Baden Govt. Forbids Citizenship for Jews; Sets Example for Reich (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Aug. 7.—No Jew will be henceforth admitted to German citizenship in the province of Baden, according to new citizenship regulations promulgated by the Baden Government. The new regulations, it is expected, will be emulated throughout the Reich.

No Jew, no Jewish descendant and no one married to someone of Jewish blood will be permitted to obtain citizenship, according to the regulations which consist of eleven paragraphs.

Every applicant for citizenship will have to prove that he does not fall within any of these categories in order to have his application granted.

"Our State is not interested in the growth of a non-Aryan population, the regulations proclaim. "We do not want racial admixtures and therefore refuse to accept more non-Aryans even if the applicant is of distant Jewish descent."

The regulations further demand that Jewish front-fighters, who were to have been exempt from all Jewish discriminations, will have to explain, why, if they are listed as having been conscripted into the army, they had not enlisted voluntarily.

Non-Jews applying for citizenship will have to undergo medical examinations and produce certificates from the State doctors attesting to their pure Aryanism.

To Free 4 Revisionist Prisoners in Palestine (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

JERUSALEM, Aug. 7.—Six of the Revisionists still imprisoned following the well-known arrest on July 25 of alleged members of a terrorist organization are to be released tomorrow, it was learned today. Those who are to be freed are Zvi Zimorovitch, Benzinger, Stancierman, Rignans and Sharoni.

The remainder of the prisoners will be examined before the magistrate at Jaffa tomorrow.

Of the twenty or so Revisionists arrested, a majority have previously been freed. One of the group, Zvi Rosenblatt, is being held in connection with the murder on June 16 of Dr. Chaim Arlossoff.

Austria Limits Foreign Students to Check Nazis (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

VIENNA, Aug. 7.—Limitation on the number of foreign students allowed to study at Austrian universities owing to the shortage of facilities and to enable the maintenance of order has been officially announced. Every foreign student newly enrolling now in any of the universities, will be notified in October whether they are to be admitted.

The Jewish Telegraphic Agency understands that the restrictions are aimed to prevent the entrance of German students into Austria to strengthen the Nazi movement here.

Numerous Against Jews

Some newspapers here have voiced the belief that this numerous clause will also be directed against Eastern European Jews and therefore, the Jewish attitude toward the new Government measure has been reserved. The Peasants' Union and the Christian Socialist elements which form the backbone of the Dollfus Government's support have been agitating for the establishment of a racial quota for the Jews in all fields of Austrian life.

Freimann Not to Attend World Zionist Congress (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

MONTREAL, Aug. 7.—A. J. Freimann, president of the Canadian Zionist Organization, and Mrs. A. J. Freimann, president of the Canadian Hebrews, will not go to the Zionist Congress as previously announced. The Canadian Zionist delegation will consist of S. E. Scherfberg, president of the Montreal Zionist Council, and H. Wolofsky, publisher of the Jewish Daily Eagle and Canadian Jewish Chronicle, who is at present in Europe.

The representatives of the Canadian People Zion-Feire Zion will be Dr. L. Harnel of Winnipeg, and Israel Freimann of Toronto.

Jailed for 'Insults'

BERLIN, Aug. 7.—According to reports published in the Frankfurter Zeitung, a number of Jews were imprisoned in the Osthausen concentration camp for making insulting remarks about Aryan girls.

Jews Ordered to Quit Towns in Nuremberg Area as Nazis Extend Repressive Rules (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Aug. 7.—The anti-Jewish feeling in the Nuremberg region culminated in the issuing of an official order forbidding the Jews to remain in the townships of Oberrothbach, Unterschrobenbach and Rimbach. The order was signed by Mayor Lowe on behalf of the above named communities. At the same time, the municipality of Debernau also in the Nuremberg region, made a public announcement that no member of the community is permitted to trade with Jews. This is believed the first time Jews have been forbidden by the Nazis to remain in their home towns.

In Nuremberg itself it was officially announced that Jews are prohibited the use of municipal swimming pools and public baths. This was the first time that such an order has been issued in any of the larger cities of Germany. For the past week Nuremberg has been the scene of a reign of terror against the Jews led by the Nazi chief Julius Streicher, editor of Der Stürmer. As a result of the incident in Der Stürmer there has been an exodus of terror stricken Jews from Nuremberg, many fled with only the clothes on their backs, leaving all their property to the tender mercies of the Nazis.

Dr. David W. Edelman Dies Suddenly in Los Angeles

(Jewish Daily Bulletin)

LOS ANGELES, Aug. 7.—Dr. David W. Edelman, chief of staff of the Cedars of Lebanon Hospital here, died suddenly of a heart attack at the hospital. He was sixty-five years old and a bachelor.

The son of the late Rabbi Abraham Edelman, first rabbi of Congregation Ansh Efrayim here, Dr. Edelman was born and brought up in this city. He was a graduate of the Columbia University medical school and was prominent here in the direction of the Jewish Federation and in the councils of the Democratic Party. He served as president of the first Civil Service Commission in this city.

He is survived by a sister, Mrs. Rachel Barnett; a brother, A. M. Edelman; two nephews and four nieces.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday with Rabbi Edgar F. Magnis officiating.

Magistrate Gottlieb Dead

Magistrate Maurice H. Gottlieb, 66 years old, died yesterday at his home, 57 East 88th Street, of heart disease, after having been confined in bed for many months. He had been a magistrate since 1926 when he was appointed by Mayor James J. Walker.

In the Magistrate's Court, his work was notable for his charitable attitude toward petty crimes induced by poverty. He organized the Baiten Fund, a revolving fund for making loans to the poor and was active in other charitable ventures.

ENTHUSIASTIC CROWDS GREET UNTERMYER WHO URGES BOYCOTT SPREAD IN BROADCAST

Sarnel Untermeyer, leader of the world boycott movement against Germany and president of the newly created World Jewish Economic Federation, returned from Europe on the French liner, Paris, Sunday, to face a highly enthusiastic reception by 15,000 New York Jews.

Specialty chartered boats met the Paris at Quarantine with bands blaring and decorated with huge posters hailing Mr. Untermeyer as "our leader", and praising him for his work at the recent world boycott conference held in Amsterdam at which he presided.

At the pier 5,000 enthusiastic Jews crowded onto the dock while 10,000 more waited patiently in the street for a glimpse of the man whom they considered the hero of the fight against the Nazis. Delegations of Jewish War Veterans in uniform, posts of the American Legion, veterans of Allied's campaigns in Palestine, Zionist and Hadassah organizations as well as many other groups were on the pier and cheered Mr. Untermeyer.

Addresses Nation Over Radio

Flanked by motorcycle police and heartily cheered by the crowds who had waited for hours to greet him, Mr. Untermeyer was rushed uptown after a short reception at the pier to deliver an address over Station WABC and a national hookup.

"I have seen and talked with many of the terror-stricken refugees who have had the good fortune to escape from Germany, though forced to leave their property behind them," said Mr. Untermeyer, "and I want to say to you that nothing that has swept through to you over the radio censorship and lying propaganda that are at work to conceal and misrepresent the situation of the Jews in Germany begins to tell a fraction of the frightful story of fiendish torture, cruelty and persecution that are being inflicted day by day upon these men, women and children, or the terrors of worse than death in which they are living.

Fiendish Boycotts

"The Hitler regime organized and are fiendishly prosecuting a boycott to exterminate the Jews by placarding Jewish shops, warning Germans against dealing with them, by imprisoning Jewish shopkeepers and parading them through the streets by the hundreds under guard of Nazi troops for the sole crime of being Jews, by ejecting them from the learned professions in which

many of them had attained eminence, by excluding their children from the schools, their men from the labor unions, closing against them every avenue of livelihood, locking them in the vile concentration camps, starving and torturing them, murdering and burning them without cause, all solely because they or their remote ancestors were Jews and all with the avowed object of exterminating them.

"As against this the foulest boycott in the annals of time, we are appealing to all mankind to enforce a counter-boycott. That appeal is meeting with the conviction that idealism and justice are still alive."

Mr. Untermeyer then appealed for support from those Jewish organizations who have so far been lukewarm or opposed to the boycott saying:

"With this explanation of our aims, I appeal to the American Jewish Committee, whose public spirit and good intentions I do not for a moment question, but the wisdom of whose judgment I challenge, no longer to hold aloof but to rid themselves of their timid and ill-considered prejudices and join in actively pressing this boycott as our only weapon except the appeal to the League, which I shall discuss at a later time.

Onits Congress Appeal

"I purposely refrain from including the American Jewish Congress in this appeal because I am satisfied that 95 per cent of their members are already with us and that they are being misrepresented by two or three men now abroad. Of them I ask that, prior to the meeting to be held this month in Prague by their executive committee, they instruct those false leaders in no uncertain terms as to the stand they must take on this all-important subject and demand that they shall either openly represent their views or resign their offices. One of them, generally recognized as the king-pin of mischief makers, is harrying around the Continent engaged in his favorite pastime of spreading discord, assuring at one time and place that he favors and supports the boycott and at another that he is opposed or indifferent to it, all dependent on the audience he is addressing; but always directly or indirectly delivering a stab in the back."

Mr. Untermeyer concluded by thanking his audience for the heartening reception he had received and expressing the conviction that through the support of all Jews aided by the millions of non-Jewish sympathizers Hitlerist bigotry and fanaticism would be driven from the earth.

Jersey City Reform Temple Adopts Conservative Ritual

JERSEY CITY, N. J., Aug. 7.—After 25 years of existence as a Reform office of worship, Temple Beth Ed here, commencing with the high holy days will no longer adhere strictly to Reform ritual but will become modern Conservative, officers of the congregation have announced. Worshipers will pray with their hats on. Another departure announced is that for the first time in its history the congregation will have a public sale of seats for the holiday services.

Announcement also was made that Rabbi Joseph Freedman has been chosen associate spiritual leader, to serve together with Dr. Maurice Thoreau. Both are Reform rabbis.

Pothura Slayer Here With French War Veterans

Shimon Schwartzbard, who killed Simon Pothura, notorious Ukrainian pogrom leader, arrived in New York on the French liner, Paris, Sunday. Mr. Schwartzbard came here with a group of 250 French War Veterans who are in the United States to return the visit the American Legion made to France some years ago. The delegation included 25 French Jewish veterans. The French veterans will remain here for three weeks.

A dinner and reception for M. Schwartzbard will be given by the Jewish War Veterans Wednesday evening in Trotty's dining room, 214 Street and 7th Avenue. National and state officers of the Jewish War Veterans and well known Jewish leaders are expected to be present.

Anti-Semitic Propaganda Reaches into South Africa

JOHANNESBURG, So. Africa, July 5.—Nazi propaganda against the Jews spreading to the far corners of the world, has reached even the small community of Vryheid, in Natal, according to the Vryheid correspondent of the Natal Mercury of Durban.

A "senseless pamphlet broadcast in town praising Germany's lead in the campaign against the biggest menace in the world—the Jew" was brought before the town council by Councillor H. Ellis, the correspondent reports, with the suggestion that the council express its abhorrence at this call to racial prejudice.

After several members of the council had spoken on the subject, it was decided to ignore the pamphlet as "beneath contempt."

Left Wing Hegemony Zionist Congress Danger Revisionist Chief Warns

WARSAW, July 25.—A hegemony of the Left Wing Zionists will be the main preoccupation of the Eighteenth World Zionist Congress at Prague in the latter part of August, Vladimir Jabotinsky, Revisionist leader, stated in an interview with the Jewish Telegraphic Agency here. He predicted a quiet Congress.

"I do not yet know the exact figures, but it already seems certain that the main preoccupation of the Congress will be the danger of a hegemony of the Left wing," Mr. Jabotinsky said.

"Should the Left be able to form a numerical majority alone or with the help of some Weizmannist elements, it will mean practically repelling all the rest of the fractious from any interest in the activities of the Zionist Organization for the next two years. Even the funds will suffer immensely in that case.

Judomast Front

"If a Left majority is not achieved, however, then we may expect various attempts to create a big Judomast front with a strong anti-class war tendency. If such a front is formed and proves strong enough to elect a Judomast Executive, in which case the new course of the Zionist movement will have to be expressed in clear resolutions, then I do not see why Revisionists, if requested, should not join such an Executive.

"I know," said Mr. Jabotinsky, "that everyone is expecting a very tumultuous Congress, but I am not so very sure of that. No blood-thirst attempts will be permitted, of course, but I very much doubt whether anyone at Prague will seek to engage in that sort of eloquence.

"I should therefore not be surprised if this Congress proves to be one of the quietest, at least until the last few days, when the Left, unless it is in an absolute majority, will begin to realize that their game is lost."

Victor Ridder Sails

Victor Ridder, secretary of the Staats-Herald Corporation is sailing tonight on the Europa accompanied by William J. Amund. Mr. Ridder plans to visit his family in Switzerland for a month. Joseph Ridder, a brother is now in Germany traveling with his family.

Mr. Ridder denied that he had any plans for visiting Germany. Mr. Amund is going to Berlin according to an official of the North German Lloyd.

Toronto Swastika Show Disturbing to Col. Cohen

MONTREAL, Aug. 7.—Lieut-Colonel Charles Wesley Cohen, representative of the British Central Chamber of Agriculture at the World Wheat Fair in Regina, has sailed for home on the Empress of Britain. Col. Cohen, a West Sussex farmer on a grand scale, is known as an agricultural expert.

News accounts of the Hitlerite swastika flag being raised in Toronto much disturbed this well-known communal worker who said: "I was horrified to read this and my view is that if these young people only knew what horror the swastika flag is associated with, they would burn it everytime they saw one. After all Canada's great contribution to the world is that it has shown how people of varying races and religions can live together amicably. The Germans cannot even stand a difference of religion," he added.

The Jewish exhibits of agricultural achievements in Canada, Palestine, Soviet Russia and other countries drew much attention at the Regina fair.

Fusion Candidate Elected In Brazil Zionist Poll

RIO DE JANEIRO, July 25.—Brazil will be represented at the World Zionist Congress by Dr. M. Helfman, candidate of the General Zionists and of the Poale-Zion.

Dr. Helfman was elected by a majority of over a thousand votes. The Zionist-Revisionist candidate, Professor Bodenheimer, polled about 600 votes.

The elections, which were held July 23, were without untoward incidents except in Sao Paulo, where the director of the Sao Paulo Yiddische Zeitung, Frankfurter, was attacked by a Revisionist. Revisionist leaders condemned the attacker, and expelled him from the local Brith Trumpeldor.

Synagogue Groups Begin Kehillah Organization

Representatives of more than one hundred Orthodox synagogues and societies met Sunday evening at the Bialystoker Center, 225 East Broadway, to begin the practical work of the Kehilla K'ehillah in New York, under the chairmanship of Dr. Jostia Simon.

After listening to speeches by representative leaders of Orthodox Jewry, the conference adopted several resolutions, among them one expressing their wholehearted support for the N. E. A. program of the Roosevelt administration and urging the elimination of Saturday as a work day.

First Rehearsal Tonight For Jewish Pageant

The first general rehearsal of the cast that will total 6,200 singers, actors and dancers participating in the Jewish pageant, "The Romance of a People," will begin tonight at the Washington Irving High School, 14th Street and Irving Place, Manhattan, at 8 o'clock. Thousands of young men and women, coming from all parts of the city have volunteered their services for the production, the proceeds of which will go towards the relief of those German Jews desiring to go to Palestine.

Isaac Van Grove, director of the Chicago Civic Opera Company, who arrived in New York yesterday from Cincinnati where he was conducting a summer opera season, will go over the score of the pageant tonight and subdivide the dancing, singing and acting groups into about thirty divisions in order to facilitate rehearsals. He will have thirty assistants in charge of the various groups.

To Design Stage

Peter Clark, noted stage engineer and designer and builder of many of the largest stages of the world, has contributed his services, and is now designing the massive stage that will be set up in the Polo Grounds. The set will be the largest ever constructed in this city and will embody the newest ideas in stage design. Mr. Clark who designed the stage of the Metropolitan Opera House, is more recently known for his construction of the stage at Rockefeller Center.

Radio Station WHOM in Jersey City has arranged to broadcast daily reports of the details in connection with the progress of "The Romance of a People," which will be presented at the Polo Grounds on September 14.

Jewish Lawyers Ousted

BERLIN, Aug. 7.—Twenty more judges and 185 lawyers in addition to those already announced, were disbanded during the past week on the score of their Jewish blood, according to a list published in the press today. The list includes 120 residents of Berlin.

Enlarge Music Department At Hebrew University

Starting October 1, the extension department for music of the Hebrew University, Jerusalem, is to be enlarged by the appointment of Emil Hansey and Karl Salomon, now resident in Palestine, according to a message received by the American office of the university, in New York, from Dr. Judah L. Magnes, chancellor, who is now in Europe.

Mr. Hansey, who for many years was leader and first violin of the Budapest String Quartet, will become instructor in instrumental music at the university. Mr. Salomon, formerly a composer and singer in Berlin, will be assigned to the department of vocal music.

Jew Elected to Brazil's Constitutional Assembly

RIO DE JANEIRO, July 25.—Dr. Horacio Lafer, well known Jewish industrialist and leader of the Association Commercial, was elected deputy to the National Constitutional Assembly in a special election held here.

Dr. Lafer lives in Sao Paulo, where he is prominent in the paper industry and in the politics of the State of Sao Paulo. He also plays an important part in national politics, having been Brazilian ambassador to Switzerland in 1920.

Dr. Lafer is active in Jewish affairs. For some time he was the official head of the Sao Paulo Hebrew High School "Hatschibah," and at present is at the head of the movement to aid the German Jews.

The news of Dr. Lafer's election was favorably received in all the Jewish settlements in Brazil, where Dr. Lafer is well known and loved.

Invite Foreign Jews to Patronize Leipzig Fair

BERLIN, Aug. 7.—Jews from outside of Germany are invited to patronize the Leipzig Fair in an official announcement by the Fair management stating that non-Aryans will be admitted to the exposition. Jewish firms in Germany are also promised that they will not be hindered in displaying their goods although there will be a "Brown display" of goods made in Germany "by Germans only" in which the Jewish firms will not be allowed to participate.

"The establishment of the Brown display gives no reason to assume that Jews will be eliminated altogether from the bazaar," states the management's communique.
