## Girls, Firms Friendly To Jews Are Warned Of Reprisals by Nazis

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Aug. 13—A public warning was issued today by the Lawyers Association of Nassau, to all firms employing Jewish lawyers and even to firms employing Jewish war veterans, that this was contrary to the national spirit.

The warning published in the *Hessische Volkswacht*, declared: "Firms which do not understand this will realize it fully when their cases come up in the courts. Then they will learn why it pays to be represented by Aryan lawyers."

The same paper is publishing lists of Christian girls who are still keeping company with Jews and alleges that a large number of Christian girls still prefer to spend their time with Jews, in churches and at work ends at amuseur resorts.

The *Volkswacht* revealed that when such girls are caught by the Nazi storm troopers, they are registered and their names published in newspaper blacklists.

The student association of Erlangen University has issued a manifesto urging all German students to join Julius Streicher, fanatic anti-Semite and editor of the notorious paper, *Der Stürmer*, in his fight against the Jews, declaring: "The

## Prague Mayor Greets World Zionist Women

PRAGUE, Aug. 13—A delegation representing the Women's International Zionist Organization (WIZO), which is holding its conference here prior to the eighteenth World Zionist Congress, today was received by Mayor Karel Baza at the City Hall. In a speech of welcome to the Jewish women, the mayor declared the City of Prague felt honored at having been selected as the scene of important Zionist deliberations.

Dr. Vera Weismann, president of the organization, responded with a toast to President Masaryk of the Czechoslovakian Republic, and the delegation observed the toast in Hebrew with cries of "Hodak!"

## NAZI PRESS VIES IN HATE PROPAGANDA; CONTINUE SELIZING JEWS AS HOSTAGES

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Aug. 13—The spread of pogrom propaganda against the Jews is assuming dangerous character and proportions throughout the length and breadth of the Reich as the entire Nazi press apparently is entering into competition to see which of its members can go to the furthest extremes. No Government action has been taken to check this campaign which, since it is pressed most strongly by papers controlled by such high-ranking Nazis as Julius Streicher, organizer of the one-day open boycott against the Jews last April, must be assumed to have the tacit approval of the Nazi supreme councils.

Seeking to vie with a dozen other publications which have been foremost in anti-Jewish activities, *Die Weltzeitung* here today came out with

a streamer headline on its first page, "A Warning to Jews."

English Bishop Quoted

Berlin Jews, the paper insinuates, are secretly spreading rumors regarding the anti-Jewish atrocities. It warns them of the consequences of their alleged action. Quoting from an address in London by the Bishop of Gloucester, in which, according to *Die Weltzeitung*, the prelate declared that Jews fomented the Russian Revolution and asserted that what Germany really needs is for a French army to occupy Berlin, the paper warns its readers to heed the Bishop's remarks. Under the pretext that these statements set forth the actual situation, the paper calls on the Germans to paralyze the Jews and prevent further activities along these lines.

The article, with the exception of the reference to the British prelate, is strikingly similar to an article in yesterday's *Völkischer Beobachter*, newspaper owned by Hitler and the chief Government organ.

Continue Seizing Hostages

The future course of the Nazis in combating the opposition throughout the world to the ruthless policies and program of Hitler is seen in the extension of the system of seizing hostages among the helpless population here and punishing them for acts committed by others, over whom they have no control. A striking example of this was the seizure

## Urges British Retort To Nazi Shipping Rule

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON, Aug. 13—Reprisals against the discriminations imposed by Germany on British and American shipping were forecast today by the *London Financial Times* which learned that British shipping interests have suggested that British ports be closed to German ships.

However the execution of such reprisals is unlikely in the near future in view of the fact that Parliament is not in session now. It is unlikely that reprisals will include the abrogation of the treaty for the export of British coal to Germany.

Although the official German declaration on the shipping discrimination stated that they were due to currency restrictions, the *Financial Times* emphasized that the true German motive was an attempt to regulate some of the shipping lost to the Germans through the world wide Jewish boycott. The discriminations are also intended to force German Jews to travel on German ships which they allegedly avoid.

## "Black Book" Will List Nazi Anti-Jew Edicts

PARIS, Aug. 13—The Committee of Jewish Delegations announces that a "Black book" will be issued, edited by Dr. Leo Motzkin, containing a compilation of the anti-Jewish legislation and actions of the Hitlerite government in Germany. Copies of the book will be sent to all the governments of the world and to all members of the League of Nations.

of five persons supposedly related to  
Philip Scheidemann, once chancel-  
lor of the Second Reich, in retaliation  
for his anti-Nazi activities. Scheidemann  
asserted later that he had only four  
relatives in Germany.

Today's press reports that Frau  
Sitzmield was "taken under police  
observation" because her husband,  
proprietor of the large Ottag street,  
went abroad. The theory is, of  
course, that Herr Sitzmield will be  
unable to do anything abroad to  
which the Nazis could possibly take  
exception for fear that his wife  
would be made to suffer the conse-  
quences.

Many similar cases are being re-  
ported from the provinces. In many  
cases the relationship is a very dis-  
tant one, and in the case of some  
Jewish merchants who have fled  
abroad, there is no blood relation-  
ship, the hostages being Jewish for-  
mer employees.

Refugees abroad are being closely  
watched by an efficient Nazi espion-  
age organization, particularly to  
learn whether they have taken any  
of their capital abroad in violation  
of Government decree. Evidence  
of this provides especially fruitful  
grounds for charges against hos-  
tages already taken or against in-  
dividuals marked as hostages in par-  
ticular cases, to be seized on the  
least provocation.

### American Protest

Representatives of the American  
and British governments acted Fri-  
day to protect the interests of the  
seafaring lines in the German trade  
following the announcements that  
new restrictions on the shipping of  
foreign passengers in Germany  
would be rigidly enforced.

According to the new German re-  
gulations, foreign firms would be al-  
lowed to route to their home office  
only \$65.00 per passenger. The  
minimum for a one way fare from  
Germany to the United States is  
about \$102.50.

## Reich Bars "Moment", Yiddish Warsaw Daily

Russ Harris, vice president of the

whose commerce is definitely tied up  
with the United States (83 per cent  
of the trans-Atlantic trade is known  
to be American) would attempt to  
limit the transfer of an American  
ship line's funds in this manner," he  
said.

## Israel Rokach Remains To Be Taken To Palestine; Funeral Held Yesterday

Funeral services for Israel Ro-  
kach, founder and president of I.  
Rokach & Son, Inc., were held yester-  
day afternoon in the synagogue of  
Congregation Chevrotz Torah,  
Brooklyn, of which he was a mem-  
ber. Mr. Rokach, who was 62  
years of age, died Friday at the  
Brooklyn Jewish Hospital after be-  
ing ill for several weeks.

Temporary burial took place in  
Mount Lebanon Cemetery, Brook-  
lyn, and permanent burial will be in  
Palestine in accordance with the  
wishes of Mr. Rokach.

Israel Rokach was born in Wil-  
lowick, Lithuania, in 1871, the son  
of Rabbi A. L. Rokach and the  
former Miriam Rindsky. He came  
to the United States in 1893 and  
within a short time accumulated  
enough money to send for his wife  
and children.

Forty-five years ago, Mr. Rokach  
opened a small plant, in a cellar on  
Market Street in which he manu-  
factured kosher soap. His business  
grew by leaps and bounds, and time  
and again he moved his plant into  
larger quarters until in 1929 the firm  
moved into a huge plant built at a  
cost of \$1,000,000. This factory is  
located at 240 Wythe Avenue, Brook-  
lyn.

In his later years, Mr. Rokach  
devoted more and more time to  
philanthropic activities. He was a  
large contributor to the Brooklyn  
Federation of Jewish Charities, the  
Yeshiva College and the Jewish Na-  
tional Fund for the upbuilding of  
Palestine. In 1930 he was guest of  
honor at a dinner arranged by a

## Hebrew University Plans To Expand Institute for Jewish Studies Division

(Jewish Telegraph Agency)

GENEVA, Aug. 13—A program for the development of the Institute for Jewish Studies at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem was adopted here today at a meeting of the governing council of the university under the chairmanship of Chief Rabbi J. H. Hertz of London. Dr. Judah L. Magnes, chancellor of the university, presented a detailed report of the Institute's expansion in order to provide facilities for and to utilize the services of famous Jewish scholars who have suffered as a result of the Hitler persecution of the Jews in Germany.

New professorships were created in Hebrew and Jewish philosophy with the establishment of a new chair library, and chairs in ancient Israelite history and the literature of the second Jewish commonwealth were determined upon.

The council decided to make every possible effort during the coming month to raise a fund sufficient to cope with the present crisis and to provide new facilities for teaching and research.

## No Swastika Flies Over Reich Exhibit Where Jewish Women Lunch

CHICAGO, Aug. 13—Assurances that under no conditions would the Swastika flag fly over the World's Fair were received by the Jewish Women's Organization of Chicago today.

Mrs. Benjamin I. Morris, of the Jewish Women's Aid Society, demanded this assurance as the price of her group's participation in the large luncheon to be held in the German American Building, at the Century of Progress, on Monday. The luncheon is to be the main event in the celebration of Women's Day at the Fair.

Miss Marie Becker, chairman of the German American luncheon society, called a meeting of the advisory committee consisting of the presidents of 75 organizations of women at the headquarters of the Chicago Association of Commerce. Miss Becker told the Jewish organization, "not only will there be no Nazi flag on the German-American Building, but there will be no official exhibit by the German government." She added that the exhibit now in the United States for that purpose has been cancelled.

## ANTI-SEMITIC DANGER IN U. S. BARELY AVERTED 10 YEARS AGO, SAYS 'CHRISTIAN CENTURY' WRITER

The persistency of the Jews in maintaining their "polarities and racial isolation" and their "dead relationship to two distinct nationalities" are the grounds for suspicion of the Jew as some one alien and foreign, declares Alfred Williams Anthony, founder of the Federal Council of Churches of Christ Commission on Good Will Between Jews and Christians, in an article, "Explaining the Jew," in the current issue of The Christian Century.

A wave of anti-Semitism which threatened this country ten years ago, "when Henry Ford was issuing his Dearborn Independent and the revived Ku Klux Klan was flourishing," was only narrowly repelled, Mr. Anthony says. Anti-Semitism, such as it manifests now in Germany is "a double problem of the

Jew and the Christian; certainly not less for the Jew to work upon and solve than for the Christians," he declares.

Referring to the causes of anti-Jewish feeling, he states:

"As the Jews move among the nations they persist in polarities and racial isolation as no other peoples do. While they may profess to be loyal to the government under which they live, yet common folk, seeing their alien and foreign ways, scarcely can be blamed for regarding them as still alien and foreign. Particularly is this suspicion of disloyalty aggravated when some of the Jews continue to glory in their national ideals, as distinct from the ideals of the country in which they live, and endeavor to recover Palestine as their country, and there set up a modern state, autonomous and independent. That dual relationship to two distinct nationalities, which may be justified in the mind of a Zionist Jew, is hard to understand and justify in any other mind. Frequently it takes the aspect of treason to the land of residence, as the non-Jew looks at it."

## Bialik Argentine Delegate To Zion Congress; Second Mandate Being Disputed

(J.T.A. Special Correspondent)

BUENOS AIRES, Aug. 1—One of two World Zionist Congress mandates to which Argentina and Uruguay are jointly entitled will go to the General Zionists, whose delegate is Chaim Nachman Bialik, election returns from the two countries show. The General Zionists also claim the second mandate, but their claim is being contested by the Poale Zion-Zivri Zion group.

Elections were held July 2 and 9, but final decisions are still unknown. This is not unusual here, where months often elapse before the results of important elections are made known. In this instance, however, the delay is due to the contest between the two leading parties for the second mandate.

## Rabbi in Mexico City Found Dead in Fast

MEXICO CITY, Aug. 13—Rabbi Benjamin Sorley, fifty-three, was found dead here at his home on Calle Heros de Granaditas. The rabbi's body was discovered when his wife, Mrs. Rosa Sorley, returned home after an absence of over a week during which the rabbi had been alone in the performance of a religious rite.

When found, Rabbi Sorley had apparently been dead about five days. Authorities who examined him declared his death was caused by malnutrition probably induced by the period of fasting which the rabbi had entered. His death was a great shock to the Jewish colony here, where he had been widely known and beloved.

## Syracuse Rabbi Gives Lie To Hitler White-Washer Who Was German Guest

SYRACUSE, Aug. 13—Rabbi Isaac Eisenfeld, of Temple Adas Yeshurun, has taken the local Commissioner of Health, Dr. George C. Rabland, sharply to task for an interview Dr. Rabland gave the local press on his return from a short European trip.

Dr. Rabland stated that while he had only been in Germany four weeks in order to study public health work in Berlin, he had seen little or no signs of anti-Jewish feeling. He declared that he had only seen one sign vying the boycott against the Jews and that he had seen Gentile and Jewish children playing on the streets together. Dr. Rabland also stated that most of the stories of Hitler's persecution of the Jews are pure fiction, and that the Jews are suffering little from the highly advertised persecution.

Rabbi Eisenfeld noted that Rabland's expenses were paid by the Oberlander Fund and that this is himself made Rabland a very respectable witness. He also called attention to the fact that many of the doctors in Syracuse had found it necessary to protest against the German regime. Rabbi Eisenfeld threatened that if Rabland did not apologize, he would call upon his superior in the city administration to disavow him.

were annulled, so that 2,804 valid votes remain. Of these, the General Zionists received 1,638; Poale Zion-Zeire Zion, 823; Hatzr Zion Youth-Fleishchaltz, 163; Revisionists, 161. The General-Zionists have therefore definitely won the first mandate. Their candidates are Chaim Nachman Bialik and Leib Jaffe, and their alternates, Dr. Moscovici and H. Wilensky. While the General Zionists also claim the second mandate, the labor coalition is contesting the claim, which will be settled by the elections committee of the World Congress. The labor candidates are A. L. Schuchheim and Ada Fishman, with Dr. A. S. Yarin and Chaim Charuzi as alternates.

### Roumanian and Bukovinian

#### Jews Meet Own Relief Issue

The impoverished Jewish communities in Roumania and Bukovina, are meeting their welfare problems out of their own meager resources, according to Dr. Bernhard Kahn, European Director of the Joint Distribution Committee, in a report made public here by Rabbi Joseph J. Wise.

Dr. Kahn declared that despite the fact that the Joint Distribution Committee had only given these communities \$1,213 for the purpose of feeding school children, many of them orphans, 1,158 were fed during the past winter.

### American Boycott Leaders

#### Will Meet Here Sept. 12

American leaders of the anti-Nazi boycott will meet here on Sept. 12, to prepare detailed plans for the enforcement of the boycott throughout the country. It was announced yesterday by the American League for the Defense of Jewish Rights. The conference will not be open to the public.
