Jews Cannot Plead in Court or Be Executors Under Two New Decisions

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, Aug. 10.—The principle of a decision handed down by the Labor Court and featured in the current issue of the *Jüdische Wochenschrift*, is that under no circumstances is a Jew allowed to plead in court, independently of whether he is appearing as a lawyer or as representative of a particular trade or vocation.

The occasion for this decision was the appearance of the Jewish secretary of a labor union before the Labor Court, to plead for one of the union members in a dispute between employers and employes.

The lawyers present publicly demanded of the judge that he refuse the Jewish representative the right to appear, which he did. The judge declared that although the government regulations in regard to the inadmissibility of Jews referred only to Jewish lawyers and Jewish notaries he nevertheless must act in the spirit not the letter of the government regulations and forbade the Jewish representative to appear.

A court at Cologne resolved yesterday that a Jewish executor for a non-Jewish will was inadmissible.

Frankfurt Scientist Dies After Attack by Nazis

FRANKFURT, Aug. 10.—Professor G. Embden, prominent physiologist, died here today at the age of 58. He had been ill ever since he was the victim of a Nazi attack which took place a few weeks ago.

While working in his laboratory in the Institute of Physiology of Frankfurt University, Professor Embden was attacked by two Nazis who dragged him out of the building and forced him to parade through the city streets in the midst of a Nazi gang.

The fact that the physiological institute was founded by a Jew did not save the noted German-Jewish scientist from attack.

German Zionists Plead For Restraint, Practical Measures at Congress

BERLIN, Aug. 10.—An appeal to the Eighteenth Zionist Congress, which opens August 21 at Prague, to concentrate its endeavors on practical measures for the settlement of German Jews in Palestine and to refrain from diffuse discussions on the situation which would tend to turn the Congress into a public meeting, is made editorially today by the *Jüdische Rundschau*, official organ of the German Zionist Federation.

"While not expecting anyone to welcome the German Jewish situation," the *Rundschau* declares, "at the same time it is not the duty of the Congress to declare war, but in a Zionist spirit, through practical measures to bring about spiritual encouragement and relief in the situation.

"Perhaps the time has not yet arrived to tackle this matter seriously."

General Zionists Protest Actions Committee Delay On Laborite Demands

PRAGUE, Aug. 10.—A protest against the decision to postpone the meeting of the Actions Committee which was to have met last night was made officially to Dr. Leo Motzkin, chairman of the committee, by the General Zionists, following a lengthy consultation. The General Zionists consider any postponement as being against the spirit of the Zionist constitution.

In calling a meeting of the presidium for today, Dr. Motzkin evaded the earlier decision to postpone the sitting until Thursday. According to Dr. Motzkin, the committee was anxious to gain a few days respite in order to clarify its attitude towards the political problems connected with Palestine as well as with the fate of the Jews in the Diaspora. This is the first time that any divergence of opinion has

East Prussia Ends Mail Delivery to Jews; Children Are Forced Out of Schools

INNSBRUCK, Austria, Aug. 10.—Jews in the province of East Prussia have been informed by the local authorities that mail addressed to them will no longer be delivered. Nazi postmen will therefore not have to be humiliated by serving Jews.

Instead, Jewish residents will have to call at the postoffice personally, after six o'clock in the evening, when there is no danger that they can mingle with Aryans. This arrangement is already popularly known as the "Judenpost."

Jewish parents throughout East Prussia are being compelled to withdraw their children from the public schools because the Christian children are unwilling to share their benches with them and because of the insulting behavior of the teachers. It has become a popular pastime among Nazi school-teachers to confront classes in which there are Jewish children with such questions as "What is the difference between a human being and a Jew?"

Rather than have their children constantly isolated and humiliated by being asked such questions, Jewish parents in large numbers are withdrawing their children from the schools and in many cases, for want of another school to send them, where they will receive better treatment, are keeping them at home.

Large Palestine Surplus Revealed by Treasurer

JERUSALEM, Aug. 10.—A large governmental surplus from Palestinian revenue during the years of 1932 and 1933 is revealed in the report of the Palestine treasurer.

The report, which was made public yesterday, showed a surplus of 1,250,000 pounds. Local bank deposits totaled seven million pounds and another three million were being held abroad to Palestine credit.

The report declared "the unprecedented favorable economic conditions show no signs of abatement."

The Jewish role in the creation of this huge governmental surplus was not mentioned.

Funeral Services Today**For Ezekiel Sarasohn,
Editor and Publisher**

The funeral of Ezekiel Sarasohn, member of a pioneer family of Jewish publishers in New York City, long an editor of Yiddish papers there, Hebrew scholar of note and one of the early advocates of Zionism, will take place this afternoon at the Mount Pleasant Cemetery, Pleasantville, New York. He will be buried on a plot owned by Temple Israel of New Rochelle. Rabbi Albert Auch, of Temple Israel, will officiate at the funeral. Mr. Sarasohn died Tuesday at his home in New Rochelle, after a lingering illness. He was 69 years old.

Mr. Sarasohn had resided in New Rochelle since his retirement from the publishing business in 1928. He formerly was publisher and chief editor of the Jewish Gazette and the Jewish Daily News, the former the first conservative orthodox Jewish weekly in the United States and the latter the first daily of its kind in this country.

Born in Suwalki, Poland, he was a son of the late Rabbi Kasrul Hersch Sarasohn and the late Mrs. Bashe Sarasohn. His mother was noted for her charitable activities.

Mr. Sarasohn had his training in Jewish religious schools and under German and Russian private teachers. His father preceded him to the United States having become rabbi of a congregation in Syracuse, N. Y. In 1874, Rabbi Sarasohn founded the Gazette which was published on the lower east side of New York.

In 1876 Ezekiel Sarasohn followed

New International Plot**Charged by Nazi Press**

BERLIN, Aug. 16—A new attempt to rally all Germans in the defense of Hitlerism, was made here yesterday by Der Deutsche, official organ of the Nazi Labor Front, which published an utterly unbelievable story of an alleged plot against the Hitler regime by representatives of "international Jewry," "Soviet Jews" and "international Masons."

According to Der Deutsche, the plotters are Maxim Litvinoff, Russian Foreign Minister; Leon Trotzky, exiled Soviet leader; Andre Tardieu, former French Premier and Bernard M. Baruch, American financier.

The basis for this alleged plot was the presence of all the men named above in France at one time. The fact that they were in widely separated parts of the country does not seem to bother that Nazi paper, which talks of a secret meeting between them in which the anti-German plot was hatched.

No details of the alleged plot were revealed by Der Deutsche, the mere presence of the men being regarded as conclusive proof that a combination has been formed by the Jews and the Soviets to take advantage of the increased world chaos and to do Germany harm.

Bishop Manning Pageant Sponsor

Bishop William T. Manning, of the Protestant Episcopal Church, is one of more than fifty leading Christians of New York City, who have formed a committee of Christians to aid in the sponsoring of the Jewish pageant, "The Romance of a People," to be given at the Polo Grounds on September 14, according to an announcement by Charles H. Tuttle, chairman of the committee. The Christian Friends Committee has joined with a similar committee headed by Governor Herbert H. Lehman and Nathan Straus, Jr., to raise funds for the settlement of German Jews in Palestine.

Cantor Rabinowitz Honored

SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 16—Cantor Joseph Rabinowitz's forty-third year of service with Temple Beth Israel was honored significantly at the synagogue when special services in tribute to him were conducted here.

There was an appropriate musical service and the long faithful service of the veteran cantor was praised by officers of the congregation.

**Will Boycott Even German
Films If Jews Aid Making**

BERLIN, Aug. 16—Threats that even German-produced films would be boycotted if even one Jewish actor or director participated in the making of the film, are made by the Deutsche Filmschau.

The paper pointed out that a number of films have been released in Germany recently which were made under the direction of Jews. Particular attention was called to the film called "Tunnel," where the technicians and several of the leading actors were Jews.

"Do producers believe," the Filmschau asked, "that the German public, particularly in the provinces, would permit such a state of affairs to continue? As long as any Jews participated in the making of films, no matter in what capacity, even German-made films should be boycotted."

**Stavsky's Father Gets Visa
To Visit Son in Palestine**

WARSAW, Aug. 16—The father of Abraham Stavsky, one of the men held in Palestine in connection with the assassination of Dr. Chaim Arlosoroff, Zionist labor leader, today succeeded in obtaining a visa enabling him to visit his son. The elder Stavsky had previously been refused a visa by the authorities here. It was granted today following an urgent cabled plea to the Palestine Government.

Stavsky will leave for Palestine as soon as he can complete his arrangements.

**Conservative Services
In Seattle for First Time**

SEATTLE, Aug. 16—Seattle's first Conservative Rosh Hashona and Yom Kippur services will be held at Herzl Synagogue, only Conservative house of worship in the state, September 21 and 23 and September 30, Rabbi Philip A. Langh announced today. Rabbi Langh will be assisted by Cantor S. Tovbin and a choir of fourteen voices directed by Boris Dolgoff.

WARSAW, Aug. 16—Three hundred Polish Jews, including a group of 140 chalutzim (settlers) left here today for Palestine.

Thousand Jewish Athletes At Prague Macabadee

PRAGUE, Aug. 16—A thousand Jewish athletes, including a team of one hundred German-Jews and Dr. Daniel Forna, famous German-Jewish tennis player, will participate in the Macabadee, Jewish sports festival which will open here August 23. The games were moved here from Czernowitz, Rumania, after the authorities had uncovered an alleged plot by anti-Semites to assassinate Lord Mitchell, honorary president of the organization.

Forna, who was barred from the German Davis Cup team because of his Jewish ancestry, will wear the colors of the British Macabadee organization.

Poland will have the largest team of athletes in the field, having three hundred entered in the various events, which will include wrestling, boxing, football, tennis and field sports. Germany will have a hundred representatives and Palestine, sixty.

Special trains will be run to Prague from various points, including Austrian cities, to carry the large number of spectators expected to attend the games.

Tighten Rules on Jewish Doctors, Restrict Scope

BERLIN, Aug. 16—Further tightening of the regulations against the Jewish doctors was announced yesterday by Medical Commissioner Wagner. The new regulations prohibit Jewish doctors from replacing Aryan doctors as substitutes or vice versa. Aryan doctors are forbidden to send Jewish doctors to their patients and Jewish doctors are not to send Aryans to Jewish patients. Again Aryan doctors are prohibited from calling Jewish doctors into consultations and similarly, Jewish doctors must not invite non-Jews into consultations.

The commissioner also announced that within a short time the sick fund societies will publish a complete list of all panel doctors, stating clearly who of them are Aryans and who are Jews. Thus the patients will be able to choose for themselves the doctor they prefer. The announcement stated that patients desiring to leave Jewish doctors for Aryans would receive new sick fund cards without any charge.

American Jewish Congress Appeals to Hindenburg To Save German Jews

President von Hindenburg of Germany, in an open letter from the American Jewish Congress, is asked to use his prerogatives under the Weimar Constitution to "rescue from certain extermination the 600,000 Jews of Germany who look to you for succor."

The letter, which is signed by Bernard S. Deutsch, president of the organization, points out that the Weimar Constitution has not been formally abrogated and that the prerogatives of the President of the Republic, which include the right to dissolve the Chancellor, have not been impaired by the enabling act of last March. It expresses the view that in conferring dictatorship powers on Adolf Hitler, it was not the President's intention to "defy the foundations on which the German republic was built" or "to vanquish every principle of humanity in relation to the Jews."

The letter charges the Hitler Government with contravening fifteen articles of the Reich constitution, and enumerates these charges with the specific facts of their violation.

Constitute Contravention

"We submit that the killing of some three hundred Jews and more for no other reason than that they are Jews; that the heinous torture of some 1,000 Jews for no reason except the blind hatred of the National Socialists for the so-called non-Aryan; that the arrest of thousands of Jews and their incarceration in prison camps on spurious charges; that the deprivation of the citizenship rights of the Jews on the ground that they are non-Aryans; that the withdrawal from them of means of livelihood, their exclusion as a parish caste; their exclusion from the political, social and cultural life of the country; the espionage exercised against them; the expropriation of their property and the refusal to permit them free exit from the country, constitute a contravention of the Constitution of the German Republic and inexorably call for the intervention of the President of the Reich," states the preamble to the letter.

Jewish Veterans Not Exempt

"Not even the Jewish veterans of the war are spared from this legislation. To them as to their co-religionists, in every walk of life, every means of subsistence is de-

Confiscate All Property Of Jewish Refugee

LONDON, Aug. 16—The entire property of Hugo Artner, Jewish merchant of Stuttgart, Germany, was confiscated by the Nazi authorities. Mr. Artner and his wife are now in London.

The excuse used by the Nazis was that Mr. Artner had been illegally and secretly exporting capital. According to the regulations now in force in Germany it is forbidden to send any money above a specified sum out of the country. A wide net of espionage has been spread over the entire country and informers have been promised large rewards for cases reported to the authorities. When the new regulations were announced foreign observers said that now an opportunity to pay off all old scores had arisen and the Jewish population felt that it was aimed exclusively at them.

Reports received from Germany today indicate that there have been similar cases of the confiscation of Jewish property under the same allegations.

Palestine Advisors Hold Conference in Berlin

BERLIN, Aug. 16—A conference of 120 advisors in the Palestine bureau of the Zionist organization throughout the Reich, was held in Berlin today for the purpose of fixing the distribution of the thousand immigration certificates allotted for German Jews by the Palestine Government. The certificates are for immigrants who can qualify as artisans and laborers.

The advisors also considered the possibility of Palestine child and youth immigration and the questions of the exporting of funds, money transfers and taxes as these questions affect emigrants to Palestine and their ability to take some of their possessions with them.

Rabbi Bekker Resigns

VANCOUVER, B.C., Aug. 16—Resignation of Rabbi Ben Zion Bekker, young spiritual leader of Beth Israel Congregation, Vancouver, was announced by Nat Bell, congregation president. Rabbi Bekker, an honor graduate of the Jewish Theological Seminary, was Western Canada's only Conservative rabbi.

his father to the United States and began writing for the Gazette.

The Sarachovs founded the Jewish Daily News in 1903, the father becoming chief editor and the son assistant editor. In 1908 when Rabbi Sarachov died, his son became publisher and chief editor. The daily was a morning paper and one of the first Yiddish papers to publish an English section.

For several years Mr. Sarachov published the Hebrew weekly Hahayy. And for three years he was proprietor and publisher of the Chicago Jewish Daily Courier.

Ezekiel Sarachov was a director of the Hias for many years. He was also active in other Jewish charitable groups and in Jewish educational movements. He was a director of the Central Jewish Relief Committee and of the Hebrew National School. He belonged to a number of other societies.

Mr. Sarachov is survived by his widow, the former Dora Franklin; a daughter, Mrs. Frieda Rosett; a son, Eliot Sarachov, and by a brother, Abraham H. Sarachov.

cautiously. This is the reason why German Zionists urged that the present Congress should not be held or that it should be postponed. Since, however, the Congress was not postponed, it is the duty of the Congress management and executive to establish a spirit of creative responsibility dealing only with the two main problems of Palestine work and the German Jewish situation, adopting practical measures to enable Jewish mass emigration from Germany to Palestine."

German Zionists are not participating in the Congress at Prague. Many German Zionist officials who were in Prague have left the city in order not to lay themselves open to Nazi reprisals for any action taken there.

Jewish Council Votes In Favor of Boycott

Approval of the boycott movement was voted by the executive committee of the Jewish Council of Greater New York Tuesday evening at which Bernard G. Richards presided and Stephen Schwartzman was the principal speaker. Members of the council who are members of the executive committee of the American Jewish Congress, with which the council is affiliated, were instructed by resolution to vote in favor of participation by that body in the boycott.

The executive committee decided to call a meeting of all delegates to the council to be held in October, to work out plans for making the council a central agency for New York Jewry.

Milwaukee Jewish Leaders Join Faith Fellowship

MILWAUKEE, Aug. 16—A fellowship of faith, with a local rabbi and an outstanding Jewish layman among its officers, has been organized for participation in the parliament of religions at the Moorlawn hotel in Chicago from August 27 to Sept. 17.

Rabbi Joseph L. Baron of Temple Emanuel-Eli Woe Jechuan has been named vice-chairman and Circuit Judge Charles L. Aaron was appointed an honorary vice-president. The religious parliament, it was explained, is to "unite the inspiration of all faiths upon the solution of man's present problems."

The Jewish executorship, which was cancelled, had originally been granted under the will of a Christian woman who died recently.

The will was made in 1929, the court explained and although the woman died in February, 1933, she couldn't have known how conditions in Germany would be now. Otherwise, the court stated, he felt sure that she would have changed the will of her own accord, substituting an Aryan for the Jewish executor.
