Upper Silesian Jews **Arrested in Reprisal** **For 'Atrocity' Information** (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Aug. 9.—Mass arrests of Jews in German Upper Silesia are reported today from Beuthen. The pretext is that the Jews who live near the Polish-German frontier are transmitting atrocity information to the Polish press at Kattowitz.

Every time that reports of anti-Jewish activities appear in the Polish press, Jews are arrested in German Silesian towns as a reprisal. The result has been that the Jews are fearful of communicating with anyone outside of Germany, even fearing to write their relatives abroad. This Nazi policy is in line with the Nazi intention to hold the relatives of German exiles responsible for anything that is said or done abroad. Recently the Nazis announced that Communists in jail would be punished for actions of their comrades not yet jailed by the Hitlerites. This policy is now being applied to the Jews.

Orloff's Release Is Due; **To Be Deported to U. S.** (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Aug. 9.—Walter Orloff, Brooklyn, N. Y., medical student who has been imprisoned for over a month on charges of alleged Communist activities in Germany, is to be released this afternoon, George S. Messersmith, American consul general here, was informed by the authorities today. He will be deported immediately in accordance with the agreement made between the authorities and Mr. Messersmith that Orloff would leave the country. The charges against Orloff, under the new Nazi code, are punishable by death.

Wilno Nazi Boycott

WILNO, Aug. 9.—The Wilno chamber of commerce has unanimously voted to proclaim a boycott against goods from Nazi Germany in protest against the continued persecution of the Jews there.

Nazi Paper in Pogrom Cry **Asks Annihilation of Jews** (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Aug. 9.—The old Czarist pogrom slogan, "Kill the Jews!" was sounded yesterday by the Fraenkische Zeitung, a newspaper owned by Julius Streicher, notorious Nazi leader of Nuremberg, who has been in the forefront of all Nazi Jew-baiting activities. The paper editorially called on the Nazis for a pogrom on the Jews.

The Jews of Germany, the paper said in effect, should be made responsible for the anti-German propaganda allegedly conducted abroad by their relatives.

"We must not exercise mercy nor understanding," the paper exhorts. "Only hanging and confinement in concentration camps will help—lasting them and using the severest Dra-

Investigate Nazi Leaflets **'Bombing' of N. J. Meeting** (Jewish Daily Bulletin)

SPRINGFIELD, N. J., Aug. 9.—A thorough investigation of the "bombing" with Nazi propaganda of the open air meetings here Sunday and Monday of the United Jewish Society was under way today. Police and an inspector of the Department of Commerce Aeronautics Branch were seeking to trace the ownership of the mystery plane which dropped hundreds of Nazi leaflets on the 7,000 members of the organization, which has taken a stand in opposition to the present regime in Germany.

The leaflets protested against refusal of permission to allow the Friends of New Germany, Nazi organization in this country, to be represented at the gathering. They were printed in German.

The investigation follows complaints to the authorities by Albert F. Frosch, president of the United Singers Society. The plane, he said, had flown over the meeting and the noise of its engine had interrupted the community singing program.

Jews at Leipzig Fair **Considered a Bitter Jest** **As Repressions Continue** (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Aug. 9.—The announcement that Jews will be permitted to participate in the Leipzig Fair is considered as a bitter joke in view of the increased use of terroristic measures against Jewish merchants. Not a single day passes without publication in the Nazi provincial press of the most violent personal attacks against local Jewish merchants.

In many cases, the names and addresses of these unfortunate people are used and the tacit understanding conveyed by the newspaper stories is that no one need fear punishment for attacks on these people. Thus, their lives are sharply endangered.

Boycott and Intimidation

All this is in addition to the open boycott and picketing of Jewish shops and the intimidation of prospective customers, and the levying of special taxes on the Jewish merchants aimed—and succeeding in—bankrupting them.

At Leipzig, German Jews, who according to a recent announcement

Stavsky's Father in Warsaw **Seeking Palestine Visa** (Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WARSAW, Aug. 9.—The father of Abraham Stavsky, Polish Revisionist who is held in Palestine for the murder of Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff, Zionist labor leader and member of the political department of the Jewish Agency, is in Warsaw attempting to gain permission to enter Palestine, Der Moment, Yiddish daily, reported today.

The senior Stavsky liquidated his business in Brest-Litovsk, the paper reports, coming here with his possessions to obtain a middle-class immigration certificate. The British consul here declined to visa his passport, according to the paper. His refusal was allegedly due to the charges against Stavsky's son.

Ratify Deutsch Candidacy For Aldermanic Presidency On Anti-Tammany Slate

The informed choice of Bernard S. Deutsch for the nomination for President of the Board of Aldermen was ratified Tuesday evening by the "harmony" committee of the Fusion, anti-Tammany group. It was announced yesterday, by Charles G. Buckingham, chairman of the committee. The nomination of Mr. Deutsch had been freely predicted in the press during the last few days. In the last city election, running on an independent ticket for the Supreme Court, Mr. Deutsch made a remarkable showing.

Mr. Deutsch, who is forty-five years old, was born in Baltimore and educated in the public schools of New York City, the College of the City of New York and the New York Law School. He was admitted to the Bar in 1908 and has been in active practice ever since.

He is a leading member and officer of many legal associations and is active in Jewish affairs in New York City. Since 1929 Mr. Deutsch has been president of the American Jewish Congress, having been elected to that office for the fifth consecutive time in 1933. In politics Mr. Deutsch is listed as an independent Democrat.

At the meeting which confirmed the nomination of Mr. Deutsch, United States Attorney George S. Medfelle was asked by Samuel S. S. to accept the nomination for District Attorney of New York. Mr. Medfelle at first declined but later

Police Grapple for Bodies Of Six Jewish Orphans Drowned on Beach Outing

Police continued to grapple yesterday for the bodies of the six of the seven orphans of the Fride of Judea Home in Brooklyn who had been drowned when a wave swept over the sandbar on which the children had been playing on Tuesday. Officials of the home concentrated members of their staff from any liability for the disaster.

The particular spot on the beach where the children were having their outing is known as a treacherous place but no warning had been given the officials of the orphan home. Forty-one persons had been rescued from that spot on July 30.

Complaints that the life guards at the beach were negligent in their duty were made yesterday to the Queens County District Attorney's office. As a result of these, a grand jury investigation of the life guards is expected to be ordered.

Maurice Stollerman, superintendent of the Fride of Judea Home and Max Blumberg, its president, today issued the following joint statement:

"We have refrained until now from making any statement and issuing a report pending a reasonable check-up on the multiplicity of the varied facts. We are now able to advise after a careful analysis of details surrounding the unfortunate occurrence that we cannot in any sense place the responsibility or liability on anyone.

"It was clearly an unforeseen and unfortunate occurrence. We are

National Woman's Party Condemns Hitler Regime

In response to an open letter from Madame Rosika Schwimmer, noted feminist, to all American feminists concerning their reaction to Hitler's anti-Jewish decrees and orders, the National Council of the National Woman's Party issued a statement embodying a series of resolutions adopted by the organization.

The resolutions condemned in no uncertain terms the actions of the Hitler regime in excluding German women from all professional and business activity and asserted that such action would "reduce the German woman to economic dependence upon the man."

Jewish Communities Urged To Accept Into Their Fold Converts and Non-Jews

BRISLAU, Aug. 9.—The Jüdische Zeitung in a long article urged the Jewish community to adopt all converted and half Jews who wish to return to the Jewish religion. According to the paper there are many Christians who come under the above categories who are anxious to join the Jewish community.

The Jüdische Rundschau, organ of the German Zionists, also devoted a long editorial to the same problem estimating that in Germany there are at least two hundred and fifty thousand non-Aryans, non-Jews. According to the new racial laws adopted by the Nazis any one who has even one non-Aryan grandparent is a non-Aryan and comes under the restrictions imposed upon those of unquestioned Jewish parentage.

Ether Van Rijk, Actress, Celebrates 50th Birthday

AMSTERDAM, Aug. 9.—Yvonne Ether Boer van Rijk, Holland's most famous actress, celebrated her eightieth birthday here today at her home, where she received showers of congratulations from devoted followers in all walks of life.

Despite her advanced age, Yvonne van Rijk is still active and full of vigor. Her popularity has not ebbed with the passing of the years and the press here devoted much space to eulogistic articles.

The most famous actress in Holland, Yvonne van Rijk was early recognized as one of the most outstanding exponents of naturalism on the stage. Daughter of a pious Jewish family of Rotterdam, she began her stage career at the age of 21, and has won wide acclaim, not only in Holland, but also in Germany, France and England, where she frequently made guest appearances.

Disavows Hitler Remarks

Dr. Gustav Kell, professor of German at Hunter College, who was accused of pro-Nazi sentiment by the American Jewish Congress as a result of a purported interview upon his recent arrival from Germany, denied in the most emphatic terms that he was in favor of the Hitler regime, or anti-Jewish in any way. Dr. Kell said that he had been misquoted by the press.

Laborite Strength Over Forty Percent of Total at World Zionist Congress

LONDON, Aug. 9.—Although the Laborites did not secure a complete majority in the world election of delegates to the World Zionist Congress which is to meet at Prague later in the month, their number exceeds forty percent of the total according to authoritative figures secured by the Jewish Telegraphic Agency today.

Altogether there will be three hundred delegates at the Congress of whom approximately fifteen will be chosen by the world election committee after the Congress is in session. Some slight variations are possible during the scrutination of the delegates' mandates by the credentials commission at the Congress.

According to present reliable figures, the Laborites hold 127 seats; the General Zionists, including the group of Isaac Grunbaum, 76; the Jabotinsky Revisionists hold 43 seats; the Grossman Revisionists 4; the Mizrachi 2; Radicals, 2, and others, 1.

The fifteen additional seats on the remainder votes of the various countries will probably be divided chiefly among the smaller parties, but it is considered unlikely that it will affect the general proportions.

Fire Sweeps Polish Town, Jewish Families Homeless

WARSAW, Aug. 9.—Two hundred Jewish families were made homeless when fire swept through the village of Czerwinski, near the city of Luck, Poland, and destroyed most of the buildings in the village. With their belongings almost completely destroyed by the flames, the homeless Jews were reported faced with great hardships.

Card Resigns Ellis Island Post

Edward Card, Commissioner of Immigration at Ellis Island, stated yesterday that he has sent his resignation to Secretary of Labor Frances Perkins.

Presumably it will take effect at once, for at midnight the Immigration Department of which he is an officer, lost its identity in a merger and became the Department of Immigration and Naturalization.

Commissioner Card gave no specific reason for his resignation. He was appointed Immigration Commissioner by President Hoover on October 8, 1931.

Future of Jewish Grants To German Universities Exciting Speculation

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Aug. 9.—The question of what will happen to Jewish endowments in German Universities which have barred Jewish professors, continues to provide great interest in American circles in Germany, since most of the endowments were made by American Jews.

In this connection it was pointed out that the University of Frankfurt has several chairs established by Jewish endowments, including one of a quarter million marks, on physiology, from the late Jacob Schiff; one million marks, from Mathilde Rothschild, on advanced scientific studies; a quarter million marks from Katherine and Moritz Oppenheim, for natural science (it will be recalled that these two venerable Jewish philanthropists committed suicide recently declaring that they could no longer live in Nazi Germany).

Chemical Institute

Among the other endowments listed are: three hundred thousand marks from Arthur Weisberg for a chemical institute; 3,000,000 marks for various purposes from the Georg Speyer Foundation; one hundred and fifty thousand marks from Charles Hallgarten for a therapeutic institute; eighty thousand marks from Theodore Stern for pharmacology; the Otto and Ida Brunschild endowment of one hundred and seventy-five thousand marks for the Roman Seminary and thirty thousand marks annually for an economic institute from Wilhelm Merion.

In addition there are also institutes fully endowed by Jewish funds, such as the dental institute which received its funds from Carl Rothschild and the neurological institute endowed by Ludwig Edinger.

Mrs. Manischewitz was interred at the Mount Carmel Cemetery. Rabbi Fishelson, of the Brooklyn Jewish Center, officiated at the funeral. Mrs. Manischewitz, who was 43 years old, had been ill for six weeks.

3 Jews Go On Trial, After Long Delay, in Grothowski Slaying Case

LYON, Aug. 9.—Moses Kotz was sentenced to four years' imprisonment for the death of Grothowski. The other two defendants, Schauer and Tann, were released for lack of sufficient evidence.

LYON, Aug. 9.—The trial of the three Jews, M. Kotz, N. Schauer and Isaac Tann, accused of the murder of Jan Grothowski, Polish student, in a street brawl, last November, was renewed here today.

The death of Grothowski last November led to bloody riots against the Jews in Lyon and many other Polish cities. It also led to a renewal of anti-Semitic propaganda all over Poland. Originally four Jews were arrested and charged with the crime, but later S. Koller was released by the Polish authorities.

Grothowski succumbed to knife wounds received when he and five drunken companions returning from an all-night party engaged in a drunken brawl with Jewish passers-by.

Jewish Boy Scouts Hold Special Jamboree Services

BUDAPEST, Aug. 9.—Jewish Boy Scouts here from many countries to attend the international Scout Jamboree, were present at a special religious service conducted for them yesterday. Rabbi Paul Isidor of Goodrich Temple, conducted the services assisted by a choir of Scouts.

Jewish kids here for the Jamboree include several from England, Palestine, France and Syria.

Mower Secures Release Of Jewish Journalist By Bargain with Nazis

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Aug. 29—Edgar Ansel Mower, Berlin correspondent of the Chicago Daily News and president of the Foreign Correspondents Association here, has resigned from his post in order to secure the freedom from prison of Dr. Paul Goldmann, sixty-eight-year-old Jewish correspondent of the Vienna Neue Presse, who had been held for "high treason."

Mr. Mower had been in high disfavor with the Nazi authorities ever since their advent to power because of his unsparring criticism of Hitlerism and one of their first efforts was directed toward securing his removal from his post as representative of the foreign press group.

The association interceded with the authorities to secure Dr. Goldmann's freedom, which was finally granted after Mr. Mower offered to resign. Mr. Mower is shortly to leave Berlin to assume new duties with the Chicago Daily News at Tokio.

by the Fair management, would be permitted to exhibit their wares, do not dare to do so, particularly after announcements that the Berlin fashion show and the soap-makers' exhibit would be barred to them.

Foreign circles in Berlin are wryly amused at the invitation broadcast from Leipzig to the Jews abroad. They see this as an example of the organizers' belief that the Fair is doomed to failure. The appeal to the Jews, it is felt, will not prove successful since most Jews abroad do not feel it safe to visit Germany, particularly after the reports of the severe beating administered to Philip Zuckerman, New York fur dealer, who was assaulted and badly injured by uniformed storm-troopers despite the fact that he informed them he was an American citizen.
