stavsky, said Captain Rice, and stated that he resembled the taller man of the

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State Senate Appeal**To President for German****Jews Asked in Resolution**

ALBANY, Aug. 3.—A resolution putting the New York State Senate on record as deploring the persecution of the Jews in Germany and requesting President Roosevelt to make representations to the Nazi regime is being held in committee for subsequent action. The resolution was introduced yesterday by Thomas C. Donnan, Republican, of Orange County, and is similar to that introduced in Congress by Representative Hamilton Fish, Jr.

The resolution states in part that "the members of the New York State Senate regret the continued persecution of the Jews in Germany and express sympathy for them in their hour of trial, humiliation and economic discrimination and request the President of the United States to use his good offices and make friendly representations to the German Government in the interest of humanity, justice and world peace, to respect the civic and economic rights of their citizens of Jewish origin, and to put an end to racial and religious persecution."

Jewish Colonization in**Jugoslavia Province****Starts With 50 Families**

VIENNA, Aug. 3.—Jewish colonization of the Macedonian part of Jugoslavia started today when the first fifty families set forth for Bitoli, the Belgrade press reported. The Jugoslavian minister of agriculture has approved the Jewish colonization movement on the ground that the economic crisis has rendered a large number of Jews destitute. Jewish financing of the movement is assured, the Belgrade press added.

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group which she said took part in her husband's killing.

For this reason, and also for other reasons, Captain Rice explained, Starvsky was arrested on the following day. On the evening of the day he was arrested he and sixteen other persons took part in an identification parade at police headquarters. Mrs. Arlossoff immediately pointed to Starvsky, said Captain Rice, and when she came closer to him she fainted away. A few minutes later she walked down the line once more and again pointed to Starvsky. Then she insisted that all of the suspects should walk up and down. They did so, and she indicated four of the men as resembling the taller accomplice to the murder.

According to Captain Rice, Mrs. Arlossoff then urged that the police let her speak with each of the five men she had pointed out. They were told to pronounce the Hebrew word: "Kamushka." After Starvsky spoke this word, Mrs. Arlossoff told the police "He is trying to speak within his throat."

Widow's Identification Possible

On Saturday, a week after the murder, Captain Rice described how he and two other police officers went to the scene of the crime and after conducting experiments became convinced that it was possible for the widow to distinguish between the suspects and give a good description of the accomplices owing to the reflection of the light of Jaffa and the fact that it was a bright night, many stars being visible.

Regarding Rosenblatt, Captain Rice stated that he ordered this man's arrest as a result of secret information received by the police. In the identification parade at police headquarters on July 29 Mrs. Arlossoff recognized Rosenblatt as a second accomplice, Captain Rice testified.

On the following day, said Captain Rice, Mrs. Arlossoff said she wanted to see Rosenblatt unshaved. Upon seeing Rosenblatt with a two-day's growth of beard, she told Captain Rice she was convinced he was the man she saw on the beach at Jaffa the night her husband was killed.

Replying to a question from the magistrate, Captain Rice stated he had been seeking information regarding Starvsky's movements since the day of the killing. He declared that he had not heard what Mrs. Arlossoff said about Starvsky when she identified him in the parade at police headquarters.

**Nazi Deny Reports of
Clash Between Reichswehr,
Storm Troops in Nuremberg**

BERLIN, Aug. 3.—A Hearst report that several persons were wounded during a clash between military units and storm troopers in Nuremberg when the Reichswehr guards and the police made an effort to prevent storm troopers from plundering Jewish houses was officially denied by the Nazi press here today.

"It is untrue that plundering or other disturbances occurred in Nuremberg," the Nazi press stated. "No Jewish houses or Jewish stores were raided. It is also untrue that General Von Epp has asked President Van Hinderburg's permission to declare martial law in Bavaria. Rumors of clashes between Reichswehr men and storm troopers are also false."

The press, however, made no reference to the mass arrest last week of more than 100 Jews, who were released after being detained in the Nazi barracks in Nuremberg for more than five hours. It is believed that the Hearst stories concerning trouble in Nuremberg probably originated from the story concerning the mass arrests.

Seize Jewish Student Homes

BERLIN, Aug. 3.—All the Jewish student homes in Wursburg, Saxony, were occupied today by Nazi storm troopers to be used for party offices. At the same time the Jewish Students Association of Wursburg was ordered to dissolve itself.

Upon reading the government notice the following day describing the suspects in the murder, Chabeta said he immediately thought of Starvsky as being the taller accomplice because he resembled the police description generally and also because of his peculiar manner of walking and his rough appearance.

Chabeta told the court that his colleague, Talbot, the passport clerk in his office, had the same thought on the matter and immediately notified Captain Rice that he suspected Starvsky was one of the accomplices.

Hitler Intercedes, Waives Duty on Horses for Jewish Peddler, War Veteran

BERLIN, Aug. 3.—The first instance of Chancellor Hitler's taking personal interest in the plight of a Jew was reported in yesterday's *Tilster Zeitung*. A Jewish peddler, Max Bergmann, lost his only horse, which made the continuance of his hawking business impossible. Since horses are very cheap in Meissel, or in Klispoda, Lithuania, which is across the border from Tilsit in East Prussia, Bergmann wrote a letter and mailed it directly to Chancellor Hitler, asking permission to import a horse from Meissel duty free in view of his impoverishment.

Bergmann enclosed documents in his letter to Hitler proving that he was a war veteran who had seen service in the front line trenches.

In reply to Bergmann's letter, customs officials on the border between East Prussia and Lithuania received instructions from Chancellor Hitler to permit Bergmann to import a horse from Meissel without charging him so much as a penny in duty.

German Jewish Situation Is Worse Than Spanish Expulsion, Says Dr. Adler

LOS ANGELES, Aug. 3.—Declaring that placing the swastika alongside the American flag was the lowest kind of blasphemy, Dr. Cyrus Adler, head of the American Jewish Committee, who is here for a brief visit, yesterday addressed a group of more than 100 representative members of the local Jewish community at a luncheon given in his honor. Dr. Adler's statement was in connection with a photograph which appeared a few weeks ago in a local daily newspaper showing four young men wearing the Hitlerite emblem and standing beside an American flag.

The situation for the Jews today is more serious than in 1932, when they were expelled from Spain, Dr. Adler stated. "At least, in those days the Jew could be converted to Catholicism," he pointed out. "They were given three months' time within which to sell some of their belongings, and the rest of the world was open to them for colonization."

Now the world is closed to the German victims of Hitlerism, he stated, and the worst part of this phase of persecution is that the Nazis are not courageous enough to adopt a plan of open massacre of the Jews in Germany. "What the Nazi wants is not to kill the Jew but to degrade him, to cast leading physicians from their positions and to make them scrub the floors of the hospitals where they formerly were the chief medical authorities," he said.

Committee's Work

In discussing the work of the American Jewish Committee, Dr. Adler said that long before Hitler became chancellor of Germany the committee had already been communicating by telephone and cable with the leaders of the German Jews.

"World opinion so far has had but little effect on Germany's attitude toward the Jew," Dr. Adler stated. "The German Government has disregarded the opinion of official England. Mussolini has turned his back on the Nazi representatives. In America Hans Luther and Dr. Schacht have been told in no uncertain terms what this country thinks of the persecution of the Jew. And yet all of this pressure has done little to alleviate the lot of the Jew in Germany."

"It is up to us in America to help financially. Here in America we do not yet feel keenly the terrible plight of the German Jew. But England does, and with its handful of Jews has contributed more money than the four and a half million Jews in this country."

Blacklist German Girls Seen in Jewish Company, Warn Them of Punishment

BERLIN, Aug. 3.—Nazis have terrorized the minds and blinded the eyes of young Germany, but now for the first time they are striking fear into the hearts of Reich womanhood. A hunt for non-Jewish girls keeping company with Jewish men has been started throughout Bavaria by Julius Streicher's fanatical Hitlerite newspaper, *Der Sturmer*. The paper has started the publication of a blacklist, printing the names and addresses of German young women seen in the company of Jewish men.

"There are still German women and girls who cling to Jews," the paper stormed. "Propaganda alone has not succeeded in persuading these women to take the right path. Henceforth we shall get the names and photographs of such women on our blacklist. If their blood refuses to revolt against Jews, public fury perhaps will prevent them from associating with Jews."

Nazis Suspend Magazine

For Pro-Jewish Remarks

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Aug. 3.—The son of Mrs. Rosine Spieker, a non-Jewess, has been arrested and their magazine, the *Hausfrauen Zeitung*, has been suspended by the authorities here. Reason for the action is believed to be because Mrs. Spieker, a venerable women's leader and president of the *Nuremberger Women's Association*, permitted herself to make several remarks favorable to the Jews.

Racial Affairs Dictator

BERLIN, Aug. 3.—Dr. Adolph Goerck, Reichs-Commissar of Racial Affairs, was officially proclaimed yesterday dictator in complete charge of racial problems. His word makes binding any decision on racial issues reached, especially with reference to the racial origins of those whose 100 percent Aryanism is held in doubt.

Felix Warburg Denies Report

Felix M. Warburg, in a letter to Dr. S. Margoshes, editor of *The Day*, denied reports that he had dissuaded President Roosevelt from making public comment on the persecution of the Jews in Germany.

"The report is not true either generally or in particular," Mr. Warburg declared.

Investigate Nazi Actions

In Toronto After Protest

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

TORONTO, Aug. 3.—Mayor Stewart today issued a stern order to the police department of this city to investigate the Swastika Club here. "Toronto will not tolerate Hitlerism or any group's taking the law into its own hand," the mayor stated.

Massable police closed down the Buley Beach headquarters of the Swastika Club after a large body of Jewish young men had peacefully staged a demonstration near the premises. The demonstration was of a peaceful nature, but police acted on the safe side, fearing an impending clash between the Hitlerites and the Jews.

The rumor is current here that the leaders of the Swastika Club are discredited Hitler agents from the United States, where they were encountered in their work by strong Jewish opposition. Therefore they have moved to Canada, hoping eventually to send the Hitler movement into the United States through this country.

Several young Swastika Club members paraded the boardwalk last night singing the following ditty:

"Oh give me a home
Where the Gentiles may roam,
Where the Jews are not rampant always,
Where seldom is heard
A loud Yiddish word,
And the Gentiles are free all
The day!"

Straps Appointment Manipulated

The paper charges that Rabbi Stephen S. Wise, honorary president of the American Jewish Congress; Bernard M. Baruch, outstanding financier and industrialist, and Henry Morgenthau, former Ambassador to Turkey and head of President Roosevelt's commission to the wheat stabilization conference, helped to make Jesse L. Straps American Ambassador to France because "the Jews hope that Straps may destroy Germany through Paris."

It further asserts that it had been proposed that Mr. Morgenthau be named as Ambassador to Germany.

Germans Disbanded Here

Forgetting that German concerns are dismissing or have dismissed all their Jewish employees, the newspaper complains bitterly that Jewish employees in the United States are discharging their German workers. This alleged state of affairs, according to Der Sturmer, is provoking fury in American circles "as this violation of rights by one class of citizens against another."

The paper admits that the central American Jewish organizations have obtained from an open anti-Nazi boycott but explains that this is because "American Jews feel if too much publicity is given to German anti-Semitism, it will inspire anti-Semitism also in America which the Jews have good reason to fear."

"The long diatribe concludes with what is a revelation to the German public—that there had been a split in the Nazi ranks in New York, and that the Nazi leader, Paul Mangot, had been the victim of terrorism, had lost his job and had been evicted from his home for inability to pay his rent.

Racial Problems Course For German Doctors Opens

BERLIN, Aug. 3.—The first course in racial problems opened yesterday at the University of Halle in the presence of more than five hundred doctors, one-third of all the doctors in Saxony.

In his opening speech, state commissioner Harman declared that laws will be issued for all Germany requiring every doctor to prove in the course of a year or two that they have passed the special racial course, without which no one will be permitted to practice.

Grietswald to prevail upon the authorities to transfer Orloff to Berlin.

Visits Orloff in Prison

Representing Geist, American consul here, visited Orloff in prison this afternoon. The authorities agreed to permit Mr. Geist to see the young Brooklyn student from time to time until the case is settled.

In filing a complaint with the ministry of justice over the failure to give Orloff a hearing, Mr. Messersmith promised that Orloff would leave the country on his release.

Orloff was brought to Berlin only after long and protracted effort by the consular authorities. Mr. Messersmith conferred with Ambassador William E. Dodd yesterday concerning the case.

The position of Orloff was considered especially serious since under recent decrees communist activities such as Orloff is charged with, are punishable by death. Orloff has steadfastly denied being a communist or having engaged in communist activities.

He is reported to have been seriously ill-treated in the Grietswald prison.

Transjordan Settlement By Jews Debate Subject Of League Mandates Body

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The British Government is not prepared at present to permit Jews to settle in the Transjordan territory. There is a general feeling in that country that settlement at present is impracticable for reasons of security, he contended.

Large Desert Areas

The British representative stated that though it is true that Transjordan is much bigger than Palestine it does not contain as much cultivable land, consisting largely of desert areas. The cultivable parts of Transjordan are as densely populated as the larger part of Palestine, Mr. Young declared.

Lord Lugard, British member of the Mandates Commission, asked Mr. Young to define his Government's attitude toward Arabs from Palestine settling in Transjordan with the assistance of Jews in Palestine. Mr. Young replied that the British Government would not object to this so long as the number of Arabs immigrating falls within the absorptive capacity of Transjordan. He claimed that the Transjordan area does not contain large unoccupied tracts of land suitable to support a big wave of immigration.
