Funeral Services Today For Ezekiel Sarasohn Editor and Publisher

The funeral of Ezekiel Sarasohn. member of a pioneer family of Tewish publishers in New York City. long an editor of Viddish papers there. Hebrew scholar of note and one of the early advocates of Zionism, will take place this afternoon at the Mount Pleasant Cemetery. Pleasantville, New York. He will be buried on a plot owned by Temnle Israel of New Rochelle, Rabbi Albert Auchs, of Temple Israel, will officiate at the funeral. Mr. Sarasohn died Tuesday at his home in New Rochelle, after a lingering illness. He was 69 years old.

Mr. Sarasohn had resided in New Rochelle since his retirement from the publishing business in 1928. He formerly was publisher and chief editor of the Jewish Gazette and the Tewish Daily News, the former the first conservative orthodox Tewish weekly in the United States and the latter the first daily of its kind in this country.

Born in Suvalki. Poland, he was a son of the late Rabbi Kasrul Hersch Sarasohn and the late Mrs. Bashe Sarasohn. His mother was noted for her charitable activities. Mr. Sarasohn had his training in

Tewish religious schools and under German and Russian private teach-His father preceded him to the United States having become rabbi of a congregation in Syracuse, N. Y. In 1874, Rabbi Sarasohn founded the Gazette which was published on the lower east side of New York.

BERLIN, Aug. 16—A new attempt to rally all Germans in the defense of Hitleriem was made here westerday by Der Deutsche official organ of the Nazi Labor Front, which published an utterly uphelievable story of an alleged plot against the Hitler regime by representatives of "international Jewry", "Soviet Jews" and "international Masons."

The basis for this alleged plot was the presence of all the mea named shove in France at one time. The fact that they were in widely senaseem to hother that Nazi naper. which talks of a secret meeting between them in which the anti-German plot was batched

No details of the alleged plot were revealed by Der Deutsche, the mere presence of the men being regarded as conclusive proof that a combination has been formed by the Iews and the Soviets to take advantage of the increased world chaos and to do Germany harm.
